Chances For A Home Run Today Are Really Good.....

Neither team homered in last night's 1-0 Reds victory...was only the **40th homerless game** in the **523-game** history of Great American Ball Park, the fourth this season (4/29 vs Hou, 6/16 vs Atl, 6/21 vs WSox, 7/1 vs Ari)...only once in the ballpark's 7-year existence has there been a streak of **2 straight games** without a home run by either team (8/6-8/7, 2005 vs Fla).

TODAY'S GAME: Is Game 3 (1-1) of a 3-game series vs Mike McNally's Diamondbacks and Game 3 (1-1) of a 6-game homestand that also includes the upcoming weekend series vs the Cardinals (3g)...is the Reds' final homestand before the All-Star break...beginning Monday will finish the first half on the road at Phi (4g) and at NYM (3g), including their first visit to the Mets' new Citi Field.

<u>TODAY'S FESTIVITIES</u>: Prior to today's game, Major League Baseball's **Baseball Tomorrow Fund** will present a **\$5,000 grant** to the **Fairfield Community Foundation** in support of the **Joe Nuxhall Character Education Fund** and its **Reds Rookie Success League Butler County** program...**Mario Lopez**, host of NBC's *EXTRA*, will serve as today's honorary captain of the game...Lopez, who starred as **AC Slater** in the classic TV show *Saved By The Bell*, finished second on the third season of *Dancing with the Stars*.

ALL-STAR AMONG US: Sherri J. Friedman of Amberley Village is the Reds' nominee for *PEOPLE Magazine's* All-Stars Among Us campaign, which recognizes an individual from each Major League Baseball team who serves his or her community in extraordinary ways...she will be honored on the field during ceremonies prior to the July 14 All-Star Game in St. Louis...Friedman was elected in online voting for her community service through Most Valuable Kids of Greater Cincinnati, an organization that distributes unused tickets to underserved children...she has helped 22,000 kids experience local sporting and entertainment events, including more than 4,800 Reds games.

<u>DOT, DOT, DOT....</u>: The Reds have won 4 of their last 6g...last night's 1-0 victory was the first 1-0 win by the Reds since 8/8/07 vs LAD...**OF Jonny Gomes** has hit 3 of the Reds' last 6 homers and 4 of their last 11 homers...**Ryan Hanigan** leads all National League rookie batters in on-base percentage (.408)...**Ramon Hernandez** needs 2 runs scored to reach **500** in his career.

<u>INJURY PLAGUED</u>: The Reds are 5-5 in the 10 games that included a starting lineup of C Ramon Hernandez, 1B Joey Votto, 2B Brandon Phillips, 3B Edwin Encarnacion, SS Alex Gonzalez, RF Jay Bruce, CF Willy Taveras and either Chris Dickerson or Jerry Hairston Jr. in LF.

EDWIN'S REHAB: **3B Edwin Encarnacion** is on a rehabilitation assignment at Class AAA Louisville (9g, 8-31, .258, 1 2b, 2hr, 7rbi, 8bb, 4k)...the Bats were off last night...he has been on the disabled list since 4/28 with a chip fracture in his left wrist.

<u>M*A*S*H</u>: From the Opening Day roster the Reds are missing starters SS Alex Gonzalez (right elbow surgery, out 4-5 weeks) and 3B Edwin Encarnacion (broken left wrist, rehabbing in Louisville) along with starting RHP Edinson Volquez (right elbow) and reliever RHP Mike Lincoln (bulging disc in his neck)...all are on the disabled list, along with C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo (season-ending left shoulder surgery)...Volquez is scheduled to throw off flat ground tomorrow...Gonzalez could hit off a batting tee tomorrow...several other players missed action recently because of various ailments, including 1B Joey Votto (stress), 2B Brandon Phillips (hairline fracture, right thumb), OF Willy Taveras (tight right hamstring) and IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr. (flu).

OHIO CUP MOP: Reds C Ramon Hernandez was voted by the media the coveted Ohio Cup trophy, presented by The Ohio Lottery, as the Most Outstanding Player of this year's interleague series between the Reds and Indians that concluded Sunday...he will receive the award in ceremonies prior to Friday's game...in 5g vs the Tribe Hernandez went 9-for-19 (.474) with a double, triple, homer and 5rbi...OF Jonny Gomes (6g, 7-23, .304, 1hr, 4rbi) and LHP Arthur Rhodes (4g, 4ip, 1h, 0r, 0bb, 3k) also received votes...the Reds won the series, 4 games to 2...Reds OF Adam Dunn won the 2008 MOP Award (.300, 5hr, 10rbi).

