Today's Surgery

IF Danny Richar today had season-ending surgery to repair the torn posterior labrum in his left shoulder (Dr. Timothy Kremchek)...since 7/3 **Richar** has been on the 15-day with the injury, suffered on 7/2 vs Ari while sliding head first into home plate...he is expected to recover fully by spring training...**Richar** is the fifth Reds player this season to have a surgical procedure, joining **C Ramon Hernandez** (cleaned out left knee), **SS Alex Gonzalez** (removed loose bodies, right elbow), **RHP Mike Lincoln** (cervical disc replacement) and **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder).

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 2** (1-0) of a 4-game series vs **Bret Picciolo's** Padres and **Game 2** (1-0) of a **10-game homestand**, the Reds' longest of the season (**1-0 vs SD**, 3g vs Col, 3g vs Chi)...including tonight's game the Reds will finish the season with 36g at **Great American Ball Park** and 28g on the road.

LEGACY WALL OF FAME: Prior to tonight's game **Bob Crotty/Green Diamond Gallery**, the **Cintas Corporation** and the **Reds** will receive **Legacy Wall of Fame** plaques for their support and commitment to helping preserve and promote the history of the franchise through the **Reds Hall of Fame and Museum**.

DOT. DOT. DOT: For the second straight day the Reds are a season high **7.5g out of first place**...are **3-8** since the All-Star break...last night snapped a season-high 6-game losing streak...the Reds (40-0) and Dodgers (49-0) are the only undefeated NL teams when leading after 8 innings.

VOLQUEZ UPDATE: **RHP Edinson Volquez**, on the 15-day disabled list since 6/2 with **right elbow tendinitis**, yesterday threw a 76-pitch bullpen without complaint...he is scheduled to throw a light bullpen tomorrow, followed by an 80-pitch simulated game on Friday.

BATTING LEADER: **Joey Votto** is hitting .350 but missed 21g while on the disabled list and thus remains 29 plate apps shy of qualifying for the National League leaders...even with an 0-for-29, **Votto** would be hitting .312.

FRIENDS OF REDS BASEBALL: At tonight's game **Alex Gonzalez** and **Ramon Hernandez** are hosting 100 fans in moon deck Section 143 as part of their **Los Amigos del Beisbol de Los Rojos** ticket program targeting local hispanic families...the guests received transportation to and from the game, a custom Reds cap, a \$10 concession voucher and in-stadium welcomes via the public address announcer and scoreboard.

OPENING DAY LINEUP: Because of injuries, the Reds have played just **10g** (5-5) that included the projected **Opening Day** lineup of **C Ramon Hernandez**, **1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips**, **3B Edwin Encarnacion**, **SS Alex Gonzalez**, **RF Jay Bruce**, **CF Willy Taveras** and either **Chris Dickerson** or **Jerry Hairston Jr.** in LF...Reds manager **Dusty Baker** has produced **79 different lineups** in 98g.

M*A*S*H: From the **Opening Day roster** the Reds currently are missing starting **C Ramon Hernandez** (left knee surgery), starting **RF Jay Bruce** (broken right wrist), starting **OF Chris Dickerson** (bruised right rotator cuff), starting **RHP Edinson Volquez** (right elbow) and relief **RHP Mike Lincoln** (cervical disc replacement surgery)...all are on the disabled list, along with backups **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (season-ending left shoulder surgery) and **IF Danny Richar** (season-ending left shoulder surgery)...each member of the starting infield missed extended time because of various ailments, including **SS Alex Gonzalez** (disabled following right elbow surgery), **1B Joey Votto** (disabled with stress/anxiety), **2B Brandon Phillips** (hairline fracture, right thumb) and **3B Edwin Encarnacion** (disabled with a chip fracture in his left wrist).

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUTS: Five Reds players made their Major League debuts this season, including **RHP Carlos Fisher**, **LHP Matt Maloney**, **IF Drew Sutton**, **RHP Robert Manuel** and **C Craig Tatum**...in 2008, 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts: **RHP Johnny Cueto**, **IF Paul Janish**, **OF Jay Bruce**, **LHP Daniel Ray Herrera**, **RHP Daryl Thompson**, **IF Adam Rosales**, **OF Chris Dickerson**, **RHP Ramon Ramirez**, **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** and **RHP Josh Roenicke**.

JET LAG: The Reds' next road trip (3g at SF, 3g at StL) will include the third of their 3 scheduled visits to the **West Coast**...are **0-6** on the **West Coast** so far this season (0-3 at SD, 0-3 at LAD)...over the last 4 seasons the Redlegs are **11-31 (.262) on the West Coast** (0-12 at LAD, 4-9 at SD, 5-6 at SF, 1-2 at Oak, 1-2 at Sea)...this stretch includes an active **12-game losing streak** at **Dodger Stadium**, where the Reds haven't won since their final appearance of **2005** (a 6-1 victory by **Brandon Claussen** on 7/28/05)...were swept in all four 3-game series there since then.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (23-22 .511): The Reds went **5-7-3 in their 15 home series**...produced a winning record on just 2 of their 8 homestands (2-3, 2-4, **3-2**, **6-3**, 1-2, 3-3, 3-3, 2-2)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **264-267-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38)...at **217-217-1** the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since **6/26/04** (57-57)...also reached .500 at **219-219-1**.

