Prior to tomorrow night's game vs Col, Mayor Don Ryan will present keys to the nearby City of Hamilton to Rockies manager Jim Tracy and pitcher Aaron Cook...Tracy graduated from Hamilton Badin High School and Cook from Hamilton High...Mayor Ryan will receive an authentic Rockies jersey autographed by Cook.

TODAY'S GAME: Is **Game 4** (1-2) of a 4-game series vs **Bret Picciolo's** Padres and **Game 4** (1-2) of a **10-game homestand**, the Reds' longest of the season (**1-2 vs SD**, 3g vs Col, 3g vs Chi)...including today's game the Reds will finish the season with 34g at **Great American Ball Park** and 28g on the road.

DOT, DOT, DOT: The Reds are **10 games under .500** and **9.0g out of first place**, both season highs...are **3-10** since the All-Star break...at 40-0 the Reds club is the National League's only undefeated team when leading after 8 innings.

YESTERDAY'S TRADE: Yesterday the Reds acquired from the Mariners **OF Vladimir Balentien** (#64, pronounced Vladimir Ballenteen) in exchange for **RHP Robert Manuel**...**Balentien** will be in uniform for this afternoon's game...the press release and his media guide bio are available in the press box.

1-HITTER: In last night's 7-1 loss, 3 Padres rookies combined on a 1-hitter (**Jerry Hairston Jr.** homer off **Mat Latos**)...the **2006 Braves** team was the last to use at least 2 rookie pitchers in a 1-hitter (**Chuck James & Macay McBride**, 9/4/06 at NYM)...since the rookie rule was established in 1957, prior to last night no team had held an opponent to 1 hit or less while using **3 rookie pitchers**...Reds batters were held to 1 hit for the first time since **9/29/07 vs the Cubs** (**Buck Coats** doubled off **Rich Hill**)...**Hairston Jr.** became the first Reds player to produce a homer as his team's only hit since **Eddie Milner** did it in a 7-1 loss to the Dodgers on **8/2/86**...information courtesy Elias Sports Bureau and Padres media relations.

DUCKS ON THE POND: **Brandon Phillips**, **Ryan Hanigan**, **Jay Bruce**, **Micah Owings** and **Chris Dickerson** will attend tonight's **Celebrity Duck Auction** that kicks off the 15th annual **Rubber Duck Regatta**...the auction will be held from 5:30 to 8:30 at **Jefferson Hall** at **Newport on the Levee**...it is free and open to the public...among the autographed rubber ducks slated to be auctioned off are those signed by **Dusty Baker** and most of the Reds players, **Carson Palmer** and **Marvin Lewis** of the Bengals, Reds broadcasters, **President Barack Obama**, **Billy Joel**, **Elton John**, **Toby Keith**, **Rascal Flatts**, **Roger Federer** and **Rafael Nadal**...all proceeds benefit **Freestore Foodbank**.

MEDICAL UPDATES: **RHP Edinson Volquez**, on the 15-day disabled list since 6/2 with **right elbow tendinitis**, will throw an 80-pitch simulated game tomorrow...**C Ryan Hanigan**, who has missed 5g with a stiff neck, remains day-to-day...**RHP Jared Burton** (right shoulder fatigue) and **RHP Micah Owings** (tight right shoulder) are scheduled to long toss today...**OF Chris Dickerson** (bruised right rotator cuff) could swing a bat today.

BATTING LEADER: **Joey Votto** is hitting .343 but missed 21g while on the disabled list and thus remains 28 plate apps shy of qualifying for the National League leaders...even with an 0-for-28, **Votto** would be hitting .308.

OPENING DAY LINEUP: Because of injuries, the Reds have played just **10g** (5-5) that included the projected **Opening Day** lineup of **C Ramon Hernandez**, **1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips**, **3B Edwin Encarnacion**, **SS Alex Gonzalez**, **RF Jay Bruce**, **CF Willy Taveras** and either **Chris Dickerson** or **Jerry Hairston Jr.** in LF...Reds manager **Dusty Baker** has produced **80 different lineups** in 100g.

SURGERIES: Five Reds players have had surgical procedures so far this season, including **C Ramon Hernandez** (cleaned out left knee), **SS Alex Gonzalez** (removed loose bodies, right elbow), **RHP Mike Lincoln** (cervical disc replacement), **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder) and **IF Danny Richar** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder).

M*A*S*H: From the **Opening Day roster** the Reds currently are missing starting **C Ramon Hernandez** (left knee surgery), starting **RF Jay Bruce** (broken right wrist), starting **OF Chris Dickerson** (bruised right rotator cuff), starting **RHP Edinson Volquez** (right elbow) and relief **RHP Mike Lincoln** (cervical disc replacement surgery)...all are on the disabled list, along with backups **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (season-ending left shoulder surgery) and **IF Danny Richar** (season-ending left shoulder surgery)...each member of the starting infield missed extended time because of various ailments, including **SS Alex Gonzalez** (disabled following right elbow surgery), **1B Joey Votto** (disabled with stress/anxiety), **2B Brandon Phillips** (hairline fracture, right thumb) and **3B Edwin Encarnacion** (disabled with a chip fracture in his left wrist).

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (23-24 .489): The Reds went **5-7-3 in their previous 15 home series**...produced a winning record on just 2 of their previous 8 homestands (2-3, 2-4, **3-2**, **6-3**, 1-2, 3-3, 3-3, 2-2)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **264-269-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38).

REDS ON THE ROAD (22-31, .407): The Reds went 0-6 on their most recent road trip (0-3 at LAD, 0-3 at Chi)...have lost their last 8 road games, a season high, and 10 of their last 11 road games...went **7-8-2 in their 17 road series**...produced a winning or .500 record on 4 of their 8 road trips (**7-3**, **3-2**, **3-3**, 2-5, 2-4, **3-3**, 2-5, 0-6).

