In his last 14g **Jonny Gomes** is hitting .389 (14-36, 5 2b, 3hr, 7rbi), raising BA from .286...he has served as the Reds' DH in all 6 interleague road games (7-19, .368, 3 2b, 2hr, 3rbi, 4bb, 4r).

Statistically Speaking...

The Reds went 26-21, hit .257 and scored 4.57 runs per game before 1B Joey Votto went on the disabled list on 5/30...during his 21g on the disabled list the Reds went 8-13, hit .217 and scored 3.38 runs per game...in the 3g since Votto's return the Reds are 1-2, hitting .250 (25-100) and have scored 4.67 runs per game (14r).

Class AA Carolina OF Chris Heisey (U.S. Team) and Class A Dayton RHP Juan Carlos Sulbaran (World Team) have been selected to participate in Major League Baseball's XM II-Star Futures Game on Sunday, 7/12 at Busch Stadium in St. Louis...Futures Game alumni include Reds players Jay Bruce (2007), Francisco Cordero (1999), Edwin Encarnacion (2003-05), Brandon Phillips (2002), Edinson Volquez (2005) and Joey Votto (2006-07)...Cordero and Volquez are the only 2 Reds players to appear in both the Futures Game and an All-Star Game... Cordero was an All-Star in 2004 and 2007, Volquez was an All-Star last year.

Todav's Trade

Today the Reds acquired from the White Sox minor league **C Corky Miller** in exchange for minor league **OF Norris Hopper...Miller** this season appeared in 14g for the White Sox and 4g for Class AAA Charlotte...he will report to Class AAA Louisville...**Hopper** has spent the entire season with Louisville.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 1** of a 3-game series vs **Lonnie Soloff's** Indians and **Game 4** (1-2) of a 6-game road trip that included a visit to **Tor's Rogers Centre** (1-2)...is **Game 7** (2-4) of 9 consecutive contests against American League opponents (1-2 vs WSox, 1-2 at Tor, 3g at Cle).

<u>HEADING INTO THE BREAK</u>: Following this series the Reds return to Great American Ball Park for their final homestand of the season's first half, a 6-game set vs the **Diamondbacks** (3g) and **Cardinals** (3g)...will finish the first half on the road at **Phi** (4g) and at **NYM** (3g), including their first visit to the Mets' new **Citi Field**...coming out of the All-Star break will host the **Brewers** (4g) before hitting the road again to play at **LAD** (3g) and at **Chi** (3g).

<u>STREAKING</u>: Last night's 7-5 victory at Tor snapped the Reds' 4-game losing streak and their 6-game road losing streak...both streaks tied season highs...overall have lost 9 of their last 13g and 5 of their 6 interleague road games (0-3 at KC, 1-2 at Tor, 3g at Cle).

INTERLEAGUE PLAY: In its 13th season, interleague play continues for the Reds on this road trip to **Tor** and **Cle...** Cin is **4-8 vs the American League** so far this season (2-1 vs Cle, 0-3 at KC, 1-2 vs WSox, 1-2 at Tor, **3g at Cle**)...are **2-4** in a stretch of 9 consecutive games vs AL rivals (1-2 vs WSox, 1-2 at Tor, **3g at Cle**)...the Reds are **81-102** (.443) all-time vs American League teams...their all-time results vs AL teams can be found on page 351 of the media guide.

<u>DOT, DOT.</u>: Jay Bruce is tied for the Major League lead with 8 outfield assists...Ryan Hanigan leads all National League rookie batters in on-base percentage (.411) and ranks second in hitting (.325)...Ramon Hernandez needs 2 runs scored to reach 500 in his career.

EDWIN'S REHAB: **3B Edwin Encarnacion** is on a rehabilitation assignment at Class AAA Louisville (5g, 4-16, .250, 1 2b, 2hr, 6rbi, 5bb, 3k)...in last night's 7-0 Bats victory at **Charlotte** he went 1-for-2 with a double, 1rbi and 3 walks... he has been on the disabled list since 4/28 with a chip fracture in his left wrist.

M*A*S*H: From the Opening Day roster the Reds are missing starters SS Alex Gonzalez (right elbow surgery, out 4-5 weeks) and 3B Edwin Encarnacion (broken left wrist, rehabbing in Louisville) along with starting RHP Edinson Volquez (right elbow, rehabbing in Cincinnati) and reliever RHP Mike Lincoln (bulging disc in his neck, rehabbing in Cincinnati)...all are on the disabled list...several other players missed action recently because of various ailments, including 1B Joey Votto (stress), 2B Brandon Phillips (hairline fracture, right thumb), OF Willy Taveras (tight right hamstring) and IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr. (flu)...on Wednesday C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo will have surgery to repair the torn labrum in his right shoulder...Castillo suffered the season-ending injury on a head-first slide in the seventh inning of Saturday's game vs the White Sox.

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUT: RHP Carlos Fisher and LHP Matt Maloney made their Major League debuts this season... in 2008, 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts: RHP Johnny Cueto, IF Paul Janish, OF Jay Bruce, LHP Daniel Ray Herrera, RHP Daryl Thompson, IF Adam Rosales, OF Chris Dickerson, RHP Ramon Ramirez, C/IF/ OF Wilkin Castillo and RHP Josh Roenicke.

