D-Day

Today marks the 65th anniversary of the Invasion of Normandy...per Presidential Memorandum, the U.S. Flag will be at half mast until sunset (8:42 p.m.), when it will be raised to full mast...in the middle of the second inning the Reds will reflect on the anniversary of the epic day that turned the tide of World War II...according to The Associated Press, approximately 400,000 Allied and German soldiers were killed or wounded during D-Day and the ensuing 3 months it took to secure the Allied capture of Normandy.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 2** (0-1) of a brief 3-game homestand vs **Dusty Harrington's** Cubs and **Game 9** (2-6) of a stretch in which the Reds will play 13-16g on the road (0-3 at Mil, 2-2 at StL, **0-1 vs Cubs**, 3g at Wsh, 3g at KC)...following this series Cin will head back out on the road for a 6-game trip to **Wsh** (3g) and **KC** (3g)...on Thu the Reds finished a **2-5 road trip** to Mil (0-3) and StL (2-2).

SOUTHPAW: In his Major League debut tonight, **Matt Maloney** will become the first **lefthander** to start for the Reds this season and only the second LH starter in the club's last **236 games**...in **2008**, righthanded pitchers started Cin's first 161 games until **Adam Pettyjohn** took the hill for the season finale...**Pettyjohn's start** snapped a streak of **180 consecutive starts** by Reds righthanders...according to **Elias Sports Bureau**, only the Reds, Padres and Cardinals have not started a lefthanded pitcher this season.

CENTRAL CASTING: Tonight's game is **Game 12** (5-6) of 13 straight vs **National League Central Division** rivals (3-0 vs Hou, 0-3 at Mil, 2-2 at StL, **0-1 vs Chi**)...the Reds began this stretch in third place, 2.5g out of first...following this series the Reds won't play within the division again until **Fourth of July** weekend (3g at StL), a drought that includes 21 consecutive games outside the **Central**.

PLAYERS OF THE MONTH: **OF Chris Heisey** (pronounced HI-zee) and **RHP Zach Stewart** have been named the organization's Minor League Player and Pitcher of the Month...in 29g at Class AA Carolina, **Heisey** hit .404 with 4hr, 17rbi and 3sb...in 5 starts for Carolina and Class A Sarasota, **Stewart** went 2-1, 1.04 with 1 complete game (34.2ip, 25h, 5bb, 23k).

ALL-STARS: Class A Sarasota's **RHP Enerio Del Rosario**, **RHP Zach Stewart** and **1B Yonder Alonso** were named to the **Florida State League All-Star** team...**Alonso** and **Stewart** won't play in the **6/20** game at Ft. Myers' **Hammond Stadium** because of their recent promotions to Class AA Carolina...**LHP Matt Fairrel** and **C Kevin Coddington** will represent Class A Dayton in the **Midwest League All-Star Game** on **6/23** at Clinton's **Alliant Energy Field**.

DRAFT DAY: The first round of Tuesday's first-year player draft will be broadcast live on **MLB Network** from its **Studio 42** beginning at 6:00 p.m. ET...**MLB.com** will broadcast the rest of the day's picks live via video stream...Tuesday's schedule will include the first 111 picks of Round 1, Compensation Round A, Round 2, Round 3 and Compensation Round B...the draft resumes at noon Wednesday with Rounds 4 through 30...it will conclude Thursday at 11:30 a.m. with Rounds 31 through 50...on Tuesday, the Reds will draft **eighth, 43rd** (compensation for losing Type B free agent **LHP Jeremy Affeldt**), **57th** and **88th**...the Nationals have the No. 1 overall pick...the lists of Cin's 2008 draft picks and No. 1 draft picks are on pages **212-213** of the media guide...**OF Jay Bruce** is the only first-round pick currently on the Reds' roster (2005 by Cin, 12th overall)...senior director of scouting **Chris Buckley** will be available to the local media on the third-floor lobby of the business administration building immediately following Tuesday's first-round pick (approximately 6:45 p.m.) and again following the conclusion of the draft's first day.

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUT: **LHP Matt Maloney** is the second Reds player this season to make his Major League debut (**RHP Carlos Fisher**)...last season 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts, including **RHP Johnny Cueto**, **IF Paul Janish**, **OF Jay Bruce**, **LHP Daniel Ray Herrera**, **RHP Daryl Thompson**, **IF Adam Rosales**, **OF Chris Dickerson**, **RHP Ramon Ramirez**, **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** and **RHP Josh Roenicke**.

