Volquez Update

RHP Edinson Volquez yesterday went on the 15-day disabled list with tendinitis in his right elbow...he will be examined again in 7-10 days and will not throw during that period...Volquez left Monday's start after the first inning with numbness in the pinky and ring fingers of his right hand...he is on the disabled list for the second time this season (5/22-6/1, back spasms) and has made just 1 start since 5/16.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 3** (1-1) of a 3-game series vs **Jason LaRue's** Cardinals and **Game 6** (1-4) of a 7-game road trip that also included a winless visit to Mil (0-3)...is **Game 6** (1-4) of a stretch in which the Reds will play 13-16g on the road...following this series the Reds return to **Great American Ball Park** for a brief 3-game weekend set with the Cubs before hitting the road again for **Wsh** (3g) and **KC** (3g).

CENTRAL CASTING: Tonight's game is **Game 9** (4-4) of 13 straight vs **National League Central Division** rivals (3-0 vs Hou, 0-3 at Mil, **1-1 at StL**, 3g vs Chi)...following this 13-game stretch won't play within the division again until **Fourth of July** weekend (3g at StL), a drought that includes 21 consecutive games outside the **Central**.

DOT, DOT, DOT...: **Alex Gonzalez** needs 4rbi to reach **500** in his career...**Ryan Hanigan** leads all National League rookies in hitting (.319) and on-base percentage (.412).

ANOTHER LEFTHANDER IN THE BOOTH: Former pitcher **Kent Mercker** is joining Hall of Famer **Marty Brennaman** in the **Reds On Radio Network** booth tonight and tomorrow...in 18 Major League seasons, the **Dublin, Ohio** native pitched for the Braves, Orioles, Indians, **Cardinals** (1998-99), Red Sox, Angels, Rockies, Cubs and **Reds** (1997, 2003, 2005-06, 2008)...for the next 2 nights, **Jeff Brantley** will join **George Grande** on the **FOX Sports Ohio** broadcasts.

M*A*S*H: From the **Opening Day** roster the Reds are missing starters **1B Joey Votto** and **3B Edwin Encarnacion** along with starting **RHP Edinson Volquez**...all are on the disabled list...several other players missed action recently because of various ailments, including **2B Brandon Phillips** (hairline fracture, tip of right thumb), **SS Alex Gonzalez** (strained left oblique muscle), **Willy Taveras** (tight right hamstring) and **IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr.** (flu).

BE AN EARLY BIRD...: On the riverfront Friday night, the **Cincinnati Police Department** is expecting a crowd of about **50,000** to attend both the Reds' 7:10 p.m. game with the Cubs and a sold-out **Keith Urban** concert next door at US Bank Arena...the **CPD** recommends fans who don't have passes for the parking garages adjacent to those venues avoid driving on Second and Third Streets and instead use exits into the northern part of downtown (5th Street, 6th Street, 7th Street, Gilbert Road, Reading Road, etc.).

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUT: RHP **Carlos Fisher** is the only Reds player this season to make his Major League debut...last season 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts, including **RHP Johnny Cueto**, **IF Paul Janish**, **OF Jay Bruce**, **LHP Daniel Ray Herrera**, **RHP Daryl Thompson**, **IF Adam Rosales**, **OF Chris Dickerson**, **RHP Ramon Ramirez**, **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** and **RHP Josh Roenicke**.

QUALITY CONTROL: Opposing pitchers have produced **27 quality starts**, including 11 straight from **4/14-4/25**...the Reds went **13-14** (.481) when the opposing starter produced a quality appearance...the Reds produced 23 quality starts (**Cueto 7**, **Arroyo 6**, **Harang 5**, **Volquez 3**, **Owings 2**) and went **19-4** in those QS (.826).

ZEROES: The Reds and Giants lead the National League with **6 team shutouts**...the Reds produced their 6 shutouts in the first **26g**, their fastest to 6 blankings since the **1914 staff** threw its sixth shutout in the **25th** game...Cin produced 6 team shutouts all of last season.

