Surgery

RHP Mike Lincoln is scheduled to have cervical disc replacement surgery Monday in St. Louis by orthopedic spine surgeon Dr. K Riew of Washington University Orthopedic...since 6/17 Lincoln has been on the 15-day disabled list with a bulging disc in his neck...a prognosis for recovery will be made following that surgery.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 2** (0-1) of an abbreviated 4-game homestand, all vs **Mike Vassallo's** Brewers...following this series the Reds hit the road for a 7-day, 6-game trip to **LAD** (3g) and **Chi** (off day, 3g)...including tonight's game the Reds will finish the season with 40g at **Great American Ball Park** and 34g on the road.

<u>DOT, DOT, DOT</u>: At **42-46** the Reds are **4g under .500** and **5.5g out of first place**, both season highs...**OF Chris Dickerson** left Sun's game and was scratched from last night's lineup with **back spasms**.

<u>SANDWICH ARTISTS</u>: From noon to 1:00 p.m. tomorrow, **2B Brandon Phillips** and **1B Joey Votto** will make sandwiches at the **SUBWAY®** located at 6491 Bridgetown Road...during that hour, 100 percent of the sales and all tips will be donated to the **Reds Community Fund**...mascot **Mr. Redlegs** will be on hand from 11:00 a.m. to noon, and **Rosie Red** will take over from noon to 1:00 p.m....the players will not be signing autographs during this appearance.

STARSHINE HOSPICE: Aaron and Jen Harang are supporting the annual Starshine Golf Classic at Western Hills Country Club, scheduled for Monday...Jen Harang is on the board for Starshine Hospice, an organization within Cincinnati Children's Hospital that provides comfort and support to terminally ill children and their families...Starshine Hospice is the region's only exclusive pediatric hospice program...the outing includes lunch, 18 holes of golf, a buffet dinner and a special auction...cost is \$250 per golfer or \$1,000 for a 4-some...for more information, log on to www.cincinnatichildrens.org/starshine or contact Cara Cross at cara.cross@cchmc.org or by phone at (513) 636-5647.

<u>HEISEY, KLINKER WIN WEEKLY AWARDS</u>: OF Chris Heisey and RHP Matt Klinker have been named International League Player of the Week and Southern League Pitcher of the Week, respectively...Heisey, who participated in Mon's XM All-Star Futures Game, went 9-for-20 (.450) with 2 HR, 9 RBI and a .850 slugging pct....on 6/27 he was promoted to Louisville from Class AA Carolina, where he was among league leaders in virtually every offensive category... Klinker, who was promoted to Carolina from Class A Sarasota on 7/3, went 2-0, 0.00 in 2 starts (12ip, 0r, 4h, 0r, 4bb, 15k, .105oba).

<u>JET LAG</u>: The Reds' upcoming road trip includes their second visit of the 2009 season to the **West Coast** (3g at LAD, off day, 3g at Chi)...in May were swept by the **Padres** in a 3-game series at SD's **PETCO Park**..over the last 4 seasons the Reds are **11-28** (.282) on the **West Coast** (0-9 at LAD, 4-9 at SD, 5-6 at SF, 1-2 at Oak, 1-2 at Sea)...that **11-28** record includes an active **9-game losing streak** at **Dodger Stadium**, where the Reds haven't won since their final appearance of **2005** (a 6-1 victory by **Brandon Claussen** on 7/28/05)...were swept in all three 3-game series there since then.

<u>INJURY PLAGUED</u>: Because of injuries, the Reds have played just 10g (5-5) that included the projected Opening Day lineup of C Ramon Hernandez, 1B Joey Votto, 2B Brandon Phillips, 3B Edwin Encarnacion, SS Alex Gonzalez, RF Jay Bruce, CF Willy Taveras and either Chris Dickerson or Jerry Hairston Jr. in LF.

M*A*S*H: From the Opening Day roster the Reds are missing starting SS Alex Gonzalez (right elbow surgery, out 4-5 weeks), RF Jay Bruce (broken right wrist), starting RHP Edinson Volquez (right elbow) and reliever RHP Mike Lincoln (bulging disc in his neck)...all are on the disabled list, along with C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo (season-ending left shoulder surgery) and IF Danny Richar (torn labrum, left shoulder)...Gonzalez will take batting practice with the team again today...Volquez will long toss at 120 feet tomorrow...several other players missed action because of various ailments, including 1B Joey Votto (stress), 2B Brandon Phillips (hairline fracture, right thumb), OF Willy Taveras (tight right hamstring), IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr. (flu), 3B Edwin Encarnacion (chip fracture, left wrist) and OF Chris Dickerson (back spasms).

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUTS: RHP Carlos Fisher, LHP Matt Maloney, IF Drew Sutton and RHP Robert Manuel made their Major League debuts this season...in 2008, 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts: RHP Johnny Cueto, IF Paul Janish, OF Jay Bruce, LHP Daniel Ray Herrera, RHP Daryl Thompson, IF Adam Rosales, OF Chris Dickerson, RHP Ramon Ramirez, C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo and RHP Josh Roenicke.

ALL-STAR RESOLUTION: State Senator Gary Cates (R-Butler County) has introduced a resolution in the Ohio Senate urging Major League Baseball to select the Reds and Great American Ball Park as hosts for the 2013 All-Star Game...the Reds last hosted the Mid-Summer Classic in 1988 at Riverfront Stadium...in June the club hosted one of the summer's MLB jewel events, the Gillette Civil Rights Game.

