#### Statistically Speaking...

The Reds went 26-21, hit .257 and scored 4.57 runs per game before 1B Joey Votto went on the disabled list on 5/30...during his 21g on the disabled list the Reds went 8-13, hit .217 and scored 3.38 runs per game...in the 9g since **Votto's** return the Reds are **5-4**, hitting **.277** (88-318) and have scored 3.89 runs per game (35r).

Today's Transactions
Today the Reds placed on the 15-day disabled list **IF Danny Richar** and returned from a rehabilitation assignment and reinstated from the 60-day disabled list **3B Edwin Encarnacion...Richar** suffered a torn labrum in his left shoulder sliding head first into home plate in the third inning of Wed's 1-0 win vs Ari...Encarnacion had been on the disabled list since 4/28 with a chip fracture in his left wrist...he made 11 rehab apps at Class AAA Louisville (.270, 2hr, 8rbi).

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is Game 1 of a 3-game series vs Jim Anderson's Cardinals and Game 4 (2-1) of a 6-game homestand that also included the Diamondbacks (2-1)...is the Reds' final homestand before the All-Star break.. beginning Monday will finish the first half on the road at Phi (4g) and at NYM (3g), including their first visit to the Mets' new Citi Field.

OHIO CUP MOP: In ceremonies prior to tonight's game, Reds C Ramon Hernandez will receive the coveted Ohio Cup trophy, presented by The Ohio Lottery, as the Most Outstanding Player of this year's interleague series between the Reds and Indians...in 5g vs the Tribe Hernandez went 9-for-19 (.474) with a double, triple, homer and 5rbi...OF Jonny Gomes (6g, 7-23, .304, 1hr, 4rbi) and LHP Arthur Rhodes (4g, 4ip, 1h, 0r, 0bb, 3k) also received votes...the Reds won this year's series, 4 games to 2...Reds OF Adam Dunn won the 2008 MOP Award (.300, 5hr, 10rbi).

DOT, DOT, DOT....: The Reds have won 2 straight games, 4 of their last 5g and 5 of their last 7g...OF Jonny Gomes has hit 3 of the Reds' last 6 homers and 4 of their last 11 homers...Ryan Hanigan leads all National League rookie batters in batting average (.336) and on-base percentage (.423)...Reds relievers lead the National League with a 3.21 ERA...Ramon Hernandez needs 2 runs scored to reach 500 in his career.

BARRY LARKIN: Reds Hall of Fame SS Barry Larkin, the 1995 National League MVP and a 12-time All-Star during his 19 Major League seasons, tonight in Lubbock, Texas will be inducted into the College Baseball Hall of Fame... in 1984 and '85 while at the University of Michigan, he was a first-team All-America selection and the Big Ten's first 2-time Player of the Year...Larkin finished his collegiate career with a .361 batting average and still ranks in the Top 10 on UM's career records list for slugging percentage, triples, runs, total bases and stolen bases...he led the Wolverines to a pair of College World Series berths...tonight's induction class also will include the late Branch Rickey, a former Michigan coach and pioneer of the sport.

INJURY PLAGUED: The Reds are 5-5 in the 10 games that included a starting lineup of C Ramon Hernandez, 1B Joey Votto, 2B Brandon Phillips, 3B Edwin Encarnacion, SS Alex Gonzalez, RF Jay Bruce, CF Willy Taveras and either Chris Dickerson or Jerry Hairston Jr. in LF.

M\*A\*S\*H: From the Opening Day roster the Reds are missing starting SS Alex Gonzalez (right elbow surgery, out 4-5 weeks), starting RHP Edinson Volquez (right elbow) and reliever RHP Mike Lincoln (bulging disc in his neck)...all are on the disabled list, along with C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo (season-ending left shoulder surgery) and IF Danny Richar (torn labrum, left shoulder)...Volquez is scheduled to throw off flat ground today...Gonzalez could start swinging a bat today...several other players missed action recently because of various ailments, including 1B Joey Votto (stress), 2B Brandon Phillips (hairline fracture, right thumb), OF Willy Taveras (tight right hamstring), IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr. (flu) and 3B Edwin Encarnacion (chip fracture, left wrist).

