Through **Thursday**, fans can help pick the starting lineups of the **2009 All-Star Game** in St. Louis by voting online at [reds.com/vote](http://reds.com/vote)...among National League second basemen **Brandon Phillips** ranks T1st in **RBI** (51) and **stolen bases** (11) and third in homers (11)...**1B Joey Votto** is hitting **.351** with a **.449** on-base percentage...**RHP Johnny Cueto** (7-4, 2.86) ranks among the NL leaders in ERA (6th) and opponents' batting average against (.231, 8th)...**RHP Francisco Cordero** ranks T5th in the NL with 18 saves in 19 chances.

### Designated Designated Hitter

In his last 17g **Jonny Gomes** is hitting **.367** (18-49, 5 2b, 4hr, 11rbi)...has a 5-game hitting streak, including a least 1rbi in each game (8-21, .381, 6rbi)...hit 3 of the Reds' last 6 homers and 4 of their last 11 homers...started at DH in all 9 of the Reds' interleague road games (11-32, .344, 3 2b, 3hr, 7rbi, 5r, 5bb).

### Statistically Speaking...

The Reds went **26-21**, hit **.257** and scored **4.57** runs per game before **1B Joey Votto** went on the disabled list on **5/30**...during his 21g on the disabled list the Reds went **8-13**, hit **.217** and scored **3.38** runs per game...in the 6g since **Votto's** return the Reds are **3-3**, hitting **.278** (59-212) and have scored **4.83** runs per game (29r).

### Power Outage

Neither team homered in the most recent game at Great American Ball Park, a 4-1 White Sox victory on 6/21...was only the **39th homerless game** in the **521-game** history of GABP, the third this season (also, 4/29 vs Hou & 6/16 vs Atl)...only once in the ballpark's 7-year existence has there been a streak of **2 straight games** without a home run by either team (8/6-8/7, 2005 vs Fla).

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** Is **Game 1** of a 3-game series vs **Mike McNally's** Diamondbacks and **Game 1** of a 6-game homestand that also includes the upcoming weekend series vs the **Cardinals** (3g)...is the Reds' final homestand before the **All-Star** break...beginning Mon will finish the first half on the road at **Phi** (4g) and at **NYM** (3g), including their first visit to the Mets' new **Citi Field**...are coming off a **3-3** road trip to **Tor** (1-2) and **Cle** (2-1)...on Sunday completed a **4-5** stretch against American League opponents (1-2 vs WSox, 1-2 at Tor, 2-1 at Cle).

**FRIENDS OF REDS BASEBALL:** At tonight's game **Alex Gonzalez** and **Ramon Hernandez** are hosting in moon deck Section 143 **100 children and families** from the **Su Casa Hispanic Center of Cincinnati** as part of their **Los Amigos del Beisbol de Los Rojos** ticket program targeting local hispanic families...the guests received transportation to and from the game, a custom Reds cap, a \$10 concession voucher and in-stadium welcomes via the public address announcer and scoreboard.

**INTERLEAGUE PLAY:** On Sunday the Reds finished their 13th season of interleague play...Cin went **6-9 vs the American League** this season (2-1 vs Cle, 0-3 at KC, 1-2 vs WSox, 1-2 at Tor, 2-1 at Cle)...**Jonny Gomes** served as the club's designated hitter in all 9 interleague road games (11-32, .344, 3 2b, 3hr, 7rbi, 5r, 5bb)...for the first time since Interleague play began in 1997, the Reds didn't use more than 1 designated hitter...the Reds are **83-104 (.451) all-time** vs American League teams...their all-time results vs AL teams can be found on page 351 of the media guide.

**OHIO CUP MOP:** Reds **C Ramon Hernandez** was voted by the media the coveted **Ohio Cup** trophy, presented by **The Ohio Lottery**, as the **Most Outstanding Player** of this year's interleague series between the Reds and Indians that concluded Sunday...he will receive the award in ceremonies prior to Friday's game...in 5g vs the Tribe **Hernandez** went 9-for-19 (.474) with a double, triple, homer and 5rbi...**OF Jonny Gomes** (6g, 7-23, .304, 1hr, 4rbi) and **LHP Arthur Rhodes** (4g, 4ip, 1h, 0r, 0bb, 3k) also received votes...the Reds won the series, 4 games to 2...Reds **OF Adam Dunn** won the 2008 **MOP Award** (.300, 5hr, 10rbi).

