The Reds went **26-21**, hit **.257** and scored **4.57** runs per game before **1B Joey Votto** went on the disabled list on **5/30**...during his 21g on the disabled list the Reds went 8-13, hit .217 and scored 3.38 runs per game...in the 10g since **Votto's** return the Reds are **5-5**, hitting **.280** (99-353) and have scored **3.9** runs per game (39r).

Lou Gehrig

Today marks the 70th anniversary of **Lou Gehrig's** famous farewell speech at Yankee Stadium...during pregame ceremonies, a video of that speech will be shown on the scoreboard and the Reds will introduce representatives from the **ALS Association, ALS Therapy Development Institute, MDA's Augie's Quest** and **Project A.L.S.**...today's honorary captain is **Lynn Stewart**, a U.S. Navy veteran diagnosed with ALS in 2007.

TODAY'S GAME: Is **Game 2** (0-1) of a 3-game series vs **Jim Anderson's** Cardinals and **Game 5** (2-2) of a 6-game homestand that also included the **Diamondbacks** (2-1)...is the Reds' final homestand before the **All-Star** break...beginning Monday will finish the first half on the road at **Phi** (4g) and at **NYM** (3g), including their first visit to the Mets' new **Citi Field**.

RED, WHITE & BLUE: As part of today's Fourth of July pre-game ceremonies, **U.S. Army Lt. Colonel Matthew Carran** will swear in future soldiers...**Capt. William Heitzman**, company commander of the Cincinnati Metro Recruiting Company and a veteran of Operation Iraqi Freedeom, will throw out today's ceremonial first pitch...today's official game ball will be delivered by **Command Sgt. Major Charles G. Pulliam**...**Naval Officer Ruben Minor** will sing our *National Anthem*, followed by a flyover of F-16s from the **178th Fighter Wing & 162nd Fighter Squadron** out of **Springfield**...**Naval Officer Minor** also will sing *God Bless America* in the middle of the seventh inning.

DOT, DOT, DOT....: The Reds have won 4 of their last 6g and 5 of their last 8g...the Reds have not homered in 4g on this current homestand...**Ryan Hanigan** leads all National League rookie batters in batting average (.336) and on-base percentage (.423)...**Ramon Hernandez** needs 2 runs scored to reach **500** in his career.

INJURY PLAGUED: The Reds are **5-5** in the 10 games that included a starting lineup of **C Ramon Hernandez, 1B Joey Votto, 2B Brandon Phillips, 3B Edwin Encarnacion, SS Alex Gonzalez, RF Jay Bruce, CF Willy Taveras** and either **Chris Dickerson** or **Jerry Hairston Jr.** in LF.

M*A*S*H: From the **Opening Day** roster the Reds are missing starting **SS Alex Gonzalez** (right elbow surgery, out 4-5 weeks), starting **RHP Edinson Volquez** (right elbow) and reliever **RHP Mike Lincoln** (bulging disc in his neck)...all are on the disabled list, along with **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (season-ending left shoulder surgery) and **IF Danny Richar** (torn labrum, left shoulder)...**Volquez** is scheduled to throw off flat ground again tomorrow...**Gonzalez** is scheduled to swing a bat today...several other players missed action recently because of various ailments, including **1B Joey Votto** (stress), **2B Brandon Phillips** (hairline fracture, right thumb), **OF Willy Taveras** (tight right hamstring), **IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr.** (flu) and **3B Edwin Encarnacion** (chip fracture, left wrist).

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUT: **IF Drew Sutton, RHP Carlos Fisher** and **LHP Matt Maloney** made their Major League debut this season...in **2008**, 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts: **RHP Johnny Cueto, IF Paul Janish, OF Jay Bruce, LHP Daniel Ray Herrera, RHP Daryl Thompson, IF Adam Rosales, OF Chris Dickerson, RHP Ramon Ramirez, C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** and **RHP Josh Roenicke**.

ALL-STAR AMONG US: **Sherri J. Friedman** of **Amberley Village** is the Reds' nominee for *PEOPLE Magazine's All-Stars Among Us* campaign, which recognizes an individual from each Major League Baseball team who serves his or her community in extraordinary ways...she will be honored on the field during ceremonies prior to the July 14 **All-Star Game** in St. Louis...**Friedman** was elected in online voting for her community service through **Most Valuable Kids of Greater Cincinnati**, an organization that distributes unused tickets to underserved children...she has helped 22,000 kids experience local sporting and entertainment events, including more than 4,800 Reds games.

ALL-STAR RESOLUTION: State Senator **Gary Cates** (R-Butler County) has introduced a resolution in the Ohio Senate urging Major League Baseball to select the Reds and Great American Ball Park as hosts for the **2013 All-Star Game**...the Reds last hosted the Mid-Summer Classic in **1988** at Riverfront Stadium...in June the club already hosted one of MLB's jewel events this summer, the **Gillette Civil Rights Game**.

