TODAY'S GAME: Is **Game 2** (0-1) of a 3-game series vs **Carol Misevich's** Cubs and **Game 5** (0-4) of a 7-day, 6-game road trip that included a visit to LA's **Dodger Stadium** (0-3) and an off day here Thursday...including today's game the Reds will finish the season with 37g at **Great American Ball Park** and 30g on the road...on Monday the Reds will return to GABP for a **10-game homestand**, their longest of the season (4g vs SD, 3g vs Col, 3g vs Chi).

DOT, DOT, DOT: At **44-51** the Reds are a season-high **7g under .500** and **7.0g out of first place**, both season highs...are **2-6** since the All-Star break...the current 4-game losing streak and 6-game road losing streak tie season highs...the Reds led in 3 of their 4 losses on this road trip...**2B Brandon Phillips** is 1 stolen base shy of **100** for his career.

JET LAG: The beginning of this road trip included the second of the Reds' 3 visits to the **West Coast** (0-3 at LAD)...in May were swept by the **Padres** in a 3-game series at SD's **PETCO Park**...next month will play at SF's **AT&T Park**...over the last 4 seasons the Redlegs are **11-31 (.262) on the West Coast** (0-12 at LAD, 4-9 at SD, 5-6 at SF, 1-2 at Oak, 1-2 at Sea)...this stretch includes an active **12-game losing streak** at **Dodger Stadium**, where the Reds haven't won since their final appearance of **2005** (a 6-1 victory by **Brandon Claussen** on 7/28/05)...were swept in all four 3-game series there since then.

INJURY PLAGUED: Because of injuries, the Reds have played just **10g** (5-5) that included the projected **Opening Day** lineup of **C Ramon Hernandez**, **1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips**, **3B Edwin Encarnacion**, **SS Alex Gonzalez**, **RF Jay Bruce**, **CF Willy Taveras** and either **Chris Dickerson** or **Jerry Hairston Jr.** in LF.

M*A*S*H: From the **Opening Day** roster the Reds are missing starting **C Ramon Hernandez** (left knee surgery), starting **RF Jay Bruce** (broken right wrist), starting **RHP Edinson Volquez** (right elbow) and relief **RHP Mike Lincoln** (cervical disc replacement surgery)...all are on the disabled list, along with backups **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (season-ending left shoulder surgery) and **IF Danny Richar** (season-ending left shoulder surgery)...**Volquez** at Wrigley Field yesterday threw a 60-pitch bullpen of fastballs and changeups without complication...he is scheduled to throw all of his pitches in a 75-pitch bullpen Monday at Great American Ball Park...each member of the starting infield missed extended time because of various ailments, including **SS Alex Gonzalez** (disabled following right elbow surgery), **1B Joey Votto** (disabled with stress/anxiety), **2B Brandon Phillips** (hairline fracture, right thumb) and **3B Edwin Encarnacion** (disabled with a chip fracture in his left wrist).

SURGERIES: On Tuesday in Cincinnati, **IF Danny Richar** will have season-ending surgery to repair the torn labrum in his left shoulder...since 7/3 **Richar** has been on the 15-day with the injury, suffered on 7/2 vs Ari while sliding head first into home plate...he will be the fifth Reds player this season to have a surgical procedure, joining **C Ramon Hernandez** (cleaned out left knee), **SS Alex Gonzalez** (removed loose bodies, right elbow), **RHP Mike Lincoln** (cervical disc replacement) and **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder).

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUTS: Five Reds players made their Major League debuts this season, including **RHP Carlos Fisher**, **LHP Matt Maloney**, **IF Drew Sutton**, **RHP Robert Manuel** and **C Craig Tatum**...in 2008, 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts: **RHP Johnny Cueto**, **IF Paul Janish**, **OF Jay Bruce**, **LHP Daniel Ray Herrera**, **RHP Daryl Thompson**, **IF Adam Rosales**, **OF Chris Dickerson**, **RHP Ramon Ramirez**, **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** and **RHP Josh Roenicke**.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (22-22 .500): The Reds went **5-7-3 in their 15 home series**...produced a winning record on just 2 of their 8 homestands (2-3, 2-4, **3-2**, **6-3**, 1-2, 3-3, 3-3, 2-2)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **263-267-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38)...at **217-217-1** the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since **6/26/04** (57-57)...also reached .500 at **219-219-1**.

REDS ON THE ROAD (22-29, .431): The Reds are 0-4 on this road trip...have lost their last 6 road games, tying their season high, and 8 of their last 9 road games...went **7-7-2 in their previous 16 road series**...produced a winning or .500 record on 4 of their previous 7 road trips (**7-3**, **3-2**, **3-3**, 2-5, 2-4, **3-3**, 2-5)...entering this season and dating to 2006, the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips.

IN THE STANDINGS (110): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 46, FOURTH - 35, FIFTH - 1...at **20-14** and **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g over .500** at **36-24**...at **44-51** are **7g under .500** and **7.0g out of first place**, both season highs...have spent **64** days above, **15** days at and **31** days below .500.

REDS vs CUBS: The Reds are 1,050-1,079 all-time vs the Cubs, including 982-1,008 since 1900 and 3-4 this season...against the Cubs in September/October, the Reds are 21-19 over the last 7 seasons and 35-33 over the last 12 years...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 25-26, including 1-2 this season...4 Cubs batters rank in the Top 7 in home runs by an opponent at Great American Ball Park (**Lance Berkman** 21, **Albert Pujols** 15, **Jason Bay** 14, **Aramis Ramirez** 12, **Derrek Lee** 12, **Alfonso Soriano** 11, **Sammy Sosa** 10)...**Carlos Zambrano's** 8 wins there are the most by an opposing pitcher...**at Wrigley Field:** Reds are 402-429 all-time, including 2-2 this season...**last Reds sweep:** at Cin: 4/25-4/26, 1994 (2g); 9/24-9/26, 2002 (3g); 4/8-4/11, 1983 (4g)...at Chi: 5/14-5/15, 1966 (2g); 8/8-8/10, 2005 (3g); 8/16-8/18, 1968 (4g)...**last Cubs sweep:** at Cin: 4/26-4/27, 1995 (2g); 5/28-5/30, 2001 (3g)...at Chi: 7/21-7/22, 2004 (2g); 5/22-5/24, 2001 (3g).