**DOT, DOT, DOT....:** The Reds have **won 3 of their last 4g**...are **4-6** after an off day...tomorrow **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** will have surgery to repair the torn labrum in his right shoulder...**Castillo** suffered the season-ending injury on a head-first slide in the seventh inning of lthe game on 6/20 vs the White Sox...on the road trip **Reds relievers** posted a **1.80era** (20ip, 4er)...**OF Jonny Gomes** has hit 3 of the Reds' last 6 homers and 4 of their last 11 homers...**Ryan Hanigan** leads all National League rookie batters in on-base percentage (.408)...**Ramon Hernandez** needs 2 runs scored to reach **500** in his career.

**ALL-STAR AMONG US:** Sherri J. Friedman of **Amberley Village** is the Reds' nominee for **PEOPLE Magazine's All-Stars Among Us** campaign, which recognizes an individual from each Major League Baseball team who serves his or her community in extraordinary ways...**Friedman** will be honored on the field during ceremonies prior to the July 14 **All-Star Game** in St. Louis...**tomorrow night** she will deliver the official game ball before the Reds play the Diamondbacks...**Friedman** was elected in online voting for her community service through **Most Valuable Kids of Greater Cincinnati**, an organization that distributes unused tickets to underserved children...she has helped 22,000 kids experience local sporting and entertainment events, including more than 4,800 Reds games.

**EDWIN'S REHAB:** **3B Edwin Encarnacion** is on a rehabilitation assignment at Class AAA Louisville (9g, 8-31, .258, 1 2b, 2hr, 7rbi, 8bb, 4k)...played 3B in last night's 8-2 Bats win at **Gwinnett** and went 0-for-3 with 2 walks...has been on the disabled list since 4/28 with a chip fracture in his left wrist.

**M\*A\*S\*H:** From the **Opening Day** roster the Reds are missing starters **SS Alex Gonzalez** (right elbow surgery, out 4-5 weeks) and **3B Edwin Encarnacion** (broken left wrist, rehabbing in Louisville) along with starting **RHP Edinson Volquez** (right elbow) and reliever **RHP Mike Lincoln** (bulging disc in his neck)...all are on the disabled list...several other players missed action recently because of various ailments, including **1B Joey Votto** (stress), **2B Brandon Phillips** (hairline fracture, right thumb), **OF Willy Taveras** (tight right hamstring) and **IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr.** (flu).

**MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUT:** **RHP Carlos Fisher** and **LHP Matt Maloney** made their Major League debuts this season...in **2008**, 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts: **RHP Johnny Cueto**, **IF Paul Janish**, **OF Jay Bruce**, **LHP Daniel Ray Herrera**, **RHP Daryl Thompson**, **IF Adam Rosales**, **OF Chris Dickerson**, **RHP Ramon Ramirez**, **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** and **RHP Josh Roenicke**.

**REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (17-17 .500):** The Reds went **4-6-2 in their 12 home series** and produced a winning record on just 2 of their 6 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3, 1-2, 3-3)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **258-262-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38)...at **217-217-1** the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since **6/26/04** (57-57)...also reached .500 at **219-219-1**.

**REDS ON THE ROAD (20-20 .500):** The Reds have won 2 straight road games and 3 of their last 4 road games...went **7-4-2 in their 13 road series**...produced the following records on their road trips: 7-3, 3-2, 3-3, 2-5, 2-4 and 3-3...entering this season and dating to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

**IN THE STANDINGS (85):** The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 42, FOURTH - 29, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...at **20-14** and **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g** over .500 at **36-24**...4 times were a season-high **2g under .500** (0-2, 1-3, 34-36, 35-37)...have spent **62** days above, **11** days at and **12** days below .500.

**REDS vs DIAMONDBACKS:** The Reds are 41-38 all-time vs the Diamondbacks, including 3-0 this season and 7-2 the last 2 years...have won the last 5g and 7 of the last 8g vs Ari...at **Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 10-8, including 2-1 in 2008 and 5-1 the last 2 seasons.

