In his last 15g Jonny Gomes is hitting .410 (16-39, 5 2b, 3hr, 8rbi), raising BA from .286...he has served as the Reds' DH in all 7 interleague road games (9-22, .409, 3 2b, 2hr, 4rbi, 6bb, 4r).

Statistically Speaking...

The Reds went 26-21, hit .257 and scored 4.57 runs per game before 1B Joey Votto went on the disabled list on 5/30...during his 21g on the disabled list the Reds went 8-13. hit .217 and scored 3.38 runs per game...in the 4g since Votto's return the Reds are 1-3, hitting .233 (31-133) and have scored 4.00 runs per game (14r).

XM All-Star Futures Game

Class AA Carolina OF Chris Heisey (U.S. Team) and Class A Dayton RHP Juan Carlos Sulbaran (World Team) have been selected to participate in Major League Baseball's XM II-Star Futures Game on Sunday, 7/12 at Busch Stadium in St. Louis...Futures Game alumni include Reds players Jay Bruce (2007), Francisco Cordero (1999), Edwin Encarnacion (2003-05), Brandon Phillips (2002), Edinson Volquez (2005) and Joey Votto (2006-07)...Cordero and Volquez are the only 2 Reds players to appear in both the Futures Game and an All-Star Game... Cordero was an All-Star in 2004 and 2007, Volquez was an All-Star last year.

Todav's Transactions

Today the Reds recalled from Class AAA Louisville RHP Homer Bailey...a corresponding roster move will be made prior to tonight's game...**Bailey** made his only other 2009 start for the Reds in a 7-6 loss to the Indians on 5/23 at Great American Ball Park...in 14 starts for the Bats he went 8-5, 2.71 with 2 complete games and 1 shutout.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is Game 2 (0-1) of a 3-game series vs Nick Kenney's Indians and Game 5 (1-3) of a 6-game road trip that included a visit to Tor's Rogers Centre (1-2)...is Game 8 (2-5) of 9 consecutive contests against American League opponents (1-2 vs WSox, 1-2 at Tor, 0-1 at Cle).

HEADING INTO THE BREAK: Following this series the Reds return to Great American Ball Park for their final homestand of the season's first half, a 6-game set vs the Diamondbacks (3g) and Cardinals (3g)...will finish the first half on the road at Phi (4g) and at NYM (3g), including their first visit to the Mets' new Citi Field...coming out of the All-Star break will host the **Brewers** (4g) before hitting the road again to play at **LAD** (3g) and at **Chi** (3g).

STREAKING: The Reds have lost 5 of their last 6g, 10 of their last 14g and 6 of their 7 interleague road games (0-3 at KC, 1-2 at Tor, 0-1 at Cle)...at 35-37 are a season-high 2g below .500 for the fourth time (0-2, 1-3, 34-36).

INTERLEAGUE PLAY: In its 13th season, interleague play continues for the Reds on this road trip to Tor and Cle... Cin is 4-9 vs the American League so far this season (2-1 vs Cle, 0-3 at KC, 1-2 vs WSox, 1-2 at Tor, 0-1 at Cle)...are 2-5 in a stretch of 9 consecutive games vs AL rivals (1-2 vs WSox, 1-2 at Tor, 0-1 at Cle)...the Reds are 81-103 (.440) all-time vs American League teams...their all-time results vs AL teams can be found on page 351 of the media guide.

DOT, DOT, DOT....: Celebrating birthday's tomorrow are 2B Brandon Phillips (28) and bench coach Chris Speier (59)...Jay Bruce is tied for the Major League lead with 8 outfield assists...Ryan Hanigan leads all National League rookie batters in on-base percentage (.415) and ranks second in hitting (.325)...Ramon Hernandez needs 2 runs scored to reach 500 in his career.

EDWIN'S REHAB: 3B Edwin Encarnacion is on a rehabilitation assignment at Class AAA Louisville (6g, 4-19, .211, 1 2b, 2hr, 6rbi, 6bb, 4k)...as the DH in last night's 6-0 Bats loss at Charlotte he went 0-for-3 with a walk and a strikeout... has been on the disabled list since 4/28 with a chip fracture in his left wrist.

