TODAY'S GAME: Is **Game 3** (1-1) of a brief 3-game homestand vs **Bob Rosenberg's** Cubs and **Game 10** (3-6) of a stretch in which the Reds will play 13-16g on the road (0-3 at Mil, 2-2 at StL, **1-1 vs Cubs**, 3g at Wsh, 3g at KC)...tomorrow Cin will head back out on the road for a 6-game trip to **Wsh** (3g) and **KC** (3g) that begins Tuesday...on Thu the Reds finished a **2-5 road trip** to **Mil** (0-3) and **StL** (2-2).

CENTRAL CASTING: Today's game is **Game 13** (6-6) of 13 straight vs **National League Central Division** rivals (3-0 vs Hou, 0-3 at Mil, 2-2 at StL, **1-1 vs Chi**)...the Reds began this stretch in third place, 2.5g out of first...following today's game the Reds won't play within the division again until **Fourth of July** weekend (3g at StL), a drought that includes 21 consecutive games outside the **Central**.

AARON'S ACES: This afternoon **Aaron Harang** is hosting from 30 fans in sun deck Section 143 as part of his **Aaron's Aces** program targeting local **military families**...guests receive an autographed t-shirt, in-stadium welcomes via the public address announcer and scoreboard and a \$10 concession voucher...when he is not scheduled to pitch, **Aaron** meets the guests in the bullpen...fans with family members currently on active duty or who recently returned from active duty can sign up online at www.reds.com/community, then click on ticket programs.

UMPS CARE: Today the Reds and the umpiring crew are hosting the second of 3 groups in conjunction with **UMPS CARE Charities**...the umpires provide game tickets and give behind-the-scenes tours to local children who are waiting for adoption...the group also gives to each child a Reds cap, Cracker Jack, peanuts, Big League Chew gum and a \$10 gift card...the local partners for the program are **Hamilton County Job and Family Services** and the **Dave Thomas Foundation for Adoption**...the last UMPS Care date is 8/2 vs Col.

SOUTHPAW: In his Major League debut last night, **Matt Maloney** became the first the first **lefthander** to start for the Reds this season and only the second LH starter in the club's last **236 games**...in **2008**, righthanded pitchers started Cin's first 161 games until **Adam Pettyjohn** took the hill for the season finale...**Pettyjohn's start** snapped a streak of **180 consecutive starts** by Reds righthanders...according to **Elias Sports Bureau**, prior to last night only the Reds, Padres and Cardinals had not started a lefthanded pitcher this season.

DRAFT DAY: The first round of Tuesday's first-year player draft will be broadcast live on **MLB Network** from its **Studio 42** beginning at 6:00 p.m. ET...MLB.com will broadcast the rest of the day's picks live via video stream...Tuesday's schedule will include the first 111 picks of Round 1, Compensation Round A, Round 2, Round 3 and Compensation Round B...the draft resumes at noon Wednesday with Rounds 4 through 30...it will conclude Thursday at 11:30 a.m. with Rounds 31 through 50...on Tuesday, the Reds will draft **eighth, 43rd** (compensation for losing Type B free agent **LHP Jeremy Affeldt**), **57th** and **88th**...the Nationals have the No. 1 overall pick...the lists of Cin's 2008 draft picks and No. 1 draft picks are on pages **212-213** of the media guide...**OF Jay Bruce** is the only first-round pick currently on the Reds' roster (2005 by Cin, 12th overall)...senior director of scouting **Chris Buckley** will be available to the local media immediately following Tuesday's first-round pick (approximately 6:45 p.m.) and again following the conclusion of the draft's first day.

MORE DRAFT TIDBITS: The Reds will select eighth in Tuesday's first-year player draft...notable Major League players selected with the eighth pick overall include **Todd Helton** (Col), **Jay Bell** (Min), **Todd Walker** (Min), **Jim Abbott** (Cal) and **Paul Maholm** (Pit)...7 of the 31 players who have played for the Reds this season were drafted by the organization, including **1B Joey Votto** (2002, 2nd round), **OF Chris Dickerson** (2003, 16th round), **RHP Homer Bailey** (2004, 7th overall), **IF Paul Janish** (2004, 5th round), **OF Jay Bruce** (2005, 12th overall), **RHP Carlos Fisher** (2005, 11th round), **IF Adam Rosales** (2005, 12th round).