XM ALL-STAR FUTURES GAME: Class AA Carolina **OF Chris Heisey** (U.S. Team) and Class A Dayton **RHP Juan Carlos Sulbaran** (World Team) have been selected to participate in Major League Baseball's **XM II-Star Futures Game** on Sunday, 7/12 at **Busch Stadium** in St. Louis...**Futures Game** alumni include Reds players **Jay Bruce** (2007), **Francisco Cordero** (1999), **Edwin Encarnacion** (2003-05), **Brandon Phillips** (2002), **Edinson Volquez** (2005) and **Joey Votto** (2006-07)...**Cordero** and **Volquez** are the only 2 Reds players to appear in both the **Futures Game** and an **All-Star Game**... **Cordero** was an All-Star in 2004 and 2007, **Volquez** was an All-Star last year.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (19-19 .500): The Reds went **5-6-2** in their previous **13 home series** and produced a winning record on just 2 of their previous 6 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3, 1-2, 3-3)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **260-264-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38)...**at 217-217-1** the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since **6/26/04** (57-57)...also reached .500 at **219-219-1**.

REDS ON THE ROAD (20-20 .500): The Reds have won 2 straight road games and 3 of their last 4 road games...went **7-4-2** in their **13 road series**...produced the following records on their road trips: 7-3, 3-2, 3-3, 2-5, 2-4 and 3-3...entering this season and dating to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

IN THE STANDINGS (89): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 45, FOURTH - 30, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...at **20-14** and **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g over .500** at **36-24**...4 times were a season-high **2g under .500** (0-2, 1-3, 34-36, 35-37)...have spent **63** days above, **13** days at and **13** days below .500.

REDS vs CARDINALS: The Reds are 932-1,056 all-time vs the Cardinals, including 4-4 this season...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 26-25, including 2-2 this season...**Albert Pujols'** 15 homers here trail only **Lance Berkman's** 21...**at Busch Stadium:** Reds are 10-18, including 2-2 this season and 5-14 here the last 3 years...have lost 7 of the last 9g and 10 of the last 13g here...**at Old Busch** went 119-139...**last Reds sweep:** at Cin: 5/1-5/2, 2006 (2g); 9/11-9/13, 2007 (3g); 5/5-5/8, 2003 (4g)...at StL: 6/26-6/27, 2001 (2g); 6/5-6/7, 2006 (3g); 5/4-5/7, 1990 (4g)...**last Cardinals sweep:** at Cin: 7/5-7/6, 1982 (2g); 5/2-5/4, 2005 (3g)...at StL: 6/28-6/29, 2005 (2g); 9/26-9/28, 2008 (3g); 8/13-8/16, 2001 (4g).

Last Started: Sun at Cle and earned the 8-1 victory (6ip, 5h, 1er, 4bb, 4k, 106 pitches, 63 strikes)...left leading, 7-1...allowed only a sac fly to Martinez in the first inning.

Red Hots: Is making his 15th start of the season, his second career appearance vs the Cardinals...in his previous 14 starts the Reds went 6-8 and scored 61 runs (4.36 r/g)...has 5 quality starts...with an 8-2 win on 4/26 vs Atl snapped his **9-game losing streak** dating back to a 9-3 Diamondbacks victory on 5/25/08 at Atl...in 14 apps and 10 starts between victories went **0-9, 8.53**.

In Relief: Made his only relief appearance of the season in the 16-inning, 6-5 loss at SD on 5/16...threw a career-high 5.2 innings in relief (3h, 1er, 3bb, 5k, 1hr, 81 pitches, 44 strikes)...entered the game in the 11th inning as the Reds' seventh and final pitcher...retired his first 10 batters until Scott Hairston singled with 1 out in the 14th inning...Nick Hundley homered to end the 5-hour, 14 minute struggle...**in 8 starts since then is 2-4, 5.27 (42.2ip, 25er)**.

At The Plate: In 2007 won the National League's **Silver Slugger Award** (.333, 4hr, 15rbi)...has **7 career home runs**, including **2 this season** (5/10 vs StL, pinch-hit solo off **Ryan Franklin** & 6/17 vs Atl, 3-run off **Javier Vazquez**)...his 5 career home runs prior to 2009 are listed on **page 149** of the media guide...on 5/7 vs Mil produced the first triple by a Reds pitcher since **Eric Milton** did it on 4/13/06 at Cubs.

