In his last 20g **Jonny Gomes** is hitting .352 (19-54, 6 2b, 4hr, 11rbi)...has hit safely in each of his last 6 starts, including at least 1rbi in 5 of those 6g (9-25, .360, 6rbi)...hit 3 of the Reds' last 6 homers and 4 of their last 11 homers.

Statistically Speaking...

The Reds went **26-21**, hit **.257** and scored **4.57** runs per game before **1B Joey Votto** went on the disabled list on **5/30**...during his 21g on the disabled list the Reds went **8-13**, hit **.217** and scored **3.38** runs per game...in the 9g since **Votto's** return the Reds are **5-4**, hitting **.277** (88-318) and have scored **3.89** runs per game (35r).

Today's Transactions

Today the Reds placed on the 15-day disabled list **IF Danny Richar** and returned from a rehabilitation assignment and reinstated from the 60-day disabled list **3B Edwin Encarnacion**...**Richar** suffered a torn labrum in his left shoulder sliding head first into home plate in the third inning of Wed's 1-0 win vs Ari...**Encarnacion** had been on the disabled list since 4/28 with a chip fracture in his left wrist...he made 11 rehab apps at Class AAA Louisville (.270, 2hr, 8rbi).

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 1** of a 3-game series vs **Jim Anderson's** Cardinals and **Game 4** (2-1) of a 6-game homestand that also included the **Diamondbacks** (2-1)...is the Reds' final homestand before the **All-Star** break...beginning Monday will finish the first half on the road at **Phi** (4g) and at **NYM** (3g), including their first visit to the Mets' new **Citi Field**.

OHIO CUP MOP: In ceremonies prior to tonight's game, Reds **C Ramon Hernandez** will receive the coveted **Ohio Cup** trophy, presented by **The Ohio Lottery**, as the **Most Outstanding Player** of this year's interleague series between the Reds and Indians...in 5g vs the Tribe **Hernandez** went 9-for-19 (.474) with a double, triple, homer and 5rbi...**OF Jonny Gomes** (6g, 7-23, .304, 1hr, 4rbi) and **LHP Arthur Rhodes** (4g, 4ip, 1h, 0r, 0bb, 3k) also received votes...the Reds won this year's series, 4 games to 2...Reds **OF Adam Dunn** won the 2008 **MOP Award** (.300, 5hr, 10rbi).

DOT, DOT, DOT....: The Reds have won 2 straight games, 4 of their last 5g and 5 of their last 7g...**OF Jonny Gomes** has hit 3 of the Reds' last 6 homers and 4 of their last 11 homers...**Ryan Hanigan** leads all National League rookie batters in batting average (.336) and on-base percentage (.423)...Reds relievers lead the National League with a 3.21 ERA...**Ramon Hernandez** needs 2 runs scored to reach **500** in his career.

BARRY LARKIN: Reds Hall of Fame **SS Barry Larkin**, the 1995 National League MVP and a 12-time All-Star during his 19 Major League seasons, tonight in Lubbock, Texas will be inducted into the **College Baseball Hall of Fame**...in 1984 and '85 while at the **University of Michigan**, he was a first-team **All-America** selection and the Big Ten's first 2-time **Player of the Year**...**Larkin** finished his collegiate career with a .361 batting average and still ranks in the Top 10 on UM's career records list for slugging percentage, triples, runs, total bases and stolen bases...he led the Wolverines to a pair of College World Series berths...tonight's induction class also will include the late **Branch Rickey**, a former Michigan coach and pioneer of the sport.

INJURY PLAGUED: The Reds are **5-5** in the 10 games that included a starting lineup of **C Ramon Hernandez**, **1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips**, **3B Edwin Encarnacion**, **SS Alex Gonzalez**, **RF Jay Bruce**, **CF Willy Taveras** and either **Chris Dickerson** or **Jerry Hairston Jr.** in LF.

M*A*S*H: From the **Opening Day** roster the Reds are missing starting **SS Alex Gonzalez** (right elbow surgery, out 4-5 weeks), starting **RHP Edinson Volquez** (right elbow) and reliever **RHP Mike Lincoln** (bulging disc in his neck)...all are on the disabled list, along with **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (season-ending left shoulder surgery) and **IF Danny Richar** (torn labrum, left shoulder)...**Volquez** is scheduled to throw off flat ground today...**Gonzalez** could start swinging a bat today...several other players missed action recently because of various ailments, including **1B Joey Votto** (stress), **2B Brandon Phillips** (hairline fracture, right thumb), **OF Willy Taveras** (tight right hamstring), **IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr.** (flu) and **3B Edwin Encarnacion** (chip fracture, left wrist).

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUT: **IF Drew Sutton** yesterday became the third Reds player this season to make his Major League debut (**RHP Carlos Fisher**, **LHP Matt Maloney**)...in 2008, 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts: **RHP Johnny Cueto**, **IF Paul Janish**, **OF Jay Bruce**, **LHP Daniel Ray Herrera**, **RHP Daryl Thompson**, **IF Adam Rosales**, **OF Chris Dickerson**, **RHP Ramon Ramirez**, **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** and **RHP Josh Roenicke**.

ALL-STAR AMONG US: **Sherri J. Friedman** of **Amberley Village** is the Reds' nominee for **PEOPLE Magazine's All-Stars Among Us** campaign, which recognizes an individual from each Major League Baseball team who serves his or her community in extraordinary ways...she will be honored on the field during ceremonies prior to the July 14 **All-Star Game** in St. Louis...**Friedman** was elected in online voting for her community service through **Most Valuable Kids of Greater Cincinnati**, an organization that distributes unused tickets to underserved children...she has helped 22,000 kids experience local sporting and entertainment events, including more than 4,800 Reds games.

