In his last 16g **Jonny Gomes** is hitting .386 (17-44, 5 2b, 3hr, 9rbi), raising BA from .286...he has served as the Reds' DH in all 8 interleague road games (10-27, .370, 3 2b, 2hr, 5rbi, 4r).

Statistically Speaking...

The Reds went **26-21**, hit **.257** and scored **4.57** runs per game before **1B Joey Votto** went on the disabled list on **5/30**...during his 21g on the disabled list the Reds went **8-13**, hit **.217** and scored **3.38** runs per game...in the 5g since **Votto's** return the Reds are **2-3**, hitting **.257** (44-171) and have scored **4.20** runs per game (21r).

TODAY'S GAME: Is **Game 2** (1-1) of a 3-game series vs **Matt Whewell's** Indians and **Game 6** (2-3) of a 6-game road trip that included a visit to **Tor's Rogers Centre** (1-2)...is **Game 9** (3-5) of 9 consecutive contests against American League opponents (1-2 vs WSox, 1-2 at Tor, 1-1 at Cle).

HEADING INTO THE BREAK: Following this afternoon's game the Reds return to Great American Ball Park for their final homestand of the season's first half, a 6-game set vs the **Diamondbacks** (3g) and **Cardinals** (3g) that begins Tuesday...will finish the first half on the road at **Phi** (4g) and at **NYM** (3g), including their first visit to the Mets' new **Citi Field**...coming out of the All-Star break the Reds will host the **Brewers** (4g) before hitting the road again to play at **LAD** (3g) and at **Chi** (3g).

STREAKING: The Reds have **won 2 of their last 3g** but lost **5 of their last 7g**, **10 of their last 15g** and **6 of their 8 interleague road games** (0-3 at KC, 1-2 at Tor, 1-1 at Cle).

INTERLEAGUE PLAY: Today interleague play will conclude its 13th season...Cin is **5-9 vs the American League** so far this season (2-1 vs Cle, 0-3 at KC, 1-2 vs WSox, 1-2 at Tor, **1-1 at Cle**)...are **3-5** in a stretch of 9 consecutive games vs AL rivals (1-2 vs WSox, 1-2 at Tor, **1-1 at Cle**)...the Reds are **82-103 (.443)** all-time vs American League teams...their all-time results vs AL teams can be found on page 351 of the media guide.

DOT, DOT, DOT....: **Jay Bruce** is tied for the Major League lead with **8 outfield assists**...**Ryan Hanigan** leads all National League rookie batters in on-base percentage (.408) and ranks second in hitting (.321)...**Ramon Hernandez** needs 2 runs scored to reach **500** in his career.

EDWIN'S REHAB: **3B Edwin Encarnacion** is on a rehabilitation assignment at Class AAA Louisville (7g, 6-23, .261, 1 2b, 2hr, 7rbi, 6bb, 4k)...played 3B in last night's 4-3 Bats loss at **Gwinnett** and went 2-for-4 with an RBI...has been on the disabled list since 4/28 with a chip fracture in his left wrist.

M*A*S*H: From the **Opening Day** roster the Reds are missing starters **SS Alex Gonzalez** (right elbow surgery, out 4-5 weeks) and **3B Edwin Encarnacion** (broken left wrist, rehabbing in Louisville) along with starting **RHP Edinson Volquez** (right elbow, rehabbing in Cincinnati) and reliever **RHP Mike Lincoln** (bulging disc in his neck, rehabbing in Cincinnati)...all are on the disabled list...several other players missed action recently because of various ailments, including **1B Joey Votto** (stress), **2B Brandon Phillips** (hairline fracture, right thumb), **OF Willy Taveras** (tight right hamstring) and **IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr.** (flu)...on Wednesday **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** will have surgery to repair the torn labrum in his right shoulder...**Castillo** suffered the season-ending injury on a head-first slide in the seventh inning of lthe game on 6/20 vs the White Sox.

TOP PICK: With the eighth pick overall, the Reds selected Arizona State University junior **RHP Mike Leake** in the first round of the 2009 first-year player draft...**Leake**, 21, this season went 16-1, 1.36 to help lead the Sun Devils to the College World Series...his 40 career wins at ASU are the most in school history...is a finalist for the **Golden Spikes Award** and the College Baseball Foundation's **Pitcher of the Year Award**...the lists of Cin's 2008 draft picks and No. 1 draft picks are on pages **212-213** of the media guide...**OF Jay Bruce** (2005, 12th overall) and **Homer Bailey** (2004, 7th overall) are the only first-round picks currently on the Reds' roster...all draft information can be found at reds.com.

