TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 1** of a 4-game series vs **Bret Picciolo's** Padres and **Game 1** of a **10-game** homestand, the Reds' longest of the season (**4g vs SD**, 3g vs Col, 3g vs Chi)...including tonight's game the Reds will finish the season with 37g at **Great American Ball Park** and 28g on the road.

TODAY'S MEDICAL UPDATES: RHP **Micah Owings** (right shoulder) and **OF Chris Dickerson** (right shoulder) each were injured in yesterday's 5-2 loss at Chi...both were scheduled to be examined this morning...**RHP Jared Burton**, who went on the disabled list yesterday with right shoulder fatigue, is having a battery of tests...**OF Laynce Nix** and **C Ryan Hanigan**, each of whom were scratched from starting lineups over the weekend with **stiff necks**, will be examined again prior to tonight's game.

DOT, DOT, DOT: At **44-53** the Reds are **9g under .500** and **7.5g out of first place**, both season highs...are **2-8** since the All-Star break...the current 6-game losing streak and 8-game road losing streak are season highs...**RHP Edinson Volquez** (right elbow) this afternoon is scheduled to throw all of his pitches in a 75-pitch bullpen.

BATTING LEADER: **Joey Votto** is hitting .351 but missed 21g while on the disabled list and thus remains 27 plate apps shy of qualifying for the National League leaders...even with an 0-for-27, **Votto** would be hitting .316 to earn a qualifying spot among the league's Top 10...he currently is working on a 7-game hitting streak (11-27, .407, 2 2b, 3hr, 5rbi), the longest active streak on the team.

FRIENDS OF REDS BASEBALL: At tomorrow night's game **Alex Gonzalez** and **Ramon Hernandez** will host 100 fans in moon deck Section 143 as part of their **Los Amigos del Beisbol de Los Rojos** ticket program targeting local hispanic families...the guests will receive transportation to and from the game, a custom Reds cap, a \$10 concession voucher and in-stadium welcomes via the public address announcer and scoreboard.

SURGERIES: **IF Danny Richar** tomorrow will have season-ending surgery to repair the torn labrum in his left shoulder...since 7/3 **Richar** has been on the 15-day with the injury, suffered on 7/2 vs Ari while sliding head first into home plate...he will be the fifth Reds player this season to have a surgical procedure, joining **C Ramon Hernandez** (cleaned out left knee), **SS Alex Gonzalez** (removed loose bodies, right elbow), **RHP Mike Lincoln** (cervical disc replacement) and **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder).

INJURY PLAGUED: Because of injuries, the Reds have played just **10g** (5-5) that included the projected **Opening Day** lineup of **C Ramon Hernandez**, **1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips**, **3B Edwin Encarnacion**, **SS Alex Gonzalez**, **RF Jay Bruce**, **CF Willy Taveras** and either **Chris Dickerson** or **Jerry Hairston Jr.** in LF.

M*A*S*H: From the **Opening Day** roster the Reds are missing starting **C Ramon Hernandez** (left knee surgery), starting **RF Jay Bruce** (broken right wrist), starting **RHP Edinson Volquez** (right elbow) and relief **RHP Mike Lincoln** (cervical disc replacement surgery)...all are on the disabled list, along with backups **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (season-ending left shoulder surgery) and **IF Danny Richar** (season-ending left shoulder surgery)...**Volquez** is scheduled to throw all of his pitches in a 75-pitch bullpen today at Great American Ball Park...each member of the starting infield missed extended time because of various ailments, including **SS Alex Gonzalez** (disabled following right elbow surgery), **1B Joey Votto** (disabled with stress/anxiety), **2B Brandon Phillips** (hairline fracture, right thumb) and **3B Edwin Encarnacion** (disabled with a chip fracture in his left wrist).

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUTS: Five Reds players made their Major League debuts this season, including **RHP Carlos Fisher**, **LHP Matt Maloney**, **IF Drew Sutton**, **RHP Robert Manuel** and **C Craig Tatum**...in 2008, 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts: **RHP Johnny Cueto**, **IF Paul Janish**, **OF Jay Bruce**, **LHP Daniel Ray Herrera**, **RHP Daryl Thompson**, **IF Adam Rosales**, **OF Chris Dickerson**, **RHP Ramon Ramirez**, **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** and **RHP Josh Roenicke**.