M*A*S*H: From the Opening Day roster the Reds are missing starters SS Alex Gonzalez (right elbow surgery, out 4-5 weeks) and 3B Edwin Encarnacion (broken left wrist, rehabbing in Louisville) along with starting RHP Edinson Volquez (right elbow, rehabbing in Cincinnati) and reliever RHP Mike Lincoln (bulging disc in his neck, rehabbing in Cincinnati)...all are on the disabled list...several other players missed action recently because of various ailments, including 1B Joey Votto (stress), 2B Brandon Phillips (hairline fracture, right thumb), OF Willy Taveras (tight right hamstring) and IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr. (flu)...on Wednesday C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo will have surgery to repair the torn labrum in his right shoulder... Castillo suffered the season-ending injury on a head-first slide in the seventh inning of Saturday's game vs the White Sox.

TOP PICK: With the eighth pick overall, the Reds selected Arizona State University junior RHP Mike Leake in the first round of the 2009 first-year player draft...Leake, 21, this season went 16-1, 1.36 to help lead the Sun Devils to the College World Series...his 40 career wins at ASU are the most in school history...is a finalist for the Golden Spikes Award and the College Baseball Foundation's Pitcher of the Year Award...the lists of Cin's 2008 draft picks and No. 1 draft picks are on pages 212-213 of the media guide...OF Jay Bruce (2005, 12th overall) and Homer Bailey (2004, 7th overall) are the only first-round picks currently on the Reds' roste...all draft information can be found at reds.com.

VOTE REDSI: Through Thursday, fans can help pick the starting lineups of the 2009 All-Star Game in St. Louis by voting online at reds.com/vote...fans attending games at Great American Ball Park can vote using laptop computers set up near Section 114 on Terrace Level...one online voter per game will be selected randomly to receive a Kroger gift card...fans who vote 25 times online and indicate the Reds as their favorite team automatically are entered in a sweepstakes to win a FOX Sports Champions Club box for 4 for an upcoming game...Reds players on the ballot include C Ramon Hernandez, 1B Joey Votto, 2B Brandon Phillips, SS Alex Gonzalez, 3B Edwin Encarnacion, OF Chris Dickerson, OF Willy Taveras and OF Jay Bruce.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (17-17 .500): The Reds went 4-6-2 in their 12 home series and produced a winning record on just 2 of their 6 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3, 1-2, 3-3)...in 7 seasons at GABP are 258-262-1... last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38)...at 217-217-1 the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since 6/26/04 (57-57)...also reached .500 at 219-219-1.

REDS ON THE ROAD (18-20, .474): The Reds have lost 7 of their last 8 road games (0-1 at Wsh, 0-3 at KC, 1-2 at Tor, 0-1 at Cle)...went 6-4-2 in their previous 12 completed road series...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2), a .500 record on the third trip (3-3) and losing records on each of their last 2 road trips (2-5, 2-4)... entering this season and dating to 2006, the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips.

IN THE STANDINGS (82): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 39, FOURTH - 29, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...at 20-14 and 26-20 were a season-high 6g over .500...prior to this season hadn't been 6g over .500 since 2006, when they reached a season-high 12g over .500 at 36-24...4 times were a season-high 2g under .500 (0-2, 1-3, 34-36, 35-37)... have spent 62 days above, 9 days at and 11 days below .500.

REDS vs INDIANS: The Reds are 29-32 all-time vs the Indians, including 2-2 in 2009 and 7-3 the last 2 seasons...have won 4 of the last 6g vs Cle...at Great American Ball Park: Reds are 11-7, including 2-1 in 2009, 5-1 the last 2 seasons and 7-2 the last 3 years...have won 6 of the last 7g here vs Cle...the Reds and Indians met in the first 2g played at GABP, with the Tribe winning both exhibition games, 6-1 and 3-1, on 3/28 and 3/29, 2003...Reds went 4-8 all-time vs Cle at Cinergy Field...at Progressive Field: Reds are 14-17, including 0-1 this season and 2-1 in 2008...Cin has lost 12 of the last 18g here...last Reds sweep: at Cin: 5/16-5/18, 2008...at Cie: never...last Indians sweep: at Cin: 6/11-6/13, 1999 (3g)...at Cle: 6/11-6/13, 2004 (3g).

<u>Last Pitched</u>: For Class AAA Louisville on Mon vs Gwinnett and threw his seventh consecutive quality start to earn the 11-5 victory (7ip, 6h, 1er, 2bb, 8k, 1hr, 115 pitches, 74 strikes)...allowed only a leadoff HR to Reid Gorecki on the third pitch of the game.