M*A*S*H: From the **Opening Day** roster the Reds are missing starters **1B Joey Votto** and **3B Edwin Encarnacion** along with starting **RHP Edinson Volquez**...all are on the disabled list...several other players missed action recently because of various ailments, including **2B Brandon Phillips** (hairline fracture, tip of right thumb), **SS Alex Gonzalez** (strained left oblique muscle), **Willy Taveras** (tight right hamstring) and **IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr.** (flu).

GILLETTE CIVIL RIGHTS GAME: At Great American Ball Park on **Sat, 6/20** the Reds and Chicago White Sox will meet in the **Gillette Civil Rights Game**, the first time the contest will be played during the regular season...the weekend's festivities will include a roundtable discussion at the National Underground Railroad Freedom Center's **Harriet Tubman Theater** (Fri, 6/19, 4:00 p.m.), a luncheon at **Duke Energy Center** honoring the 3 winners of Major League Baseball's **Beacon Awards** (Sat, 6/20, 11:30 a.m.) and a **Youth Summit** at **Fountain Square** downtown (Sat, 6/20, 4:00 p.m.)...scheduled to attend the **Sat, 6/20** luncheon are Beacon of Change winner **Muhammad Ali**, Beacon of Hope winner **Bill Cosby** and Beacon of Life winner **Hank Aaron**...Beacon Award presenters include **Sugar Ray Leonard** (Ali), Hall of Fame pitcher **Bob Gibson** (Cosby) and **Commissioner Allan H. (Bud) Selig** (Aaron)...Grammy Award-winning gospel artist **BeBe Winans** will perform at the luncheon and at that night's game...former **President Bill Clinton** will be the keynote speaker at the luncheon...for more information, log on to www.mlb.com/civilrightsgame.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (14-13, .519): The Reds went **3-4-2** in their previous 9 home series and produced a winning record on 2 of their 4 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3)...at **14-13** their record at home is above .500 for the second time this season (13-12)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **255-258-1**.

REDS ON THE ROAD (15-13, .536): The Reds went **5-2-2** in their **9 road series**...produced winning records on each of their first 2 road trips (7-3, 3-2), a .500 record on the third trip (3-3) and a losing record in their most recent road trip (2-5)...entering this season and dating to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

REDS vs CUBS: The Reds are 1,050-1,077 all-time vs the Cubs, including 982-1006 since 1900 and 3-2 this season...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 25-25, including 1-1 this season...**Aramis Ramirez** and **Derrek Lee** rank in the Top 5 in home runs by an opponent at GABP (**Lance Berkman** 21, **Jason Bay** 14, **Albert Pujols** 14, **Ramirez** 12, **Lee** 12).

UP NEXT: REDS at NATIONALS: The Reds are 224-189 all-time vs the franchise formerly known as the Montreal Expos, including 4-3 last season when they swept the 4-game series in July at GABP and were swept in a 3-game set at Nationals Park in August...**at Nationals Park:** Reds are 0-3.

Wins Beginning 6/29

In the 14-1 loss on 6/24/08 at Tor, **Bronson Arroyo** made the shortest start of his career and became only the sixth starting pitcher in Major League history to allow at least 10 earned runs in a game in which he retired 3 batters or fewer (1+ip, 11h, 10er)...beginning with his next start, a 9-5 win at Cle on 6/29/08, **Arroyo** has 18 wins, second-most in the Major Leagues since then:

Roy Halladay 21-6, 2.59

BRONSON ARROYO 18-8, 4.17

Last Pitched: Tue at StL and suffered the 5-2 loss (5.1ip, 7h, 5er, 2bb, 5k, 1hbp, 111 pitches, 73 strikes)...left trailing, 4-2, and was charged with another run scored off Fisher...allowed an RBI-groundout to Pujols in the first inning and a 2-out, RBI-double to Pujols in the fifth...in the sixth allowed a 2-run double to Stavinoha.

Red Hots: Is making his 12th start of the season, his first start of the year vs the Cubs...is tied for the National League lead in victories (7)...in his previous 11 starts the Reds went 7-4 and scored 52 runs (4.73 r/g)...has 6 quality starts...since he was acquired by the Reds prior to the 2006 season leads all Major League pitchers with 114 starts and ranks second in the National League with 721.2 innings pitched (**Aaron Harang** 1st, 727ip).

Short Cuts: Made the 2 shortest starts of his career (1ip, plus 4 batters) in a 14-1 loss at Tor on 6/24/08 and a 15-3 loss on 5/6/09 vs Mil...in between those 2 starts

went **15-5, 3.76**...since that 6/24/08 loss at Tor still ranks second in the Major Leagues with **18 wins**.

