Through **tomorrow**, fans can help pick the starting lineups of the **2009 All-Star Game** in St. Louis by voting online at reds.com/vote...among National League second basemen **Brandon Phillips** ranks T1st in **RBI** (52) and **stolen bases** (11) and third in homers (11)...**1B Joey Votto** is hitting **.351** with a **.451** on-base percentage...**RHP Johnny Cueto** (7-4, 2.86) ranks among the NL leaders in ERA (6th) and opponents' batting average against (.231, 8th)...**RHP Francisco Cordero** ranks T5th in the NL with 18 saves in 19 chances.

Designated Designated Hitter

In his last 18g **Jonny Gomes** is hitting .360 (18-50, 5 2b, 4hr, 11rbi)...has hit safely in each of his last 5 starts, including at least 1rbi in each of those 5g (8-21, .381, 6rbi)...hit 3 of the Reds' last 6 homers and 4 of their last 11 homers...started at DH in all 9 of the Reds' interleague road games (11-32, .344, 3 2b, 3hr, 7rbi, 5r, 5bb).

Statistically Speaking...

The Reds went **26-21**, hit **.257** and scored **4.57** runs per game before **1B Joey Votto** went on the disabled list on **5/30**...during his 21g on the disabled list the Reds went 8-13, hit .217 and scored 3.38 runs per game...in the 7g since **Votto's** return the Reds are **3-4**, hitting **.267** (65-244) and have scored **4.43** runs per game (31r).

Castillo's Surgery

Today **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** was scheduled to have surgery to repair the torn labrum in his right shoulder...the procedure was to be performed by Reds medical director Dr. Timothy Kremchek...**Castillo** suffered the season-ending injury on a head-first slide in the seventh inning of the game on 6/20 vs the White Sox...later this afternoon the Reds will have an update on **Castillo's** condition and prognosis.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 2** (0-1) of a 3-game series vs **Mike McNally's** Diamondbacks and **Game 2** (0-1) of a 6-game homestand that also includes the upcoming weekend series vs the **Cardinals** (3g)...is the Reds' final homestand before the **All-Star** break...beginning Monday will finish the first half on the road at **Phi** (4g) and at **NYM** (3g), including their first visit to the Mets' new **Citi Field**...are coming off a **3-3** road trip to **Tor** (1-2) and **Cle** (2-1)...on Sunday completed a **4-5** stretch against American League opponents (1-2 vs WSox, 1-2 at Tor, 2-1 at Cle).

SCOUTING MACHINE: As part of tonight's **Ashland/Huntington Community Night** festivities, the **Ashland American Little League** will recognize longtime Reds Senior Special Assistant to the General Manager **Gene Bennett** for his generous support...**Bennett**, in his 57th season with the Reds, will receive a *Dreams Come True* plaque autographed by Ashland Little League alumni **Brandon Webb** of the Diamondbacks, former first-round pick and Major League pitcher **Drew Hall** and MLB umpires **Charlie Reliford** and **Greg Gibson**.

ALL-STAR AMONG US: **Sherri J. Friedman** of **Amberley Village** is the Reds' nominee for *PEOPLE Magazine's All-Stars Among Us* campaign, which recognizes an individual from each Major League Baseball team who serves his or her community in extraordinary ways...**Friedman** will be honored on the field during ceremonies prior to the July 14 **All-Star Game** in St. Louis...**tonight** she will deliver the official game ball before the Reds play the Diamondbacks...**Friedman** was elected in online voting for her community service through **Most Valuable Kids of Greater Cincinnati**, an organization that distributes unused tickets to underserved children...she has helped 22,000 kids experience local sporting and entertainment events, including more than 4,800 Reds games.

DOT, DOT, DOT....: The Reds have won 3 of their last 5g...Reds relievers lead the NL with a 3.29 ERA...**OF Jonny Gomes** has hit 3 of the Reds' last 6 homers and 4 of their last 11 homers...**Ryan Hanigan** leads all National League rookie batters in on-base percentage (.408)...**Ramon Hernandez** needs 2 runs scored to reach **500** in his career.

INJURY PLAGUED: The Reds are **5-5** in the 10 games that included a starting lineup of **C Ramon Hernandez, 1B Joey Votto, 2B Brandon Phillips, 3B Edwin Encarnacion, SS Alex Gonzalez, RF Jay Bruce, CF Willy Taveras** and either **Chris Dickerson** or **Jerry Hairston Jr.** in LF.