Owings' Most Recent Starts: **5/2 at Pit** and suffered the 8-6 loss (5.2ip, 9h, 5er, 2bb, 0k, 99 pitches, 64 strikes)...left trailing, 5-3...in the first inning allowed 4 runs on 4 hits, 1 walk and 1 hit batter...**5/7 vs Mil** and earned the 6-5 victory (6ip, 7h, 5r, 4er, 1bb, 4k, 100 pitches, 67 strikes)...left leading, 6-5...allowed 3 runs in the fourth inning and 2 runs in the sixth...his RBI-triple in the bottom of the fourth off Braden Loper gave the Reds a 4-3 lead they would not relinquish...**5/12 at Ari**, in his first career appearance vs his former team earned the 3-1 victory (7+ip, 4h, 1er, 2bb, 4k, 1hbp, 90 pitches, 53 strikes)...took a 4-hit shutout into the eighth inning but then hit with a pitch leadoff batter Ryan Roberts...was charged with that run, which scored on Felipe Lopez' RBI-double off Arthur Rhodes...**5/21 vs Phi** and suffered the 12-5 loss (3ip, 6h, 5er, 3bb, 3k, 1hr, 71 pitches, 41 strikes)...left trailing, 5-0...allowed 1 run in the first inning, 3 runs in the second and a solo HR to Dobbs in the third...**5/26 vs Hou** and received no decision in the 6-4 victory (5ip, 6h, 3er, 4bb, 3k, 99 pitches, 62 strikes)...allowed all 3 runs in the fourth inning on a 2-run double by Rodriguez and a run-scoring single by Maysonet...**5/31 at Mil** and suffered the 5-2 loss (5.2ip, 8h, 5er, 3bb, 5k, 1hr, 103 pitches, 67 strikes)...left trailing, 5-2, but retired 10 of his 11 final batters...in the first inning allowed consecutive 2-out, RBI-singles to Cameron and Gamel...in the second allowed a sac fly to Hardy...in the third allowed Cameron's 2-run HR...**6/5 vs Cubs** and suffered the 2-1 loss (6ip, 5h, 2er, 3bb, 6k, 1hr, 98 pitches, 64 strikes)...left trailing, 2-0...allowed only a bases-loaded walk to Fontenot in the first inning and a solo HR to Zambrano in the fifth...**6/11 at Wsh** and was the victim of a blown save in the 3-2 loss (5.1ip, 4h, 1er, 4bb, 4k, 2hbp, 1wp, 102 pitches, 56 strikes)...left leading, 2-0, but was charged with a run scored off Burton...the Nats took a 3-2 lead with a 2-run eighth inning off Fisher, Herrera and Masset...through 5 scoreless innings allowed 2 hits, 4 walks and 2hbp but stranded all 8 baserunners...**6/17 vs Atl** and earned the 4-3 victory (6ip, 6h, 2er, 2bb, 0k, 1hr, 108 pitches, 67 strikes)...left leading, 4-2...allowed only a 2-run HR to Escobar in the third inning...in the fifth frame hit a 3-run HR off Vazquez that gave the Reds their 4-2 lead...was his second homer of the season, the seventh of his career...**6/23 at Tor** and allowed a season-high 6 runs in the 7-5 loss (5.2ip, 9h, 6er, 2bb, 1k, 3hr, 102 pitches, 65 strikes)...left trailing, 6-0...allowed 4 runs on 3 homers (Rolen solo, Barajas solo, Scutaro 2-run).

Tomorrow's Pitcher: Bronson Arroyo

Last Pitched: Tue vs Ari and suffered the 6-2 loss (5.1ip, 10h, 6r, 5er, 4bb, 2k, 2hr, 105 pitches, 65 strikes)...left trailing, 6-0...gave up 3 runs in both the third and sixth innings...in the sixth allowed back-to-back HR to Montero (2-run) and pitcher Haren (1st career).

Red Hots: Tomorrow will make his 17th start of the season, his second of the year vs the Cardinals...with 8 victories is 2 shy of the National League leaders...in his previous 16 starts the Reds went 8-8 and scored 67 runs (4.19 r/g)...has 8 quality starts...since he was acquired by the Reds prior to the 2006 season leads all Major League pitchers with 118 starts and ranks second in the National League with 749.1 innings pitched (**Aaron Harang** 755.1ip).

In The Big Inning: Allowed at least 1 run in the first inning of 8 of his 16 starts, including 6 of his last 8 starts...has posted a 10.13era in the first inning (16ip, 18er) and a 4.83era after the first frame (82ip, 44er).

Unlucky June 24: On 6/24 each of the last 2 seasons started against the Blue Jays at Tor's Rogers Centre...in those 2 starts, a 14-1 loss on 6/24/08 and an 8-2 loss on 6/24/09, allowed 17 runs in 4.2 innings...in the 2008 loss became only the sixth starting pitcher in Major League history to allow at least 10 earned runs while retiring 3 batters or fewer...in the 2009 loss allowed 5 runs in the first inning on homers by Hill (2-run), Wells (solo) and Lind (2-run)...**in the calendar year between those 2 starts went 19-9, 4.19**...the 19 wins were the second-most in the Major Leagues in that 1-year span (Tor's **Roy Halladay**, 22-6, 2.49).
