## Today's Transactions

**SS Alex Gonzalez** today is expected to return from a rehabilitation assignment and be reinstated from the 15-day disabled list...a corresponding roster move will be announced prior to gametime...on 6/22 **Gonzalez** had surgery to remove 4 loose bodies in his right elbow...in 4 rehab apps at Louisville he went 1-for-13.

**TODAY'S GAME:** Is **Game 1** of a 3-game series vs **Dusty Harrington's** Cubs and **Game 4** (0-3) of a 7-day, 6-game road trip that included a visit to LA's **Dodger Stadium** (0-3) and an off day here yesterday...including today's game will finish the season with 37g at **Great American Ball Park** and 31g on the road...following this series the Reds will return to GABP for a **10-game homestand**, their longest of the season (4g vs SD, 3g vs Col, 3g vs Chi).

**DOT, DOT, DOT:** At **44-50** the Reds are a season-high **6g under .500** and **6.0g out of first place**, both season highs...are **2-5** since the All-Star break...**2B Brandon Phillips** is 2 stolen bases shy of **200** for his career...with Wed's 6-2 loss, the Reds extended losing streaks to 9 straight games vs LAD and 12 consecutive games at Dodger Stadium.

**JET LAG:** The beginning of this road trip included the second of the Reds' 3 visits to the **West Coast** (0-3 at LAD)...in May were swept by the **Padres** in a 3-game series at SD's **PETCO Park**...next month will play at SF's **AT&T Park**...over the last 4 seasons the Redlegs are **11-31 (.262) on the West Coast** (0-12 at LAD, 4-9 at SD, 5-6 at SF, 1-2 at Oak, 1-2 at Sea)...this stretch includes an active **12-game losing streak at Dodger Stadium**, where the Reds haven't won since their final appearance of **2005** (a 6-1 victory by **Brandon Claussen** on 7/28/05)...were swept in all four 3-game series there since then.

**INJURY PLAGUED:** Because of injuries, the Reds have played just **10g** (5-5) that included the projected **Opening Day** lineup of **C Ramon Hernandez**, **1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips**, **3B Edwin Encarnacion**, **SS Alex Gonzalez**, **RF Jay Bruce**, **CF Willy Taveras** and either **Chris Dickerson** or **Jerry Hairston Jr.** in LF.

**M\*A\*S\*H:** From the **Opening Day** roster the Reds are missing starting **C Ramon Hernandez** (left knee surgery), starting **RF Jay Bruce** (broken right wrist), starting **RHP Edinson Volquez** (right elbow) and relief **RHP Mike Lincoln** (cervical disc replacement surgery)...all are on the disabled list, along with backups **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (season-ending left shoulder surgery) and **IF Danny Richar** (scheduled to have season-ending left shoulder surgery)...**Volquez** at Wrigley Field today was scheduled to throw a 60-pitch bullpen of fastballs and changeups...each member of the starting infield missed extended time because of various ailments, including **SS Alex Gonzalez** (disabled following right elbow surgery), **1B Joey Votto** (disabled with stress/anxiety), **2B Brandon Phillips** (hairline fracture, right thumb) and **3B Edwin Encarnacion** (disabled with a chip fracture in is left wrist).

**SURGERIES:** On Tuesday in Cincinnati, **IF Danny Richar** will have season-ending surgery to repair the torn labrum in his left shoulder...since 7/3 **Richar** has been on the 15-day with the injury, suffered on 7/2 vs Ari while sliding head first into home plate...he will be the fifth Reds player this season to have a surgical procedure, joining **C Ramon Hernandez** (cleaned out left knee), **SS Alex Gonzalez** (removed loose bodies, right elbow), **RHP Mike Lincoln** (cervical disc replacement) and **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder).

**MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUTS:** Five Reds players made their Major League debuts this season, including **RHP Carlos Fisher**, **LHP Matt Maloney**, **IF Drew Sutton**, **RHP Robert Manuel** and **C Craig Tatum**...in **2008**, 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts: **RHP Johnny Cueto**, **IF Paul Janish**, **OF Jay Bruce**, **LHP Daniel Ray Herrera**, **RHP Daryl Thompson**, **IF Adam Rosales**, **OF Chris Dickerson**, **RHP Ramon Ramirez**, **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** and **RHP Josh Roenicke**.

**REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (22-22 .500):** The Reds went **5-7-3 in their 15 home series**...produced a winning record on just 2 of their 8 homestands (2-3, 2-4, **3-2, 6-3**, 1-2, 3-3, 3-3, 2-2)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **263-267-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38)...**at 217-217-1** the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since **6/26/04** (57-57)...also reached .500 at **219-219-1**.

**REDS ON THE ROAD (22-28, .440):** The Reds are 0-3 on this road trip...have lost their last 5 road games, 1 shy of their season high, and 7 of their last 8 road games...went **7-7-2 in their previous 16 road series**...produced a winning or .500 record on 4 of their previous 7 road trips (**7-3, 3-2, 3-3**, 2-5, 2-4, **3-3**, 2-5)...entering this season and dating to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

**IN THE STANDINGS (109):** The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: **FIRST** - 1, **SECOND** - 9, **THIRD** - 46, **FOURTH** - 35, **FIFTH** - 17, **SIXTH** - 1...at **20-14** and **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g over .500** at **36-24**...at **44-50** are a season-high **6g under .500**...have spent **64** days above, **15** days at and **30** days below .500.

**REDS vs CUBS:** The Reds are 1,050-1,078 all-time vs the Cubs, including 982-1007 since 1900 and 3-3 this season...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 25-26, including 1-2 this season...4 Cubs batters rank in the Top 7 in home runs by an opponent at Great American Ball Park (**Lance Berkman** 21, **Albert Pujols** 15, **Jason Bay** 14, **Aramis Ramirez** 12, **Derrek Lee** 12, **Alfonso Soriano** 11, **Sammy Sosa** 10)...**Carlos Zambrano's** 8 wins there are the most by an opposing pitcher...**at Wrigley Field:** Reds are 402-428 all-time, including 2-1 this season...**last Reds sweep:** at Cin: 4/25-4/26, 1994 (2g); 9/24-9/26, 2002 (3g); 4/8-4/11, 1983 (4g)...at Chi: 5/14-5/15, 1966 (2g); 8/8-8/10, 2005 (3g); 8/16-8/18, 1968 (4g)...**last Cubs sweep:** at Cin: 4/26-4/27, 1995 (2g); 5/28-5/30, 2001 (3g)...at Chi: 7/21-7/22, 2004 (2g); 5/22-5/24, 2001 (3g).

**UP NEXT: REDS vs PADRES:** The Reds are 309-253 all-time vs the Padres, including 0-3 this season...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 8-10, including 2-1 in 2008...**at PETCO Park:** Reds are 8-11, including 0-3 in 2009 and 4-9 the last 4 seasons...from 5/15-5/17 the Reds were swept at SD for the first time since June 2000...**last Reds sweep:** at Cin: 4/17-4/18, 1990 (2g); 8/9-8/11, 2002 (3g); 5/10-5/13, 1993 (4g)...at SD: 9/30-10/1, 1987 (2g); 7/29-7/31, 2005 (3g); 9/21-9/23, 1990 (4g)...**last Padres sweep:** at Cin: 7/24-7/25, 1995 (2g); 5/4-5/6, 2001 (3g)...at SD: 10/2-10/3, 1985 (2g); 5/15-5/17, 2009 (3g).

**Last Started:** Sat vs Mil and suffered the 5-1 loss (7ip, 7h, 4r, 3er, 2bb, 7k, 1hr, 107 pitches, 68 strikes)...left trailing, 4-1...allowed all 4 runs in the fourth inning on 4 hits, an error and an intentional walk...in the third inning recorded his 1,000th strikeout as a Red (Manny Parra).

**Red Hots:** Is making his 21st start of the season, his second of the year vs the Cubs...with 11 quality starts ranks second on the staff to **Johnny Cueto** (12qs)...in his previous 20 starts the Reds went 9-11 and scored 74 runs (3.70 r/g)...in his 20 starts **Reds batters** hit .245 (165-674)...on 6/4 at StL suffered the 3-1 loss in a game in which **Harang** and **Chris Carpenter** each threw a complete game.