EDWIN'S REHAB: **3B Edwin Encarnacion** is on a rehabilitation assignment at Class AAA Louisville (9g, 8-31, .258, 1 2b, 2hr, 7rbi, 8bb, 4k)...he was given yesterday off...he has been on the disabled list since 4/28 with a chip fracture in his left wrist.

M*A*S*H: From the **Opening Day** roster the Reds are missing starters **SS Alex Gonzalez** (right elbow surgery, out 4-5 weeks) and **3B Edwin Encarnacion** (broken left wrist, rehabbing in Louisville) along with starting **RHP Edinson Volquez** (right elbow) and reliever **RHP Mike Lincoln** (bulging disc in his neck)...all are on the disabled list, along with **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (season-ending right shoulder surgery)...**Volquez** could begin throwing this weekend...**Gonzalez** could begin swinging a bat this weekend...several other players missed action recently because of various ailments, including **1B Joey Votto** (stress), **2B Brandon Phillips** (hairline fracture, right thumb), **OF Willy Taveras** (tight right hamstring) and **IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr.** (flu).

OHIO CUP MOP: Reds **C Ramon Hernandez** was voted by the media the coveted **Ohio Cup** trophy, presented by **The Ohio Lottery**, as the **Most Outstanding Player** of this year's interleague series between the Reds and Indians that concluded Sunday...he will receive the award in ceremonies prior to **Friday's** game...in 5g vs the Tribe **Hernandez** went 9-for-19 (.474) with a double, triple, homer and 5rbi...**OF Jonny Gomes** (6g, 7-23, .304, 1hr, 4rbi) and **LHP Arthur Rhodes** (4g, 4ip, 1h, 0r, 0bb, 3k) also received votes...the Reds won the series, 4 games to 2...Reds **OF Adam Dunn** won the 2008 **MOP Award** (.300, 5hr, 10rbi).

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUT: **RHP Carlos Fisher** and **LHP Matt Maloney** made their Major League debuts this season...in 2008, 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts: **RHP Johnny Cueto, IF Paul Janish, OF Jay Bruce, LHP Daniel Ray Herrera, RHP Daryl Thompson, IF Adam Rosales, OF Chris Dickerson, RHP Ramon Ramirez, C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** and **RHP Josh Roenicke**.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (17-18 .486): The Reds went **4-6-2** in their previous **12 completed home series** and produced a winning record on just 2 of their previous 6 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3, 1-2, 3-3)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **258-263-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38).

REDS ON THE ROAD (20-20 .500): The Reds have won 2 straight road games and 3 of their last 4 road games...went **7-4-2** in their **13 road series**...produced the following records on their road trips: 7-3, 3-2, 3-3, 2-5, 2-4 and 3-3...entering this season and dating to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

IN THE STANDINGS (86): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 43, FOURTH - 29, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...at **20-14** and **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g over .500** at **36-24**...4 times were a season-high **2g under .500** (0-2, 1-3, 34-36, 35-37)...have spent **62** days above, **11** days at and **13** days below .500.

REDS vs DIAMONDBACKS: The Reds are 41-39 all-time vs the Diamondbacks, including 3-1 this season and 7-3 the last 2 years...have won 5 of the last 6g and 7 of the last 9g vs Ari...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 10-9, including 0-1 in 2009 5-2 the last 3 seasons...**at Chase Field:** Reds are 22-18, including 3-0 in 2009 and 5-1 the last 2 seasons...are 18-9 with the roof closed and 4-9 with the roof open...in their most recent visit there, a 3-game sweep from 5/11-5/13, played all 3g with the roof open...was their first sweep at Chase Field since June 1999...won their first 7g at Bank One Ballpark until a 9-6 loss on 7/1/00...Cin was the last visiting team to lose a game in Phoenix...**last Diamondbacks sweep:** at Cin: 8/13-8/15, 2002 (3g)...at Ari: 6/20-6/22, 2003 (3g).

Last Pitched: Thu at Tor and earned the 7-5 victory (6ip, 5h, 5er, 3bb, 4k, 1hr, 95 pitches, 55 strikes)...left leading, 6-5, after Votto's homer leading off the seventh inning snapped the 5-5 tie...after the Reds scored 4 runs in the top of the first allowed Hill's solo HR in the bottom of the inning...took a 5-1 lead into the bottom of the fifth but allowed 4 runs with 2 outs on Wells' 2-run double and Rolen's 2-run single.

