Rehabbing

SS Alex Gonzalez today was sent to Class AAA Louisville on a rehabilitation assignment...on 6/19 vs WSox he was scratched from a start with a sore right elbow...the next day went on the disabled list...on 6/22 **Gonzalez** had arthroscopic surgery to remove 4 loose bodies from his right elbow.

TODAY'S GAME: Is **Game 4** (1-2) of an abbreviated 4-game homestand, all vs **Mike Vassallo's** Brewers...following today's game the Reds hit the road for a 7-day, 6-game trip to **LAD** (3g) and **Chi** (off day, 3g)...including today's game the Reds will finish the season with 38g at **Great American Ball Park** and 34g on the road.

<u>JET LAG</u>: The Reds' upcoming road trip includes the second of their 3 visits to the **West Coast** (3g at LAD, off day, 3g at Chi)...in May were swept by the **Padres** in a 3-game series at SD's **PETCO Park**...next month will play at SF's **AT&T Park**...over the last 4 seasons the Reds are **11-28** (.282) on the **West Coast** (0-9 at LAD, 4-9 at SD, 5-6 at SF, 1-2 at Oak, 1-2 at Sea)...that **11-28** record includes an active **9-game losing streak** at **Dodger Stadium**, where the Reds haven't won since their final appearance of **2005** (a 6-1 victory by **Brandon Claussen** on 7/28/05)...were swept in all three 3-game series there since then.

<u>DOT, DOT, DOT</u>: For the third straight day the Reds are a season-high **5.5g out of first place**...at **43-47** are a season-high **4g below** .**500** for the second time (42-46)...last night, in his 63rd game **Adam Rosales** made his first career appearance at SS...last night's rain delay was the Reds' 13th of the season, their 10th at Great American Ball Park.

AARON'S ACES: This afternoon **Aaron Harang** is hosting 30 fans in sun deck Section 143 as part of his **Aaron's Aces** program targeting local **military families**...guests receive an autographed t-shirt, in-stadium welcomes via the public address announcer and scoreboard and a \$10 concession voucher...when he is not scheduled to pitch, **Aaron** meets the guests in the bullpen...fans with family members currently on active duty or who recently returned from active duty can sign up online at www.reds.com/community, then click on ticket programs.

STARSHINE HOSPICE: Aaron and Jen Harang are supporting the annual Starshine Golf Classic at Western Hills Country Club, scheduled for tomorrow...Jen Harang is on the board for Starshine Hospice, an organization within Cincinnati Children's Hospital that provides comfort and support to terminally ill children and their families...Starshine Hospice is the region's only exclusive pediatric hospice program...the outing includes lunch, 18 holes of golf, a buffet dinner and a special auction...cost is \$250 per golfer or \$1,000 for a 4-some...for more information, log on to www.cincinnatichildrens.org/starshine or contact Cara Cross at cara.cross@cchmc.org or by phone at (513) 636-5647.

<u>INJURY PLAGUED</u>: Because of injuries, the Reds have played just 10g (5-5) that included the projected Opening Day lineup of C Ramon Hernandez, 1B Joey Votto, 2B Brandon Phillips, 3B Edwin Encarnacion, SS Alex Gonzalez, RF Jay Bruce, CF Willy Taveras and either Chris Dickerson or Jerry Hairston Jr. in LF.

M*A*S*H: From the Opening Day roster the Reds are missing starting SS Alex Gonzalez (right elbow surgery, out 4-5 weeks), RF Jay Bruce (broken right wrist), starting RHP Edinson Volquez (right elbow) and reliever RHP Mike Lincoln (bulging disc in his neck)...all are on the disabled list, along with C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo (season-ending left shoulder surgery) and IF Danny Richar (torn labrum, left shoulder)...Gonzalez is rehabbing at Louisville...Volquez is scheduled to throw a 30-pitch bullpen tomorrow at Dodger Stadium...Lincoln is scheduled to have cervical disc replacement surgery tomorrow in St. Louis (Dr. Daniel Riew)...several other players missed action because of various ailments, including 1B Joey Votto (stress), 2B Brandon Phillips (hairline fracture, right thumb), OF Willy Taveras (tight right hamstring), IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr. (flu), 3B Edwin Encarnacion (chip fracture, left wrist) and OF Chris Dickerson (back spasms).

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUTS: RHP Carlos Fisher, LHP Matt Maloney, IF Drew Sutton and RHP Robert Manuel made their Major League debuts this season...in 2008, 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts: RHP Johnny Cueto, IF Paul Janish, OF Jay Bruce, LHP Daniel Ray Herrera, RHP Daryl Thompson, IF Adam Rosales, OF Chris Dickerson, RHP Ramon Ramirez, C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo and RHP Josh Roenicke.

ALL-STAR RESOLUTION: State Senator Gary Cates (R-Butler County) has introduced a resolution in the Ohio Senate urging Major League Baseball to select the Reds and Great American Ball Park as hosts for the 2013 All-Star Game...the Reds last hosted the Mid-Summer Classic in 1988 at Riverfront Stadium...in June the club hosted one of the summer's MLB jewel events, the Gillette Civil Rights Game.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (21-22 .488): The Reds went 5-7-2 in their previous 14 home series... produced a winning record on just 2 of their previous 7 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3, 1-2, 3-3, 3-3)...in 7 seasons at GABP are 262-267-1...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38).

