Heating Up

In his last 13g **Jonny Gomes** is hitting .375 (12-32, 4 2b, 3hr, 6rbi), raising BA from .286...he has served as the Reds' DH in all 5 interleague road games (5-15, .333, 2 2b, 2 solo HR, 3bb, 3r).

Statistically Speaking...

The Reds went **26-21**, hit **.257** and scored **4.57** runs per game before **1B Joey Votto** went on the disabled list on **5/30** and went **8-13**, hit **.217** and scored **3.38** runs per game during his 21g on the disabled list...in the 2g since his return are **10-for-61** (.164) with 7 runs scored (3.5 r/g).

Oh, Canada

Earlier this spring Toronto native **1B Joey Votto** returned home and played at **Rogers Centre** as a member of **Team Canada** during the first round **World Baseball Classic**...in **Canada's** 6-5 loss to the USA and 6-2 loss to Italy, **Votto** went 5-for-9 with 2 doubles, 1hr and 2rbi...he led the Canadian club in almost every offensive category...before **42,314** fans here in the tournament opener vs the USA he went 4-for-5 with 2rbi, including a solo homer off **Jake Peavy**...**Votto** ranked among the WBC overall leaders in **hitting** (.556, 2nd), **slugging** (1.111, 3rd) and **on-base percentage** (.600, 5th).

Team Venezuela

C/1B Ramon Hernandez also played at **Rogers Centre** during the first round of the **World Baseball Classic**...in 4g here for his native **Venezuela**, **Hernandez** went 3-for-9 with 1hr and 4rbi in 7-10 and 10-1 victories vs Italy, a 15-6 loss to USA and a 5-3 win vs USA.

Ohio Cup MVP

The **Most Outstanding Player** of the 6-game series between the Reds and Indians will receive the coveted **Ohio Cup** trophy, presented by **The Ohio Lottery**...Reds **OF Adam Dunn** won the MOP last year (.300, 5hr, 10rbi)...the 2009 series concludes this weekend...leading candidates for this year's **Ohio Cup** trophy include Cin's **Ramon Hernandez** (5-11, .455, 1hr, 2rbi) and **Joey Votto** (2-4, .500, 2hr, 4rbi) along with Cle's **Grady Sizemore** (4-12, .333, 1hr, 2rbi) and **Mark DeRosa** (3-11, .273, 1hr, 4rbi).

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 3** (0-2) of a 3-game series vs **Val Vagners'** Blue Jays and **Game 3** (0-2) of a 6-game road trip that includes an upcoming weekend visit to **Cle's Progressive Field** (3g)...is **Game 6** (1-4) of 9 consecutive contests against American League opponents (1-2 vs WSox, 0-2 at Tor, 3g at Cle).

INTERLEAGUE PLAY: In its 13th season, interleague play continues for the Reds on this road trip to **Tor** and **Cle**...Cin is **3-8 vs the American League** so far this season (2-1 vs Cle, 0-3 at KC, 1-2 vs WSox, **0-2 at Tor**, 3g at Cle)...are **1-4** in a stretch of 9 consecutive games vs AL rivals (1-2 vs WSox, **0-2 at Tor**, 3g at Cle)...the Reds are **80-102 (.440) all-time** vs American League teams...their all-time results vs AL teams can be found on page 351 of the media guide.

HEADING INTO THE BREAK: Following this road trip the Reds return to Great American Ball Park for their final homestand of the season's first half, a 6-game set vs the **Diamondbacks** (3g) and **Cardinals** (3g)...will finish the first half on the road at **Phi** (4g) and **NYM** (3g), including their first visit to the Mets' new **Citi Field**.

STREAKING: The Reds have lost **4 straight games** (0-2 vs WSox, 0-2 at Tor), **9 of their last 12g**, their **last 6 road games** (0-1 at Wsh, 0-3 at KC, 0-2 at Tor) and **all 5 interleague road games** (0-3 at KC, 0-2 at Tor)...the 4-game losing streak and 6-game road losing streak tie season highs...at **34-36** are a season-high 2g below .500 for the third time (0-2, 1-3)...today's 4.5-game deficit ties the Reds' season high.

