### Hernandez' Surgery

**C Ramon Hernandez** today in Cincinnati had arthroscopic surgery to clean out his left knee (Dr. Timothy Kremchek)...he is expected to miss about 4 weeks.

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** Is **Game 2** (0-1) of a 3-game series vs **Alex Lawrence's** Dodgers and **Game 2** (0-1) of a 7-day, 6-game road trip that includes an off day Thursday in **Chicago** followed by a weekend visit to **Wrigley Field** (3g)...the Redlegs opened the second half of the season with a **2-2** homestand vs the **Brewers**...including tonight's game will finish the season with 37g at **Great American Ball Park** and 33g on the road...following this road trip the Reds will return to GABP for a **10-game homestand**, their longest of the season (4g vs SD, 3g vs Col, 3g vs Chi).

**LEADERSHIP SERIES:** This afternoon **Dusty Baker** spoke at a fundraiser to benefit the Los Angeles chapter of the **Reviving Baseball In Inner Cities** (RBI) program...the *Leadership Secrets of Major League Managers* series has featured or will feature **Jerry Manuel, Sparky Anderson, Tony LaRussa** and **Tommy Lasorda**.

**DOT, DOT, DOT:** The Reds have lost their last 7g vs LAD and their last 10g at Dodger Stadium...are **2-3** since the All-Star break...for the fifth straight day face a season-high **5.5-game deficit**...at **44-48** the Reds are a season-high **4g under .500** for the third time (42-46, 43-47)...are **13-16** in games started by **lefthanded** pitchers...**C Ryan Hanigan** has thrown out the **last 4 baserunners** attempting to steal...last night's first inning took 42 minutes but the relatively short time of game was only 3:06.

**JET LAG:** This road trip includes the second of the Reds' 3 visits to the **West Coast** (3g at LAD, off day, 3g at Chi)...in May were swept by the **Padres** in a 3-game series at SD's **PETCO Park**...next month will play at SF's **AT&T Park**...over the last 4 seasons the Redlegs are **11-29 (.275) on the West Coast** (0-10 at LAD, 4-9 at SD, 5-6 at SF, 1-2 at Oak, 1-2 at Sea)...that **11-29** record includes an active **10-game losing streak** at **Dodger Stadium**, where the Reds haven't won since their final appearance of **2005** (a 6-1 victory by **Brandon Claussen** on 7/28/05)...were swept in all three 3-game series here since then, prior to this one.

**REHABBING:** **SS Alex Gonzalez** (right elbow surgery) is on a rehabilitation assignment at Class AAA Louisville...in last night's 5-1 Bats win vs Durham he went 1-for-4 with an RBI and a walk...in his 2 rehab apps **Gonzalez** is 1-for-6 (1rbi, 1bb, 1k).

**INJURY PLAGUED:** Because of injuries, the Reds have played just **10g** (5-5) that included the projected **Opening Day** lineup of **C Ramon Hernandez, 1B Joey Votto, 2B Brandon Phillips, 3B Edwin Encarnacion, SS Alex Gonzalez, RF Jay Bruce, CF Willy Taveras** and either **Chris Dickerson** or **Jerry Hairston Jr.** in LF.

**M\*A\*S\*H:** From the **Opening Day** roster the Reds are missing starting **C Ramon Hernandez** (left knee surgery), starting **SS Alex Gonzalez** (right elbow surgery), starting **RF Jay Bruce** (broken right wrist), starting **RHP Edinson Volquez** (right elbow) and relief **RHP Mike Lincoln** (cervical disc replacement surgery)...all are on the disabled list, along with backups **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (season-ending left shoulder surgery) and **IF Danny Richar** (torn labrum, left shoulder)...**Gonzalez** is rehabbing at Louisville and is expected to be ready this weekend...**Volquez** yesterday threw a 30-pitch bullpen without complications...he is expected to throw another 30-pitch bullpen here tomorrow...several other starters missed extended time because of various ailments, including **1B Joey Votto** (stress/anxiety), **2B Brandon Phillips** (hairline fracture, right thumb) and **3B Edwin Encarnacion** (chip fracture, left wrist).