JET LAG: The Reds' next road trip (3g at SF, 3g at StL) will include the third of their 3 scheduled visits to the **West Coast**...are **0-6** on the **West Coast** so far this season (0-3 at SD, 0-3 at LAD)...over the last 4 seasons the Redlegs are **11-31 (.262) on the West Coast** (0-12 at LAD, 4-9 at SD, 5-6 at SF, 1-2 at Oak, 1-2 at Sea)...this stretch includes an active **12-game losing streak at Dodger Stadium**, where the Reds haven't won since their final appearance of **2005** (a 6-1 victory by **Brandon Claussen** on 7/28/05)...were swept in all four 3-game series there since then.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (22-22 .500): The Reds went **5-7-3 in their 15 home series**...produced a winning record on just 2 of their 8 homestands (2-3, 2-4, **3-2**, **6-3**, 1-2, 3-3, 3-3, 2-2)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **263-267-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38)...at **217-217-1** the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since **6/26/04** (57-57)...also reached .500 at **219-219-1**.

REDS ON THE ROAD (22-31, .407): The Reds went 0-6 on their most recent road trip (0-3 at LAD, 0-3 at Chi)...have lost their last 8 road games, a season high, and 10 of their last 11 road games...went **7-8-2 in their 17 road series**...produced a winning or .500 record on 4 of their 8 road trips (**7-3**, **3-2**, **3-3**, 2-5, 2-4, **3-3**, 2-5, 0-6)...entering this season and dating to 2006, the **Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

IN THE STANDINGS (112): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 46, FOURTH - 35, FIFTH - 20, SIXTH - 1...at **20-14** and **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g** over .500 at **36-24**...at **44-53** are **9g under .500** and **7.5g out of first place**, both season highs...have spent **64** days above, **15** days at and **33** days below .500.

REDS vs PADRES: The Reds are 309-253 all-time vs the Padres, including 0-3 this season...at **Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 8-10, including 2-1 in 2008...at **PETCO Park:** Reds are 8-11, including 0-3 in 2009 and 4-9 the last 4 seasons...from 5/15-5/17 the Reds were swept at SD for the first time since June 2000...**last Reds sweep:** at Cin: 4/17-4/18, 1990 (2g); 8/9-8/11, 2002 (3g); 5/10-5/13, 1993 (4g)...at SD: 9/30-10/1, 1987 (2g); 7/29-7/31, 2005 (3g); 9/21-9/23, 1990 (4g)...**last Padres sweep:** at Cin: 7/24-7/25, 1995 (2g); 5/4-5/6, 2001 (3g)...at SD: 10/2-10/3, 1985 (2g); 5/15-5/17, 2009 (3g).

On The Road, Again

On the road trip completed yesterday **Reds** pitchers went 0-6, 7.50 (48ip, 40er, 13hr), including 0-6, 9.00 **by starters** (28ip, 28er, 8hr) and 0-0, 5.40 **by relievers** (20ip, 12er, 5hr)...**Reds batters** hit .204 (39-191, 6hr) with 20 runs scored (3.33 r/g)...the Reds led in 5 of the 6 losses.

Road Trippin'

The Reds went **0-6** on the road trip that ended yesterday (0-3 at LAD, 0-3 at Chi)...were winless on a road trip of at least 6g for the first time since **6/7-6/14, 2004** (0-3 at Oak, 0-3 at Cle, 0-1 at Phi)...were swept at **Dodger Stadium** for the fourth straight year and were swept in a 3-game series at **Wrigley Field** for the first time since **May 2001**...the active **8-game road losing streak** is Cin's longest since an 8-game road skid from **5/31-6/15, 2005**.

