Today's Trade

Today the Reds acquired from the Mariners **OF Wladimir Balentien** (#64) in exchange for **RHP Robert Manuel**... **Balentien**, 25, this season appeared in 56g for Sea, including 47 apps and 37 starts in the outfield...over the last 3 seasons he played in 130g for the Mariners...**Balentien** is expected to join the Reds tomorrow or Friday.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 3** (1-1) of a 4-game series vs **Bret Picciolo's** Padres and **Game 3** (1-1) of a **10-game homestand**, the Reds' longest of the season (**1-1 vs SD**, 3g vs Col, 3g vs Chi)...including tonight's game the Reds will finish the season with 35g at **Great American Ball Park** and 28g on the road.

DOT, DOT, DOT: The Reds are **9 games under .500** and **8.0g out of first place**, both season highs...are **3-9** since the All-Star break...the Reds (40-0) and Dodgers (49-0) are the only undefeated NL teams when leading after 8 innings...the Reds' **Family Game** is tomorrow from 11:20 to 11:50 a.m..

DUCKS ON THE POND: **Brandon Phillips**, **Ryan Hanigan**, **Jay Bruce**, **Micah Owings** and **Chris Dickerson** will attend tomorrow night's **Celebrity Duck Auction** that kicks off the 15th annual **Rubber Duck Regatta**...the auction will be held from 5:30 to 8:30 at **Jefferson Hall** at **Newport on the Levee**...it is free and open to the public...among the autographed rubber ducks slated to be auctioned off are those signed by **Dusty Baker** and most of the Reds players, **Carson Palmer** and **Marvin Lewis** of the Bengals, Reds broadcasters, **President Barack Obama**, **Billy Joel**, **Elton John**, **Toby Keith**, **Rascal Flatts**, **Roger Federer** and **Rafael Nadal**...all proceeds benefit **Freestore Foodbank**.

MEDICAL UPDATES: **RHP Edinson Volquez**, on the 15-day disabled list since 6/2 with **right elbow tendinitis**, today is scheduled to throw a light bullpen...barring complications, he will throw an 80-pitch simulated game Friday...**C Ryan Hanigan**, who has missed 4g with a stiff neck, will be examined again today...**RHP Jared Burton** (right shoulder fatigue) is scheduled to long toss today...**RHP Micah Owings** (tight right shoulder) will play catch today...**OF Chris Dickerson** (bruised right rotator cuff) could swing a bat today.

BATTING LEADER: **Joey Votto** is hitting .348 but missed 21g while on the disabled list and thus remains 28 plate apps shy of qualifying for the National League leaders...even with an 0-for-28, **Votto** would be hitting .313.

OPENING DAY LINEUP: Because of injuries, the Reds have played just **10g** (5-5) that included the projected **Opening Day** lineup of **C Ramon Hernandez**, **1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips**, **3B Edwin Encarnacion**, **SS Alex Gonzalez**, **RF Jay Bruce**, **CF Willy Taveras** and either **Chris Dickerson** or **Jerry Hairston Jr.** in LF...Reds manager **Dusty Baker** has produced **79 different lineups** in 99g.

SURGERIES: Five Reds players have had surgical procedures so far this season, including **C Ramon Hernandez** (cleaned out left knee), **SS Alex Gonzalez** (removed loose bodies, right elbow), **RHP Mike Lincoln** (cervical disc replacement), **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder) and **IF Danny Richar** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder).

M*A*S*H: From the **Opening Day** roster the Reds currently are missing starting **C Ramon Hernandez** (left knee surgery), starting **RF Jay Bruce** (broken right wrist), starting **OF Chris Dickerson** (bruised right rotator cuff), starting **RHP Edinson Volquez** (right elbow) and relief **RHP Mike Lincoln** (cervical disc replacement surgery)...all are on the disabled list, along with backups **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (season-ending left shoulder surgery) and **IF Danny Richar** (season-ending left shoulder surgery)...each member of the starting infield missed extended time because of various ailments, including **SS Alex Gonzalez** (disabled following right elbow surgery), **1B Joey Votto** (disabled with stress/anxiety), **2B Brandon Phillips** (hairline fracture, right thumb) and **3B Edwin Encarnacion** (disabled with a chip fracture in his left wrist).