**LINCOLN'S SURGERY:** **RHP Mike Lincoln** yesterday had cervical disc replacement surgery...the 2-hour procedure was performed by orthopedic spine surgeon **Dr. Daniel Riew** at Barnes Jewish Hospital in St. Louis...**Lincoln** is expected to make a full recovery and barring complications could begin a throwing program in September...since 6/17 he has been on the 15-day disabled list with a bulging disc in his neck.

**MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUTS:** When he plays, **C Craig Tatum** will become the fifth Reds player this season to make his Major League debut (**RHP Carlos Fisher, LHP Matt Maloney, IF Drew Sutton, RHP Robert Manuel**)...in **2008**, 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts: **RHP Johnny Cueto, IF Paul Janish, OF Jay Bruce, LHP Daniel Ray Herrera, RHP Daryl Thompson, IF Adam Rosales, OF Chris Dickerson, RHP Ramon Ramirez, C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** and **RHP Josh Roenicke**.

**REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (22-22 .500):** The Reds went **5-7-3 in their 15 home series**...produced a winning record on just 2 of their 8 homestands (2-3, 2-4, **3-2, 6-3**, 1-2, 3-3, 3-3, 2-2)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **263-267-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38)...at **217-217-1** the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since **6/26/04** (57-57)...also reached .500 at **219-219-1**.

**REDS ON THE ROAD (22-26 .458):** The Reds 0-1 on this road trip...have lost their last 3 road games and 5 of their last 6 road games...went **7-6-2 in their previous 15 road series**...produced a winning or .500 record on 4 of their previous 7 road trips (**7-3, 3-2, 3-3**, 2-5, 2-4, **3-3**, 2-5)...entering this season and dating to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

**IN THE STANDINGS (106):** The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 46, FOURTH - 35, FIFTH - 14, SIXTH - 1...at **20-14** and **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g over .500** at **36-24**...at **44-48** are a season-high **4g under .500** for the third time (42-46, 43-47)...have spent **64** days above, **15** days at and **27** days below .500.

**REDS vs DODGERS:** Reds are 995-1,033 since 1900 vs the Dodgers, including 0-1 in 2009 and 1-8 the last 2 seasons...have lost their last 7g vs LAD...at **Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 7-13, including 1-4 in 2008...LA was Cin's only NL opponent with a winning mark at Cinergy Field (123-118)...at **Dodger Stadium:** Reds are 160-182, including 0-1 in 2009 and 0-3 in each of the previous 3 seasons...haven't won here since their final appearance of the 2005 season, a 6-1 victory by **Brandon Claussen** on **7/28/05**...**last Dodgers sweep:** at Cin: 9/26-9/27, 1983 (2g); **6/17-6/19, 2008 (3g)**...at LA: 7/20-7/21, 1998 (2g); **5/19-5/21, 2008 (3g)**; 4/14-4/17, 1975 (4g).

IF Paul Janish pitched in the ninth inning of the 15-3 loss vs Mil on 5/6 (1ip, 5h, 5er, 0bb, 2k, Fielder 2-run HR)...he became the first Reds position player to pitch since Lenny Harris on 6/1/98 at SF.				

**Reds Pitchers:** Rank ninth in the National League with a 4.27 team ERA...**on the road trip are 0-1, 7.88 (8ip, 7er, 2hr)**...in the 22-1 loss on 7/6 at Phi allowed 22 runs in a game for the first time since a 22-6 loss at Chi on **8/13/37** (8ip, 21er)..the 21-run deficit was the worst loss in franchise history...excluding that game the team ERA drops from 4.27 to 4.09 (821.2ip, 373er)...the Reds already have 9 team shutouts, their highest total since they had 10sho in 2006...had 6 shutouts last year...with a 7-0 win on 5/5 at Fla reached 6 shutouts in their 26th game, their fastest to 6 team shutouts since the 1914 Reds threw their sixth shutout in their 25th game.