<u>REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (20-21 .488)</u>: The Reds went **5-7-2 in their previous 14 home series...** produced a winning record on just 2 of their 7 homestands (2-3, 2-4, **3-2**, **6-3**, 1-2, 3-3, 3-3)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **261-266-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38).

REDS ON THE ROAD (22-25, .468): The Reds went 7-6-2 in their 15 road series...produced a winning or .500 record on 4 of their previous 7 road trips (7-3, 3-2, 3-3, 2-5, 2-4, 3-3, 2-5)...entering this season and dating to 2006, the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips.

IN THE STANDINGS (102): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 46, FOURTH - 35, FIFTH - 10, SIXTH - 1...at 20-14 and 26-20 were a season-high 6g over .500...prior to this season hadn't been 6g over .500 since 2006, when they reached a season-high 12g over .500 at 36-24...at 42-46 are a season-high 4g under .500...have spent 64 days above, 15 days at and 23 days below .500.

REDS vs BREWERS: The Reds are 93-94-1 all-time vs the Brewers, including 3-6 this season and 13-14 the last 2 seasons...**at Great American Ball Park**: Reds are 27-27, including 1-2 this season...**at Miller Park**: Reds are 39-37, including 2-4 this season and 8-6 the last 2 seasons...**last Reds sweep**: at Cin: 7/19-7/20, 2004 (2g); 5/6-5/8, 2002 (3g)...at Mil: 6/5-6/6, 2001 (2g); 7/11-7/13, 2003 (3g); 5/13-5/16, 2002 (4g)...**last Brewers sweep**: at Cin: 8/30-9/1, 2002 (3g); 8/25-8/28, 2003 (4g)...at Mil: 4/27-4/28, 2004 (2g), 5/29-5/31, 2009 (3g).

Last Pitched: Last Fri at NYM, in the Reds' first game at new Citi Field threw a 4-hitter in the 3-0 win (9ip, 0bb, 5k, 115 pitches, 75 strikes)...didn't allow a runner to reach second base...was his eighth career complete game and his second career shutout.

Red Hots: Is making his 19th start of the season, his third of the year vs the Brewers...with 9 victories is 2 shy of the National League leaders...in his previous 18 starts the Reds went 9-9 and scored 71 runs (3.94 r/g)...has 9 quality starts... since he was acquired by the Reds prior to the 2006 season leads all Major League pitchers with 121 starts and ranks second in the National League with 763.1 innings pitched (Aaron Harang 764.1ip).

In The Big Inning: Allowed at least 1 run in the first inning of 9 of his 18 starts, including 7 of his last 10 starts...has posted a 10.00era in the first inning (18ip, 20er) and a 4.50era after the first frame (94ip, 47er).

<u>Unlucky June 24</u>: On 6/24 each of the last 2 seasons started against the Blue

Jays at Tor's Rogers Centre...in those 2 starts, a 14-1 loss on 6/24/08 and an 8-2 loss on 6/24/09, allowed 17 runs in 4.2 innings...in the **2008 loss** became only the sixth starting pitcher in Major League history to allow at least 10 earned runs while retiring 3 batters or fewer...in the **2009 loss** allowed 5 runs in the first inning on homers by Hill (2-run), Wells (solo) and Lind (2-run)...**in the calendar year between those 2 starts went 19-9, 4.19**...the 19 wins were the second-most in the Major Leagues in that 1-year span (Tor's **Roy Halladay**, 22-6, 2.49).

Perfect: Began the season 3-0 for the third time in his career but for the first time won his first 3 starts of a season...won his first 2 starts in 2006, when he started off 5-0...began the 2005 campaign 4-0...was the first Reds pitcher to begin the season in the rotation and win his first 3 starts since **LHP Pete Schourek** did it in 1996 and the first righthander since **Jack Armstrong** won his first 5 starts of 1990.

Tomorrow's Pitcher: RHP Aaron Harang

<u>Last Started</u>: Sun at NYM and in the final game before the All-Star break suffered the 9-7 loss (3ip, 8h, 5er, 1bb, 2k, 1wp, 74 pitches, 50 strikes)...left trailing, 5-0...allowed a solo run in the first inning and then 4 runs in the third on 5 hits and a walk.

Red Hots: Tomorrow will make his 20th start of the season, his second of the year vs the Brewers...in his last 9 starts is 0-5, 6.42 (49.2ip, 29er)...the 5-game losing streak is the longest by a Reds pitcher this season and 1 shy of his career high (6g, 6/4-7/7, 2005)...has 998 strikeouts for the Reds...in his previous 19 starts the Reds went 9-10 and scored 73 runs (3.84 r/g)...in his 19 starts Reds batters hit .248 (159-642).

<u>Home Cookin'</u>: Is **4-3**, **2.83** (54ip, 17er, 6hr) in 9 starts at Great American Ball Park and **1-6**, **5.40** (60ip, 36er, 10hr) in 10 starts on the road.

Staff Ace: Since he was acquired from the Athletics at the 2003 trading deadline is the Reds' leader in most statistical pitching categories, including starts (186), wins (68), innings pitched (1183.0) and strikeouts (998)...since the beginning of the 2006 season leads the National League 764.1 innings pitched...in 2005 and 2007 won the BBWAA's Johnny Vander Meer Award as the club's Most Outstanding Pitcher.