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUTS: Five Reds players made their Major League debuts this season, including **RHP Carlos Fisher**, **LHP Matt Maloney**, **IF Drew Sutton**, **RHP Robert Manuel** and **C Craig Tatum**...in 2008, 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts: **RHP Johnny Cueto**, **IF Paul Janish**, **OF Jay Bruce**, **LHP Daniel Ray Herrera**, **RHP Daryl Thompson**, **IF Adam Rosales**, **OF Chris Dickerson**, **RHP Ramon Ramirez**, **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** and **RHP Josh Roenicke**.

JET LAG: The Reds' next road trip (3g at SF, 3g at StL) will include the third of their 3 scheduled visits to the **West Coast**...are **0-6** on the **West Coast** so far this season (0-3 at SD, 0-3 at LAD)...over the last 4 seasons the Redlegs are **11-31 (.262) on the West Coast** (0-12 at LAD, 4-9 at SD, 5-6 at SF, 1-2 at Oak, 1-2 at Sea)...this stretch includes an active **12-game losing streak** at **Dodger Stadium**, where the Reds haven't won since their final appearance of **2005** (a 6-1 victory by **Brandon Claussen** on 7/28/05)...were swept in all four 3-game series there since then.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (23-23 .500): The Reds went **5-7-3** in their previous **15 home series**...produced a winning record on just 2 of their previous 8 homestands (2-3, 2-4, **3-2**, **6-3**, 1-2, 3-3, 3-3, 2-2)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **264-268-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38).

REDS ON THE ROAD (22-31, .407): The Reds went 0-6 on their most recent road trip (0-3 at LAD, 0-3 at Chi)...have lost their last 8 road games, a season high, and 10 of their last 11 road games...went **7-8-2** in their **17 road series**...produced a winning or .500 record on 4 of their 8 road trips (**7-3**, **3-2**, **3-3**, 2-5, 2-4, **3-3**, 2-5, 0-6)...entering this season and dating to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

IN THE STANDINGS (114): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: **FIRST** - 1, **SECOND** - 9, **THIRD** - 46, **FOURTH** - 35, **FIFTH** - 22, **SIXTH** - 1...at **20-14** and **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g over .500** at **36-24**...at **45-54** are a season high **9g under .500** for the second time (44-53)...are a season-high **8.0g out of first place**...have spent **64** days above, **15** days at and **35** days below .500.

REDS vs PADRES: The Reds are 310-254 all-time vs the Padres, including 1-4 this season...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 9-11, including 1-1 this season and 2-1 in 2008...**at PETCO Park:** Reds are 8-11, including 0-3 in 2009 and 4-9 the last 4 seasons...from 5/15-5/17 the Reds were swept at SD for the first time since June 2000.

Last Started: Fri at Cubs and suffered the 8-5 loss (6ip, 9h, 4er, 1bb, 6k, 2hr, 119 pitches, 74 strikes)...left trailing, 4-3...allowed an RBI-double to Ramirez with 2 outs in the first inning, a solo HR to Fontenot in the second, an RBI-single to Ramirez with 2 outs in the third and a homer to Ramirez leading off the sixth...as a batter, in the second inning produced his first career home run, a 3-run shot off Randy Wells that erased a 1-0 deficit.

Red Hots: Is making his 22nd start of the season, his second of the year vs the Padres...with 11 quality starts is tied with **Bronson Arroyo** for second on the staff to **Johnny Cueto** (12qs)...in his previous 21 starts the Reds went 9-12 and scored 79 runs (3.76 r/g)...in his 21 starts **Reds batters** hit .246 (175-710).