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUT: IF Drew Sutton yesterday became the third Reds player this season to make his Major League debut (RHP Carlos Fisher, LHP Matt Maloney)...in 2008, 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts: RHP Johnny Cueto, IF Paul Janish, OF Jay Bruce, LHP Daniel Ray Herrera, RHP Daryl Thompson, IF Adam Rosales, OF Chris Dickerson, RHP Ramon Ramirez, C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo and RHP Josh Roenicke.

ALL-STAR AMONG US: Sherri J. Friedman of Amberley Village is the Reds' nominee for PEOPLE Magazine's All-Stars Among Us campaign, which recognizes an individual from each Major League Baseball team who serves his or her community in extraordinary ways...she will be honored on the field during ceremonies prior to the July 14 All-Star Game in St. Louis...Friedman was elected in online voting for her community service through Most Valuable Kids of Greater Cincinnati, an organization that distributes unused tickets to underserved children...she has helped 22,000 kids experience local sporting and entertainment events, including more than 4,800 Reds games.

ALL-STAR RESOLUTION: State Senator Gary Cates (R-Butler County) has introduced a resolution in the Ohio Senate urging Major League Baseball to select the Reds and Great American Ball Park as hosts for the 2013 All-Star Game...the Reds last hosted the Mid-Summer Classic in 1988 at Riverfront Stadium...in June the club already hosted one of MLB's jewel events this summer, the Gillette Civil Rights Game.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (19-18.514): The Reds went 5-6-2 in their previous 13 home series and produced a winning record on just 2 of their previous 6 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3, 1-2, 3-3)...in 7 seasons at GABP are 260-263-1...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38)...at 217-217-1 the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since 6/26/04 (57-57)...also reached .500 at 219-219-1.

REDS ON THE ROAD (20-20, .500): The Reds have won 2 straight road games and 3 of their last 4 road games... went 7-4-2 in their 13 road series...produced the following records on their road trips: 7-3, 3-2, 3-3, 2-5, 2-4 and 3-3... entering this season and dating to 2006, the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips.

IN THE STANDINGS (88): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 45, FOURTH - 29, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...at 20-14 and 26-20 were a season-high 6g over .500...prior to this season hadn't been 6g over .500 since 2006, when they reached a season-high 12g over .500 at 36-24...4 times were a season-high 2g under .500 (0-2, 1-3, 34-36, 35-37)... have spent 63 days above, 12 days at and 13 days below .500.

REDS vs CARDINALS: The Reds are 932-1,055 all-time vs the Cardinals, including 4-3 this season...at Great American Ball Park: Reds are 26-24, including 2-1 this season...Albert Pujols' 14 homers here trail only Lance Berkman's 21 (Jason Bay also w/ 14)...at Busch Stadium: Reds are 10-18, including 2-2 this season and 5-14 there the last 3 years... have lost 7 of the last 9g and 10 of the last 13g there...<u>last Reds sweep</u>: at Cin: 5/1-5/2, 2006 (2g); 9/11-9/13, 2007 (3g); 5/5-5/8, 2003 (4g)...<u>last Cardinals sweep</u>: at Cin: 7/5-7/6, 1982 (2g); 5/2-5/4, 2005 (3g).

**Last Pitched**: Sat at Cle, in his second start of the season earned the 7-3 victory (5ip, 3h, 3er, 7bb, 2k, 106 pitches, 54 strikes)...left leading, 6-3... for the second straight start established a career-high for walks...2 batters who walked scored...after the Reds scored 4 runs in the top of the second allowed a run scoring-GIDP in the bottom of the inning...with 2 outs in the fourth allowed Sizemore's 2-run single.

**2009 Season**: Is making his third start of the season for the Reds, his second since Sat's promotion...began the year at Class AAA Louisville, where he went 3-5, 4.57 with 2 complete games and a shutout in 8 starts before he was promoted on 5/22...started the 7-6 loss vs Cle on 5/23, then was optioned back to Louisville the next day...made 6 more starts for the Bats (5-0, 0.81) before he was recalled again to start Sat at Cle...in that 5/23 start vs the Indians became only the sixth different pitcher to start a game for the Reds this season, in the club's 42nd game...was the longest such streak to begin a season since **RHP John Roper** became the staff's **sixth** different starter in the **42nd game** of the **1994** campaign.