NATIONAL TREASURE: Reds **1B Joey Votto** was born in **Toronto** and grew up in the greater Toronto area of **Etobicoke**...in 2002 he graduated from **Richview Collegiate Institute** in Toronto, the same high school as **Stephen Harper**, the **Prime Minister of Canada**...in the 9-0 win vs the Cubs on 5/7/08, **Votto** became only the third Canadian-born player to hit 3 home runs in a Major League game, joining **Larry Walker** (3 times) and **Justin Morneau**...he is the only Canadian-born *rookie* to do it...he sent his game-used cap to the **Canadian Baseball Hall of Fame and Museum** in St. Mary's, Ontario...in 2007, **Votto** became the 14th native Canadian to appear for the Reds (LHP Rheal Cormier, RHP Ryan Dempster, RHP Chris Reitsma, OF Glen Gorbous, P Bert Sincok, OF Doc Miller, P Clarence Currie, P Bob Hooper, OF Nigel Wilson, P Rube Vickers, OF Andy Kyle, P Win Kellum, OF Tip O'Neill).

DOT, DOT, DOT....: **Jay Bruce** is tied for the Major League lead with **8 outfield assists**...**Ryan Hanigan** leads all National League rookie batters in hitting (.325) and on-base percentage (.411)...**Chris Dickerson** ranks second among all NL rookies in on-base percentage (.383)...**Ramon Hernandez** needs 3 runs scored to reach **500** in his career.

EDWIN'S REHAB: **3B Edwin Encarnacion** is on a rehabilitation assignment at Class AAA Louisville (4g, 3-14, .214, 2hr, 5rbi, 2bb, 3k)...in last night's 5-0 Bats victory at **Charlotte** he went 2-for-5 with a 2-run HR...he has been on the disabled list since 4/28 with a chip fracture in his left wrist.

M*A*S*H: From the **Opening Day** roster the Reds are missing starters **SS Alex Gonzalez** (right elbow surgery, out 4-5 weeks) and **3B Edwin Encarnacion** (broken left wrist, rehabbing in Louisville) along with starting **RHP Edinson Volquez** (right elbow, rehabbing in Cincinnati) and reliever **RHP Mike Lincoln** (bulging disc in his neck, rehabbing in Cincinnati)...all are on the disabled list...several other players missed action recently because of various ailments, including **1B Joey Votto** (stress), **2B Brandon Phillips** (hairline fracture, right thumb), **OF Willy Taveras** (tight right hamstring) and **IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr.** (flu)...on Wednesday **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** will have surgery to repair the torn labrum in his right shoulder...**Castillo** suffered the season-ending injury on a head-first slide in the seventh inning of Saturday's game vs the White Sox.

TOP PICK: With the eighth pick overall, the Reds selected Arizona State University junior **RHP Mike Leake** in the first round of the 2009 first-year player draft...**Leake**, 21, this season went 16-1, 1.36 to help lead the Sun Devils to the upcoming College World Series...his 40 career wins at ASU are the most in school history...is a finalist for the **Golden Spikes Award** and the College Baseball Foundation's **Pitcher of the Year Award**...the lists of Cin's 2008 draft picks and No. 1 draft picks are on pages **212-213** of the media guide...**OF Jay Bruce** is the only first-round pick currently on the Reds' roster (2005 by Cin, 12th overall)...all draft information can be found at reds.com.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (17-17, .500): The Reds went **4-6-2 in their 12 home series** and produced a winning record on just 2 of their 6 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3, 1-2, 3-3)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **258-262-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38).

REDS ON THE ROAD (17-19, .472): The Reds have lost their last 6 road games (0-1 at Wsh, 0-3 at KC, 0-2 at Tor)...the 6-game road losing streak ties their longest of the season (5/15-5/31)...including this one have gone **6-4-2 in their 12 road series**...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2), a .500 record on the third trip (3-3) and losing records on each of their last 2 road trips (2-5, 2-4)...entering this season and dating to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

IN THE STANDINGS (80): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 38, FOURTH - 28, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...at **20-14** and again at **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g over .500** at **36-24**...at **34-36 are a season-high 2g under .500 for the third time (0-2, 1-3)**...have spent **62** days above, **9** days at and **9** days below .500.

