### Rehabbing

**SS Alex Gonzalez** today was sent to Class AAA Louisville on a rehabilitation assignment...on 6/19 vs WSox he was scratched from a start with a sore right elbow...the next day went on the disabled list...on 6/22 **Gonzalez** had arthroscopic surgery to remove 4 loose bodies from his right elbow.

**TODAY'S GAME:** Is **Game 4** (1-2) of an abbreviated 4-game homestand, all vs **Mike Vassallo's** Brewers...following today's game the Reds hit the road for a 7-day, 6-game trip to **LAD** (3g) and **Chi** (off day, 3g)...including today's game the Reds will finish the season with 38g at **Great American Ball Park** and 34g on the road.

**JET LAG:** The Reds' upcoming road trip includes the second of their 3 visits to the **West Coast** (3g at LAD, off day, 3g at Chi)...in May were swept by the **Padres** in a 3-game series at SD's **PETCO Park**...next month will play at SF's **AT&T Park**...over the last 4 seasons the Reds are **11-28 (.282) on the West Coast** (0-9 at LAD, 4-9 at SD, 5-6 at SF, 1-2 at Oak, 1-2 at Sea)...that **11-28** record includes an active **9-game losing streak** at **Dodger Stadium**, where the Reds haven't won since their final appearance of **2005** (a 6-1 victory by **Brandon Claussen** on 7/28/05)...were swept in all three 3-game series there since then.

**DOT, DOT, DOT:** For the third straight day the Reds are a season-high **5.5g out of first place**...at **43-47** are a season-high **4g below .500** for the second time (42-46)...last night, in his 63rd game **Adam Rosales** made his first career appearance at SS...last night's rain delay was the Reds' 13th of the season, their 10th at Great American Ball Park.

**AARON'S ACES:** This afternoon **Aaron Harang** is hosting 30 fans in sun deck Section 143 as part of his **Aaron's Aces** program targeting local **military families**...guests receive an autographed t-shirt, in-stadium welcomes via the public address announcer and scoreboard and a \$10 concession voucher...when he is not scheduled to pitch, **Aaron** meets the guests in the bullpen...fans with family members currently on active duty or who recently returned from active duty can sign up online at [www.reds.com/community](http://www.reds.com/community), then click on ticket programs.

**STARSHINE HOSPICE:** **Aaron** and **Jen Harang** are supporting the annual **Starshine Golf Classic** at Western Hills Country Club, scheduled for tomorrow...Jen Harang is on the board for Starshine Hospice, an organization within **Cincinnati Children's Hospital** that provides comfort and support to terminally ill children and their families...**Starshine Hospice** is the region's only exclusive pediatric hospice program...the outing includes lunch, 18 holes of golf, a buffet dinner and a special auction...cost is \$250 per golfer or \$1,000 for a 4-some...for more information, log on to [www.cincinnatichildrens.org/starshine](http://www.cincinnatichildrens.org/starshine) or contact **Cara Cross** at [cara.cross@cchmc.org](mailto:cara.cross@cchmc.org) or by phone at (513) 636-5647.

**INJURY PLAGUED:** Because of injuries, the Reds have played just **10g** (5-5) that included the projected **Opening Day** lineup of **C Ramon Hernandez**, **1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips**, **3B Edwin Encarnacion**, **SS Alex Gonzalez**, **RF Jay Bruce**, **CF Willy Taveras** and either **Chris Dickerson** or **Jerry Hairston Jr.** in LF.

**M\*A\*S\*H:** From the **Opening Day** roster the Reds are missing starting **SS Alex Gonzalez** (right elbow surgery, out 4-5 weeks), **RF Jay Bruce** (broken right wrist), starting **RHP Edinson Volquez** (right elbow) and reliever **RHP Mike Lincoln** (bulging disc in his neck)...all are on the disabled list, along with **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (season-ending left shoulder surgery) and **IF Danny Richar** (torn labrum, left shoulder)...**Gonzalez** is rehabbing at Louisville...**Volquez** is scheduled to throw a 30-pitch bullpen tomorrow at Dodger Stadium...**Lincoln** is scheduled to have cervical disc replacement surgery tomorrow in St. Louis (Dr. Daniel Riew)...several other players missed action because of various ailments, including **1B Joey Votto** (stress), **2B Brandon Phillips** (hairline fracture, right thumb), **OF Willy Taveras** (tight right hamstring), **IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr.** (flu), **3B Edwin Encarnacion** (chip fracture, left wrist) and **OF Chris Dickerson** (back spasms).

**MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUTS:** **RHP Carlos Fisher**, **LHP Matt Maloney**, **IF Drew Sutton** and **RHP Robert Manuel** made their Major League debuts this season...in **2008**, 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts: **RHP Johnny Cueto**, **IF Paul Janish**, **OF Jay Bruce**, **LHP Daniel Ray Herrera**, **RHP Daryl Thompson**, **IF Adam Rosales**, **OF Chris Dickerson**, **RHP Ramon Ramirez**, **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** and **RHP Josh Roenicke**.

**ALL-STAR RESOLUTION:** State Senator **Gary Cates** (R-Butler County) has introduced a resolution in the Ohio Senate urging Major League Baseball to select the Reds and Great American Ball Park as hosts for the **2013 All-Star Game**...the Reds last hosted the Mid-Summer Classic in **1988** at Riverfront Stadium...in June the club hosted one of the summer's MLB jewel events, the **Gillette Civil Rights Game**.

**REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (21-22 .488):** The Reds went **5-7-2 in their previous 14 home series**...produced a winning record on just 2 of their previous 7 homestands (2-3, 2-4, **3-2**, **6-3**, 1-2, 3-3, 3-3)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **262-267-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38).

**REDS ON THE ROAD (22-25, .468):** The Reds went **7-6-2 in their 15 road series**...produced a winning or .500 record on 4 of their previous 7 road trips (**7-3**, **3-2**, **3-3**, 2-5, 2-4, **3-3**, 2-5)...entering this season and dating to 2006, **the Reds** had losing records in **23** of their previous **28** road trips.

**IN THE STANDINGS (104):** The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 46, FOURTH - 35, FIFTH - 12, SIXTH - 1...at **20-14** and **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g** over .500 at **36-24**...twice were a season-high **4g under .500** (42-46, 43-47)...have spent **64** days above, **15** days at and **25** days below .500.

**REDS vs BREWERS:** The Reds are 94-95-1 all-time vs the Brewers, including 4-7 this season and 14-15 the last 2 seasons...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 28-28, including 2-3 this season...**at Miller Park:** Reds are 39-37, including 2-4 this season and 8-6 the last 2 seasons.

**UP NEXT: REDS at DODGERS:** Reds are 995-1,032 since 1900 vs the Dodgers, including 1-7 in 2008...lost their last 6g vs LAD...**at Dodger Stadium:** Reds are 160-181, including 0-3 in each of the last 3 seasons...haven't won there since their final appearance of the 2005 season, a 6-1 victory by Brandon Claussen on 7/28/05.

IF Paul Janish pitched in the ninth inning of the 15-3 loss vs Mil on 5/6 (1ip, 5h, 5er, 0bb, 2k, Fielder 2-run HR)...he became the first Reds position player to pitch since Lenny Harris on 6/1/98 at SF.				

**Reds Pitchers:** Rank eighth in the National League with a 4.25 team ERA...**on the homestand are 1-2, 4.00 (27ip, 12er)**...in the 22-1 loss on 7/6 at Phi allowed 22 runs in a game for the first time since a 22-6 loss at Chi on **8/13/37** (8ip, 21er)...the 21-run deficit was the worst loss in franchise history...the team ERA excluding that game drops from 4.25 to 4.06 (804.2ip, 363er)...the Reds already have 9 team shutouts, their highest total since they had 10sho in 2006...had 6 shutouts last year...with a 7-0 win on 5/5 at Fla reached 6 shutouts in their 26th game, their fastest to 6 team shutouts since the 1914 Reds threw their sixth shutout in their 25th game.