GILLETTE CIVIL RIGHTS GAME: At Great American Ball Park on **Sat, 6/20** the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the **Gillette Civil Rights Game**, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's **Harriet Tubman Theater** (Fri, 6/19, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at **Duke Energy Center** honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's **Beacon Awards** (Sat, 6/20, 11:30 a.m.) and a **Youth Summit** at **Fountain Square** downtown (Sat, 6/20, 4:00 p.m.)...scheduled to attend the **Sat, 6/20** luncheon are Beacon of Change winner **Muhammad Ali**, Beacon of Hope winner **Bill Cosby** and Beacon of Life winner **Hank Aaron**...Beacon Award presenters include **Sugar Ray Leonard** (Ali), Hall of Fame pitcher **Bob Gibson** (Cosby) and **Commissioner Allan H. (Bud) Selig** (Aaron)...Grammy Award-winning gospel artist **BeBe Winans** will perform at the luncheon and at that night's game...former **President Bill Clinton** will be the keynote speaker at the luncheon...for more information, log on to www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (13-12, .520): The Reds went **3-4-2** in their 9 home series and produced a winning record on 2 of their 4 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3)...at **13-12** their record at home is above .500 for the first time this season...in 7 seasons at GABP are **254-257-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38).

REDS ON THE ROAD (14-12, .538): The Reds went **5-2-1 in their first 8 road series**...are **1-4** so far on this road trip...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2), a .500 record on the third trip (3-3) and regardless of outcomes tonight and tomorrow will post a sub-.500 record on this trip (1-4)...entering this season and dating back to 2006, the **Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

IN THE STANDINGS (58): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: **FIRST** - 1, **SECOND** - 8, **THIRD** - 27, **FOURTH** - 18, **FIFTH** - 3, **SIXTH** - 1...at **20-14** and again at **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g over .500** at **36-24**...have spent **46** days above, **5** days at and **7** days below .500.

REDS vs CARDINALS: The Reds are 931-1,054 all-time vs the Cardinals, including 3-2 this season...**at Busch Stadium:** Reds are 9-17, including 1-1 this season and 4-13 here the last 3 years...lost 6 of the last 7g and 9 of the last 11g here...**at Old Busch** went 119-139.

IF Paul Janish pitched in the ninth inning of the 15-3 loss vs Mil on 5/6 (1ip, 5h, 5er, 0bb, 2k, Fielder 2-run HR)...he became the first Reds position player to pitch since Lenny Harris on 6/1/98 at SF.				

Reds Pitchers: Rank sixth in the National League with a 4.08 team ERA...**on the road trip are 1-4, 5.27 (41ip, 24er)**...in May went 15-13, 4.08...have 6 team shutouts...had 6 shutouts all last season...with a 7-0 win on 5/5 at Fla reached 6 shutouts in their 26th game, their fastest to 6 team shutouts since the 1914 Reds threw their sixth shutout in their 25th game.

Reds Starters: Rank 10th in the National League with 4.45 rotation ERA...**on the road trip are 0-4, 8.49 (23.1ip, 22er)**...in May went 13-9, 4.64...have produced 23 quality starts (Cueto 7, **Arroyo 6, Harang 5, Volquez 3, Owings 2**)...the Reds went 19-4 in those quality starts (.826)...haven't produced any quality starts in the last 4g, tied for their longest stretch of the season...through the first 41g of the season used just 5 starting pitchers, their longest such streak to begin a year since **RHP John Roper** became the staff's **sixth** different starter in the **42nd game of the 1994 campaign**...on 5/23 vs Cle, in the club's 42nd game, **RHP Homer Bailey** became the Reds' sixth starting pitcher...**Aaron Harang** threw a 3-hitter in the 2-0 win vs Pit in the club's fifth game of the season...was the earliest complete game by a Reds pitcher since **Pete Harnisch** beat the Cardinals, 3-0 in Busch Stadium, in the **fourth** contest of the **1999** campaign.

Reds Relievers: Rank third in the National League with a 3.35 bullpen ERA (NYM 3.10, Mil 3.30)...**on the road trip are 1-0, 1.02 (17.2ip, 2er)**...in May went 2-4, 2.92 and converted 6-7 save opps...in their last 42g have posted a 2.46era (128ip, 35er) and in their last 30g have posted a 2.20era (94ip, 23er)...none of the previous notes include the pitching performance by IF Paul Janish in the ninth inning of the 15-3 loss on 5/6 vs Mil (1ip, 5er)...didn't blow a save until the club's 36th game, a 6-5 loss in 16 innings on 5/16 at SD...for the second straight season the Reds' bullpen was the last in the Major Leagues to suffer a blown save...in 2008 didn't blow a save until the 41st game (5/14)...over the last 2 seasons **Francisco Cordero** has recorded all **48** of the bullpen's saves (34sv in 2008, 14sv in 2009).