REDS vs BLUE JAYS: The Reds are 2-6 all-time vs the Blue Jays, including 1-2 at Great American Ball Park in 2003, 1-2 at the Rogers Centre in 2008 and 0-2 at Rogers Center in 2009.

UP NEXT: REDS vs INDIANS: The Reds are 29-31 all-time vs the Indians, including 2-1 in 2009 and 7-2 the last 2 seasons...have won 4 of the last 5g vs Cle...at **Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 11-7, including 2-1 in 2009, 5-1 the last 2 seasons and 7-2 the last 3 years...have won 6 of the last 7g there vs Cle...at **Progressive Field:** Reds are 14-16, including 2-1 in 2008...Cin has lost 11 of the last 17g there...**last Reds sweep:** at Cin: 5/16-5/18, 2008...at Cle: never...**last Indians sweep:** at Cin: 6/11-6/13, 1999 (3g)...at Cle: 6/11-6/13, 2004 (3g).

Last Pitched: Sat vs WSox and received no decision in the 10-8 loss (4.2ip, 10h, 5er, 0bb, 4k, 3hr, 82 pitches, 54 strikes)...left with the score tied, 5-5...allowed all 5 runs on homers (Beckham 3-run, Podsednik solo, Pierzynski solo)...the 10 hits allowed were a career high and the 3 homers allowed tied his career high.

Red Hots: The 23-year-old righthander is making his 15th start of the season, the 46th start of his career...is his fourth start of the season vs an American League team and his first career appearance against the Blue Jays...ranks among the National League leaders with a 2.55era (3rd) and a .231 opponents' BA (8th)...in his 14 starts the Reds went 8-6 and scored 59 runs (4.21 r/g)...in 9 of his 14 starts threw at least 7.0 innings and in 12 of his 14 starts threw at least 6.0 innings.

Quality: Leads the team with 10 quality starts...his strings of 5 consecutive QS (4/22-5/13, 5/24-6/14) are the longest stretches of quality starts by a Reds pitcher this season...last year, **Edinson Volquez** produced a string of 12 straight QS (4/22-6/20).

No Place Like Home...For the fifth time in 6 starts is pitching on the road...for the season is **1-2, 3.96** in 6 starts at home (38.2ip, 17er) and **5-2, 1.53** in 8 starts on the road (53ip, 9er).

Streaking I: In 5 starts from 4/22-5/13 went **4-0, 1.25** (36ip, 5er)...the 4-game winning streak was the longest of his career...allowed 4 earned runs in his first start of the season (6ip) and 22 earned runs in his last 13 starts (85.2ip, 2.31era).

Streaking II: In each of 4 starts from 4/22-5/8 threw at least 7.0 innings while allowing no more than 1 run, the longest streak of that kind by a Reds pitcher since **Tim Belcher** had a 4-game run from **5/27-6/13, 1992** (courtesy Elias Sports Bureau).

World Baseball Classic: Started the Dominican Republic's second game of the tournament and threw 4.2 scoreless innings to earn the 9-0 win vs Panama in the San Juan bracket (4.2ip, 3h, 1bb, 5k).

Career Highs: **Innings:** 8.0, 5/3/09 at Pit (longest) & 1.2 (shortest), 4/29/08 at StL; **Hits:** 10, 6/20/09 vs WSox; **Runs:** 7, 4/29/08 at StL; **Earned Runs:** 6 (4x), last on 7/17/08 vs NYM; **Walks:** 8, 6/11/08 vs StL; **Strikeouts:** 10 (2x), 4/3/08 vs Ari (ML debut) & 7/22/08 vs SD; **HR allowed:** 3 (2x), 5/16/08 vs Cle (Blake & Hafner, Peralta) & 6/20 vs WSox (Beckham, Podsednik, Pierzynski).

