#### Fourth of July Celebration

In yesterday's 5-2 win vs StL, **Micah Owings** became the first pitcher in more than 50 years to celebrate the **Fourth of July** with both a victory and a home run...the last 3 pitchers to do it did it in a 4-year span from **1955-58** and produced even better highlights later in those seasons...on **7/4/58**, NYY's **Bob Turley** did it in a 2-1 complete game win at Washington, then later that season went on to win 2 World Series games against the **Milwaukee Braves** and the **Cy Young Award**...on **7/4/56**, NYY's Don Larsen was the winner and homered in a 9-4 win at Fenway Park, followed 3 months later by his **perfect game** in the World Series win against the **Brooklyn Dodgers**...on **7/4/55**, Brooklyn reliever **Clem Labine** started and finished the 6-3 win at Philadelphia, then against the Yankees helped Brooklyn win its only World Series (courtesy Elias Sports Bureau).

**TODAY'S GAME:** Is **Game 3** (1-1) of a 3-game series vs **Jim Anderson's** Cardinals and **Game 6** (3-2) of a 6-game homestand that also included the **Diamondbacks** (2-1)...is the Reds' final homestand before the **All-Star** break...beginning tomorrow will finish the first half on the road at **Phi** (4g) and at **NYM** (3g), including their first visit to the Mets' new **Citi Field**.

**AARON'S ACES:** This afternoon **Aaron Harang** is hosting 30 fans in sun deck Section 143 as part of his **Aaron's Aces** program targeting local **military families**...guests receive an autographed t-shirt, in-stadium welcomes via the public address announcer and scoreboard and a \$10 concession voucher...when he is not scheduled to pitch, **Aaron** meets the guests in the bullpen...fans with family members currently on active duty or who recently returned from active duty can sign up online at [www.reds.com/community](http://www.reds.com/community), then click on ticket programs.

**DOT, DOT, DOT....:** The Reds have won 3 of their last 4g, 5 of their last 7g and 6 of their last 9g...**Ryan Hanigan** leads all National League rookie batters in batting average (.336) and on-base percentage (.423)...**Ramon Hernandez** needs 2 runs scored to reach **500** in his career.

**MINOR LEAGUE PLAYERS OF THE MONTH:** Class AA Carolina **IF Zack Cozart** and LHP Travis Wood have been named the organization's **Minor League Players of the Month**...in 27g **Cozart** hit .319 with 6 doubles, 6hr, 12rbi and 4sb...in 6 starts **Wood** went 4-0, 1.13 with 1 shutout (40ip, 24h, 6bb, 39k).

**INJURY PLAGUED:** The Reds are **5-5** in the 10 games that included a starting lineup of **C Ramon Hernandez, 1B Joey Votto, 2B Brandon Phillips, 3B Edwin Encarnacion, SS Alex Gonzalez, RF Jay Bruce, CF Willy Taveras** and either **Chris Dickerson** or **Jerry Hairston Jr.** in LF.

**M\*A\*S\*H:** From the **Opening Day** roster the Reds are missing starting **SS Alex Gonzalez** (right elbow surgery, out 4-5 weeks), starting **RHP Edinson Volquez** (right elbow) and reliever **RHP Mike Lincoln** (bulging disc in his neck)...all are on the disabled list, along with **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (season-ending left shoulder surgery) and **IF Danny Richar** (torn labrum, left shoulder)...**Volquez** was scheduled to throw off flat ground this morning...**Gonzalez** is scheduled to hit off a tee in the next few days...several other players missed action recently because of various ailments, including **1B Joey Votto** (stress), **2B Brandon Phillips** (hairline fracture, right thumb), **OF Willy Taveras** (tight right hamstring), **IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr.** (flu) and **3B Edwin Encarnacion** (chip fracture, left wrist).

**ALL-STAR AMONG US:** Sherri J. Friedman of **Amberley Village** is the Reds' nominee for *PEOPLE Magazine's* **All-Stars Among Us** campaign, which recognizes an individual from each Major League Baseball team who serves his or her community in extraordinary ways...she will be honored on the field during ceremonies prior to the July 14 **All-Star Game** in St. Louis...**Friedman** was elected in online voting for her community service through **Most Valuable Kids of Greater Cincinnati**, an organization that distributes unused tickets to underserved children...she has helped 22,000 kids experience local sporting and entertainment events, including more than 4,800 Reds games.

**ALL-STAR RESOLUTION:** State Senator **Gary Cates** (R-Butler County) has introduced a resolution in the Ohio Senate urging Major League Baseball to select the Reds and Great American Ball Park as hosts for the **2013 All-Star Game**...the Reds last hosted the Mid-Summer Classic in **1988** at Riverfront Stadium...in June the club already hosted one of MLB's jewel events this summer, the **Gillette Civil Rights Game**.