GILLETTE CIVIL RIGHTS GAME: At Great American Ball Park on **Sat, 6/20** the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the **Gillette Civil Rights Game**, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's **Harriet Tubman Theater** (Fri, 6/19, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at **Duke Energy Center** honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's **Beacon Awards** (Sat, 6/20, 11:30 a.m.) and a **Youth Summit** at **Fountain Square** downtown (Sat, 6/20, 4:00 p.m.)...scheduled to attend the **Sat, 6/20** luncheon are Beacon of Change winner **Muhammad Ali**, Beacon of Hope winner **Bill Cosby** and Beacon of Life winner **Hank Aaron**...Beacon Award presenters include **Sugar Ray Leonard** (Ali), Hall of Fame pitcher **Bob Gibson** (Cosby) and **Commissioner Allan H. (Bud) Selig** (Aaron)...Grammy Award-winning gospel artist **BeBe Winans** will perform at the luncheon and at that night's game...former **President Bill Clinton** will be the keynote speaker at the luncheon...for more information, log on to www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (13-13, .500): The Reds went **3-4-2** in their previous 9 home series and produced a winning record on 2 of their 4 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3)...at **13-12** their record at home was above .500 for the only time this season...in 7 seasons at GABP are **254-258-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38).

REDS ON THE ROAD (15-13, .536): The Reds went **5-2-2 in their 9 road series**...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2), a .500 record on the third trip (3-3) and a losing record in their most recent road trip (2-5)...entering this season and dating to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

IN THE STANDINGS (61): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 8, THIRD - 29, FOURTH - 19, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...at **20-14** and again at **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g over .500** at **36-24**...have spent **49** days above, **5** days at and **7** days below .500.

REDS vs CUBS: The Reds are 1,049-1,077 all-time vs the Cubs, including 981-1006 since 1900 and 2-2 this season...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 24-25, including 0-1 this season...**Aramis Ramirez** and **Derrek Lee** rank in the Top 5 in home runs by an opponent at GABP (**Lance Berkman** 21, **Jason Bay** 14, **Albert Pujols** 14, **Ramirez** 12, **Lee** 12)...**Carlos Zambrano's** 8 wins here are the most by an opposing pitcher...**last Cubs sweep:** at Cin: 4/26-4/27, 1995 (2g); 5/28-5/30, 2001 (3g)...at Chi: 7/21-7/22, 2004 (2g); 5/22-5/24, 2001 (3g).

Red Hots: The 25-year-old lefthander tonight is making his Major League debut after 99 minor league apps and 98 minor league starts...was born in **Sandusky, Ohio** and lives in **Columbus**...graduated from **Huron (OH) High School**...his media guide bio is on page 135.

Southpaws: Will be the first **lefthander** to start for the Reds this season and only the second LHP starter in the club's last **236 games**...in **2008**, righthanders started Cin's first 161 games until **Adam Pettyjohn** took the hill for the season finale...**Pettyjohn's start** snapped a streak of **180 consecutive starts** by Reds righthanders...according to **Elias Sports Bureau**, only the Reds, Padres and Cardinals have not started a lefthanded pitcher this season.

With The Bats: Began the season with Louisville and in 10 starts for the Bats went 4-3, 2.00...led the staff in starts (10, tied with **Homer Bailey**), innings pitched (67.1) and strikeouts (58)...in his last 5 starts for Louisville went 2-2, 0.73 (37ip, 3er)...was the organization's Minor League Pitcher of the Month for April (3gs, 2-0, 1.86).

At The Plate: As a batter for Louisville hit .286 (2-7), including a solo home run on 4/17 at Indianapolis off **Daniel McCutchen**.

Major League Debut: Is the second Reds player to make a Major League debut this season (**RHP Carlos Fisher**)...last season 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts, including **RHP Johnny Cueto**, **IF Paul Janish**, **OF Jay Bruce**, **LHP Daniel Ray Herrera**, **RHP Daryl Thompson**, **IF Adam Rosales**, **OF Chris Dickerson**, **RHP Ramon Ramirez**, **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** and **RHP Josh Roenicke**.

