Gonzalez Update

SS Alex Gonzalez yesterday had arthroscopic surgery to remove 4 loose bodies in his right elbow...the 1-hour procedure was performed by Reds medical director **Dr. Timothy Kremchek**... **Gonzalez** is expected to miss 4-5 weeks.

Statistically Speaking...

The Reds went **26-21**, hit **.257** and scored **4.57** runs per game before **1B Joey Votto** went on the disabled list on **5/30** and went **8-13**, hit **.217** and scored **3.38** runs per game during his 21g on the DL.

Oh, Canada

Earlier this spring Toronto native **1B Joey Votto** returned home and played at **Rogers Centre** as a member of **Team Canada** during the first round **World Baseball Classic**...in **Canada's** 6-5 loss to the USA and 6-2 loss to Italy, **Votto** went 5-for-9 with 2 doubles, 1hr and 2rbi...he led the Canadian club in almost every offensive category...before **42,314** fans here in the tournament opener vs the USA he went 4-for-5 with 2rbi, including a solo homer off **Jake Peavy**...**Votto** ranked among the WBC overall leaders in **hitting** (.556, 2nd), **slugging** (1.111, 3rd) and **on-base percentage** (.600, 5th).

Team Venezuela

C/1B Ramon Hernandez also played at **Rogers Centre** during the first round of the **World Baseball Classic**...in 4g here for his native **Venezuela**, **Hernandez** went 3-for-9 with 1hr and 4rbi in 7-10 and 10-1 victories vs Italy, a 15-6 loss to USA and a 5-3 win vs USA.

Today's Transactions

Today the Reds reinstated from the 15-day disabled list **1B Joey Votto**...he takes the roster spot vacated by **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo**, who went on the 15-day DL, retroactive to Sunday, with a **torn labrum** in his right shoulder...**Castillo** suffered the season-ending injury on a head-first slide in the seventh inning of Sat's game vs WSox.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 1** of a 3-game series vs **Nadia Flaim's** Blue Jays and **Game 1** of a 6-game road trip that includes an upcoming weekend visit to **Cle's Progressive Field** (3g)...is **Game 4** (1-2) of 9 consecutive contests against American League opponents (1-2 vs WSox, 3g at Tor, 3g at Cle)...the Reds are coming off a **3-3 homestand** vs the **Braves** (2-1) and **White Sox** (1-2).

HOMECOMING: Reds **1B Joey Votto** was born in **Toronto** and grew up in the greater Toronto area of **Etobicoke**...in 2002 he graduated from **Richview Collegiate Institute** in Toronto, the same high school as **Stephen Harper**, the **Prime Minister of Canada**...in the 9-0 win vs the Cubs on 5/7/08, **Votto** became only the third Canadian-born player to hit 3 home runs in a Major League game, joining **Larry Walker** (3 times) and **Justin Morneau**...he is the only Canadian-born *rookie* to do it...he sent his game-used cap to the **Canadian Baseball Hall of Fame and Museum** in St. Mary's, Ontario...in 2007, **Votto** became the 14th native Canadian to appear for the Reds (LHP Rheal Cormier, RHP Ryan Dempster, RHP Chris Reitsma, OF Glen Gorbous, P Bert Sincok, OF Doc Miller, P Clarence Currie, P Bob Hooper, OF Nigel Wilson, P Rube Vickers, OF Andy Kyle, P Win Kellum, OF Tip O'Neill).

INTERLEAGUE PLAY: In its 13th season, interleague play continues for the Reds on this road trip to **Tor** (3g) and **Cle** (3g)...Cin is **3-6 vs the American League** so far this season (2-1 vs Cle, 0-3 at KC, 1-2 vs WSox)...are in the middle of a stretch of 9 consecutive games vs AL rivals (1-2 vs WSox, 3g at Tor, 3g at Cle)...the Reds are **80-100 (.444) all-time** vs American League teams...their all-time results vs AL teams can be found on page 351 of the media guide.

