Bruce Update

Jay Bruce left Sat's game at NYM in the bottom of the first inning with a fractured right wrist suffered while diving for David Wright's single to right field...an MRI the next day showed no damage to the tendons or ligaments...he is expected to miss 6-8 weeks.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is the first game of the **Second Half** and **Game 1** of an abbreviated 4-game homestand, all vs **Mike Vassallo's** Brewers...following this series the Reds hit the road for a 7-day, 6-game trip to **LAD** (3g) and **Chi** (off day, 3g)...the Reds will finish the season with 41g at **Great American Ball Park** and 34g on the road.

HAIRSTON'S HEROES: Tonight **Jerry Hairston Jr.** is hosting **30 fans** in moon deck Section 143 as part of his **Hairston's Heroes** program targeting underprivileged children...the kids will receive an autographed t-shirt, while the entire group receives \$10 in concession vouchers and in-stadium welcomes via the public address announcer and scoreboard.

WORLD 7, USA 5: Sunday's All-Star **XM Futures Game** in St. Louis was shortened by rain to 7 innings...play was halted in the middle of the first inning for 4 hours and 9 minutes...Class AAA Louisville's **OF Chris Heisey** started in LF and batted sixth for Team USA...he finished 0-for-2....Class A Dayton's **RHP J.C. Sulbaran** pitched a scoreless seventh inning to earn the save (1ip, 2bb)...additional **Futures Game** alumni include Reds players **Homer Bailey** (2006), **Jay Bruce** (2007), **Francisco Cordero** (1999), **Edwin Encarnacion** (2003-05), **Brandon Phillips** (2002), **Edinson Volquez** (2005) and **Joey Votto** (2006-07)...**Cordero** and **Volquez** are the only 2 Reds players to appear in both the **Futures Game** and the **All-Star Game**... **Cordero** was an All-Star in 2004 and 2007, **Volquez** was an All-Star last year.

JET LAG: The Reds' upcoming road trip includes their second visit of the 2009 season to the **West Coast** (3g at LAD, off day, 3g at Chi)...in May were swept by the **Padres** in a 3-game series at SD's **PETCO Park**...over the last 4 seasons the Reds are **11-28 (.282) on the West Coast** (0-9 at LAD, 4-9 at SD, 5-6 at SF, 1-2 at Oak, 1-2 at Sea)...that **11-28** record includes an active **9-game losing streak** at **Dodger Stadium**, where the Reds haven't won since their final appearance of **2005** (a 6-1 victory by **Brandon Claussen** on 7/28/05)...were swept in all three 3-game series there since then.

INJURY PLAGUED: Because of injuries, the Reds have played just **10g** (5-5) that included the projected **Opening Day** lineup of **C Ramon Hernandez**, **1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips**, **3B Edwin Encarnacion**, **SS Alex Gonzalez**, **RF Jay Bruce**, **CF Willy Taveras** and either **Chris Dickerson** or **Jerry Hairston Jr.** in LF.

M*A*S*H: From the **Opening Day** roster the Reds are missing starting **SS Alex Gonzalez** (right elbow surgery, out 4-5 weeks), **RF Jay Bruce** (broken right wrist), starting **RHP Edinson Volquez** (right elbow) and reliever **RHP Mike Lincoln** (bulging disc in his neck)...all are on the disabled list, along with **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (season-ending left shoulder surgery) and **IF Danny Richar** (torn labrum, left shoulder)...**Gonzalez** and **Volquez** were scheduled to resume their workouts today...several other players missed action because of various ailments, including **1B Joey Votto** (stress), **2B Brandon Phillips** (hairline fracture, right thumb), **OF Willy Taveras** (tight right hamstring), **IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr.** (flu) and **3B Edwin Encarnacion** (chip fracture, left wrist).

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUTS: RHP Carlos Fisher, LHP Matt Maloney, IF Drew Sutton and RHP Robert Manuel made their Major League debuts this season...in 2008, 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts: **RHP Johnny Cueto**, **IF Paul Janish**, **OF Jay Bruce**, **LHP Daniel Ray Herrera**, **RHP Daryl Thompson**, **IF Adam Rosales**, **OF Chris Dickerson**, **RHP Ramon Ramirez**, **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** and **RHP Josh Roenicke**.

ALL-STAR AMONG US: Sherri J. Friedman of **Amberley Village** was the Reds' nominee for *PEOPLE Magazine's All-Stars Among Us* campaign, which recognizes an individual from each Major League Baseball team who serves his or her community in extraordinary ways...she was honored on the field during ceremonies prior to the **All-Star Game** in St. Louis...**Friedman** was elected in online voting for her community service through **Most Valuable Kids of Greater Cincinnati**, an organization that distributes unused tickets to underserved children...she has helped 22,000 kids experience local sporting and entertainment events, including more than 4,800 Reds games.

ALL-STAR RESOLUTION: State Senator **Gary Cates** (R-Butler County) has introduced a resolution in the Ohio Senate urging Major League Baseball to select the Reds and Great American Ball Park as hosts for the **2013 All-Star Game**...the Reds last hosted the Mid-Summer Classic in **1988** at Riverfront Stadium...in June the club hosted one of the summer's MLB jewel events, the **Gillette Civil Rights Game**.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (20-20 .500): The Reds went **5-7-2 in their previous 14 home series**...produced a winning record on just 2 of their 7 homestands (2-3, 2-4, **3-2**, **6-3**, 1-2, 3-3, 3-3)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **261-265-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38)...at **217-217-1** the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since **6/26/04** (57-57)...also reached .500 at **219-219-1**.