**Streaking:** In his last 10 starts is **0-6, 5.08** (56.2ip, 32er)...the 6-game losing streak is the longest by a Reds pitcher this season and ties his career high (6/4-7/7, 2005).

**Home Cookin':** Is **4-4, 2.95** (61ip, 20er, 7hr) in 10 starts at Great American Ball Park and **1-6, 5.40** (60ip, 36er, 10hr) in 10 starts on the road.

**Staff Ace:** Since he was acquired from the Athletics at the **2003 trading deadline** is the Reds' leader in most statistical pitching categories, including starts (187), wins (68), innings pitched (1190.0) and strikeouts (1,005)...since the beginning of the **2006 season** ranks third in the National League **771.1** innings pitched (Roy Oswalt 776.2ip, **Bronson Arroyo** 775.2ip)...in 2005 and 2007 won the BBWAA's Johnny Vander Meer Award as the club's Most Outstanding Pitcher.

**Long Balls:** From **4/28-6/4** allowed a home run in 8 consecutive apps (10hr), the longest streak by a Reds pitcher since **RHP Ramon Ortiz** tied the National League record by allowing a home run in **15** consecutive apps from **5/1-7/17, 2005**.

**Milestones:** On 4/23 at Chi recorded the **1,000th strikeout** of his career (**Derrek Lee**)...on 7/18 vs Mil recorded his **1,000th strikeout as a Red (Manny Parra)**...his 3-hitter in the club's fifth game, a 2-0 win on 4/12 vs Pit, was the quickest complete game by a Reds pitcher since **Pete Harnisch** threw a CG in the Reds' fourth game of **1999**.

**Career Highs:** **Innings:** 10.0 (longest), 7/23/07 vs Mil & 1.0 (shortest, 2x), 9/5/03 at StL & 7/28/07 vs Chi; **Hits:** 14, 9/28/05 at Mil; **Runs:** 9, 4/3/06 vs Chi; **Earned runs:** 8 (3x), last on 5/30/09 at Mil; **Walks:** 7, 7/8/08 for Cin at Chi; **Strikeouts:** 13, 9/29/07 vs Chi; **HR allowed:** 4 (3x), last on 8/19/07 at Mil (Braun solo, Hall 2-run, Fielder 2-run, Hardy solo); **Complete Games:** 13, last on 6/4/09 for Cin at StL (3-1 loss); **Shutouts:** 6, last on 4/12/09 for Cin vs Pit (2-0 win).

Tomorrow’s Pitcher: RHP Johnny Cueto

**Last Pitched:** Sun vs Mil and in his first start of the second half received no decision in the 5-3 victory (6ip, 19h, 3er, 1bb, 5k, 1hr, 108 pitches, 68 strikes)...allowed a career-high 10 hits but left with the score tied, 3-3...allowed Hardy's run-scoring fielder's choice in the second inning and Fielder's 2-run HR in the third...Gomes snapped the 3-3 tie in the eighth with a 2-run HR off McClung.

**Red Hots:** The 23-year-old righthander tomorrow will make his 20th start of the season, his second vs the Cubs...in his 19 starts the Reds went 11-8 and scored 73 runs (3.84 r/g)...in 9 of his 19 starts threw at least 7.0 innings and in 15 of his 19 starts threw at least 6.0 innings.

**Quality:** Leads the staff with 12 quality starts...his 2 strings of 5 consecutive QS (4/22-5/13, 5/24-6/14) are the longest stretches of quality starts by a Reds pitcher this season...last year, **Edinson Volquez** produced a string of 12 straight QS (4/22-6/20).

**Road Warrior**...For the season is **2-2, 3.55** in 8 starts at home (50.2ip, 20er, 7hr) and **6-4, 3.76** in 11 starts on the road (64.2ip, 27er, 8hr).

**World Baseball Classic:** Started the Dominican Republic's second game of the tournament and threw 4.2 scoreless innings to earn the 9-0 win vs Panama in the San Juan bracket (4.2ip, 3h, 1bb, 5k).