Streaking: In his last 11 starts is **0-7, 5.17** (62.2ip, 36er)...the 7-game losing streak is a career-high and the longest by a Reds pitcher since **Bronson Arroyo's** 7-game losing streak from **5/11-6/24, 2007**...no Reds pitchers has lost more than 7 straight decisions in a single season since **Danny Graves** lost 8 straight from **7/5-9/2, 2003**.

Home Cookin': Is **4-4, 2.95** (61ip, 20er, 7hr) in 10 starts at Great American Ball Park and **1-7, 5.45** (66ip, 40er, 12hr) in 10 starts on the road.

Staff Ace: Since he was acquired from the Athletics at the **2003 trading deadline** is the Reds' leader in most statistical pitching categories, including starts (188), wins (68), innings pitched (1196.0) and strikeouts (1,011)...since the beginning of the **2006 season** ranks third in the National League **777.1** innings pitched (**Arroyo** 782ip, **Roy Oswalt** 778.1ip)...in 2005 and 2007 won the BBWAA's Johnny Vander Meer Award as the club's Most Outstanding Pitcher.

Milestones: On 4/23 at Chi recorded the **1,000th strikeout** of his career (**Derrek Lee**)...on 7/18 vs Mil recorded his **1,000th strikeout as a Red (Manny Parra)**...on 7/24 at Chi hit his first career **home run** (3-run off Randy Wells).

Community Affairs: Is one of the club's more active members of the local community...for the third straight season, as part of his **Aaron's Aces** ticket program is hosting at all Sunday home games children of military personnel serving in the **War On Terrorism**...along with wife **Jen** donated \$55,000 to the **Miracle League of Greater Cincinnati and Northern Kentucky** and on 5/9 attended the dedication of that field at the **Durham Recreation Complex** in Western Hills...for his community service has been the club's nominee for the **Robert Clemente Award** (2007), **Branch Rickey Award** (2007) and **Marvin Miller Man of the Year Award** (2007, 2008).

Career Highs: **Innings:** 10.0 (longest), 7/23/07 vs Mil & 1.0 (shortest, 2x), 9/5/03 at StL & 7/28/07 vs Chi; **Hits:** 14, 9/28/05 at Mil; **Runs:** 9, 4/3/06 vs Chi; **Earned runs:** 8 (3x), last on 5/30/09 at Mil; **Walks:** 7, 7/8/08 for Cin at Chi; **Strikeouts:** 13, 9/29/07 vs Chi; **HR allowed:** 4 (3x), last on 8/19/07 at Mil (Braun solo, Hall 2-run, Fielder 2-run, Hardy solo); **Complete Games:** 13, last on 6/4/09 for Cin at StL (3-1 loss); **Shutouts:** 6, last on 4/12/09 for Cin vs Pit (2-0 win).

Tomorrow's Pitcher: RHP Johnny Cueto

Last Pitched: Sat at Cubs and suffered the 5-3 loss (6ip, 9h, 4er, 3bb, 4k, 2hr, 105 pitches, 62 strikes)...left trailing, 4-1...in the first inning allowed 3 runs on a walk and 5 hits, including an RBI-bloop triple to Lee and a 2-run HR to Ramirez...in the fifth allowed Soriano's solo HR.

Red Hots: The 23-year-old righthander tomorrow will make his 21st start of the season, his first of the year vs the Padres...in his 20 starts the Reds went 11-9 and scored 76 runs (3.8 r/g)...in 9 of his 20 starts threw at least 7.0 innings and in 16 of his 20 starts threw at least 6.0 innings.

Quality: Leads the staff with 12 quality starts...his 2 strings of 5 consecutive QS (4/22-5/13, 5/24-6/14) are the longest stretches of quality starts by a Reds pitcher this season...last year, **Edinson Volquez** produced a string of 12 straight QS (4/22-6/20).

Streaking: In his last 4 starts is 0-3, 10.19 (17.2ip, 20er).
