City of Hamilton Night

Prior to tonight's game, **Mayor Don Ryan** will present keys to the nearby **City of Hamilton** to Rockies manager **Jim Tracy** and pitcher **Aaron Cook** along with a donation to the **Joe Nuxhall Character Education Fund**...**Tracy** graduated from **Hamilton Badin High School** and **Cook** from **Hamilton High**...**Mayor Ryan** will receive an authentic Rockies jersey autographed by **Cook**...the **Reds Community Fund** will present to the **City of Hamilton School District** the **2009 School of Character Award** and a **\$5,000 grant**.

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** Is **Game 1** (0-0) of a 3-game series vs **Jay Alves'** Rockies and **Game 5** (1-3) of a **10-game homestand**, the Reds' longest of the season (**1-3 vs SD**, 3g vs Col, 3g vs Chi)...including tonight's game the Reds will finish the season with 33g at **Great American Ball Park** and 28g on the road...following this homestand the Reds embark on a 6-game road trip to **SF** (3g) and **StL** (3g).

**DOT, DOT, DOT:** The Reds are **11 games under .500** and **9.5g out of first place**, both season highs...are **3-11** since the All-Star break...at 40-0 the Reds club is the National League's only undefeated team when leading after 8 innings.

**WEDNESDAY'S TRADE:** The Reds acquired from the Mariners **OF Wladimir Balentien** (#64) in exchange for **RHP Robert Manuel**...his media guide bio are available in the press box.

**MEDICAL UPDATES:** **RHP Edinson Volquez**, on the 15-day disabled list since 6/2 with **right elbow tendinitis**, is scheduled to throw an 80-pitch simulated game today...**C Ryan Hanigan**, who has missed 6g with a stiff neck, remains day-to-day...**RHP Jared Burton** (DL, right shoulder fatigue) and **RHP Micah Owings** (DL, tight right shoulder) are scheduled to long toss today...**OF Chris Dickerson** (DL, bruised right rotator cuff) today is scheduled to play catch and hit soft toss...**OF Willy Taveras**, scratched from yesterday's lineup with a sore left wrist, will be examined again this afternoon.

**BATTING LEADER:** **Joey Votto** is hitting .341 but missed 21g while on the disabled list and thus remains 27 plate apps shy of qualifying for the National League leaders...even with an 0-for-27, **Votto** would be hitting .308 to rank among the league leaders.

**M\*A\*S\*H:** The Reds currently have **9 players on the disabled list**, including 7 players from their **Opening Day Roster:** **C Ramon Hernandez** (left knee surgery), **RF Jay Bruce** (broken right wrist), **OF Chris Dickerson** (bruised right rotator cuff), **RHP Edinson Volquez** (right elbow), **RHP Micah Owings** (tight right shoulder), **RHP Mike Lincoln** (cervical disc replacement surgery) and **RHP Jared Burton** (right shoulder fatigue)...also on the DL are **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (season-ending left shoulder surgery) and **IF Danny Richar** (season-ending left shoulder surgery)...each member of the starting infield missed extended time because of various ailments, including **SS Alex Gonzalez** (disabled following right elbow surgery), **1B Joey Votto** (disabled with stress/anxiety), **2B Brandon Phillips** (hairline fracture, right thumb) and **3B Edwin Encarnacion** (disabled with a chip fracture in his left wrist).

**OPENING DAY LINEUP:** Because of injuries, the Reds have played just **10g** (5-5) that included the projected **Opening Day** lineup of **C Ramon Hernandez**, **1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips**, **3B Edwin Encarnacion**, **SS Alex Gonzalez**, **RF Jay Bruce**, **CF Willy Taveras** and either **Chris Dickerson** or **Jerry Hairston Jr.** in LF...Reds manager **Dusty Baker** has produced **81 different lineups** in 101g.

**SURGERIES:** Five Reds players have had surgical procedures so far this season, including **C Ramon Hernandez** (cleaned out left knee), **SS Alex Gonzalez** (removed loose bodies, right elbow), **RHP Mike Lincoln** (cervical disc replacement), **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder) and **IF Danny Richar** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder).

**MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUTS:** Five Reds players made their Major League debuts this season, including **RHP Carlos Fisher**, **LHP Matt Maloney**, **IF Drew Sutton**, **RHP Robert Manuel** and **C Craig Tatum**...in **2008**, 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts: **RHP Johnny Cueto**, **IF Paul Janish**, **OF Jay Bruce**, **LHP Daniel Ray Herrera**, **RHP Daryl Thompson**, **IF Adam Rosales**, **OF Chris Dickerson**, **RHP Ramon Ramirez**, **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** and **RHP Josh Roenicke**.

**JET LAG:** The Reds' next road trip (3g at SF, 3g at StL) will include the third of their 3 scheduled visits to the **West Coast**...are **0-6** on the **West Coast** so far this season (0-3 at SD, 0-3 at LAD)...over the last 4 seasons the Redlegs are **11-31 (.262) on the West Coast** (0-12 at LAD, 4-9 at SD, 5-6 at SF, 1-2 at Oak, 1-2 at Sea)...this stretch includes an active **12-game losing streak** at **Dodger Stadium**, where the Reds haven't won since their final appearance of **2005** (a 6-1 victory by **Brandon Claussen** on 7/28/05)...were swept in all four 3-game series there since then.

**REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (23-25 .479):** The Reds went **5-8-3 in their previous 16 home series**...produced a winning record on just 2 of their previous 8 homestands (2-3, 2-4, **3-2**, **6-3**, 1-2, 3-3, 3-3, 2-2)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **264-270-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38).