ALL-STAR RESOLUTION: State Senator **Gary Cates** (R-Butler County) has introduced a resolution in the Ohio Senate urging Major League Baseball to select the Reds and Great American Ball Park as hosts for the **2013 All-Star Game**...the Reds last hosted the Mid-Summer Classic in **1988** at Riverfront Stadium...the club already is hosting one of MLB's jewel events this summer, when on **6/20** the Reds and White Sox meet here in the **Gillette Civil Rights Game**.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (17-17 .500): The Reds went **4-6-2 in their 12 home series** and produced a winning record on just 2 of their 6 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3, 1-2, 3-3)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **258-262-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38).

REDS ON THE ROAD (19-20, .487): The Reds have won 2 of their last 3 road games but have lost 7 of their last 9 road games (0-1 at Wsh, 0-3 at KC, 1-2 at Tor, 1-1 at Cle)...went **6-4-2 in their previous 12 completed road series**...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2), a .500 record on the third trip (3-3) and losing records on each of their last 2 road trips (2-5, 2-4)...entering this season and dating to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

IN THE STANDINGS (83): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 40, FOURTH - 29, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...at **20-14** and **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g over .500** at **36-24**...4 times were a season-high **2g under .500** (0-2, 1-3, 34-36, 35-37)...have spent **62** days above, **9** days at and **12** days below .500.

REDS vs INDIANS: The Reds are 30-32 all-time vs the Indians, including 3-2 in 2009 and 8-3 the last 2 seasons...have won 5 of the last 7g vs Cle...**at Progressive Field:** Reds are 15-17, including 1-1 this season and 2-1 in 2008...Cin has lost 12 of the last 19g here.

UP NEXT: REDS vs DIAMONDBACKS: The Reds are 41-38 all-time vs the Diamondbacks, including 3-0 this season and 7-2 the last 2 years...have won the last 5g and 7 of the last 8g vs Ari...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 10-8, including 2-1 in 2008 and 5-1 the last 2 seasons.

Last Started: Tue at Tor and allowed a season-high 6 runs in the 7-5 loss (5.2ip, 9h, 6er, 2bb, 1k, 3hr, 102 pitches, 65 strikes)...left trailing, 6-0...allowed 4 runs on 3 homers (Rolen solo, Barajas solo, Scutaro 2-run).

Red Hots: Is making his 14th start of the season and his first career appearance vs the Indians...in his previous 13 starts the Reds went 5-8 and scored 53 runs (4.08 r/g)...has 4 quality starts...with an 8-2 win on 4/26 vs Atl snapped his **9-game losing streak** dating back to a 9-3 Diamondbacks victory on 5/25/08 at Atl...in 14 apps and 10 starts between victories went **0-9, 8.53**.

In Relief: Made his only relief appearance of the season in the 16-inning, 6-5 loss at SD on 5/16...threw a career-high 5.2 innings in relief (3h, 1er, 3bb, 5k, 1hr, 81 pitches, 44 strikes)...entered the game in the 11th inning as the Reds' seventh and final pitcher...retired his first 10 batters until Scott Hairston singled with 1 out in the 14th inning...Nick Hundley homered to end the 5-hour, 14 minute struggle...in **7 starts since then is 1-4, 5.89 (36.2ip, 24er)**.

At The Plate: In 2007 won the National League's **Silver Slugger Award** (.333, 4hr, 15rbi)...has **7 career home runs**, including **2 this season** (5/10 vs StL, pinch-hit solo off **Ryan Franklin** & 6/17 vs Atl, 3-run off **Javier Vazquez**)...his 5 career home runs prior to 2009 are listed on **page 149** of the media guide.