DOT, DOT, DOT....: The Reds are **34-34**, including **17-17** at Great American Ball Park and **17-17** on the road...are **4-5** after off days...are **22-14** Mondays through Thursdays and **12-20** on the weekends...**Jay Bruce** is tied for the Major League lead with **8 outfield assists**...**Ryan Hanigan** leads all National League rookie batters in hitting (.325) and on-base percentage (.411)...**Chris Dickerson** ranks second among all NL rookies in on-base percentage (.384)...**Ramon Hernandez** needs 4 runs scored to reach **500** in his career.

EDWIN'S REHAB: **3B Edwin Encarnacion** is on a rehabilitation assignment at Class AAA Louisville (2g, 1-5, 1hr, 3rbi)...in last night's 11-5 Bats victory vs **Gwinnett** he went 1-for-3 with a 3-run HR off **Tony Armas**...he has been on the disabled list since 4/28 with a chip fracture in his left wrist.

M*A*S*H: From the **Opening Day** roster the Reds are missing starters **SS Alex Gonzalez** (right elbow surgery, out 4-5 weeks) and **3B Edwin Encarnacion** (broken left wrist, rehabbing in Louisville) along with starting **RHP Edinson Volquez** (right elbow, rehabbing in Cincinnati) and reliever **RHP Mike Lincoln** (bulging disc in his neck, rehabbing in Cincinnati)...all are on the disabled list...several other players missed action recently because of various ailments, including **2B Brandon Phillips** (hairline fracture, right thumb), **OF Willy Taveras** (tight right hamstring) and **IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr.** (flu).

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUT: **RHP Carlos Fisher** and **LHP Matt Maloney** made their Major League debuts this season...in 2008, 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts: **RHP Johnny Cueto**, **IF Paul Janish**, **OF Jay Bruce**, **LHP Daniel Ray Herrera**, **RHP Daryl Thompson**, **IF Adam Rosales**, **OF Chris Dickerson**, **RHP Ramon Ramirez**, **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** and **RHP Josh Roenicke**.

TOP PICK: With the eighth pick overall, the Reds selected Arizona State University junior **RHP Mike Leake** in the first round of the 2009 first-year player draft...**Leake**, 21, this season went 16-1, 1.36 to help lead the Sun Devils to the upcoming College World Series...his 40 career wins at ASU are the most in school history...is a finalist for the **Golden Spikes Award** and the College Baseball Foundation's **Pitcher of the Year Award**...the lists of Cin's 2008 draft picks and No. 1 draft picks are on pages **212-213** of the media guide...**OF Jay Bruce** is the only first-round pick currently on the Reds' roster (2005 by Cin, 12th overall)...all draft information can be found at reds.com.

VOTE REDS!: Through **7/2**, fans can help pick the starting lineups of the **2009 All-Star Game** in St. Louis by voting online at reds.com/vote...fans attending games at Great American Ball Park can vote using **laptop computers** set up near **Section 114** on Terrace Level...one online voter per game will be selected randomly to receive a **Kroger gift card**...fans who vote 25 times online and indicate the Reds as their favorite team automatically are entered in a sweepstakes to win a **FOX Sports Champions Club** box for 4 for an upcoming game...in-stadium paper balloting ends on **6/28**...Reds players on the ballot include **C Ramon Hernandez**, **1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips**, **SS Alex Gonzalez**, **3B Edwin Encarnacion**, **OF Chris Dickerson**, **OF Willy Taveras** and **OF Jay Bruce**.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (17-17 .500): The Reds went **4-6-2** in their **12 home series** and produced a winning record on just 2 of their 6 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3, 1-2, 3-3)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **258-262-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38).

REDS ON THE ROAD (17-17 .500): The Reds went **6-3-2** in their previous **11 road series**...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2), a .500 record on the third trip (3-3) and losing records on each of their last 2 road trips (2-5, 2-4)...entering this season and dating to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

IN THE STANDINGS (78): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: **FIRST** - 1, **SECOND** - 9, **THIRD** - 38, **FOURTH** - 26, **FIFTH** - 3, **SIXTH** - 1...at **20-14** and again at **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g over .500** at **36-24**...have spent **62** days above, **9** days at and **7** days below .500.