**Bronson Arroyo** made the shortest start of his career and became only the sixth starting pitcher in Major League history to allow at least 10 earned runs in a game in which he retired 3 batters or fewer (1+ip, 1H, 10er)...beginning with his next start, a 9-5 win at Cle on 6/29/08, **Arroyo** has 19 wins, second-most in the Major Leagues since then:

**Last Pitched:** Wed at Tor and suffered the 8-2 loss (3.2p, 8h, 7r, 6er, 3bb, 2k, 3hr, 93 pitches, 54 strikes)...left trailing, 7-2, with the bases loaded but Burton stranded all 3 runners...in the 5-run first inning allowed a 2-run HR to Hill, a solo HR to Wells and a 2-run HR to Lind...the homers to Hill and Wells were on consecutive pitches...in the second inning allowed a 2-out, RBI-double to Wells...allowed an unearned run in the fourth...

**Red Hots:** Is making his 15th start of the season, his second vs the Diamondbacks...with 8 victories is just shy of the National League leaders...in his previous 15 starts the Reds went 8-7 and scored 65 runs (4.33 r/g)...has 8 quality starts...since he was acquired by the Reds prior to the 2006 season leads all Major League pitchers with 117 starts and ranks third in the National League with 744.0 innings pitched (**Aaron Harang** 748.1ip, **Roy Oswalt** 746.2ip).

**Unlucky June 24:** On 6/24 each of the last 2 seasons started against the Blue Jays at Tor's Rogers Centre...in those 2 starts, a 14-1 loss on 6/24/08 and an 8-2

loss on 6/24/09, allowed 17 runs in 4.2 innings...in the 2008 loss became only the sixth starting pitcher in Major League history to allow at least 10 earned runs while retiring 3 batters or fewer...in the 2009 loss allowed 5 runs in the first inning on homers by Hill (2-run), Wells (solo) and Lind (2-run)...in the calendar year between those 2 starts went 19-9, 4.19...the 19 wins were the second-most in the Major Leagues in that 1-year span (Tor's **Roy Halladay**, 22-6, 2.49).

**In The Big Inning:** Allowed at least 1 run in the first inning of 8 of his 15 starts, including 6 of his last 7 starts...has posted a 10.80era in the first inning (15ip, 18er) and a 4.52era after the first frame (77.2ip, 39er).

**Perfect:** Began the season 3-0 for the third time in his career but for the first time won his first 3 starts of a season...won his first 2 starts in 2006, the season in the rotation and win his first 3 starts since **LHP Pete Sch** 1990.

## Tomorrow's Pitcher: RHP Johnny Cueto

**Last Pitched:** Thu at Tor and earned the 7-5 victory (6ip, 5h, 5er, 3bb, 4k, 1hr, 95 pitches, 55 strikes)...left leading, 6-5, after Votto's homer leading off the seventh inning snapped the 5-1 tie...after the Reds scored 4 runs in the top of the first allowed Hill's solo HR in the bottom of the inning...took a 5-1 lead into the bottom of the fifth...but allowed 4 runs with 2 outs on Wells' 2-run double and Rolen's 2-run single.

**Red Hots:** The 23-year-old righthander tomorrow will make his 16th start of the season...ranks among the National League leaders with a 2.86era (6th) and a .231 opponents' BA (8th)...in his 15 starts the Reds went 9-6 and scored 66 runs (4.40 r/g)...in 9 of his 15 starts threw at least 7.0 innings and in 13 of his 15 starts threw at least 6.0 innings.

**Holding On:** In his last 2 starts did not hold 3 leads of at least 4 runs...in a no-decision in the 10-8 loss on 6/20 vs WSox took a **5-0 cushion** into the top of the fourth inning but then allowed 3 runs in that frame and 2 more runs in the fifth...in Thu's 7-5 win at Tor led **4-0** and **5-1** but the Blue Jays pulled even at 5-5 with a 4-run fifth inning.

**No Place Like Home...**For just the second time in 7 starts will pitch at Great American Ball Park...for the season is **1-2, 3.96** in 6 starts at home (38.2ip, 17er) and **6-2, 2.14** in 9 starts on the road (59ip, 14er).