IN THE STANDINGS (115): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 46, FOURTH - 35, FIFTH - 23, SIXTH - 1...at **20-14** and **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g over .500** at **45-55** are **10g under .500** and **9.0g out of first place**, both season highs...have spent **64** days above, **15** days at and **36** days below .500.

REDS vs PADRES: The Reds are 310-255 all-time vs the Padres, including 1-5 this season...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 9-12, including 1-2 this season and 2-1 in 2008.

UP NEXT: REDS vs ROCKIES: The Reds are 71-64 all-time vs the Rockies, including 1-5 in 2008...Rockies batters produced at least 10 hits in all 6g in 2008...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 12-7, including 0-3 last season...Col's sweep from 7/25-7/27 of last year was its first in the Queen City since June 2001...in that 3-game sweep, Rockies batters hit .375 (45-120).

IF Paul Janish pitched in the ninth inning of the 15-3 loss vs Mil on 5/6 (1ip, 5h, 5er, 0bb, 2k, Fielder 2-run HR) and in the eighth inning of the historic 22-1 loss on 7/6 at Phi (1ip, 4h, 6er, 2bb, 1k, Werth grand slam)...he became the first Reds position player to pitch since Lenny Harris on 6/1/98 at SF and the first Reds position player to pitch more than once in a season since OF Mel Queen took the mound 7 times during the second half of the 1966 campaign.				

Reds Pitchers: Rank 13th in the National League with a 4.43 staff ERA...**on the homestand are 1-2, 4.67 (27ip, 14er, 6hr)**...in the 22-1 loss on 7/6 at Phi allowed 22 runs in a game for the first time since a 22-6 loss at Chi on **8/13/37**...the Reds already have 9 team shutouts, their highest total since they had 10sho in 2006...had 6 shutouts last year...with a 7-0 win on 5/5 at Fla reached 6 shutouts in their 26th game, their fastest to 6 team shutouts since the 1914 Reds threw their sixth shutout in their 25th game.

Reds Starters: Rank 14th in the National League with a 4.86 rotation ERA...**on the homestand are 1-2, 5.66 (20.2ip, 13er, 5hr)**...have produced 47 quality starts (**Cueto 12, Harang 11, Arroyo 11, Owings 6, Volquez 3, Bailey 3, Maloney 1**)...the Reds went 34-13 in those quality starts (.723)...from 6/3-6/10 produced a season-high **7 consecutive quality starts**, their best stretch since they threw 8 consecutive QS from **8/6-8/14, 2005**...through the first 41g of the season used just 5 starting pitchers, their longest such streak to begin a year since **RHP John Roper** became the staff's **sixth** different starter in the **42nd game of the 1994 campaign**...on 5/23 vs Cle, in the club's 42nd game, **RHP Homer Bailey** became the Reds' sixth starting pitcher...**Aaron Harang** threw a 3-hitter in the 2-0 win vs Pit in the club's fifth game of the season...was the earliest complete game by a Reds pitcher since **Pete Harnisch** beat the Cardinals, 3-0 in Busch Stadium, in the **fourth** contest of the **1999** campaign.

Start Me Up: In the last 21g, Reds starting pitchers are **3-15, 7.09** (113ip, 89er)...**Bronson Arroyo** earned 2 of the 3 wins by throwing a complete game in the 3-0 victory at NYM on 7/10 and 7.0 shutout innings in the 4-0 win on 7/17 vs Mil...Homer Bailey was the winner in Mon's game vs SD (7.1ip, 3r)...in the 18 other apps during this stretch Reds starters went **0-15, 8.63** (89.2ip, 86er)...in the last 11g overall are 1-9, 6.86 (61.2ip, 47er).

Reds Relievers: Rank third in the National League with a 3.59 bullpen ERA (LAD 3.27, SF 3.38, NYM 3.61)...**on the homestand are 0-0, 1.42 (6.1ip, 1er, 1hr)**...in 7.1 innings during the 22-1 loss on 7/6 at Phi allowed 13r/12er, the bullpen's highest single-game totals since identical totals in a 16-3 loss on **6/1/98 at SF**...bullpen's ERA excluding that game drops from 3.65 to 3.32 (301ip, 111er)...didn't blow a save until the club's 36th game, a 6-5 loss in 16 innings on 5/16 at SD...for the second straight season the Reds' bullpen was the last in the Major Leagues to suffer a blown save...in 2008 didn't blow a save until the 41st game (5/14)...over the last 2 seasons **Francisco Cordero** has recorded **57** of the bullpen's **58** saves (34sv in 2008, 23sv in 2009)...**David Weathers** has the only other save over the last 2 seasons (6/10/09 at Wsh).

48 FRANCISCO CORDERO, rhp **40g, 1-2-23, 1.83**
Was an All-Star for the third time (2004 for Tex, 2007 for Mil)...in his last 10 apps has allowed just 1 run on 3 hits (9.1ip, 1hr)...with 23 saves ranks among the National League leaders...converted 23 of his 24 save opps, including each of his last 8 save opps...in the 12-inning, 4-2 win on 6/10 at Wsh returned to the mound after a rain delay and suffered his only blown save since 7/21/08 vs SD...had converted 29 consecutive save chances, including his first 15 save opps this year...including last season has recorded 57 of the bullpen's last 58 saves (34sv in 2008, 23sv in 2009, Weathers 1sv in 2009)...with 234 career saves ranks 30th on that all-time list...Ugeth Urbina is 29th with 237 saves...in the 3-0 victory on 4/22 at Chi recorded his 100th save in the National League to become only the 11th pitcher in history with at least 100 saves in each league (see box).