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUT: When he plays, IF Drew Sutton will become the third Reds player this season to make his Major League debut (RHP Carlos Fisher, LHP Matt Maloney)...in 2008, 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts: RHP Johnny Cueto, IF Paul Janish, OF Jay Bruce, LHP Daniel Ray Herrera, RHP Daryl Thompson, IF Adam Rosales, OF Chris Dickerson, RHP Ramon Ramirez, C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo and RHP Josh Roenicke.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (18-18 .500): The Reds went 4-6-2 in their previous 12 completed home series and produced a winning record on just 2 of their previous 6 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3, 1-2, 3-3)...in 7 seasons at GABP are 259-263-1...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38).

REDS ON THE ROAD (20-20, .500): The Reds have won 2 straight road games and 3 of their last 4 road games... went **7-4-2** in their 13 road series...produced the following records on their road trips: 7-3, 3-2, 3-3, 2-5, 2-4 and 3-3... entering this season and dating to 2006, the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips.

IN THE STANDINGS (87): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 44, FOURTH - 29, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...at 20-14 and 26-20 were a season-high 6g over .500...prior to this season hadn't been 6g over .500 since 2006, when they reached a season-high 12g over .500 at 36-24...4 times were a season-high 2g under .500 (0-2, 1-3, 34-36, 35-37)... have spent 62 days above, 12 days at and 13 days below .500.

REDS vs DIAMONDBACKS: The Reds are 42-39 all-time vs the Diamondbacks, including 4-1 this season and 8-3 the last 2 years...have won 6 of the last 7g and 8 of the last 10g vs Ari...<u>at Great American Ball Park</u>: Reds are 11-9, including 1-1 in 2009 and 6-2 the last 3 seasons.

<u>UP NEXT: REDS vs CARDINALS</u>: The Reds are 932-1,055 all-time vs the Cardinals, including 4-3 this season...<u>at Great American Ball Park</u>: Reds are 26-24, including 2-1 this season...**Albert Pujols'** 14 homers here trail only **Lance Berkman's** 21 (**Jason Bay** also w/ 14).

Until midnight tonight, fans can help pick the starting lineups of the 2009 All-Star Game in St. Louis by voting online at reds. com/vote...among National League second basemen Brandon Phillips ranks T1st in RBI (52) and stolen bases (11) and third in homers (11)...1B Joey Votto is hitting .354 with a .452 on-base percentage...RHP Johnny Cueto (8-4, 2.69) ranks among the NL leaders in ERA (4th) and opponents' batting average against (.223, 4th)...RHP Francisco Cordero ranks T4th in the NL with 19 saves in 20 chances.

Designated Designated Hitter

In his last 19g **Jonny Gomes** is hitting .360 (18-50, 5 2b, 4hr, 11rbi)...has hit safely in each of his last 5 starts, including at least 1rbi in each of those 5g (8-21, .381, 6rbi)... hit 3 of the Reds' last 6 homers and 4 of their last 11 homers...started at DH in all 9 of the Reds' interleague road games (11-32, .344, 3 2b, 3hr, 7rbi, 5r, 5bb).

Statistically Speaking...

The Reds went 26-21, hit .257 and scored 4.57 runs per game before 1B Joey Votto went on the disabled list on 5/30...during his 21g on the disabled list the Reds went 8-13, hit .217 and scored 3.38 runs per game...in the 8g since Votto's return the Reds are 4-4, hitting .269 (74-275) and have scored 4 runs per game (32r).

Last Started: Fri at Cle and suffered the 9-2 loss (4.2ip, 10h, 7r, 5er, 1bb. 3k. 2hr. 91 pitches. 61 strikes)...left trailing, 7-0...in the third inning allowed an RBI-double to Sizemore and a sac fly to Martinez...in the fourth retired the first 2 batters, then allowed a single to Peralta and a 2-run HR to Garko...in the fifth allowed a solo HR to Martinez and 2 unearned runs following Phillips' 2-out error.