<u>Walks Will Haunt</u>: In each of his 2 starts for the Reds this season established a career high for walks issued (6bb on 5/23 vs Cle, 7bb on 6/27 at Cle)...in his 2 starts walked the leadoff batter in 5 of his 10 innings...of the 13 batters he walked overall, 6 scored.

At Louisville: In 14 apps for the Bats produced 11 quality starts, including quality starts in each of his last 7 apps (5-1, 1.07, 50.1ip, 47h, 6er, 12bb, 45k)... in his first start of the season allowed a season-high 8 earned runs in 5.1 innings (13.50era) and in his last 13 starts posted a 2.03era (84.1ip, 19er)...following his most recent start for the Bats ranked among the International League leaders in innings pitched (89.2, 1st), wins (8, 2nd), strikeouts (82, 2nd) and ERA (2.71, 10th)...for the Bats, in 6 starts between his 5/22 and 6/27 promotions went 5-0, 0.81.

IL Pitcher of the Week: Twice this season was named the International League's Pitcher of the Week...in 2 starts the week of 4/20-4/26 went 2-0, 2.92 with 18 strikeouts in 12.1 innings (10h, 6bb)...in the 10-3 win at Toledo on 4/26, over 6.1 innings he struck out a career-high 15 batters to tie the Louisville single-game record...in 2 starts from 6/1-6/7 went 2-0 without allowing a run (14.2ip, 11h, 2bb, 14k).

2008 Season: Spent most of the season at Class AAA Louisville (19gs, 4-7, 4.77)...made 8 starts during 2 stints with the Reds (0-6, 7.93)...from 6/5-6/17 filled in for injured starter **Josh Fogg** and from 7/13-8/9 took the spot vacated by the disabled **Aaron Harang**...from 8/24-9/2 was on Louisville's disabled list with a sprained medial collateral ligament in his right knee, an injury that prevented a September promotion...between a 4-3 victory for Louisville on 4/30 vs Toledo and a 19-3 win on 9/4 vs Durham in Game 2 of the International League playoffs made 21 starts without a victory (13gs for Louisville, 8gs at Cin)...in his 8 starts the Reds went 0-8, scored 14 runs (1.75 r/g) and twice were shut out...produced 2 quality starts...twice was the victim of blown saves.

<u>Last Started</u>: Sun at Cle and earned the 8-1 victory (6ip, 5h, 1er, 4bb, 4k, 106 pitches, 63 strikes)...left leading, 7-1...allowed only a sac fly to Martinez in the first inning.

<u>Red Hots</u>: Tomorrow will make his 15th start of the season, his second career appearance vs the Cardinals...in his previous 14 starts the Reds went 6-8 and scored 61 runs (4.36 r/g)...has 5 quality starts...with an 8-2 win on 4/26 vs Atl snapped his **9-game losing streak** dating back to a 9-3 Diamondbacks victory on 5/25/08 at Atl... in 14 apps and 10 starts between victories went **0-9. 8.53**.

In Relief: Made his only relief appearance of the season in the 16-inning, 6-5 loss at SD on 5/16...threw a career-high 5.2 innings in relief (3h, 1er, 3bb, 5k, 1hr, 81 pitches, 44 strikes)...entered the game in the 11th inning as the Reds' seventh and final pitcher... retired his first 10 batters until Scott Hairston singled with 1 out in the 14th inning...Nick Hundley homered to end the 5-hour, 14 minute struggle...in 8 starts since then is 2-4, 5.27 (42.2ip, 25er).

At The Plate: In 2007 won the National League's Silver Slugger Award (.333, 4hr, 15rbi)...has 7 career home runs, including 2 this season (5/10 vs StL, pinch-hit solo off Ryan Franklin & 6/17 vs Atl, 3-run off Javier Vazquez)...his 5 career home runs prior to 2009 are listed on page 149 of the media guide...on 5/7 vs Mil produced the first triple by a Reds pitcher since Eric Milton did it on 4/13/06 at Cubs.
