Volquez Update

700 wlw/fsoHD, 1:10et

RHP Edinson Volquez yesterday went on the 15-day disabled list with tendinitis in his right elbow...he will be examined again in 7-10 days and will not throw during that period...**Volquez** left Monday's start after the first inning with numbness in the pinky and ring fingers of his right hand...he is on the disabled list for the second time this season (5/22-6/1, back spasms) and has made just 1 start since 5/16.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 3** (1-1) of a 3-game series vs **Jason LaRue's** Cardinals and **Game 6** (1-4) of a 7-game road trip that also included a winless visit to Mil (0-3)...is **Game 6** (1-4) of a stretch in which the Reds will play 13-16g on the road...following this series the Reds return to **Great American Ball Park** for a brief 3-game weekend set with the Cubs before hitting the road again for **Wsh** (3g) and **KC** (3g).

<u>CENTRAL CASTING</u>: Tonight's game is **Game 9** (4-4) of 13 straight vs **National League Central Division** rivals (3-0 vs Hou, 0-3 at Mil, **1-1 at StL**, 3g vs Chi)...following this 13-game stretch won't play within the division again until **Fourth of July** weekend (3g at StL), a drought that includes 21 consecutive games outside the **Central**.

<u>DOT, DOT.</u>: Alex Gonzalez needs 4rbi to reach 500 in his career...Ryan Hanigan leads all National League rookies in hitting (.319) and on-base percentage (.412).

ANOTHER LEFTHANDER IN THE BOOTH: Former pitcher Kent Mercker is joining Hall of Famer Marty Brennaman in the Reds On Radio Network booth tonight and tomorrow...in 18 Major League seasons, the Dublin, Ohio native pitched for the Braves, Orioles, Indians, Cardinals (1998-99), Red Sox, Angels, Rockies, Cubs and Reds (1997, 2003, 2005-06, 2008)...for the next 2 nights, Jeff Brantley will join George Grande on the FOX Sports Ohio broadcasts.

<u>M*A*S*H</u>: From the **Opening Day roster** the Reds are missing starters **1B Joey Votto** and **3B Edwin Encarnacion** along with starting **RHP Edinson Volquez**...all are on the disabled list...several other players missed action recently because of various ailments, including **2B Brandon Phillips** (hairline fracture, tip of right thumb), **SS Alex Gonzalez** (strained left oblique muscle), **Willy Taveras** (tight right hamstring) and **IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr.** (flu).

BE AN EARLY BIRD...: On the riverfront Friday night, the **Cincinnati Police Department** is expecting a crowd of about **50,000** to attend both the Reds' 7:10 p.m. game with the Cubs and a sold-out **Keith Urban** concert next door at US Bank Arena...the **CPD** recommends fans who don't have passes for the parking garages adjacent to those venues avoid driving on Second and Third Streets and instead use exits into the northern part of downtown (5th Street, 6th Street, 7th Street, Gilbert Road, Reading Road, etc.).

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUT: RHP Carlos Fisher is the only Reds player this season to make his Major League debut... last season 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts, including RHP Johnny Cueto, IF Paul Janish, OF Jay Bruce, LHP Daniel Ray Herrera, RHP Daryl Thompson, IF Adam Rosales, OF Chris Dickerson, RHP Ramon Ramirez, C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo and RHP Josh Roenicke.

QUALITY CONTROL: Opposing pitchers have produced **27 quality starts**, including 11 straight from **4/14-4/25**...the Reds went **13-14** (.481) when the opposing starter produced a quality appearance...the Reds produced 23 quality starts (**Cueto** 7, **Arroyo** 6, **Harang** 5, **Volquez** 3, **Owings** 2) and went **19-4** in those QS (.826).

ZEROES: The Reds and Giants lead the National League with **6 team shutouts**...the Reds produced their 6 shutouts in the first **26g**, their fastest to 6 blankings since the **1914 staff** threw its sixth shutout in the **25th** game...Cin produced 6 team shutouts all of last season.

