Gonzalez Update

SS Alex Gonzalez yesterday had arthroscopic surgery to remove 4 loose bodies in his right elbow...the 1-hour procedure was performed by Reds medical director Dr. Timothy Kremchek... Gonzalez is expected to miss 4-5 weeks.

Statistically Speaking...

The Reds went 26-21, hit .257 and scored 4.57 runs per game before 1B Joey Votto went on the disabled list on 5/30 and went 8-13, hit .217 and scored 3.38 runs per game during his 21g on the DL.

Oh, Canada

Earlier this spring Toronto native 1B Joey Votto returned home and played at Rogers Centre as a member of Team Canada during the first round World Baseball Classic...in Canada's 6-5 loss to the USA and 6-2 loss to Italy, Votto went 5-for-9 with 2 doubles, 1hr and 2rbi...he led the Canadian club in almost every offensive category...before 42,314 fans here in the tournament opener vs the USA he went 4-for-5 with 2rbi, including a solo homer off Jake Peavy...Votto ranked among the WBC overall leaders in hitting (.556, 2nd), slugging (1.111, 3rd) and on-base percentage (.600, 5th).

Team Venezuela

C/1B Ramon Hernandez also played at Rogers Centre during the first round of the World Baseball Classic...in 4g here for his native Venezuela, Hernandez went 3-for-9 with 1hr and 4rbi in 7-10 and 10-1 victories vs Italy, a 15-6 loss to USA and a 5-3 win vs USA.

Today is Halisactions

Today the Reds reinstated from the 15-day disabled list **1B Joey Votto**...he takes the roster spot vacated by **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo**, who went on the 15-day DL, retroactive to Sunday, with a **torn labrum** in his right shoulder...**Castillo** suffered the season-ending injury on a head-first slide in the seventh inning of Sat's game vs WSox.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 1** of a 3-game series vs **Nadia Flaim's** Blue Jays and **Game 1** of a 6-game road trip that includes an upcoming weekend visit to **Cle's Progressive Field** (3g)...is **Game 4** (1-2) of 9 consecutive contests against American League opponents (1-2 vs WSox, 3g at Tor, 3g at Cle)...the Reds are coming off a **3-3 homestand** vs the **Braves** (2-1) and **White Sox** (1-2).

HOMECOMING: Reds 1B Joey Votto was born in Toronto and grew up in the greater Toronto area of Etobicoke... in 2002 he graduated from Richview Collegiate Institute in Toronto, the same high school as Stephen Harper, the Prime Minister of Canada...in the 9-0 win vs the Cubs on 5/7/08, Votto became only the third Canadian-born player to hit 3 home runs in a Major League game, joining Larry Walker (3 times) and Justin Morneau...he is the only Canadian-born rookie to do it...he sent his game-used cap to the Canadian Baseball Hall of Fame and Museum in St. Mary's, Ontario...in 2007, Votto became the 14th native Canadian to appear for the Reds (LHP Rheal Cormier, RHP Ryan Dempster, RHP Chris Reitsma, OF Glen Gorbous, P Bert Sincock, OF Doc Miller, P Clarence Currie, P Bob Hooper, OF Nigel Wilson, P Rube Vickers, OF Andy Kyle, P Win Kellum, OF Tip O'Neill).

INTERLEAGUE PLAY: In its 13th season, interleague play continues for the Reds on this road trip to **Tor** (3g) and **Cle** (3g)...Cin is **3-6 vs the American League** so far this season (2-1 vs Cle, 0-3 at KC, 1-2 vs WSox)...are in the middle of a stretch of 9 consecutive games vs AL rivals (1-2 vs WSox, 3g at Tor, 3g at Cle)...the Reds are **80-100 (.444) all-time** vs American League teams...their all-time results vs AL teams can be found on page 351 of the media guide.

<u>DOT, DOT, DOT....</u>: The Reds are **34-34**, including **17-17** at Great American Ball Park and **17-17** on the road...are **4-5** after off days...are **22-14** Mondays through Thursdays and **12-20** on the weekends...**Jay Bruce** is tied for the Major League lead with **8 outfield assists...Ryan Hanigan** leads all National League rookie batters in hitting (.325) and on-base percentage (.411)...**Chris Dickerson** ranks second among all NL rookies in on-base percentage (.384)... **Ramon Hernandez** needs 4 runs scored to reach **500** in his career.

EDWIN'S REHAB: **3B Edwin Encarnacion** is on a rehabilitation assignment at Class AAA Louisville (2g, 1-5, 1hr, 3rbi)...in last night's 11-5 Bats victory vs **Gwinnett** he went 1-for-3 with a 3-run HR off **Tony Armas**...he has been on the disabled list since 4/28 with a chip fracture in his left wrist.

M*A*S*H: From the Opening Day roster the Reds are missing starters SS Alex Gonzalez (right elbow surgery, out 4-5 weeks) and 3B Edwin Encarnacion (broken left wrist, rehabbing in Louisville) along with starting RHP Edinson Volquez (right elbow, rehabbing in Cincinnati) and reliever RHP Mike Lincoln (bulging disc in his neck, rehabbing in Cincinnati)...all are on the disabled list...several other players missed action recently because of various ailments, including 2B Brandon Phillips (hairline fracture, right thumb), OF Willy Taveras (tight right hamstring) and IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr. (flu).