**Reds Starters:** Rank 11th in the National League with 4.69 rotation ERA...**on the road trip are 0-1, 12.60 (5ip, 7er, 2hr)**...have produced 45 quality starts (**Cueto 12, Harang 11, Arroyo 10, Owings 6, Volquez 3, Bailey 2, Maloney 1**)...the Reds went 33-12 in those quality starts (.733)...from 6/3-6/10 produced a season-high **7 consecutive quality starts**, their best stretch since they threw 8 consecutive QS from **8/6-8/14, 2005**...through the first 41g of the season used just 5 starting pitchers, their longest such streak to begin a year since **RHP John Roper** became the staff's **sixth** different starter in the **42nd game** of the **1994 campaign**...on 5/23 vs Cle, in the club's 42nd game, **RHP Homer Bailey** became the Reds' sixth starting pitcher...**Aaron Harang** threw a 3-hitter in the 2-0 win vs Pit in the club's fifth game of the season...was the earliest complete game by a Reds pitcher since **Pete Harnisch** beat the Cardinals, 3-0 in Busch Stadium, in the **fourth** contest of the **1999** campaign.

**Reds Relievers:** Rank second in the National League with a 3.47 bullpen ERA (LAD 3.21)...**on the road trip are 0-0, 0.00 (3ip, 0r, 0hr)**...since the All-Star break have posted a 1.32era (13.2ip, 2er)...threw 3.0 perfect innings in Sun's 5-3 win vs Mil and 3.0 scoreless innings in last night's 7-5 loss at LAD...in 7.1 innings during the 22-1 loss on 7/6 at Phi allowed 13r/12er, the bullpen's highest single-game totals since identical totals in a 16-3 loss on **6/1/98 at SF**...bullpen's ERA excluding that game drops from 3.47 to 3.18 (277.2ip, 98er)...didn't blow a save until the club's 36th game, a 6-5 loss in 16 innings on 5/16 at SD...for the second straight season the Reds' bullpen was the last in the Major Leagues to suffer a blown save...in 2008 didn't blow a save until the 41st game (5/14)...over the last 2 seasons **Francisco Cordero** has recorded **56** of the bullpen's **57** saves (34sv in 2008, 22sv in 2009)...**David Weathers** has the only other save over the last 2 seasons (6/10/09 at Wsh)...**IF Paul Janish** has pitched twice, in the 15-3 loss on 5/6 vs Mil (1ip, 5h, 5er, 0bb, 2k, Fielder 2-run HR) and in the 22-1 loss on 7/6 at Phi (1ip, 4h, 6er, 2bb, 1k, Werth grand slam).

Yesterday was recalled from Louisville (8g, 2-0, 1.00, 9ip, 8h, 1er, 3bb, 8k)...technically is his third stint with the Reds...began the season with Cin and posted a 6.33era in 20 apps before he was optioned to Louisville on 6/1, when Edinson Volquez came off the disabled list...never left the team and was recalled the next day, when Volquez returned to the disabled list...posted a 2.19era in 9 more apps for the Reds before he was optioned to Louiville on 7/1, when IF Drew Sutton was promoted.

Was an All-Star for the third time (2004 for Tex, 2007 for Mil)...in his last 8 apps has allowed just 1 hit (8ip, 0r)...with 22 saves ranks among the National League leaders...converted 22 of his 23 save opps, including each of his last 7 save opps...in the 12-inning, 4-2 win on 6/10 at Wsh returned to the mound after a rain delay and suffered his only blown save since 7/21/08 vs SD...had converted 29 consecutive save chances, including his first 15 save opps this year...including last season has recorded 56 of the bullpen's last 57 saves (34sv in 2008, 22sv in 2009, Weathers 1sv in 2009)...with 233 career saves ranks 30th on that all-time list...Ugeth Urbina is 29th with 237 saves...in the 3-0 victory on 4/22 at Chi recorded his 100th save in the National League to become only the 11th pitcher in history with at least 100 saves in each league (see box below).