GILLETTE CIVIL RIGHTS GAME: At Great American Ball Park on Sat, 6/20 the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the Gillette Civil Rights Game, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's Harriet Tubman Theater (Fri, 6/19, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at Duke Energy Center honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's Beacon Awards (Sat, 6/20, 11:30 a.m.) and a Youth Summit at Fountain Square downtown (Sat, 6/20, 4:00 p.m.)...scheduled to attend the Sat, 6/20 luncheon are Beacon of Change winner Muhammad Ali, Beacon of Hope winner Bill Cosby and Beacon of Life winner Hank Aaron...Beacon Award presenters include Sugar Ray Leonard (Ali), Hall of Fame pitcher Bob Gibson (Cosby) and Commissioner Allan H. (Bud) Selig (Aaron)...Grammy Award-winning gospel artist BeBe Winans will perform at the luncheon and at that night's game... former President Bill Clinton will be the keynote speaker at the luncheon...for more information, log on to www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (13-12, .520): The Reds went 3-4-2 in their 9 home series and produced a winning record on 2 of their 4 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3)...at 13-12 their record at home is above .500 for the first time this season...in 7 seasons at GABP are 254-257-1...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38).

REDS ON THE ROAD (14-12, .538): The Reds went 5-2-1 in their first 8 road series...are 1-4 so far on this road trip...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2), a .500 record on the third trip (3-3) and regardless of outcomes tonight and tomorrow will post a sub-.500 record on this trip (1-4)...entering this season and dating back to 2006, the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips.

<u>IN THE STANDINGS (58)</u>: The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 8, THIRD - 27, FOURTH - 18, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...at **20-14** and again at **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g** over .500 at **36-24**...have spent **46** days above, **5** days at and **7** days below .500.

REDS vs CARDINALS: The Reds are 931-1,054 all-time vs the Cardinals, including 3-2 this season...**at Busch Stadium**: Reds are 9-17, including 1-1 this season and 4-13 here the last 3 years...lost 6 of the last 7g and 9 of the last 11g here...**at Old Busch** went 119-139.

<u>Last Pitched</u>: Fri at Mil and suffered the 3-2 loss (7ip, 3h, 3er, 4bb, 3k, 2hr, 104 pitches, 64 strikes)...left trailing, 3-2...allowed just 3 hits, but 2 of the hits were home runs that produced all 3 Brewers runs...in the first inning retired the first 2 batters but then walked Braun and allowed a 2-run HR to Fielder...Hart homered leading off the Brewers' seventh.

Red Hots: The 23-year-old righthander is making his 11th start of the season and the 42nd start of his career...ranks among the National League leaders with a 2.53era (5th) and a .208 opponents' BA against (4th)...in his 10 starts the Reds went 6-4 and scored 38 runs (3.8 r/g)...leads the team with 7 quality starts, all in his last 8 apps...his string of 5 consecutive QS from 4/22-5/13 was the longest stretch of quality starts by a Reds pitcher this season...last year, Edinson Volquez produced a string of 12 straight QS (4/22-6/20)...on 4/22 at Chi singled twice off Ted Lilly for his first career 2-hit game.

<u>Streaking I</u>: In 5 starts from 4/22-5/13 went **4-0, 1.25** (36ip, 5er)...the 4-game winning streak was the longest of his career...allowed 4 earned runs in his first start of the season (6ip) and 15 earned runs in his last 9 starts (61.2ip, 2.19era).

<u>Streaking II</u>: In each of 4 starts from 4/22-5/8 threw at least 7.0 innings while allowing no more than 1 run, the longest streak of that kind by a Reds pitcher since **Tim Belcher** had a 4-game run from **5/27-6/13**, **1992** (courtesy Elias Sports Bureau).

World Baseball Classic: Started the Dominican Republic's second game of the tournament and threw 4.2 scoreless innings to earn the 9-0 win vs Panama in the San Juan bracket (4.2ip, 3h, 1bb, 5k).

