3B Edwin Encarnacion has begun the second half **7-for-7**, including last night's career-high 4-hit game, with **2hr** and **6rbi**...he is the first Reds player to reach base safely in 8 consecutive plate apps and produce hits over 7 straight at bats since **Jeff Keppinger** did both on **5/10 & 5/11, 2008 at NYM**...see **Red Hots** to the left.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 3** (1-1) of an abbreviated 4-game homestand, all vs **Mike Vassallo's** Brewers...following this series the Reds hit the road for a 7-day, 6-game trip to **LAD** (3g) and **Chi** (off day, 3g)...including tonight's game the Reds will finish the season with 39g at **Great American Ball Park** and 34g on the road.

DOT, DOT, DOT: For the second straight day the Reds are a season-high **5.5g out of first place**...following Thu's loss were a season-high **4g under .500** at **42-46**.

STARSHINE HOSPICE: **Aaron** and **Jen Harang** are supporting the annual **Starshine Golf Classic** at Western Hills Country Club, scheduled for Monday...Jen Harang is on the board for Starshine Hospice, an organization within **Cincinnati Children's Hospital** that provides comfort and support to terminally ill children and their families...**Starshine Hospice** is the region's only exclusive pediatric hospice program...the outing includes lunch, 18 holes of golf, a buffet dinner and a special auction...cost is \$250 per golfer or \$1,000 for a 4-some...for more information, log on to www.cincinnatichildrens.org/starshine or contact **Cara Cross** at cara.cross@cchmc.org or by phone at (513) 636-5647.

JET LAG: The Reds' upcoming road trip includes the second of their 3 visits to the **West Coast** (3g at LAD, off day, 3g at Chi)...in May were swept by the **Padres** in a 3-game series at SD's **PETCO Park**...next month will play at **SF**...over the last 4 seasons the Reds are **11-28 (.282) on the West Coast** (0-9 at LAD, 4-9 at SD, 5-6 at SF, 1-2 at Oak, 1-2 at Sea)...that **11-28** record includes an active **9-game losing streak** at **Dodger Stadium**, where the Reds haven't won since their final appearance of **2005** (a 6-1 victory by **Brandon Claussen** on 7/28/05)...were swept in all three 3-game series there since then.

INJURY PLAGUED: Because of injuries, the Reds have played just **10g** (5-5) that included the projected **Opening Day** lineup of **C Ramon Hernandez**, **1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips**, **3B Edwin Encarnacion**, **SS Alex Gonzalez**, **RF Jay Bruce**, **CF Willy Taveras** and either **Chris Dickerson** or **Jerry Hairston Jr.** in LF.

M*A*S*H: From the **Opening Day** roster the Reds are missing starting **SS Alex Gonzalez** (right elbow surgery, out 4-5 weeks), **RF Jay Bruce** (broken right wrist), starting **RHP Edinson Volquez** (right elbow) and reliever **RHP Mike Lincoln** (bulging disc in his neck)...all are on the disabled list, along with **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (season-ending left shoulder surgery) and **IF Danny Richar** (torn labrum, left shoulder)...**Gonzalez** is scheduled for another full workout today...**Volquez** was scheduled to long toss at 120 feet today...several other players missed action because of various ailments, including **1B Joey Votto** (stress), **2B Brandon Phillips** (hairline fracture, right thumb), **OF Willy Taveras** (tight right hamstring), **IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr.** (flu), **3B Edwin Encarnacion** (chip fracture, left wrist) and **OF Chris Dickerson** (back spasms).

HEISEY, KLINKER WIN WEEKLY AWARDS: **OF Chris Heisey** and **RHP Matt Klinker** have been named International League Player of the Week and Southern League Pitcher of the Week, respectively...**Heisey**, who participated in Mon's **XM All-Star Futures Game**, went 9-for-20 (.450) with 2 HR, 9 RBI and a .850 slugging pct....on 6/27 he was promoted to Louisville from Class AA Carolina, where he was among league leaders in virtually every offensive category...**Klinker**, who was promoted to Carolina from Class A Sarasota on 7/3, went 2-0, 0.00 in 2 starts (12ip, 0r, 4h, 0r, 4bb, 15k, .105oba).

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUTS: **RHP Carlos Fisher**, **LHP Matt Maloney**, **IF Drew Sutton** and **RHP Robert Manuel** made their Major League debuts this season...in 2008, 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts: **RHP Johnny Cueto**, **IF Paul Janish**, **OF Jay Bruce**, **LHP Daniel Ray Herrera**, **RHP Daryl Thompson**, **IF Adam Rosales**, **OF Chris Dickerson**, **RHP Ramon Ramirez**, **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** and **RHP Josh Roenicke**.

ALL-STAR RESOLUTION: State Senator **Gary Cates** (R-Butler County) has introduced a resolution in the Ohio Senate urging Major League Baseball to select the Reds and Great American Ball Park as hosts for the **2013 All-Star Game**...the Reds last hosted the Mid-Summer Classic in **1988** at Riverfront Stadium...in June the club hosted one of the summer's MLB jewel events, the **Gillette Civil Rights Game**.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (21-21 .500): The Reds went **5-7-2 in their previous 14 home series**...produced a winning record on just 2 of their 7 homestands (2-3, 2-4, **3-2**, **6-3**, 1-2, 3-3, 3-3)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **262-266-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38)...at **217-217-1** the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since **6/26/04** (57-57)...also reached .500 at **219-219-1**.