Owings' Most Recent Starts: **4/26 vs Atl** and earned the 8-2 victory (7ip, 6h, 1er, 3bb, 6k, 1hr, 102 pitches, 60 strikes)...left leading, 8-1...allowed only a solo HR to David Ross with 1 out in the seventh inning...his first victory since May 2008 snapped a personal 9-game losing streak...**5/2 at Pit** and suffered the 8-6 loss (5.2ip, 9h, 5er, 2bb, 0k, 99 pitches, 64 strikes)...left trailing, 5-3...in the first inning allowed 4 runs on 4 hits, 1 walk and 1 hit batter...**5/7 vs Mil** and earned the 6-5 victory (6ip, 7h, 5r, 4er, 1bb, 4k, 100 pitches, 67 strikes)...left leading, 6-5...allowed 3 runs in the fourth inning and 2 runs in the sixth...his RBI-triple in the bottom of the fourth off Braden Looper gave the Reds a 4-3 lead they would not relinquish...**5/12 at Ari**, in his first career appearance vs his former team earned the 3-1 victory (7+ip, 4h, 1er, 2bb, 4k, 1hbp, 90 pitches, 53 strikes)...took a 4-hit shutout into the eighth inning but then hit with a pitch leadoff batter Ryan Roberts...was charged with that run, which scored on Felipe Lopez' RBI-double off Arthur Rhodes...**5/21 vs Phi** and suffered the 12-5 loss (3ip, 6h, 5er, 3bb, 3k, 1hr, 71 pitches, 41 strikes)...left trailing, 5-0...allowed 1 run in the first inning, 3 runs in the second and a solo HR to Dobbs in the third...**5/26 vs Hou** and received no decision in the 6-4 victory (5ip, 6h, 3er, 4bb, 3k, 99 pitches, 62 strikes)...allowed all 3 runs in the fourth inning on a 2-run double by Rodriguez and a run-scoring single by Maysonet...**5/31 at Mil** and suffered the 5-2 loss (5.2ip, 8h, 5er, 3bb, 5k, 1hr, 103 pitches, 67 strikes)...left trailing, 5-2, but retired 10 of his 11 final batters...in the first inning allowed consecutive 2-out, RBI-singles to Cameron and Gamel...in the second allowed a sac fly to Hardy...in the third allowed Cameron's 2-run HR...**6/5 vs Cubs** and suffered the 2-1 loss (6ip, 5h, 2er, 3bb, 6k, 1hr, 98 pitches, 64 strikes)...left trailing, 2-0...allowed only a bases-loaded walk to Fontenot in the first inning and a solo HR to Zambrano in the fifth...**6/11 at Wsh** and was the victim of a blown save in the 3-2 loss (5.1ip, 4h, 1er, 4bb, 4k, 2hbp, 1wp, 102 pitches, 56 strikes)...left leading, 2-0, but was charged with a run scored off Burton...the Nats took a 3-2 lead with a 2-run eighth inning off Fisher, Herrera and Masset...through 5 scoreless innings allowed 2 hits, 4 walks and 2hbp but stranded all 8 baserunners...**6/17 vs Atl** and earned the 4-3 victory (6ip, 6h, 2er, 2bb, 0k, 1hr, 108 pitches, 67 strikes)...left leading, 4-2...allowed only a 2-run HR to Escobar in the third inning...in the fifth frame hit a 3-run HR off Vazquez that gave the Reds their 4-2 lead...was his second homer of the season, the seventh of his career.

Tuesday vs D'Backs: Bronson Arroyo

Last Pitched: Wed at Tor and suffered the 8-2 loss (3.2p, 8h, 7r, 6er, 3bb, 2k, 3hr, 93 pitches, 54 strikes)...left trailing, 7-2, with the bases loaded but Burton stranded all 3 runners...in the 5-run first inning allowed a 2-run HR to Hill, a solo HR to Wells and a 2-run HR to Lind...the homers to Hill and Wells were on consecutive pitches...in the second inning allowed a 2-out, RBI-double to Wells...allowed an unearned run in the fourth.

Red Hots: On Tue vs Ari will make his 15th start of the season, his second of the year vs the Diamondbacks...in his previous 15 starts the Reds went 8-7 and scored 65 runs (4.33 r/g)...has 8 quality starts...since he was acquired by the Reds prior to the 2006 season leads all Major League pitchers with 117 starts and ranks second in the National League with 744.0 innings pitched (**Aaron Harang** 1st, 748.1ip).

Unlucky June 24: On **6/24** each of the last 2 seasons started against the Blue Jays at Tor's Rogers Centre...in those 2 starts, a 14-1 loss on 6/24/08 and an 8-2 loss on 6/24/09, allowed 17 runs in 4.2 innings...in the 2008 loss became only the sixth starting pitcher in Major League history to allow at least 10 earned runs while retiring 3 batters or fewer...in the 2009 loss allowed 5 runs in the first inning on homers by Hill (2-run), Wells (solo) and Lind (2-run)...in the calendar year between those 2 starts went **19-9, 4.19**...the 19 wins were the second-most in the Major Leagues in that 1-year span (Tor's **Roy Halladay**, 22-6, 2.49).

In The Big Inning: Allowed at least 1 run in the first inning of 8 of his 15 starts, including 6 of his last 7 starts...has posted a 10.80era in the first inning (15ip, 18er) and a 4.52era after the first frame (77.2ip, 39er).