**Reds Starters:** Rank 11th in the National League with 4.62 rotation ERA...**on the homestand are 1-2, 4.66 (19.1ip, 10er)**...have produced 44 quality starts (**Cueto 11, Harang 11, Arroyo 10, Owings 6, Volquez 3, Bailey 2, Maloney 1**)...the Reds went 32-12 in those quality starts (.727)...from 6/3-6/10 produced a season-high 7 consecutive quality starts, their best stretch since they threw 8 consecutive QS from **8/6-8/14, 2005**...through the first 41g of the season used just 5 starting pitchers, their longest such streak to begin a year since **RHP John Roper** became the staff's **sixth** different starter in the **42nd game of the 1994 campaign**...on 5/23 vs Cle, in the club's 42nd game, **RHP Homer Bailey** became the Reds' sixth starting pitcher...**Aaron Harang** threw a 3-hitter in the 2-0 win vs Pit in the club's fifth game of the season...was the earliest complete game by a Reds pitcher since **Pete Harnisch** beat the Cardinals, 3-0 in Busch Stadium, in the **fourth** contest of the **1999** campaign.

**Reds Relievers:** Rank third in the National League with a 3.55 bullpen ERA (LAD 3.28, SF 3.29)...**on the homestand are 0-0, 2.35 (7.2ip, 2er)**... in 7.1 innings during the 22-1 loss on 7/6 at Phi allowed 13r/12er, the bullpen's highest single-game totals since identical totals in a 16-3 loss on **6/1/98 at SF**...bullpen's ERA excluding that game drops from 3.55 to 3.25 (271.2ip, 98er)...didn't blow a save until the club's 36th game, a 6-5 loss in 16 innings on 5/16 at SD...for the second straight season the Reds' bullpen was the last in the Major Leagues to suffer a blown save...in 2008 didn't blow a save until the 41st game (5/14)...over the last 2 seasons **Francisco Cordero** has recorded **55** of the bullpen's **56** saves (34sv in 2008, 21sv in 2009)...**David Weathers** has the only other save over the last 2 seasons (6/10/09 at Wsh)...**IF Paul Janish** has pitched twice, in the 15-3 loss on 5/6 vs Mil (1ip, 5h, 5er, 0bb, 2k, Fielder 2-run HR) and in the 22-1 loss on 7/6 at Phi (1ip, 4h, 6er, 2bb, 1k, Werth grand slam).

**48 FRANCISCO CORDERO, rhp** **37g, 1-2-21, 1.70**  
Was an All-Star for the third time (2004 for Tex, 2007 for Mil)...has allowed only one hit in his last 7 apps (7ip)...with 21 saves ranks among the National League leaders...has converted 21 of his 22 save opps, including each of his last 6 save opps...in the 12-inning, 4-2 win on 6/10 at Wsh suffered his first blown save since 7/21/08 vs SD...had converted 29 consecutive save chances, including his first 15 save opps this year...including last season has recorded 55 of the bullpen's last 56 saves (34sv in 2008, 21sv in 2009, Weathers 1sv in 2009)...with 232 career saves ranks 30th on that all-time list...Ugeth Urbina is 29th with 237 saves...in the 3-0 victory on 4/22 at Chi recorded his 100th save in the National League to become only the 11th pitcher in history with at least 100 saves in each league (see box below).

In his last 7 apps has posted a 1.80era (10ip, 2er)...5 times has thrown 2.0 innings, including 3 times in his last 4 apps, and 8 times has thrown more than 1.0 inning...in the 11-inning, 4-3 win on 5/24 vs Cle picked up the victory his Major League debut...in his outing on 6/7 vs the Cubs faced 4 batters but recorded 5 outs (K/CS, K, K, K)...on 5/21 was promoted from Class AAA Louisville (13g, 2-0-2, 2.00, 18ip, 11h, 4er, 4bb, 21k, 0hr, .175 opponents' BA).

Last name is pronounced MASS-it...opponents are hitting just .176 (23-131), including .131 by RH batters (11-84)...from 4/28-6/14 produced a career-best 16.2-inning scoreless streak, the longest by a Reds pitcher this season...from 5/19-5/25 was on the 15-day DL with a strained left oblique muscle...posted a 1.23era in 11 apps before his disabling (14.2ip, 2er) and a 3.22era in 22 apps since he came off the DL (22.1ip, 8er).