IF Paul Janish pitched in the ninth inning of the 15-3 loss vs Mil on 5/6 (1ip, 5h, 5er, 0bb, 2k, Fielder 2-run HR)...he became the first Reds position player to pitch since Lenny Harris on 6/1/98 at SF.				

Reds Pitchers: On the road trip are 0-4, 8.44 (32ip, 30er, 10hr)...in the 22-1 loss on 7/6 at Phi allowed 22 runs in a game for the first time since a 22-6 loss at Chi on **8/13/37**...the Reds already have 9 team shutouts, their highest total since they had 10sho in 2006...had 6 shutouts last year...with a 7-0 win on 5/5 at Fla reached 6 shutouts in their 26th game, their fastest to 6 team shutouts since the 1914 Reds threw their sixth shutout in their 25th game.

Reds Starters: On the road trip are 0-4, 10.42 (19ip, 22er, 6hr)...have produced 45 quality starts (**Cueto 12, Harang 11, Arroyo 10, Owings 6, Volquez 3, Bailey 2, Maloney 1**)...the Reds went 33-12 in those quality starts (.733)...from 6/3-6/10 produced a season-high **7 consecutive quality starts**, their best stretch since they threw 8 consecutive QS from **8/6-8/14, 2005**...through the first 41g of the season used just 5 starting pitchers, their longest such streak to begin a year since **RHP John Roper** became the staff's **sixth** different starter in the **42nd game** of the **1994 campaign**...on 5/23 vs Cle, in the club's 42nd game, **RHP Homer Bailey** became the Reds' sixth starting pitcher...**Aaron Harang** threw a 3-hitter in the 2-0 win vs Pit in the club's fifth game of the season...was the earliest complete game by a Reds pitcher since **Pete Harnisch** beat the Cardinals, 3-0 in Busch Stadium, in the **fourth** contest of the **1999** campaign.

Reds Relievers: On the road trip are 0-0, 5.54 (13ip, 8er, 4hr)...in 7.1 innings during the 22-1 loss on 7/6 at Phi allowed 13r/12er, the bullpen's highest single-game totals since identical totals in a 16-3 loss on **6/1/98 at SF**...bullpen's ERA excluding that game drops from 3.60 to 3.32 (287.2ip, 106er)...didn't blow a save until the club's 36th game, a 6-5 loss in 16 innings on 5/16 at SD...for the second straight season the Reds' bullpen was the last in the Major Leagues to suffer a blown save...in 2008 didn't blow a save until the 41st game (5/14)...over the last 2 seasons **Francisco Cordero** has recorded **56** of the bullpen's **57** saves (34sv in 2008, 22sv in 2009)...**David Weathers** has the only other save over the last 2 seasons (6/10/09 at Wsh)...**IF Paul Janish** has pitched twice, in the 15-3 loss on 5/6 vs Mil (1ip, 5h, 5er, 0bb, 2k, Fielder 2-run HR) and in the 22-1 loss on 7/6 at Phi (1ip, 4h, 6er, 2bb, 1k, Werth grand slam).

51 JARED BURTON, rhp **31g, 0-0-0, 5.70**
On Mon was recalled from Louisville (8g, 2-0, 1.00, 9ip, 8h, 1er, 3bb, 8k)...technically is his third stint with the Reds...began the season with Cin and posted a 6.33era in 20 apps before he was optioned to Louisville on 6/1, when Edinson Volquez came off the disabled list...never left the team and was recalled the next day, when Volquez returned to the disabled list...posted a 2.19era in 9 more apps for the Reds before he was optioned to Louiville on 7/1, when IF Drew Sutton was promoted.

48 FRANCISCO CORDERO, rhp **38g, 1-2-22, 1.66**

Was an All-Star for the third time (2004 for Tex, 2007 for Mil)...in his last 8 apps has allowed just 1 hit (8ip, Or)...with 22 saves ranks among the National League leaders...converted 22 of his 23 save opps, including each of his last 7 save opps...in the 12-inning, 4-2 win on 6/10 at Wsh returned to the mound after a rain delay and suffered his only blown save since 7/21/08 vs SD...had converted 29 consecutive save chances, including his first 15 save opps this year...including last season has recorded 56 of the bullpen's last 57 saves (34sv in 2008, 22sv in 2009, Weathers 1sv in 2009)...with 233 career saves ranks 30th on that all-time list...Ugeth Urbina is 29th with 237 saves...in the 3-0 victory on 4/22 at Chi recorded his 100th save in the National League to become only the 11th pitcher in history with at least 100 saves in each league (see box).

In his last 8 apps has posted a 1.50era (12ip, 2er)...hasn't allowed a run in his last 4 apps (7ip)...6 times has thrown 2.0 innings, including 4 times in his last 5 apps, and 9 times has thrown more than 1.0 inning...in the 11-inning, 4-3 win on 5/24 vs Cle picked up the victory his Major League debut...in his outing on 6/7 vs the Cubs faced 4 batters but recorded 5 outs (K/CS, K, K, K)...on 5/21 was promoted from Class AAA Louisville (13g, 2-0-2, 2.00, 18ip, 11h, 4er, 4bb, 21k, Ohr, .175 opponents' BA).