Cueto's Most Recent Starts: 4/22 at Chi, in one of the best starts of his career threw 7.0 shutout innings to earn the 3-0 victory (4h, 0bb, 3k, 108 pitches, 68 strikes)... left leading, 1-0...the Reds added insurance runs in the eighth and ninth innings...singled twice off Lilly, his first career 2-hit game...4/27 vs Hou and received no decision in the 4-1 loss (7ip, 7h, 1er, 1bb, 5k, 1hr, 98 pitches, 64 strikes)...left with the score tied, 1-1...allowed only a solo HR to Berkman leading off the sixth inning, snapping his scoreless streak at career-high 12 innings...was Berkman's 20th career homer at Great American Ball Park, the most by any opposing player...the Astros scored 3 runs in the ninth off Cordero...5/3 at Pit, in the 5-0 victory threw 8.0 shutout innings in the best start of his young career (4h, 1bb, 9k, 109 pitches, 68 strikes)...the 8.0 innings are a career high...allowed only 4 singles...5/8 vs StL and earned the 6-4 victory (7ip, 5h, 1er, 2bb, 3k, 98 pitches, 67 strikes)...left leading, 6-1...allowed only a run-scoring GIDP by Thurston in the seventh inning, snapping his career-high scoreless streak at 15 innings...5/13 at Ari and earned the 10-3 victory (7ip, 4h, 3er, 2bb, 4k, 2hr, 100 pitches, 67 strikes)...in the first inning allowed a solo HR to Gerardo Parra in Parra's first career plate appearance, followed by a walk to Justin Upton...then retired 12 consecutive batters until Chad Tracy walked with 1 out in the fifth...after Parra's HR didn't allow another hit until Upton doubled with 2 outs in the sixth, followed by Stephen Drew's RBI-single...with 2 outs in the seventh inning allowed a solo HR to Ojeda, his first homer since 6/15/07 at Bal (410ab)...as a batter, led off the third inning with his second bunt single of the season to spark a 3-run rally...5/19 vs Phi and suffered the 4-3 loss (7ip, 7h, 4er, 0bb, 4k, 1hr, 112 pitches, 68 strikes)...in the second inning allowed a solo HR to Howard...allowed 3 runs in the fifth on Rollins' RBI-double, Utley's RBI-single and a sac fly by Iban

Tomorrow's Pitcher: RHP Aaron Harang

<u>Last Started</u>: Sat at Mil and suffered the 9-5 loss (4.2ip, 12h, 8er, 0bb, 5k, 3hr, 104 pitches, 64 strikes)...left trailing, 7-5, and was charged with another run scored off Burton...allowed 6 his 8 runs on homers, to Fielder (3-run in the first inning), Braun (solo in the fifth) and Cameron (2-run in the fifth)...led 3-0 and 5-3 but the Brewers scored 6 runs in the bottom of the fifth off Harang and Burton to take a lead they would not relinquish.

Red Hots: Tomorrow will make his 12th start of the season and 200th start of his career...in his previous 11 starts the Reds went 5-6 and scored 44 runs (4 r/g)...in his 11 starts Reds batters hit .258 (94-365)...on 4/23 at Chi recorded the 1,000th strikeout of his career (Derrek Lee)...his 3-hitter in the club's fifth game, a 2-0 win on 4/12 vs Pit, was the quickest complete game by a Reds pitcher since Pete Harnisch threw a CG in the Reds' fourth game of 1999.

<u>Home Cookin</u>': Is **4-2, 2.84** (38ip, 12er) in 6 starts at Great American Ball Park and **1-3, 587** (30.2ip, 20er) in 5 starts on the road.

<u>Staff Ace</u>: Since he was acquired from the Athletics at the **2003** trading deadline is the Reds' leader in most statistical pitching categories, including starts (178), wins (68), innings pitched (1137.2) and strikeouts (962)...since the beginning of the **2006** season ranks second in the National League in innings pitched (719.0; Arroyo 1st 721.2)...in 2005 and 2007 won the BBWAA's Johnny Vander Meer Award as the club's Most Outstanding Pitcher.