Red Hots: Is making his 17th start of the season, his first of the year vs the Diamondbacks...in his previous 16 starts the Reds went 7-9 and scored 59 runs (3.69 r/g)...in his 16 starts Reds batters hit .238 (126-530)...on 6/4 at StL suffered the 3-1 loss in a game in which Harang and Chris Carpenter each threw a complete game.

Home Cookin': Is 4-3, 2.87 (47ip, 15er) in 8 starts at Great American Ball Park and 1-5, 4.94 (51ip, 28er) in 8 starts on the road.

Streaking: From 4/28-6/4 allowed a home run in 8 consecutive apps (10hr), the longest streak by a Reds pitcher since RHP Ramon Ortiz tied the National League record by allowing a home run in 15 consecutive apps from 5/1-7/17, 2005.

Milestones: On 4/23 at Chi recorded the 1,000th strikeout of his career (Derrek Lee)...his 3-hitter in the club's fifth game, a 2-0 win on 4/12 vs Pit, was the quickest complete game by a Reds pitcher since Pete Harnisch threw a CG in the Reds' fourth game of 1999.

Staff Ace: Since he was acquired from the Athletics at the 2003 trading deadline is the Reds' leader in most statistical pitching categories, including starts (183), wins (68), innings pitched (1167.0) and strikeouts (981)...since the beginning of the 2006 season ranks second in the National League 748.1 innings pitched (Arroyo 1st, 749.1)...in 2005 and 2007 won the BBWAA's Johnny Vander Meer Award as the club's Most Outstanding Pitcher.

Opening Day: In the 2-1 loss vs the Mets made his fourth straight Opening Day start, the first Reds pitcher to do so since RHP Jose Rijo had the honors in 4 straight seasons from 1992-95...the only other Reds pitchers to make at least 4 consecutive Opening Day starts are Pete Donohue (5 straight, 1923-27) and Mario Soto (5, 1982-86)...Soto holds the club record for overall Opening Day starts (6)...in 4 career Opening Day starts Harang is 1-3, 3.52 (23ip, 9er).

Community Affairs: Is one of the club's more active members of the local

community...for the third straight season, as part of his Aaron's Aces ticket program is hosting at all Sunday home games children of military

D'Backs personnel serving in the War On Terrorism...along with wife Jen donated \$55,000 to the Miracle League of Greater Cincinnati and Northern Kentucky and on 5/9 attended the dedication of that field at the Durham Recreation Complex in Western Hills...for his community service has been the club's nominee for the Robert

Last Pitched: Sat at Cle, in his second start of the season earned the 7-3 victory (5ip, 3h, 3er, 7bb, 2k, 106 pitches, 54 strikes)...left leading, 6-3...for the second straight start established a career-high for walks...2 batters who walked scored...after the Reds scored 4 runs in the top of the second allowed a run scoring-GIDP in the bottom of the inning...with 2 outs in the fourth allowed Sizemore's 2-run single.

2009 Season: Tomorrow vs StL will make his third start of the season for the Reds, his second since Sat's promotion...began the year at Class AAA Louisville, where he went 3-5, 4.57 with 2 complete games and a shutout in 8 starts before he was promoted on 5/22...started the 7-6 loss vs Cle on 5/23, then was optioned back to Louisville the next day...made 6 more starts for the Bats (5-0, 0.81) before he was recalled again to start Sat at Cle.

Walks Will Haunt: In each of his 2 starts for the Reds this season established a career high for walks issued (6bb on 5/23 vs Cle, 7bb on 6/27 at Cle)...in his 2 starts walked the leadoff batter in 5 of his 10 innings...of the 13 batters he walked overall, 6 scored.

At Louisville: In 14 apps for the Bats produced 11 quality starts, including quality starts in each of his last 7 apps (5-1, 1.07, 50.1ip, 47h, 6er, 12bb, 45k)... in his first start of the season allowed a season-high 8 earned runs in 5.1 innings (13.50era) and in his last 13 starts posted a 2.03era (84.1ip, 19er)...following his most recent start for the Bats ranked among the International League leaders in innings pitched (89.2, 1st), wins (8, 2nd), strikeouts (82, 2nd) and ERA (2.71, 10th)...for the Bats, in 6 starts between his 5/22 and 6/27 promotions went 5-0, 0.81...twice was named the International League's Pitcher of the Week.