TOP PICK: With the eighth pick overall, the Reds selected Arizona State University junior **RHP Mike Leake** in the first round of the 2009 first-year player draft...**Leake**, 21, this season went 16-1, 1.36 to help lead the Sun Devils to the College World Series...his 40 career wins at ASU are the most in school history...is a finalist for the **Golden Spikes Award** and the College Baseball Foundation's **Pitcher of the Year Award**...the lists of Cin's 2008 draft picks and No. 1 draft picks are on pages **212-213** of the media guide...**OF Jay Bruce** is the only first-round pick currently on the Reds' roster (2005 by Cin, 12th overall)...all draft information can be found at <u>reds.com</u>.

<u>VOTE REDS!</u>: Through Thursday, fans can help pick the starting lineups of the 2009 All-Star Game in St. Louis by voting online at <u>reds.com/vote</u>...fans attending games at Great American Ball Park can vote using laptop computers set up near Section 114 on Terrace Level...one online voter per game will be selected randomly to receive a Kroger gift card...fans who vote 25 times online and indicate the Reds as their favorite team automatically are entered in a sweepstakes to win a FOX Sports Champions Club box for 4 for an upcoming game...Reds players on the ballot include C Ramon Hernandez, 1B Joey Votto, 2B Brandon Phillips, SS Alex Gonzalez, 3B Edwin Encarnacion, OF Chris Dickerson, OF Willy Taveras and OF Jay Bruce.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (17-17.500): The Reds went 4-6-2 in their 12 home series and produced a winning record on just 2 of their 6 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3, 1-2, 3-3)...in 7 seasons at GABP are 258-262-1... last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38).

REDS ON THE ROAD (18-19, .486): The Reds have lost 6 of their last 7 road games (0-1 at Wsh, 0-3 at KC, 1-2 at Tor)...went 6-4-2 in their previous 12 road series...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2), a .500 record on the third trip (3-3) and losing records on each of their last 2 road trips (2-5, 2-4)...entering this season and dating to 2006, the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips.

IN THE STANDINGS (81): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 39, FOURTH - 28, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...at 20-14 and again at 26-20 were a season-high 6g over .500...prior to this season hadn't been 6g over .500 since 2006, when they reached a season-high 12g over .500 at 36-24...3 times were a season-high 2g under .500 (0-2, 1-3, 34-36)... have spent 62 days above, 9 days at and 10 days below .500.

REDS vs INDIANS: The Reds are 29-31 all-time vs the Indians, including 2-1 in 2009 and 7-2 the last 2 seasons... have won 4 of the last 5g vs Cle...at **Progressive Field**: Reds are 14-16, including 2-1 in 2008...Cin has lost 11 of the last 17g here...**last Reds sweep**: at Cin: 5/16-5/18, 2008...at Cle: never...**last Indians sweep**: at Cin: 6/11-6/13, 1999 (3g)...at Cle: 6/11-6/13, 2004 (3g).

<u>Last Started</u>: Sun vs WSox and suffered the 4-1 loss (7ip, 8h, 3er, 0bb, 7k, 97 pitches, 66 strikes)...left trailing, 3-0...allowed 2 runs on 3 hits in the first inning and another run in the fifth on an RBI-infield single.

Red Hots: Is making his 16th start of the season, his second against an American League team...in 4 starts in June is 0-2 despite a 2.19era (24.2ip, 6er)...in his previous 15 starts the Reds went 7-8 and scored 57 runs (3.80 r/g)...in his 15 starts Reds batters hit .241 (120-497)...on 6/4 at StL suffered the 3-1 loss in a game in which Harang and Chris Carpenter each threw a complete game.

Home Cookin': Is 4-3, 2.87 (47ip, 15er) in 8 starts at Great American Ball Park and 1-4, 4.47 (46.1ip, 23er) in 7 starts on the road.

<u>Streaking</u>: From 4/28-6/4 allowed a home run in 8 consecutive apps (10hr), the longest streak by a Reds pitcher since RHP Ramon Ortiz tied the National League record by allowing a home run in 15 consecutive apps from 5/1-7/17, 2005.

<u>Milestones</u>: On 4/23 at Chi recorded the **1,000th strikeout** of his career (**Derrek Lee**)...his 3-hitter in the club's fifth game, a 2-0 win on 4/12 vs Pit, was the quickest complete game by a Reds pitcher since **Pete Harnisch** threw a CG in the Reds' fourth game of **1999**.

Opening Day: In the 2-1 loss vs the Mets made his fourth straight Opening Day start, the first Reds pitcher to do so since **RHP Jose Rijo** had the honors in 4 straight seasons from 1992-95...the only other Reds pitchers to make at least 4 consecutive Opening Day starts are **Pete Donohue** (5 straight, 1923-27) and **Mario Soto** (5, 1982-86).

Staff Ace: Since he was acquired from the Athletics at the 2003 trading deadline is the Reds' leader in most statistical pitching categories, including starts (182), wins (68), innings pitched (1162.1) and strikeouts (978)...since the beginning of the 2006 season ranks second in the National League 743.2 innings pitched (Arroyo 1st, 744ip)...in 2005 and 2007 won the BBWAA's Johnny Vander Meer Award as the club's Most Outstanding Pitcher.

Community Affairs: Is one of the club's more active members of the local community...for the third straight season, as part of his Aaron's Aces ticket program is hosting at all Sunday home games children of military personnel serving in the War On Terrorism...along with wife Jen donated \$55,000 to the Miracle League of Greater Cincinnati and Northern Kentucky and on 5/9 attended the dedication of that field at the Durham Recreation Complex in Western Hills...for his community service has been the club's nominee for the Robert Clemente Award (2007), Branch Rickey Award (2007) and Marvin Miller Man of the Year Award (2007, 2008).