Cueto's Most Recent Starts: **5/19 vs Phi** and suffered the 4-3 loss (7ip, 7h, 4er, 0bb, 4k, 1hr, 112 pitches, 68 strikes)...in the second inning allowed a solo HR to Howard...allowed 3 runs in the fifth on Rollins' RBI-double, Utley's RBI-single and a sac fly by Ibanez...**5/24 vs Cle** and received no decision in the 11-inning, 4-3 victory (7ip, 6h, 3r, 2er, 3bb, 7k, 2hnp, 1wp, 111 pitches, 67 strikeouts)...left with the score tied, 3-3...allowed all 3 runs with 2 outs...in the fourth inning gave up a run-scoring double to Luis Valbuena...in the seventh allowed an RBI-triple to Grady Sizemore, who then scored on the play after obstruction was called on 3B Adam Rosales...**5/29 at Mil** and suffered the 3-2 loss (7ip, 3h, 3er, 4bb, 3k, 2hr, 104 pitches, 64 strikes)...left trailing, 3-2...allowed just 3 hits, but 2 of the hits were home runs that produced all 3 Brewers runs...in the first inning retired the first 2 batters but then walked Braun and allowed a 2-run HR to Fielder...Hart homered leading off the Brewers' seventh...**6/3 at StL** and earned the 9-3 win (6.1ip, 7h, 1er, 0bb, 3k, 101 pitches, 69 strikes)...left leading, 4-1...allowed his only run on consecutive doubles by Rasmus and Ryan in the seventh inning...**6/9 at Wsh** and earned the 3-2 victory (7ip, 4h, 1er, 4bb, 5k, 1hr, 111 pitches, 66 strikes)...allowed only a solo HR to Dukes with 1 out in the fourth inning...threw 27 of his 111 pitches in the first inning, when he walked 2 batters and stranded 3 baserunners...**6/14 at KC** and suffered the 7-1 loss (6ip, 7h, 5r, 0er, 1bb, 4k, 110 pitches, 75 strikes)...left trailing, 5-1...all 5 runs were unearned following a pair of Hairston errors.

Tomorrow at Indians: RHP Aaron Harang

Last Started: Sun vs WSox and suffered the 4-1 loss (7ip, 8h, 3er, 0bb, 7k, 97 pitches, 66 strikes)...left trailing, 3-0...allowed 2 runs on 3 hits in the first inning and another run in the fifth on an RBI-infield single.

Red Hots: Tomorrow at Cle will make his 16th start of the season, his second against an American League team...in 4 starts in June is **0-2, 2.19** (24.2ip, 6er)...in his previous 15 starts the Reds went 7-8 and scored 57 runs (3.80 r/g)...in his 15 starts **Reds batters** hit .241 (120-497)...on 6/4 at StL suffered the 3-1 loss in a game in which **Harang** and **Chris Carpenter** each threw a complete game.

Home Cookin': Is **4-3, 2.87** (47ip, 15er) in 8 starts at Great American Ball Park and **1-4, 4.47** (46.1ip, 23er) in 7 starts on the road.

Streaking: From **4/28-6/4** allowed a home run in 8 consecutive apps (10hr), the longest streak by a Reds pitcher since **RHP Ramon Ortiz** tied the National League record by allowing a home run in **15** consecutive apps from **5/1-7/17, 2005**.

Milestones: On 4/23 at Chi recorded the **1,000th strikeout** of his career (**Derrek Lee**)...his 3-hitter in the club's fifth game, a 2-0 win on 4/12 vs Pit, was the quickest complete game by a Reds pitcher since **Pete Harnisch** threw a CG in the Reds' fourth game of **1999**.

Staff Ace: Since he was acquired from the Athletics at the **2003 trading deadline** is the Reds' leader in most statistical pitching categories, including starts (182), wins (68), innings pitched (1162.1) and strikeouts (978)...since the beginning of the **2006 season** ranks second in the National League **743.2** innings pitched (**Arroyo 1st, 744ip**)...in 2005 and 2007 won the BBWAA's Johnny Vander Meer Award as the club's Most Outstanding Pitcher.