**REDS ON THE ROAD (22-31, .407):** The Reds went 0-6 on their most recent road trip (0-3 at LAD, 0-3 at Chi)...have lost their last 8 road games, a season high, and 10 of their last 11 road games...went **7-8-2 in their 17 road series**...produced a winning or .500 record on 4 of their 8 road trips (**7-3**, **3-2**, **3-3**, 2-5, 2-4, **3-3**, 2-5, 0-6)...entering this season and dating to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

**IN THE STANDINGS (116):** The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 46, FOURTH - 35, FIFTH - 24, SIXTH - 1...at **20-14** and **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g over .500** at **36-24**...at **45-56** are **11g under .500** and **9.5g out of first place**, both season highs...have spent **64** days above, **15** days at and **37** days below .500.

**REDS vs ROCKIES:** The Reds are 71-64 all-time vs the Rockies, including 1-5 last season...Rockies batters produced at least 10 hits in all 6g in 2008...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 12-7, including 0-3 last season...Col's sweep from 7/25-7/27 of last year was its first in Cin since June 2001...in that 3-game sweep, Rockies batters hit .375 (45-120)...**at Coors Field:** Reds are 25-32, including this 1-2 in 2008.

**Last Pitched:** On Sunday for Louisville at Syracuse, started and earned the 5-3 victory (6.1ip, 6h, 3r, 2er, 0bb, 4k, 87 pitches, 56 strikes).

**Last Pitched In The Major Leagues:** On **5/22/06 for Mil at Cin**, in relief received no decision in the 15-5 Reds win (1.1ip, 5h, 3er, 1bb, 2k).

**Red Hots:** Last name is pronounced LERR...is making his first Major League appearance since **May 2006** and his first career big league start...recorded his last Major League victory on **5/18/06 vs Phi** (5-4 Brewers win)...on Monday will celebrate his 32nd birthday...his media guide bio is available in the press box.

**2009 Season:** In December was signed by the Phillies to a minor league contract and began the season with Class AAA Lehigh Valley (8g, 7gs, 5-2, 4.75)...on 5/22 was traded to the Reds in exchange for cash...went 8-1, 2.51 in 11 starts and 1 relief appearance at Class AAA Louisville before he was promoted on 8/1 to take the spot in the rotation vacated by **RHP Micah Owings**, who went on the disabled list with a tight right shoulder...overall at Class AAA went **13-3, 3.31** in 18 starts and 2 relief apps...when promoted, his 13 victories tied for the most among all minor league pitchers...twice was International League Pitcher of the Week, from **4/13-4/19** for Lehigh Valley (2gs, 2-0, 1.59) and from **7/20-7/26** for Louisville (2gs, 2-0, 1.88).

**Career Highlights:** Prior to this season had made all 66 of his Major League apps in relief...was International League Pitcher of the Week twice in 2009 and once in 2008...in 2007 was a Pacific Coast League All-Star and started the Triple-A All-Star Game...in 2000 was a California League All-Star.

Tomorrow’s Pitcher: RHP Homer Bailey

**Last Pitched:** Mon vs SD, tied his career-high with 7.1 innings and snapped the Reds' season-high 6-game losing streak with a 6-4 victory (6h, 3er, 1bb, 4k, 2hr, 111 pitches, 75 strikes)...left leading, 6-3...in the fifth inning allowed an RBI-single to Rodriguez...in the sixth allowed back-to-back solo HR to Cabrera (first career) and AGonzalez.

**Red Hots:** Tomorrow will make his eighth start of the season, his seventh since his second promotion...**in 6 starts since he rejoined the rotation on 6/27 is 2-2, 6.15 (33.2ip, 23er)**...in his 7 starts overall the Reds went 2-5 and scored 34 runs (4.86 r/g)...has 3 quality starts...once was the victim of a blown save...has walked 22 batters, 11 scored.

**2009 Season:** Began the year at Class AAA Louisville, where he went 3-5, 4.57 with 2 complete games and a shutout in 8 starts before he was promoted on 5/22...started the 7-6 loss vs Cle on 5/23, then was optioned back to Louisville the next day...made 6 more starts for the Bats (5-0, 0.81) before he was recalled again to start on 6/27 at Cle...in that 5/23 start vs the Indians became only the sixth different pitcher to start a game for the Reds this season, in the club's 42nd game...was the longest such streak to begin a season since **RHP John Roper** became the staff's **sixth** different starter in the **42nd game** of the **1994** campaign.

**At Louisville:** In 14 apps for the Bats produced 11 quality starts, including quality starts in each of his last 7 apps (5-1, 1.07, 50.1ip, 47h, 6er, 12bb, 45k)... in his first start of the season allowed a season-high 8 earned runs in 5.1 innings (13.50era) and in his last 13 starts posted a 2.03era (84.1ip, 19er)...following his most recent start for the Bats ranked among the International League leaders in innings pitched (89.2, 1st), wins (8, 2nd), strikeouts (82, 2nd) and ERA (2.71, 10th)...**for the Bats, in 6 starts between his 5/22 and 6/27 promotions went 5-0, 0.81.**

**IL Pitcher of the Week:** Twice this season was named the International League’s **Pitcher of the Week**...in 2 starts the week of **4/20-4/26** went 2-0, 2.92 with 18 strikeouts in 12.1 innings (10h, 6bb)...in the 10-3 win at Toledo on 4/26, over 6.1 innings he struck out a career-high 15 batters to tie the Louisville single-game record...in 2 starts from **6/1-6/7** went 2-0 without allowing a run (14.2ip, 11h, 2bb, 14k).