Red Hots: The 23-year-old righthander is making his 16th start of the season, his second of the year vs the Diamondbacks...ranks among the National League leaders with a 2.86era (6th) and a .231 opponents' BA (8th)...in his 15 starts the Reds went 9-6 and scored 66 runs (4.40 r/g)...in 9 of his 15 starts threw at least 7.0 innings and in 13 of his 15 starts threw at least 6.0 innings.

Holding On: In his last 2 starts did not hold 3 leads of at least 4 runs...in a no-decision in the 10-8 loss on 6/20 vs WSox took a 5-0 cushion into the top of the fourth inning but then allowed 3 runs in that frame and 2 more runs in the fifth...in Thu's 7-5 win at Tor led 4-0 and 5-1 but the Blue Jays pulled even at 5-5 with a 4-run fifth inning.

Quality: Leads the team with 10 quality starts...his 2 strings of 5 consecutive QS (4/22-5/13, 5/24-6/14) are the longest stretches of quality starts by a Reds pitcher this season...last year, **Edinson Volquez** produced a string of 12 straight QS (4/22-6/20).

No Place Like Home...For just the second time in 7 starts is pitching at Great American Ball Park...for the season is **1-2, 3.96** in 6 starts at home (38.2ip, 17er) and **6-2, 2.14** in 9 starts on the road (59ip, 14er).

Streking: In 5 starts from 4/22-5/13 went **4-0, 1.25** (36ip, 5er)...the 4-game winning streak was the longest of his career...in each of 4 starts from 4/22-5/8 threw at least 7.0 innings while allowing no more than 1 run, the longest streak of that kind by a Reds pitcher since **Tim Belcher** had a 4-game run from **5/27-6/13, 1992** (courtesy Elias Sports Bureau).

World Baseball Classic: Started the Dominican Republic's second game of the tournament and threw 4.2 scoreless innings to earn the 9-0 win vs Panama in the San Juan bracket (4.2ip, 3h, 1bb, 5k).

Tomorrow's Pitcher: RHP Aaron Harang

Last Started: Fri at Cle and suffered the 9-2 loss (4.2ip, 10h, 7r, 5er, 1bb, 3k, 2hr, 91 pitches, 61 strikes)...left trailing, 7-0...in the third inning allowed an RBI-double to Sizemore and a sac fly to Martinez...in the fourth retired the first 2 batters, then allowed a single to Peralta and a 2-run HR to Garko...in the fifth allowed a solo HR to Martinez and 2 unearned runs following Phillips' 2-out error.

Red Hots: Tomorrow will make his 17th start of the season, his first of the year vs the Diamondbacks...in his previous 16 starts the Reds went 7-9 and scored 59 runs (3.69 r/g)...in his 16 starts **Reds batters** hit .238 (126-530)...on 6/4 at StL suffered the 3-1 loss in a game in which **Harang** and **Chris Carpenter** each threw a complete game.

Harang vs Diamondbacks: Tomorrow will make his ninth career appearance vs the D'Backs...in his 8 previous starts vs Ari, Reds batters scored just 16 runs (2 r/g)...his 3-2 victory on 8/14/03 at Great American Ball Park snapped the Reds' 16-game losing streak to the D'Backs.

Home Cookin': Is **4-3, 2.87** (47ip, 15er) in 8 starts at Great American Ball Park and **1-5, 4.94** (51ip, 28er) in 8 starts on the road.

Staff Ace: Since he was acquired from the Athletics at the **2003 trading deadline** is the Reds' leader in most statistical pitching categories, including starts (183), wins (68), innings pitched (1167.0) and strikeouts (981)...since the beginning of the **2006 season** ranks second in the National League **748.1** innings pitched (**Arroyo 1st**, 749.1)...in 2005 and 2007 won the BBWAA's Johnny Vander Meer Award as the club's Most Outstanding Pitcher.

Cueto vs Diamondbacks: On 4/3/08 at Great American Ball Park made his Major League debut and earned the 3-2 victory vs the Diamondbacks...in that start became the first pitcher in modern Major League history to debut with 10 strikeouts and 0 walks, the first Reds pitcher since 1900 to record 10 strikeouts in his ML debut and only the third pitcher to win his ML debut while allowing 1 hit and recording at least 10 strikeouts...retired his first 15 batters and allowed only 1 baserunner overall, Justin Upton homered leading off the sixth.
