Reds relievers have posted a **1.77era** on this road trip (20.1ip, 4er), a **2.55era** in their last 43g (130.2ip, 37er) and a **2.33era** in their last 31g (96.2ip, 25er).

Player of the Month Candidate

Brandon Phillips hit .352 with 7hr and **29rbi** in May, the most RBI by a Reds batter in a calendar month since **Adam Dunn** had **31rbi** in **June 2005**...despite missing 5 starts with a hairline fracture on the tip of his right thumb, **Phillips** ranked T2nd in RBI among all Major League batters last month:

Multi-Tasking

In last night's win **2B Brandon Phillips** produced 3 hits, a homer, 3 RBI, 3 runs scored and 2 stolen bases...since 1920, when the RBI became an official statistic, only 2 other Reds players reached all 5 of those statistical levels in a game: **George Foster** in 1976 and **Gary Redus** in 1983 (courtesy Elias Sports Bureau).

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 4** (2-1) of a 4-game series vs **Richard Dierkes'** Cardinals and **Game 7** (2-4) of a 7-game road trip that also included a winless visit to Mil (0-3)...is **Game 7** (2-4) of a stretch in which the Reds will play 13-16g on the road...beginning tomorrow the Reds return to **Great American Ball Park** for a brief 3-game weekend set with the Cubs before hitting the road again for **Wsh** (3g) and **KC** (3g).

CENTRAL CASTING: Tonight's game is **Game 10** (5-4) of 13 straight vs **National League Central Division** rivals (3-0 vs Hou, 0-3 at Mil, **2-1 at StL**, 3g vs Chi)...following this 13-game stretch won't play within the division again until **Fourth of July** weekend (3g at StL), a drought that includes 21 consecutive games outside the **Central**.

DOT, DOT, DOT...: Tonight **RHP Aaron Harang** will make the 200th start of his career...tomorrow the Reds begin a weekend series with the Cubs at Great American Ball Park, where they have won a season-high 4 straight games...**Alex Gonzalez** needs 4rbi to reach **500** in his career...**Ryan Hanigan** leads all National League rookies in hitting (.329) and on-base percentage (.416).

BE AN EARLY BIRD...: On the riverfront tomorrow night, the **Cincinnati Police Department** is expecting a crowd of about **50,000** to attend the Reds' 7:10 p.m. game with the Cubs and a sold-out **Keith Urban** concert next door at US Bank Arena...the **CPD** recommends fans who don't have passes for the parking garages adjacent to those venues avoid driving on Second and Third Streets and instead use exits into the northern part of downtown (5th Street, 6th Street, 7th Street, Gilbert Road, Reading Road, etc.).

FLORIDA STATE LEAGUE ALL-STARS: Class A Sarasota had 3 players named to the **Florida State League All-Star Team** announced today, including **RHP Enerio Del Rosario**, **RHP Zach Stewart** and **1B Yonder Alonso**...**Alonso** and **Stewart** won't play in the **6/20** game at Ft. Myers' **Hammond Stadium** because of their recent promotions Class AA Carolina.

ANOTHER LEFTHANDER IN THE BOOTH: Former pitcher **Kent Mercker** is joining Hall of Famer **Marty Brennaman** in the **Reds On Radio Network** booth tonight...in 18 Major League seasons, the **Dublin, Ohio** native pitched for the Braves, Orioles, Indians, **Cardinals** (1998-99), Red Sox, Angels, Rockies, Cubs and **Reds** (1997, 2003, 2005-06, 2008)...**Jeff Brantley** will join **George Grande** on the **FOX Sports Ohio** broadcast.

M*A*S*H: From the **Opening Day** roster the Reds are missing starters **1B Joey Votto** and **3B Edwin Encarnacion** along with starting **RHP Edinson Volquez**...all are on the disabled list...several other players missed action recently because of various ailments, including **2B Brandon Phillips** (hairline fracture, tip of right thumb), **SS Alex Gonzalez** (strained left oblique muscle), **Willy Taveras** (tight right hamstring) and **IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr.** (flu).

QUALITY CONTROL: Opposing pitchers have produced **27 quality starts**, including 11 straight from **4/14-4/25**...the Reds went **13-14** (.481) when the opposing starter produced a quality appearance...the Reds produced 24 quality starts (**Cueto** 8, **Arroyo** 6, **Harang** 5, **Volquez** 3, **Owings** 2) and went **20-4** in those QS (.833).

GILLETTE CIVIL RIGHTS GAME: At Great American Ball Park on **Sat, 6/20** the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the **Gillette Civil Rights Game**, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's **Harriet Tubman Theater** (Fri, 6/19, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at **Duke Energy Center** honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's **Beacon Awards** (Sat, 6/20, 11:30 a.m.) and a **Youth Summit** at **Fountain Square** downtown (Sat, 6/20, 4:00 p.m.)...scheduled to attend the **Sat, 6/20** luncheon are Beacon of Change winner **Muhammad Ali**, Beacon of Hope winner **Bill Cosby** and Beacon of Life winner **Hank Aaron**...Beacon Award presenters include **Sugar Ray Leonard** (Ali), Hall of Fame pitcher **Bob Gibson** (Cosby) and **Commissioner Allan H. (Bud) Selig** (Aaron)...Grammy Award-winning gospel artist **BeBe Winans** will perform at the luncheon and at that night's game...former **President Bill Clinton** will be the keynote speaker at the luncheon...for more information, log on to www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (13-12, .520): The Reds went **3-4-2** in their 9 home series and produced a winning record on 2 of their 4 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3)...at **13-12** their record at home is above .500 for the first time this season...in 7 seasons at GABP are **254-257-1**.

