Tuesday, June 16 - Cincinnati Reds vs. Atlanta Braves, 7:10 pm

- "Straight A" Game: 2,900 7th- 12th grade students who achieved an "A" average (over a designated period during the 2008-09 school year) are attending the game for free.
- Redlegs 5K winners: Race winners from the Redlegs Run for Home 5K held on May 30 will be recognized during pregame ceremonies.

Saturday, June 20 - Cincinnati Reds vs. Chicago White Sox, 7:10 pm - Gillette Civil Rights Game

- Frank Robinson 1964 Mesh Jersey Giveaway: The first 20,000 fans will receive a free replica of the Reds Hall of Famer's 1964 jersey, just like the ones Reds players will wear for the game. Presented by Duke Energy.
- Pregame Parade: Over 1000 players and coaches from the Reds Community Fund's youth baseball teams will participate in a pregame parade around the field.
- **Pregame Ceremony:** MLB Beacon Award winners Muhammad Ali, Bill Cosby and Hank Aaron will be honored during pregame ceremonies, along with sponsors and partners of the Civil Rights Game.

Sunday, June 21 - Cincinnati Reds vs. Chicago White Sox, 1:10 pm - Dad Appreciation Day

- Tie Giveaway: Free tie in keepsake box to first 10,000 dads, presented by Kahn's.
- Ball Delivery: Local civil rights lawyer Al Gerhardstein and daughter Jessica Gingold will deliver the Official Game Ball. Al and Jessica just completed a 1,200 mile bike ride from Mobile, Alabama to Cincinnati to raise money for the Ohio Justice & Policy Center, a non-profit law office Al founded 12 years ago.
- Aaron's Aces: For the third year in a row, Reds ace Aaron Harang hosts a free ticket program for families where a parent is serving in the military oversees.