REDS ON THE ROAD (22-25, .468): The Reds went **7-6-2 in their 15 road series**...produced a winning or .500 record on 4 of their previous 7 road trips (**7-3**, **3-2**, **3-3**, 2-5, 2-4, **3-3**, 2-5)...entering this season and dating to 2006, **the Reds** had losing records in **23** of their previous **28** road trips.

IN THE STANDINGS (103): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 46, FOURTH - 35, FIFTH - 11, SIXTH - 1...at **20-14** and **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g over .500** at **36-24**...at **42-46** were a season-high **4g under .500**...have spent **64** days above, **15** days at and **24** days below .500.

REDS vs BREWERS: The Reds are 94-94-1 all-time vs the Brewers, including 4-6 this season and 14-14 the last 2 seasons...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 28-27, including 2-2 this season...**at Miller Park:** Reds are 39-37, including 2-4 this season and 8-6 the last 2 seasons.

UP NEXT: REDS at DODGERS: Reds are 995-1,032 since 1900 vs the Dodgers, including 1-7 in 2008...lost their last 6g vs LAD...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 7-13, including 1-4 in 2008...LA was Cin's only NL opponent with a winning mark at Cinergy Field (123-118)...**at Dodger Stadium:** Reds are 160-181, including 0-3 in each of the last 3 seasons.

Brewers...in his last 9 starts is 0-5, 6.42 (49.2ip, 29er)...the 5-game losing streak is the longest by a Reds pitcher this season and 1 shy of his career high (6g, 6/4-7/7, 2005)...has 998 strikeouts for the Reds...in his previous 19 starts the Reds went 9-10 and scored 73 runs (3.84 r/g)...in his 19 starts **Reds batters** hit .248 (159-642)...on 6/4 at StL suffered the 3-1 loss in a game in which **Harang** and **Chris Carpenter** each threw a complete game.

Home Cookin’: Is 4-3, 2.83 (54ip, 17er, 6hr) in 9 starts at Great American Ball Park and 1-6, 5.40 (60ip, 36er, 10hr) in 10 starts on the road.

Streaking: From 4/28-6/4 allowed a home run in 8 consecutive apps (10hr), the longest streak by a Reds pitcher since **RHP Ramon Ortiz** tied the National League record by allowing a home run in **15** consecutive apps from 5/1-7/17, 2005.

Milestones: On 4/23 at Chi recorded the **1,000th** **strikeout** of his career (**Derrek Lee**)...his 3-hitter in the club’s fifth game, a 2-0 win on 4/12 vs Pit, was the quickest complete game by a Reds pitcher since **Pete Harnisch** threw a CG in the Reds’ fourth game of **1999**.

Staff Ace: Since he was acquired from the Athletics at the **2003 trading deadline** is the Reds’ leader in most statistical pitching categories, including starts (186), wins (68), innings pitched (1183.0) and strikeouts (998)...since the beginning of the **2006 season** ranks third in the National League **764.1** innings pitched (**Bronson Arroyo** 770.1ip, **Roy Oswalt** 769.2ip)...in 2005 and 2007 won the BBWAA’s Johnny Vander Meer Award as the club’s Most Outstanding Pitcher.

Community Affairs: Is one of the club’s more active members of the local community...for the third straight season, as part of his **Aaron’s Aces** ticket program is hosting at all Sunday home games children of military personnel serving in the **War On Terrorism**...along with wife **Jen** donated \$55,000 to the **Miracle League of Greater Cincinnati and Northern Kentucky** and on 5/9 attended the dedication of that field at the **Durham Recreation Complex** in Western Hills...for his community service has been the club’s nominee for the **Robert Clemente Award** (2007), **Branch Rickey Award** (2007) and **Marvin Miller Man of the Year Award** (2007, 2008).

Tomorrow’s Pitcher: RHP Johnny Cueto

Last Pitched: On 7/11 at NYM and suffered the 4-0 loss (5ip, 9h, 4er, 2bb, 4k, 101 pitches, 62 strikes)...left trailing, 4-0...in the 40-pitch first inning allowed 3 runs on 2 walks and 3 hits, including a 2-run single to Francoeur and a run-scoring single to Santos...in the second allowed an RBI-single to Castillo.

Red Hots: The 23-year-old righthander tomorrow will make his 19th start of the season, his second vs the Brewers...in the first inning of his last 2 starts allowed 12 earned runs (1.2ip)...in his 18 starts the Reds went 10-8 and scored 68 runs (3.78 r/g)...in 9 of his 18 starts threw at least 7.0 innings and in 14 of his 18 starts threw at least 6.0 innings.

Quality: Leads the team with 11 quality starts...his 2 strings of 5 consecutive QS (4/22-5/13, 5/24-6/14) are the longest stretches of quality starts by a Reds pitcher this season...last year, **Edinson Volquez** produced a string of 12 straight QS (4/22-6/20).

Road Warrior...For the season is 2-2, 3.43 in 7 starts at home (44.2ip, 17er, 6hr) and 6-4, 3.76 in 11 starts on the road (64.2ip, 27er, 8hr).

World Baseball Classic: Started the Dominican Republic’s second game of the tournament and threw 4.2 scoreless innings to earn the 9-0 win vs Panama in the San Juan bracket (4.2ip, 3h, 1bb, 5k).