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUT: RHP Carlos Fisher and LHP Matt Maloney made their Major League debuts this season...in 2008, 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts: RHP Johnny Cueto, IF Paul Janish, OF Jay Bruce, LHP Daniel Ray Herrera, RHP Daryl Thompson, IF Adam Rosales, OF Chris Dickerson, RHP Ramon Ramirez, C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo and RHP Josh Roenicke.

TOP PICK: With the eighth pick overall, the Reds selected Arizona State University junior **RHP Mike Leake** in the first round of the 2009 first-year player draft...**Leake**, 21, this season went 16-1, 1.36 to help lead the Sun Devils to the upcoming College World Series...his 40 career wins at ASU are the most in school history...is a finalist for the **Golden Spikes Award** and the College Baseball Foundation's **Pitcher of the Year Award**...the lists of Cin's 2008 draft picks and No. 1 draft picks are on pages **212-213** of the media guide...**OF Jay Bruce** is the only first-round pick currently on the Reds' roster (2005 by Cin, 12th overall)...all draft information can be found at <u>reds.com</u>.

<u>VOTE REDS!</u>: Through 7/2, fans can help pick the starting lineups of the 2009 All-Star Game in St. Louis by voting online at <u>reds.com/vote</u>...fans attending games at Great American Ball Park can vote using laptop computers set up near Section 114 on Terrace Level...one online voter per game will be selected randomly to receive a Kroger gift card...fans who vote 25 times online and indicate the Reds as their favorite team automatically are entered in a sweepstakes to win a FOX Sports Champions Club box for 4 for an upcoming game...in-stadium paper balloting ends on 6/28...Reds players on the ballot include C Ramon Hernandez, 1B Joey Votto, 2B Brandon Phillips, SS Alex Gonzalez, 3B Edwin Encarnacion, OF Chris Dickerson, OF Willy Taveras and OF Jay Bruce.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (17-17 .500): The Reds went 4-6-2 in their 12 home series and produced a winning record on just 2 of their 6 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3, 1-2, 3-3)...in 7 seasons at GABP are 258-262-1...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38).

REDS ON THE ROAD (17-17, .500): The Reds went 6-3-2 in their previous 11 road series...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2), a .500 record on the third trip (3-3) and losing records on each of their last 2 road trips (2-5, 2-4)...entering this season and dating to 2006, the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips.

IN THE STANDINGS (78): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 38, FOURTH - 26, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...at 20-14 and again at 26-20 were a season-high 6g over .500...prior to this season hadn't been 6g over .500 since 2006, when they reached a season-high 12g over .500 at 36-24...have spent 62 days above, 9 days at and 7 days below .500.

REDS vs BLUE JAYS: The Reds are 2-4 all-time vs the Blue Jays, including 1-2 at Great American Ball Park in 2003 and 1-2 at the Rogers Centre in 2008.

<u>Last Started</u>: Wed vs Atl and earned the 4-3 victory (6ip, 6h, 2er, 2bb, 0k, 1hr, 108 pitches, 67 strikes)...left leading, 4-2...allowed only a 2-run HR to Escobar in the third inning...in the fifth frame hit a 3-run HR off Vazquez that gave the Reds their 4-2 lead...was his second homer of the season, the seventh of his career.

Red Hots: Is making his 13th start of the season, his first appearance of the season vs an American League team and his first career appearance vs the Blue Jays...in his previous 12 starts the Reds went 5-7 and scored 48 runs (4 r/g)...has 4 quality starts...with an 8-2 win on 4/26 vs Atl snapped his 9-game losing streak dating back to a 9-3 Diamondbacks victory on 5/25/08 at Atl...in 14 apps and 10 starts between victories went 0-9 8 53

In Relief: Made his only relief appearance of the season in the 16-inning, 6-5 loss at SD on 5/16...threw a career-high 5.2 innings in relief (3h, 1er, 3bb, 5k, 1hr, 81 pitches, 44 strikes)...entered the game in the 11th inning as the Reds' seventh and final pitcher...retired his first 10 batters until Scott Hairston singled with 1 out in the 14th inning...Nick Hundley homered to end the 5-hour, 14 minute struggle...in 6 starts since then is 1-3, 5.23 (31ip, 18er).

At The Plate: In 2007 won the National League's Silver Slugger Award (.333, 4hr, 15rbi)...has 7 career home runs, including 2 this season (5/10 vs StL, pinch-hit solo off Ryan Franklin & 6/17 vs Atl, 3-run off Javier Vazquez)...his 5 career home runs prior to 2009 are listed on page 149 of the media guide...on 5/7 vs Mil produced the first triple by a Reds pitcher since Eric Milton did it on 4/13/06 at Cubs.