REDS vs BLUE JAYS: The Reds are 2-4 all-time vs the Blue Jays, including 1-2 at Great American Ball Park in 2003 and 1-2 at the Rogers Centre in 2008.

IF Paul Janish pitched in the ninth inning of the 15-3 loss vs Mil on 5/6 (1ip, 5h, 5er, 0bb, 2k, Fielder 2-run HR)...he became the first Reds position player to pitch since Lenny Harris on 6/1/98 at SF.				

Reds Pitchers: Rank sixth in the National League with a 3.96 team ERA...**on the homestand went 3-3, 4.67 (54ip, 28er)**...in the last 17g are 7-10, 3.59 (158ip, 63er)...already have 6 team shutouts...had 6 shutouts all last season...with a 7-0 win on 5/5 at Fla reached 6 shutouts in their 26th game, their fastest to 6 team shutouts since the 1914 Reds threw their sixth shutout in their 25th game.

Reds Starters: Rank seventh in the National League with 4.19 rotation ERA...**on the homestand went 2-2, 5.06 (32ip, 18er)**...in the last 17g are 4-7, 3.43 (102.1ip, 39er)...have produced 34 quality starts (**Cueto 10, Arroyo 8, Harang 8, Owings 4, Volquez 3, Maloney 1**)...the Reds went 25-9 in those quality starts (.735)...from 6/3-6/10 produced a season-high 7 consecutive quality starts, their best stretch since they threw 8 consecutive QS from **8/6-8/14, 2005**...through the first 41g of the season used just 5 starting pitchers, their longest such streak to begin a year since **RHP John Roper** became the staff's **sixth** different starter in the **42nd game** of the **1994 campaign**...on 5/23 vs Cle, in the club's 42nd game, **RHP Homer Bailey** became the Reds' sixth starting pitcher...**Aaron Harang** threw a 3-hitter in the 2-0 win vs Pit in the club's fifth game of the season...was the earliest complete game by a Reds pitcher since **Pete Harnisch** beat the Cardinals, 3-0 in Busch Stadium, in the **fourth** contest of the **1999** campaign.

Reds Relievers: Rank third in the National League with a 3.49 bullpen ERA (SF 3.34, LAD 3.44)...**on the homestand went 1-1, 4.09 (22ip, 10er, 2sv)**...in their last 58g have posted a 2.89era (183.2ip, 59er) and in their last 46g have posted a 2.83era (149.2ip, 47er)...**the previous note does not include the pitching performance by IF Paul Janish in the ninth inning of the 15-3 loss on 5/6 vs Mil (1ip, 5er)**...had 1 blown save in their first 51g and then 3 blown saves in their next 5g...didn't blow a save until the club's 36th game, a 6-5 loss in 16 innings on 5/16 at SD...for the second straight season the Reds' bullpen was the last in the Major Leagues to suffer a blown save...in 2008 didn't blow a save until the 41st game (5/14)...over the last 2 seasons **Francisco Cordero** has recorded **51** of the bullpen's **52** saves (34sv in 2008, 17sv in 2009)...**David Weathers** has the only other save over the last 2 seasons (6/10/09 at Wsh).

Was optioned to Louisville on 6/1, when Volquez came off the disabled list...was recalled the next day, when Volquez returned to the disabled list, and threw 2.0 scoreless innings that night at StL...in 6 apps since his recall has posted a 1.04era (8.2ip, 1er).

With 17 saves ranks 2 behind the National League leaders...converted 17 of his 18 save opps...in the 12-inning, 4-2 win on 6/10 at Wsh suffered his first blown save since 7/21/08 vs SD...had converted 29 consecutive save chances, including all 15 save opps this year...including last season has recorded 51 of the bullpen's last 52 saves (34sv in 2008, 17sv in 2009, Weathers 1sv in 2009)...with 228 career saves ranks 30th on that all-time list...Ugeth Urbina is 29th with 237 saves...in the 3-0 victory on 4/22 at Chi recorded his 100th save in the National League to become only the 11th pitcher in history with at least 100 saves in each league (see box below).