REDS ON THE ROAD (22-31. .407): The Reds went 0-6 on their most recent road trip (0-3 at LAD, 0-3 at Chi)...have lost their last 8 road games, a season high, and 10 of their last 11 road games...went **7-8-2 in their 17 road series**...produced a winning or .500 record on 4 of their 8 road trips (**7-3**, **3-2**, **3-3**, 2-5, 2-4, **3-3**, 2-5, 0-6)...entering this season and dating to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

IN THE STANDINGS (113): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 46, FOURTH - 35, FIFTH - 21, SIXTH - 1...at **20-14** and **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g over .500** at **36-24**...at **44-53** were a season high **9g under .500**...for the second straight day are a season high **7.5g out of first place**...have spent **64** days above, **15** days at and **34** days below .500.

REDS vs PADRES: The Reds are 310-253 all-time vs the Padres, including 1-3 this season...at **Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 9-10, including 1-0 this season and 2-1 in 2008...at **PETCO Park:** Reds are 8-11, including 0-3 in 2009 and 4-9 the last 4 seasons...from 5/15-5/17 the Reds were swept at SD for the first time since June 2000...**last Reds sweep:** at Cin: 4/17-4/18, 1990 (2g); 8/9-8/11, 2002 (3g); 5/10-5/13, 1993 (4g)...at SD: 9/30-10/1, 1987 (2g); 7/29-7/31, 2005 (3g); 9/21-9/23, 1990 (4g).

all Major League pitchers with 123 starts and ranks third in the National League with 775.2 innings pitched (**Aaron Harang** 777.1ip; **Roy Oswalt** 775.2ip).

In The Big Inning: Allowed at least 1 run in the first inning of 10 of his 20 starts, including 8 of his last 12 starts...has posted a 9.45era in the first inning (20ip, 21er) and a 4.40era after the first frame (104.1ip, 51er).

Unlucky June 24: On 6/24 each of the last 2 seasons started against the Blue Jays at Tor's Rogers Centre...in those 2 starts, a 14-1 loss on 6/24/08 and an 8-2 loss on 6/24/09, allowed 17 runs in 4.2 innings...in the **2008 loss** became only the sixth starting pitcher in Major League history to allow at least 10 earned runs while retiring 3 batters or fewer...in the **2009 loss** allowed 5 runs in the first inning on homers by Hill (2-run), Wells (solo) and Lind (2-run)...in the **calendar year between those 2 starts went 19-9, 4.19**...the 19 wins were the second-most in the Major Leagues in that 1-year span (Tor's **Roy Halladay**, 22-6, 2.49).

Arroyo vs Padres: In his most recent appearance vs SD, a 3-1 loss on 5/17 at PETCO Park, **Jake Peavy** threw a 4-hit complete game...in his 3-2 loss on 5/16/07 at PETCO Park, threw a complete game but walked in the winning run in the bottom of the ninth inning.

Tomorrow's Pitcher: RHP Aaron Harang

Last Started: Fri at Cubs and suffered the 8-5 loss (6ip, 9h, 4er, 1bb, 6k, 2hr, 119 pitches)...left trailing, 4-3...allowed an RBI-double to Ramirez with 2 outs in the first inning, a solo HR to Fontenot in the second, an RBI-single to Ramirez with 2 outs in the third and a homer to Ramirez leading off the sixth...as a batter, in the second inning produced his first career home run, a 3-run shot off Randy Wells that erased a 1-0 deficit.

Red Hots: Tomorrow will make his 22nd start of the season... in his previous 21 starts the Reds went 9-12 and scored 79 runs (3.76 r/g).

Harang vs Padres: Tomorrow will make his 10th career appearance and his ninth career start vs his hometown team, his second this season...**was born in San Diego** and still resides there...in 1996 graduated from **Patrick Henry High School** and then attended **San Diego State University**, where he majored in graphic design.

Streaking: Hasn't won since 5/25...in his last 11 starts is **0-7, 5.17**...the 7-game losing streak is a career-high and the longest by a Reds pitcher since **Bronson Arroyo's** 7-game losing streak from **5/11-6/24, 2007**.

Staff Ace: Since he was acquired from the Athletics at the **2003 trading deadline** is the Reds' leader in most statistical pitching categories, including starts (188), wins (68), innings pitched (1196.0) and strikeouts (1,011).