REDS ON THE ROAD (22-25, .468): The Reds went **7-6-2 in their 15 road series**...produced a winning or .500 record on 4 of their previous 7 road trips (**7-3**, **3-2**, **3-3**, 2-5, 2-4, **3-3**, 2-5)...entering this season and dating to 2006, **the Reds** had losing records in **23** of their previous **28** road trips.

IN THE STANDINGS (101): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: **FIRST** - 1, **SECOND** - 9, **THIRD** - 46, **FOURTH** - 35, **FIFTH** - 9, **SIXTH** - 1...at **20-14** and **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g over .500** at **36-24**...at **42-45** are a season-high **3g under .500**...have spent **64** days above, **15** days at and **22** days below .500.

REDS vs BREWERS: The Reds are 93-93-1 all-time vs the Brewers, including 3-5 this season and 13-13 the last 2 seasons...at **Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 27-26, including 1-1 this season...at **Miller Park:** Reds are 39-37, including 2-4 this season and 8-6 the last 2 seasons..**last Reds sweep:** at Cin: 7/19-7/20, 2004 (2g); 5/6-5/8, 2002 (3g)...at Mil: 6/5-6/6, 2001 (2g); 7/11-7/13, 2003 (3g); 5/13-5/16, 2002 (4g)..**last Brewers sweep:** at Cin: 8/30-9/1, 2002 (3g); 8/25-8/28, 2003 (4g)...at Mil: 4/27-4/28, 2004 (2g), 5/29-5/31, 2009 (3g).

IF Paul Janish pitched in the ninth inning of the 15-3 loss vs Mil on 5/6 (1ip, 5h, 5er, 0bb, 2k, Fielder 2-run HR)...he became the first Reds position player to pitch since Lenny Harris on 6/1/98 at SF.				

Reds Pitchers: Finished the first half ranked seventh in the National League with a 4.26 team ERA...**on the road trip went 2-5, 7.52 (58.2ip, 49er)**...in the 22-1 loss on 7/6 at Phi allowed 22 runs in a game for the first time since a 22-6 loss at Chi on **8/13/37**...the 21-run deficit was the worst loss in franchise history...the Reds already have 8 team shutouts, their highest total since they had 10sho in 2006...had 6 shutouts last year...with a 7-0 win on 5/5 at Fla reached 6 shutouts in their 26th game, their fastest to 6 team shutouts since the 1914 Reds threw their sixth shutout in their 25th game.

Reds Starters: Finished the first half ranked 11th in the National League with 4.62 rotation ERA...**on the road trip went 1-4, 7.94 (34p, 30er)**...have produced 42 quality starts (**Cueto 11, Harang 10, Arroyo 9, Owings 6, Volquez 3, Bailey 2, Maloney 1**)...the Reds went 31-11 in those quality starts (.738)...from 6/3-6/10 produced a season-high 7 consecutive quality starts, their best stretch since they threw 8 consecutive QS from **8/6-8/14, 2005**...through the first 41g of the season used just 5 starting pitchers, their longest such streak to begin a year since **RHP John Roper** became the staff's **sixth** different starter in the **42nd game** of the **1994 campaign**...on 5/23 vs Cle, in the club's 42nd game, **RHP Homer Bailey** became the Reds' sixth starting pitcher...**Aaron Harang** threw a 3-hitter in the 2-0 win vs Pit in the club's fifth game of the season...was the earliest complete game by a Reds pitcher since **Pete Harnisch** beat the Cardinals, 3-0 in Busch Stadium, in the **fourth** contest of the **1999** campaign.

Reds Relievers: Finished the first half ranked third in the National League with a 3.58 bullpen ERA (SF 3.29, LAD 3.31)...**on the road trip went 1-1, 6.93 (24.2ip, 19er) and converted their only save opportunity**...in 7.1 innings during the 22-1 loss on 7/6 at Phi allowed 13r/12er, the bullpen's highest single-game totals since a 16-3 loss on **6/1/98 at SF** (7.2ip, 13r, 12er)...didn't blow a save until the club's 36th game, a 6-5 loss in 16 innings on 5/16 at SD...for the second straight season the Reds' bullpen was the last in the Major Leagues to suffer a blown save...in 2008 didn't blow a save until the 41st game (5/14)...over the last 2 seasons **Francisco Cordero** has recorded **55** of the bullpen's **56** saves (34sv in 2008, 21sv in 2009)...**David Weathers** has the only other save over the last 2 seasons (6/10/09 at Wsh)...**IF Paul Janish** has pitched twice, in the 15-3 loss on 5/6 vs Mil (1ip, 5h, 5er, 0bb, 2k, Fielder 2-run HR) and in the 22-1 loss on 7/6 at Phi (1ip, 4h, 6er, 2bb, 1k, Werth grand slam).

48 FRANCISCO CORDERO, rhp **36g, 1-2-21, 1.75**
Was an All-Star for the third time (2004 for Tex, 2007 for Mil)...hasn't allowed a hit in his last 6 apps (6ip)...with 21 saves ranks among the National League leaders...has converted 21 of his 22 save opps, including each of his last 6 save opps...in the 12-inning, 4-2 win on 6/10 at Wsh suffered his first blown save since 7/21/08 vs SD...had converted 29 consecutive save chances, including his first 15 save opps this year...including last season has recorded 55 of the bullpen's last 56 saves (34sv in 2008, 21sv in 2009, Weathers 1sv in 2009)...with 232 career saves ranks 30th on that all-time list...Ugeth Urbina is 29th with 237 saves...in the 3-0 victory on 4/22 at Chi recorded his 100th save in the National League to become only the 11th pitcher in history with at least 100 saves in each league (see box below).