ALL-STAR RESOLUTION: State Senator **Gary Cates** (R-Butler County) has introduced a resolution in the Ohio Senate urging Major League Baseball to select the Reds and Great American Ball Park as hosts for the **2013 All-Star Game**...the Reds last hosted the Mid-Summer Classic in **1988** at Riverfront Stadium...in June the club already hosted one of MLB's jewel events this summer, the **Gillette Civil Rights Game**.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (19-18 .514): The Reds went **5-6-2** in their previous **13** home series and produced a winning record on just 2 of their previous 6 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3, 1-2, 3-3)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **260-263-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38)...at **217-217-1** the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since **6/26/04** (57-57)...also reached .500 at **219-219-1**.

REDS ON THE ROAD (20-20 .500): The Reds have won 2 straight road games and 3 of their last 4 road games...went **7-4-2** in their **13** road series...produced the following records on their road trips: 7-3, 3-2, 3-3, 2-5, 2-4 and 3-3...entering this season and dating to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28** road trips.

IN THE STANDINGS (88): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 45, FOURTH - 29, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...at **20-14** and **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g** over .500 at **36-24**...4 times were a season-high **2g under .500** (0-2, 1-3, 34-36, 35-37)...have spent **63** days above, **12** days at and **13** days below .500.

REDS vs CARDINALS: The Reds are 932-1,055 all-time vs the Cardinals, including 4-3 this season...at **Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 26-24, including 2-1 this season...**Albert Pujols'** 14 homers here trail only **Lance Berkman's** 21 (**Jason Bay** also w/ 14)...at **Busch Stadium:** Reds are 10-18, including 2-2 this season and 5-14 there the last 3 years...have lost 7 of the last 9g and 10 of the last 13g there...**last Reds sweep:** at Cin: 5/1-5/2, 2006 (2g); 9/11-9/13, 2007 (3g); 5/5-5/8, 2003 (4g)...**last Cardinals sweep:** at Cin: 7/5-7/6, 1982 (2g); 5/2-5/4, 2005 (3g).

IF Paul Janish pitched in the ninth inning of the 15-3 loss vs Mil on 5/6 (1ip, 5h, 5er, 0bb, 2k, Fielder 2-run HR)...he became the first Reds position player to pitch since Lenny Harris on 6/1/98 at SF.				

Reds Pitchers: Rank sixth in the National League with a 3.99 team ERA...on the homestand are **2-1, 2.25 (28ip, 7er)**...already have 7 team shutouts...had 6 shutouts all last season...with a 7-0 win on 5/5 at Fla reached 6 shutouts in their 26th game, their fastest to 6 team shutouts since the 1914 Reds threw their sixth shutout in their 25th game.

Reds Starters: Rank ninth in the National League with 4.39 rotation ERA...on the homestand **1-1, 3.44 (18.1ip, 7er)**...have produced 37 quality starts (**Cueto 11, Harang 9, Arroyo 8, Owings 5, Volquez 3, Maloney 1**)...the Reds went 28-9 in those quality starts (.757)...from 6/3-6/10 produced a season-high 7 consecutive quality starts, their best stretch since they threw 8 consecutive QS from **8/6-8/14, 2005**...through the first 41g of the season used just 5 starting pitchers, their longest such streak to begin a year since **RHP John Roper** became the staff's **sixth** different starter in the **42nd game** of the **1994 campaign**...on 5/23 vs Cle, in the club's 42nd game, **RHP Homer Bailey** became the Reds' sixth starting pitcher...**Aaron Harang** threw a 3-hitter in the 2-0 win vs Pit in the club's fifth game of the season...was the earliest complete game by a Reds pitcher since **Pete Harnisch** beat the Cardinals, 3-0 in Busch Stadium, in the **fourth** contest of the **1999** campaign.

Reds Relievers: Lead the National League with a 3.21 bullpen ERA...on the homestand **are 1-0, 0.00 (9.2ip, 0er)**...haven't allowed a run since last Fri at Cle (5g, 16.2ip)...haven't allowed a homer since 6/20 (10g, 31.2ip)...in their last 67g have posted a 2.65era (214.1ip, 63er) and in their last 55g have posted a 2.29era (200.1ip, 51er)...the previous note does not include the pitching performance by IF Paul Janish in the ninth inning of the 15-3 loss on 5/6 vs Mil (1ip, 5er)...had 1 blown save in their first 51g and then 3 blown saves in their next 5g...didn't blow a save until the club's 36th game, a 6-5 loss in 16 innings on 5/16 at SD...for the second straight season the Reds' bullpen was the last in the Major Leagues to suffer a blown save...in 2008 didn't blow a save until the 41st game (5/14)...over the last 2 seasons **Francisco Cordero** has recorded **53** of the bullpen's **54** saves (34sv in 2008, 19sv in 2009)...**David Weathers** has the only other save over the last 2 seasons (6/10/09 at Wsh).

48 FRANCISCO CORDERO, rhp34g, 1-2-19, 1.85													
With 19 saves ranks among the National League leaders...converted 19 of his 20 save opps...in the 12-inning, 4-2 win on 6/10 at Wsh suffered his first blown save since 7/21/08 vs SD...had converted 29 consecutive save chances, including his first 15 save opps this year...including last season has recorded 53 of the bullpen's last 54 saves (34sv in 2008, 19sv in 2009, Weathers 1sv in 2009)...with 230 career saves ranks 30th on that all-time list...Ugeth Urbina is 29th with 237 saves...in the 3-0 victory on 4/22 at Chi recorded his 100th save in the National League to become only the 11th pitcher in history with at least 100 saves in each league (see box below).