Last Pitched for the Reds: On 5/23 vs Cle, in his only appearance of the season received no decision in the 7-6 loss (4.1ip, 3h, 6er, 6bb, 3k, 1hr, 95 pitches, 53 strikes)...left leading, 6-4, with the bases loaded and 1 out but was charged with 2 more runs scored off Burton...the 6 runs allowed tied his career high and the 6 walks were a new career high...walked the leadoff batter in the first, second and fifth innings...was optioned to Louisville the next day.

2009 Season: Is making his second start of the season for the Reds, his first since 5/23...began the year at Class AAA Louisville, where he went 3-5, 4.57 with 2 complete games and a shutout in 8 starts before he was promoted on 5/22...started the 7-6 loss vs Cle on 5/23, then was optioned back to Louisville the next day...made 6 more starts for the Bats (5-0, 0.81) before he was recalled again earlier today...in that 5/23 start vs the Indians became only the sixth different pitcher to start a game for the Reds this season, in the club's 42nd game...was the longest such streak to begin a season since **RHP John Roper** became the staff's **sixth** different starter in the **42nd game** of the **1994** campaign.

At Louisville: In 14 apps for the Bats produced 11 quality starts, including quality starts in each of his last 7 apps (5-1, 1.07, 50.1ip, 47h, 6er, 12bb, 45k)... in his first start of the season allowed a season-high 8 earned runs in 5.1 innings (13.50era) and in his last 13 starts posted a 2.03era (84.1ip, 19er)...through Mon's start ranked among the International League leaders in innings pitched (89.2, 1st), wins (8, 2nd), strikeouts (82, 2nd) and ERA (2.71, 10th)...for the Bats, in 6 starts between his 5/22 and 6/27 promotions went 5-0, 0.81.

IL Pitcher of the Week: Twice this season was named the International League's Pitcher of the Week...in 2 starts the week of 4/20-4/26 went 2-0, 2.92 with 18 strikeouts in 12.1 innings (10h, 6bb)...in the 10-3 win at Toledo on 4/26, over 6.1 innings he struck out a career-high 15 batters to tie the Louisville single-game record...in 2 starts from 6/1-6/7 went 2-0 without allowing a run (14.2ip, 11h, 2bb, 14k).

2008 Season: Spent most of the season at Class AAA Louisville (19gs, 4-7, 4.77)...made 8 starts during 2 stints with the Reds (0-6, 7.93)...from 6/5-6/17 filled in for injured starter **Josh Fogg** and from 7/13-8/9 took the spot vacated by the disabled **Aaron Harang**...from 8/24-9/2 was on Louisville's disabled list with a sprained medial collateral ligament in his right knee, an injury that prevented a September promotion...between a 4-3 victory for Louisville on 4/30 vs Toledo and a 19-3 win on 9/4 vs Durham in Game 2 of the International League playoffs made 21 starts without a victory (13gs for Louisville, 8gs at Cin)...in his 8 starts the Reds went 0-8, scored 14 runs (1.75 r/g) and twice were shut out.

<u>Last Started</u>: Tue at Tor and allowed a season-high 6 runs in the 7-5 loss (5.2ip, 9h, 6er, 2bb, 1k, 3hr, 102 pitches, 65 strikes)...left trailing, 6-0...allowed 4 runs on 3 homers (Rolen solo, Barajas solo, Scutaro 2-run).

Red Hots: Tomorrow will make his 14th start of the season, his first career appearance vs the Indians...in his previous 13 starts the Reds went 5-8 and scored 53 runs (4.08 r/g)...has 4 quality starts...with an 8-2 win on 4/26 vs Atl snapped his **9-game losing streak** dating back to a 9-3 Diamondbacks victory on 5/25/08 at Atl...in 14 apps and 10 starts between victories went **0-9**, **8.53**.

<u>In Relief</u>: Made his only relief appearance of the season in the 16-inning, 6-5 loss at SD on 5/16...threw a career-high 5.2 innings in relief (3h, 1er, 3bb, 5k, 1hr, 81 pitches, 44 strikes)...entered the game in the 11th inning as the Reds' seventh and final pitcher... retired his first 10 batters until Scott Hairston singled with 1 out in the 14th inning...Nick Hundley homered to end the 5-hour, 14 minute struggle...in 7 starts since then is 1-4, 5.89 (36.2ip, 24er).

At The Plate: In 2007 won the National League's Silver Slugger Award (.333, 4hr, 15rbi)...has 7 career home runs, including 2 this season (5/10 vs StL, pinch-hit solo off Ryan Franklin & 6/17 vs Atl, 3-run off Javier Vazquez)...his 5 career home runs prior to 2009 are listed on page 149 of the media guide.