In The Big Inning: Allowed at least 1 run in the first inning of 6 of his 11 starts, including each of his last 4 starts...has posted a 9.81era in the first inning (11ip, 12er) and a 4.55era after the first frame (59.1ip, 30er).

Perfect: Began the season 3-0 for the third time in his career but for the first time won his first 3 starts of a season...won his first 2 starts in 2006, when he started off 5-0...began the 2005 campaign 4-0...was the first Reds pitcher to begin the season in the rotation and win his first 3 starts since **LHP Pete Schourek** did it in 1996 and the first righthander since **Jack Armstrong** won his first 5 starts of 1990.

Career Highs: **Innings:** 9.0 (longest, 6x), last on 5/27/09 for Cin vs Hou & 1+4bf (shortest, 2x), 6/24/08 for Cin at Tor & 5/6/09 for Cin vs Mil; **Hits:** 13, 9/26/08 for Cin at StL; **Runs:** 10 (2x), 6/23/00 for Pit at NYM & 6/24/08 for Cin at Tor; **Earned Runs:** 10, 6/24/08 for Cin at Tor; **Walks:** 5 (4x), last on 8/20/08 at Chi; **Strikeouts:** 12, 7/19/04 for Bos at Sea; **HR allowed:** 4, 4/7/08 vs Phi (Rollins leadoff, Burrell 2, Jenkins); **Complete Games:** 7, last on 5/27/09 for Cin vs Hou (6-1 win); **Shutouts:** 1, 9/5/06 for Cin vs SF (3-0 win).

Arroyo's Most Recent Starts: **5/6 vs Mil** and suffered the 15-3 loss (1ip+4bf, 7h, 9er, 3bb, 0k, 2hr, 46 pitches, 24 strikes)...tied for the shortest start of his career...left trailing, 9-0...in the first inning allowed 5 runs on 2 walks and 4 hits, including a 3-run HR by Hardy...in the second allowed Braun's grand slam...**5/11 at Ari**, in his 200th career start earned the 13-5 victory (7ip, 10h, 5er, 0bb, 5k, 3hr, 123 pitches, 81 strikes)...allowed 4 of the 5 runs on homers to Upton (2-run), Lopez (solo) and Reynolds (solo)...Reds batters scored 13 runs on 18 hits and 8 extra-base hits, including 6 doubles, all season highs...**5/17 at SD** and suffered the 3-1 loss (7+ip, 6h, 3er, 4bb, 4k, 1hr, 119 pitches, 70 strikes)...allowed 2 runs in the first inning on consecutive 2-out, RBI-singles by Kouzmanoff and Gerut...allowed a HR to Kouzmanoff leading off the eighth...**5/22 vs Cle** and earned the 3-1 victory (8ip, 5h, 1er, 2bb, 2k, 1hr, 105 pitches, 61 strikes)...left leading, 3-1...allowed only a solo HR to Sizemore in the first inning...**5/27 vs Hou** and threw his seventh career complete game in the 6-1 victory (5h, 1er, 1bb, 3k, 92 pitches, 58 strikes)...allowed only a sac fly to Berkman in the first inning...at 2:08 was the shortest game at GABP since September 2006.

Tuesday at Nats: RHP Johnny Cueto

Last Pitched: Wed at StL and earned the 9-3 win (6.1ip, 7h, 1er, 0bb, 3k, 101 pitches, 69 strikes)...left leading, 4-1...allowed his only run on consecutive doubles by Rasmus and Ryan in the seventh inning.

Red Hots: On Tue at Wsh the 23-year-old righthander will make his 12th start of the season and the 43rd start of his career...ranks fourth in the National League with a 2.43era (4th) and a .213 opponents' batting average...in his 11 starts the Reds went 7-4 and scored 47 runs (4.27 r/g)...leads the team with 8 quality starts, all in his last 9 apps and including 3 straight...his string of 5 consecutive QS from 4/22-5/13 was the longest stretch of quality starts by a Reds pitcher this season.

Streaking I: In 5 starts from 4/22-5/13 went **4-0, 1.25** (36ip, 5er)...the 4-game winning streak was the longest of his career...allowed 4 earned runs in his first start of the season (6ip) and 16 earned runs in his last 10 starts (68ip, 2.12era).

Streaking II: In each of 4 starts from 4/22-5/8 threw at least 7.0 innings while allowing no more than 1 run, the longest streak of that kind by a Reds pitcher since **Tim Belcher** had a 4-game run from **5/27-6/13, 1992** (courtesy Elias Sports Bureau).