REDS ON THE ROAD (15-12, .556): The Reds went **5-2-1** in their **first 8 completed road series**...are **2-4** so far on this road trip...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2), a .500 record on the third trip (3-3) and regardless of tonight's outcome will post a sub-.500 record on this trip (2-4)...entering this season and dating back to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

IN THE STANDINGS (59): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 8, THIRD - 28, FOURTH - 18, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...at **20-14** and again at **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g over .500** at **36-24**...have spent **47** days above, **5** days at and **7** days below .500.

REDS vs CARDINALS: The Reds are 932-1,054 all-time vs the Cardinals, including 4-2 this season...**aat Busch Stadium**: Reds are 10-17, including 2-1 this season and 5-13 here the last 3 years...have won 2 of the last 3g here but lost 6 of the last 8g and 9 of the last 12g here...**at Old Busch** went 119-139.

UP NEXT: REDS vs CUBS: The Reds are 1,049-1,076 all-time vs the Cubs, including 981-1005 since 1900 and 2-1 this season...**at Great American Ball Park**: Reds are 24-24, including 4-2 in 2008 and 8-7 the last 2 seasons...**Aramis Ramirez** and **Derrek Lee** rank in the Top 5 in home runs by an opponent at GABP (**Lance Berkman** 21, **Jason Bay** 14, **Albert Pujols** 14, **Ramirez** 12, **Lee** 12)...**Carlos Zambrano's** 7 wins there tie Hou's **Roy Oswalt** for the most by an opposing pitcher.

Last Started: Sat at Mil and suffered the 9-5 loss (4.2ip, 12h, 8er, 0bb, 5k, 3hr, 104 pitches, 64 strikes)...left trailing, 7-5, and was charged with another run scored off Burton...allowed 6 his 8 runs on homers, to Fielder (3-run in the first inning), Braun (solo in the fifth) and Cameron (2-run in the fifth)...led 3-0 and 5-3 but the Brewers scored 6 runs in the bottom of the fifth off Harang and Burton to take a lead they would not relinquish.

Red Hots: Is making his 12th start of the season and 200th start of his career...in his previous 11 starts the Reds went 5-6 and scored 44 runs (4 r/g)...in his 11 starts **Reds batters** hit .258 (94-365)...on 4/23 at Chi recorded the **1,000th strikeout** of his career (**Derrek Lee**)...his 3-hitter in the club's fifth game, a 2-0 win on 4/12 vs Pit, was the quickest complete game by a Reds pitcher since **Pete Harnisch** threw a CG in the Reds' fourth game of **1999**.

Home Cookin': Is **4-2, 2.84** (38ip, 12er) in 6 starts at Great American Ball Park and **1-3, 5.87** (30.2ip, 20er) in 5 starts on the road.

Opening Day: In the 2-1 loss vs the Mets made his fourth straight Opening Day start, the first Reds pitcher to do so since **RHP Jose Rijo** had the honors in 4 straight seasons from 1992-95...the only other Reds pitchers to make at least 4 consecutive Opening Day starts are **Pete Donohue** (5 straight, 1923-27) and **Mario Soto** (5, 1982-86)...**Soto** holds the club record for overall Opening Day starts (6)...in 4 career Opening Day starts **Harang** is 1-3, 3.52 (23ip, 9er).

Staff Ace: Since he was acquired from the Athletics at the **2003 trading deadline** is the Reds' leader in most statistical pitching categories, including starts (178), wins (68), innings pitched (1137.2) and strikeouts (962)...since the beginning of the **2006 season** ranks second in the National League in innings pitched (719.0; **Arroyo** 1st, 7.21.2)...in 2005 and 2007 won the BBWAA's Johnny Vander Meer Award as the club's Most Outstanding Pitcher.

Community Affairs: Is one of the club's more active members of the local community...for the third straight season, as part of his **Aaron's Aces** ticket program is hosting at all Sunday home games children of military personnel serving in the **War On Terrorism**...along with wife **Jen** donated \$55,000 to the **Miracle League of Greater Cincinnati and Northern Kentucky** and on 5/9 attended the dedication of that field at the **Durham Recreation Complex** in Western Hills...for his community service has been the club's nominee for the **Robert Clemente Award** (2007), **Branch Rickey Award** (2007) and **Marvin Miller Man of the Year Award** (2007, 2008).

Tomorrow vs Cubs: RHP Micah Owings

Last Started: Sun at Mil and suffered the 5-2 loss (5.2ip, 8h, 5er, 3bb, 5k, 1hr, 103 pitches, 67 strikes)...left trailing, 5-2, but retired 10 of his 11 final batters...in the first inning allowed consecutive 2-out, RBI-singles to Cameron and Gamel...in the second allowed a sac fly to Hardy...in the third allowed Cameron's 2-run HR.

Red Hots: Tomorrow vs Cubs will make his 10th start of the season, his fourth start since an emergency relief appearance on 5/16 at SD...in his previous 9 starts the Reds went 4-5 and scored 41 runs (4.56 r/g)...has 2 quality starts...with an 8-2 win on 4/26 vs Atl snapped his 9-game losing streak dating back to a 9-3 Diamondbacks victory on 5/25/08 at Atl...in 14 apps and 10 starts between victories went **0-9, 8.53** (51.2ip, 49er).

In Relief: Made his only relief appearance of the season in the 16-inning, 6-5 loss at SD on 5/16...threw a career-high 5.2 innings in relief (3h, 1er, 3bb, 5k, 1hr, 81 pitches, 44 strikes)...entered the game in the 11th inning as the Reds' seventh and final pitcher...retired his first 10 batters until Scott Hairston singled with 1 out in the 14th inning...Nick Hundley homered to end the 5-hour, 14 minute struggle...in 3 starts since then is **0-2, 8.56 (13.2ip, 13er)**.