**XM ALL-STAR FUTURES GAME:** Class AA Carolina **OF Chris Heisey** (U.S. Team) and Class A Dayton **RHP Juan Carlos Sulbaran** (World Team) have been selected to participate in Major League Baseball's **XM II-Star Futures Game** on Sunday, 7/12 at **Busch Stadium** in St. Louis...**Futures Game** alumni include Reds players **Jay Bruce** (2007), **Francisco Cordero** (1999), **Edwin Encarnacion** (2003-05), **Brandon Phillips** (2002), **Edinson Volquez** (2005) and **Joey Votto** (2006-07)...**Cordero** and **Volquez** are the only 2 Reds players to appear in both the **Futures Game** and an **All-Star Game**... **Cordero** was an All-Star in 2004 and 2007, **Volquez** was an All-Star last year.

**REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (20-19 .513):** The Reds went **5-6-2** in their previous 13 home series and produced a winning record on just 2 of their previous 6 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3, 1-2, 3-3)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **261-264-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38)..

**REDS ON THE ROAD (20-20 .500):** The Reds have won 2 straight road games and 3 of their last 4 road games...went **7-4-2** in their 13 road series...produced the following records on their road trips: 7-3, 3-2, 3-3, 2-5, 2-4 and 3-3...entering this season and dating to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

**IN THE STANDINGS (90):** The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 46, FOURTH - 30, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...at **20-14** and **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g over .500** at **36-24**...4 times were a season-high **2g under .500** (0-2, 1-3, 34-36, 35-37)...have spent **64** days above, **13** days at and **13** days below .500.

**REDS vs CARDINALS:** The Reds are 933-1,056 all-time vs the Cardinals, including 5-4 this season...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 27-25, including 3-2 this season...**Albert Pujols'** 15 HR here trail only **Lance Berkman's** 21.

**UP NEXT: REDS vs PHILLIES:** Reds are 1,044-841 all-time vs the Phillies, including 1-2 in 2009 and 4-7 the last 2 seasons...**at Citizens Bank Park:** Reds are 7-10, including 1-3 in 2008 and 2-5 the last 2 seasons.

Wins Beginning 6/29

In the 14-1 loss on 6/24/08 at Tor, **Bronson Arroyo** made the shortest start of his career and became only the sixth starting pitcher in Major League history to allow at least 10 earned runs in a game in which he retired 3 batters or fewer (1+ip, 11h, 10er)...beginning with his next start, a 9-5 win at Cle on 6/29/08, **Arroyo** has 19 wins, second-most in the Major Leagues since then:

**Last Pitched:** Tue vs Ari and suffered the 6-2 loss (5.1ip, 10h, 6r, 5er, 4bb, 2k, 2hr, 105 pitches, 65 strikes)...left trailing, 6-0...gave up 3 runs in both the third and sixth innings...in the sixth allowed back-to-back HR to Montero (2-run) and pitcher Haren (1st career).

**Red Hots:** Is making his 17th start of the season, his second of the year vs the Cardinals...with 8 victories is 2 shy of National League leader **Jason Marquis**...in his previous 16 starts the Reds went 8-8 and scored 67 runs (4.19 r/g)...has 8 quality starts...since he was acquired by the Reds prior to the 2006 season leads all Major League pitchers with 119 starts and ranks second in the National League with 749.1 innings pitched (**Aaron Harang** 755.1).

**In The Big Inning:** Allowed at least 1 run in the first inning of 8 of his 16 starts, including 6 of his last 8 starts...posted a 10.13era in the first inning (16ip, 18er) and a 4.83era after the first (82ip, 44er).

**Unlucky June 24:** On 6/24 each of the last 2 seasons started against the Blue Jays at Tor's Rogers Centre...in those 2 starts, a 14-1 loss on 6/24/08 and an 8-2 loss on 6/24/09, allowed 17 runs in 4.2 innings...in the 2008 loss became only the sixth starting pitcher in Major League history to allow at least 10 earned runs while retiring 3 batters or fewer...in the 2009 loss allowed 5 runs in the first inning on homers by Hill (2-run), Wells (solo) and Lind (2-run)...**in the calendar year between those 2 starts went 19-9, 4.19**...the 19 wins were the second-most in the Major Leagues in that 1-year span (Tor's **Roy Halladay**, 22-6, 2.49).

**Perfect:** Began the season 3-0 for the third time in his career but for the first time won his first 3 starts of a season...won his first 2 starts in 2006, when he started off 5-0...began the 2005 campaign 4-0...was the first Reds pitcher to begin the season in the rotation and win his first 3 starts since **LHP Pete Schourek** did it in 1996 and the first righthander since **Jack Armstrong** won his first 5 starts of 1990.

## Tomorrow at Phillies: Johnny Cueto

**Last Pitched:** Wed vs Ari and earned the 1-0 victory by allowing just 1 hit in 6.0 scoreless innings (4bb, 8k, 108 pitches, 58 strikes)...allowed only a single by Lopez leading off the third inning, then retired his final 12 batters.

**Red Hots:** The 23-year-old righthander tomorrow at Phi will make his 17th start of the season, his second vs the Phillies and his first career appearance at Citizens Bank Park...ranks among the National League leaders with a 2.69era (4th) and a .223 opponents' BA (5th)...in his 16 starts the Reds went 10-6 and scored 67 runs (4.19 r/g)...in 9 of his 16 starts threw at least 7.0 innings and in 14 of his 16 starts threw at least 6.0 innings...leads the team with 11 quality starts.