Owings' Most Recent Starts: 4/21 at Chi, in the Reds' first game of the season at Wrigley Field and suffered the 7-2 loss (4.2ip, 5h, 5r, 2er, 4bb, 3k, 1hr, 94 pitches, 61 strikes)...left trailing, 4-2, but was charged with another run scored off Lincoln...in the second inning allowed a leadoff HR to Micah Hoffpauir...in the fifth was charged with 3 unearned runs...start of the game was delayed 12 minutes by weather...gametime temperature was 40 degrees with a 15 mile per hour wind blowing left to right...4/26 vs Atl and earned the 8-2 victory (7ip, 6h, 1er, 3bb, 6k, 1hr, 102 pitches, 60 strikes)...left leading, 8-1...allowed only a solo HR to David Ross with 1 out in the seventh inning...his first victory since May 2008 snapped a personal 9-game losing streak...5/2 at Pit and suffered the 8-6 loss (5.2ip, 9h, 5er, 2bb, 0k, 99 pitches, 64 strikes)...left trailing, 5-3...in the first inning allowed 4 runs on 4 hits, 1 walk and 1 hit batter...**5/7 vs Mil** and earned the 6-5 victory (6ip, 7h, 5r, 4er, 1bb, 4k, 100 pitches, 67 strikes)...left leading, 6-5...allowed 3 runs in the fourth inning and 2 runs in the sixth...his RBI-triple in the bottom of the fourth off Braden Looper gave the Reds a 4-3 lead they would not relinquish...5/12 at Ari, in his first career appearance vs his former team earned the 3-1 victory (7+ip, 4h, 1er, 2bb, 4k, 1hbp, 90 pitches, 53 strikes)...took a 4-hit shutout into the eighth inning but then hit with a pitch leadoff batter Ryan Roberts...was charged with that run, which scored on Felipe Lopez' RBI-double off Arthur Rhodes...5/21 vs Phi and suffered the 12-5 loss (3ip, 6h, 5er, 3bb, 3k, 1hr, 71 pitches, 41 strikes)...left trailing, 5-0... allowed 1 run in the first inning, 3 runs in the second and a solo HR to Dobbs in the third...5/26 vs Hou and received no decision in the 6-4 victory (5ip, 6h, 3er, 4bb, 3k, 99 pitches, 62 strikes)...allowed all 3 runs in the fourth inning on a 2-run double by Rodriguez and a run-scoring single by Maysonet...5/31 at Mil and suffered the 5-2 loss (5.2ip, 8h, 5er, 3bb, 5k, 1hr, 103 pitches, 67 strikes)...left trailing, 5-2, but retired 10 of his 11 final batters...in the first inning allowed consecutive 2-out, RBI-singles to Cameron and Gamel...in the second allowed a sac fly to Hardy...in the third allowed Cameron's 2-run HR...6/5 vs Cubs and suffered the 2-1 loss (6ip, 5h, 2er, 3bb, 6k, 1hr, 98 pitches, 64 strikes)...left trailing, 2-0...allowed only a bases-loaded walk to Fontenot in the first inning and a solo HR to Zambrano in the fifth...6/11 at Wsh and was the victim of a blown save in the 3-2 loss (5.1ip, 4h, 1er, 4bb, 4k, 2hbp, 1wp, 102 pitches, 56 strikes)...left leading, 2-0, but was charged with a run scored off Burton...the Nats took a 3-2 lead with a 2-run eighth inning off Fisher, Herrera and Masset...through 5 scoreless innings allowed 2 hits, 4 walks and 2hbp but stranded all 8 baserunners.

Tomorrow's Pitcher: Bronson Arroyo

<u>Last Pitched</u>: Fri vs WSox and earend the 4-3 victory (6.2ip, 2h, 2er, 4bb, 7k, 1hr, 108 pitches, 63 strikes)...left leading, 3-2... allowed only a 2-run HR to Getz in the fourth inning, Getz' first Major League homer.

Red Hots: Tomorrow will make his 15th start of the season, his fourth vs an American League club...with 8 victories is 1 shy of the National League leaders...in his previous 14 starts the Reds went 8-6 and scored 63 runs (4.50 r/g)...has 8 quality starts...since he was acquired by the Reds prior to the 2006 season leads all Major League pitchers with 117 starts and ranks second in the National League with 740.1 innings pitched (Aaron Harang 1st, 743.2ip).

Arroyo vs Blue Jays: In his most recent start vs Tor, a 14-1 loss here on 6/24 of last season, became only the sixth starting pitcher in Major League history to allowed at least 10 earned runs while retiring 3 batters or fewer...since that start has gone 19-9...the 19 wins are the second-most in the Major Leagues since then (Halladay, 22-6).

Short Cuts: Made the 2 shortest starts of his career (1ip, plus 4 batters) in a 14-1 loss at Tor on 6/24/08 and a 15-3 loss on 5/6/09 vs Mil...in between those 2 starts went 15-5, 3.76...since that 6/24/08 loss at Tor ranks second in the Major Leagues with 19 wins (Halladay, 22 wins).

In The Big Inning: Allowed at least 1 run in the first inning of 7 of his 14 starts, including 5 of his last 6 starts...has posted an 8.36era in the first inning (14ip, 13er) and a 4.56era after the first frame (75ip, 38er).