Last Time It Happened. Rookie...: Reliever **Carlos Fisher** is the last Reds pitcher to win in his Major League debut (5/24/09 vs Cle, 4-3 win in 11 innings)...**Johnny Cueto** is the last Reds starter to win in his Major League debut (4/3/08 vs Ari, 3-2 win)...**Jeff Russell** is the last Reds pitcher to throw a complete game in his first career start (8/13/83 vs SD, 3-1 win)...**Charlie Lebrandt** is the last Reds pitcher to throw a shutout in his first big league start (4/13/80 vs Atl, 5-0 win)...**Bobby Livingston** is the last Reds pitcher to record his first career victory and his first career hit in the same game (6/1/07 at Col, 4-2 win)...**Scott Randall** is the last Reds pitcher to record a hit in his first career plate appearance (9/18/03 at Pit, singled off Kip Wells).

Tomorrow's Pitcher: Bronson Arroyo

Last Pitched: Tue at StL and suffered the 5-2 loss (5.1ip, 7h, 5er, 2bb, 5k, 1hbp, 111 pitches, 73 strikes)...left trailing, 4-2, and was charged with another run scored off Fisher...allowed an RBI-groundout to Pujols in the first inning and a 2-out, RBI-double to Pujols in the fifth...in the sixth allowed a 2-run double to Stavinoha.

Red Hots: Tomorrow will make his 12th start of the season, his first start of the year vs the Cubs...is tied for the National League lead in victories (7)...in his previous 11 starts the Reds went 7-4 and scored 52 runs (4.73 r/g)...has 6 quality starts...since he was acquired by the Reds prior to the 2006 season leads all Major League pitchers with 114 starts and ranks second in the National League with 721.2 innings pitched (**Aaron Harang** 1st, 727ip).

Short Cuts: Made the 2 shortest starts of his career (1ip, plus 4 batters) in a 14-1 loss at Tor on 6/24/08 and a 15-3 loss on 5/6/09 vs Mil...in between those 2 starts went **15-5, 3.76**...since that 6/24/08 loss at Tor still ranks second in the Major Leagues with **18 wins**.

In The Big Inning: Allowed at least 1 run in the first inning of 6 of his 11 starts, including each of his last 4 starts...has posted a 9.81era in the first inning (11ip, 12er) and a 4.55era after the first frame (59.1ip, 30er).

Arroyo's Most Recent Starts: 4/25 vs Atl and suffered the 10-2 loss (5.2ip, 9h, 9er, 3bb, 5k, 1hbp, 2hr, 102 pitches, 60 strikes)...left trailing, 9-2...gave up 2 runs in the first inning, 3 in the second (CJones 3-run HR) and three in the sixth (Escobar 2-run HR)...**5/1 at Pit** and threw 8.0 shutout innings to earn the 4-0 win (4h, 3bb, 4k, 113 pitches, 71 strikes)...left leading, 2-0...**5/6 vs Mil** and suffered the 15-3 loss (1ip+4bf, 7h, 9er, 3bb, 0k, 2hr, 46 pitches, 24 strikes)...tied for the shortest start of his career...left trailing, 9-0...in the first inning allowed 5 runs on 2 walks and 4 hits, including a 3-run HR by Hardy...in the second allowed Braun's grand slam...**5/11 at Ari**, in his 200th career start earned the 13-5 victory (7ip, 10h, 5er, 0bb, 5k, 3hr, 123 pitches, 81 strikes)...allowed 4 of the 5 runs on homers to Upton (2-run), Lopez (solo) and Reynolds (solo)...Reds batters scored 13 runs on 18 hits and 8 extra-base hits, including 6 doubles, all season highs...**5/17 at SD** and suffered the 3-1 loss (7+ip, 6h, 3er, 4bb, 4k, 1hr, 119 pitches, 70 strikes)...allowed 2 runs in the first inning on consecutive 2-out, RBI-singles by Kouzmanoff and Gerut...allowed a HR to Kouzmanoff leading off the eighth...**5/22 vs Cle** and earned the 3-1 victory (8ip, 5h, 1er, 2bb, 2k, 1hr, 105 pitches, 61 strikes)...left leading, 3-1...allowed only a solo HR to Sizemore in the first inning...**5/27 vs Hou** and threw his seventh career complete game in the 6-1 victory (5h, 1er, 1bb, 3k, 92 pitches, 58 strikes)...allowed only a sac fly to Berkman in the first inning...at 2:08 was the shortest game at GABP since September 2006.