Last Pitched: Tue at LAD and allowed a career-high 9 runs in the 12-3 loss (2.2ip, 8h, 9r, 6er, 2bb, 0k, 1hbp, 2wp, 81 pitches, 45 strikes)...left trailing, 9-1...in the first inning allowed a 2-run triple to Ramirez...in the second allowed a 2-run HR to Kemp...in the third allowed 5 more runs (3 unearned) on 2 hits, 2 walks, a hit batsman and 2 errors.

Red Hots: Is making his seventh start of the season, his sixth since his second promotion...**In 5 starts since he rejoined the rotation on 6/27 is 1-2, 6.84 (26.1ip, 20er)**...in his 6 starts overall the Reds went 1-5 and scored 28 runs (4.67 r/g)...has 2 quality starts...once was the victim of a blown save...has walked 21 batters, 11 scored.

2009 Season: Began the year at Class AAA Louisville, where he went 3-5, 4.57 with 2 complete games and a shutout in 8 starts before he was promoted on 5/22...started the 7-6 loss vs Cle on 5/23, then was optioned back to Louisville the next day...made 6 more starts for the Bats (5-0, 0.81) before he was recalled again to start on 6/27 at Cle...in that 5/23 start vs the Indians became only the sixth different pitcher to start a game for the Reds this season, in the club's 42nd game...was the longest such streak to begin a season since **RHP John Roper** became the staff's **sixth** different starter in the **42nd game** of the **1994** campaign.

At Louisville: In 14 apps for the Bats produced 11 quality starts, including quality starts in each of his last 7 apps (5-1, 1.07, 50.1ip, 47h, 6er, 12bb, 45k)... in his first start of the season allowed a season-high 8 earned runs in 5.1 innings (13.50era) and in his last 13 starts posted a 2.03era (84.1ip, 19er)...following his most recent start for the Bats ranked among the International League leaders in innings pitched (89.2, 1st), wins (8, 2nd), strikeouts (82, 2nd) and ERA (2.71, 10th)...**for the Bats, in 6 starts between his 5/22 and 6/27 promotions went 5-0, 0.81.**

IL Pitcher of the Week: Twice this season was named the International League's **Pitcher of the Week**...in 2 starts the week of **4/20-4/26** went 2-0, 2.92 with 18 strikeouts in 12.1 innings (10h, 6bb)...in the 10-3 win at Toledo on 4/26, over 6.1 innings he struck out a career-high 15 batters to tie the Louisville single-game record...in 2 starts from **6/1-6/7** went 2-0 without allowing a run (14.2ip, 11h, 2bb, 14k).

Tomorrow’s Pitcher: Bronson Arroyo

Last Pitched: Wed at LAD and suffered the 6-2 loss (5.1ip, 5h, 5er, 4bb, 8k, 1hr, 100 pitches, 58 strikes)...left with the score tied, 2-2, but was charged with 3 more runs after Ramirez hit Masset's first pitch for pinch-hit grand slam...allowed a solo HR to Ethier in the first inning, an RBI-bloop triple to Loney in the fourth.

Red Hots: Tomorrow will make his 21st start of the season...with 10 victories is 2 shy of the National League leaders...his 21 wins beginning 6/29/08 are tied for second-most in the Major Leagues (Halladay, 23w)...in his previous 20 starts the Reds went 10-10 and scored 77 runs (3.85 r/g)...has 10 quality starts.

Streaking: In consecutive starts on 7/10 (CG, 3-0 win at NYM) and 7/17 (4-0 win vs Mil) put together a season-high 16.0-inning scoreless streak...that streak was snapped in the first inning of Wed's 6-2 loss at LAD...his career high remains 17.0 consecutive scoreless frames (7/2-7/19, 2004).

Workhorse: Since he was acquired by the Reds prior to the 2006 season leads all Major League pitchers with 123 starts and ranks third in the National League with 775.2 innings pitched (**Aaron Harang** 777.1ip; **Roy Oswalt** 775.2ip).

In The Big Inning: Allowed at least 1 run in the first inning of 10 of his 20 starts, including 8 of his last 12 starts...has posted a 9.45era in the first inning (20ip, 21er) and a 4.40era after the first frame (104.1ip, 51er).