<u>REDS ON THE ROAD (22-25, .468)</u>: The Reds went **7-6-2** in their **15** road series...produced a winning or .500 record on 4 of their previous 7 road trips (**7-3**, **3-2**, **3-3**, 2-5, 2-4, **3-3**, 2-5)...entering this season and dating to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

IN THE STANDINGS (104): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 46, FOURTH - 35, FIFTH - 12, SIXTH - 1...at 20-14 and 26-20 were a season-high 6g over .500...prior to this season hadn't been 6g over .500 since 2006, when they reached a season-high 12g over .500 at 36-24...twice were a season-high 4g under .500 (42-46, 43-47)..have spent 64 days above, 15 days at and 25 days below .500.

REDS vs BREWERS: The Reds are 94-95-1 all-time vs the Brewers, including 4-7 this season and 14-15 the last 2 seasons... **at Great American Ball Park**: Reds are 28-28, including 2-3 this season... **at Miller Park**: Reds are 39-37, including 2-4 this season and 8-6 the last 2 seasons.

<u>UP NEXT: REDS at DODGERS</u>: Reds are 995-1,032 since 1900 vs the Dodgers, including 1-7 in 2008...lost their last 6g vs LAD...<u>at Dodger Stadium</u>: Reds are 160-181, including 0-3 in each of the last 3 seasons...haven't won there since their final appearance of the 2005 season, a 6-1 victory by Brandon Claussen on 7/28/05.

Last Pitched: On 7/11 at NYM and suffered the 4-0 loss (5ip. 9h. 4er. 2bb, 4k, 101 pitches, 62 strikes)...left trailing, 4-0...in the 40-pitch first inning allowed 3 runs on 2 walks and 3 hits, including a 2-run single to Francoeur and a run-scoring single to Santos...in the second allowed an RBI-single to Castillo.

Red Hots: The 23-year-old righthander is making his 19th start of the season, his second vs the Brewers...in the first inning of his last 2 starts allowed 12 earned runs (1.2ip)...in his 18 starts the Reds went 10-8 and scored 68 runs (3.78 r/g)...in 9 of his 18 starts threw at least 7.0 innings and in 14 of his 18 starts threw at least 6.0 innings.

Quality: Leads the team with 11 quality starts...his 2 strings of 5 consecutive QS (4/22-5/13, 5/24-6/14) are the longest stretches of quality starts by a Reds pitcher this season...last year, Edinson Volquez produced a string of 12 straight QS (4/22-6/20).

Road Warrior...For the season is 2-2, 3.43 in 7 starts at home (44.2ip, 17er, 6hr) and 6-4, 3.76 in 11 starts on the road (64.2ip, 27er, 8hr).

Streaking: In 5 starts from 4/22-5/13 went 4-0, 1.25 (36ip, 5er)...the 4-game winning streak was the longest of his career...in each of 4 starts from 4/22-5/8 threw at least 7.0 innings while allowing no more than 1 run, the longest streak of that kind by a Reds pitcher since Tim Belcher had a 4-game run from 5/27-6/13, 1992 (courtesy Elias Sports Bureau).

World Baseball Classic: Started the Dominican Republic's second game of the tournament and threw 4.2 scoreless innings to earn the 9-0 win vs Panama in the San Juan bracket (4.2ip, 3h, 1bb, 5k).

Tomorrow at Dodgers: Micah Owings

Last Started: On 7/9 at Phi and suffered the 9-6 loss (4.1ip, 8h, 7er, 4bb, 1k, 1hr, 97 pitches, 52 strikes)...left leading, 6-5, but was charged with 1 run scored off Roenicke and another scored off Herrera...with 2 outs in the third inning allowed an inside-the-park HR to Utley and an RBI-double to Werth...in the fourth allowed a 2-out, 2-run single to Victorino...in the fifth allowed an RBI-single to Ruiz, then was charged with the runs scored off Roenicke and Herrera.

Red Hots: Tomorrow at LAD will make his 17th start of the season and his first career appearance at Dodger Stadium...in 5 of his last 7 starts threw at least 5.1 innings and allowed 2 runs or fewer...in his previous 16 starts the Reds went 7-9 and scored 72 runs (4.50 r/g)...has 6 quality starts...with an 8-2 win on 4/26 vs Atl snapped his 9-game losing streak dating back to a 9-3 Diamondbacks victory on 5/25/08 at Atl...in 14 apps and 10 starts between victories went 0-9, 8.53.

In Relief: Made his only relief appearance of the season in the 16-inning, 6-5 loss at SD on 5/16...threw a career-high 5.2 innings in relief (3h, 1er, 3bb, 5k, 1hr, 81 pitches, 44 strikes)...entered the game in the 11th inning as the Reds' seventh and final pitcher.. retired his first 10 batters until Scott Hairston singled with 1 out in the 14th inning...Nick Hundley homered to end the 5-hour, 14 minute struggle...in 10 starts since then is 3-5, 5.70 (53.2ip, 34er).

At The Plate: In 2007 won the National League's Silver Slugger Award (.333, 4hr, 15rbi)...has 8 career home runs, including 3 this season (5/10 vs StL, pinch-hit solo off Ryan Franklin; 6/17 vs Atl, 3-run off Javier Vazquez; 7/4 vs StL, solo off Brad Thompson)... his 5 career home runs prior to 2009 are listed on page 149 of the media guide...on 5/7 vs Mil produced the first triple by a Reds pitcher since Eric Milton did it on 4/13/06 at Cubs.
