TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 1** of a 3-game series vs **Deanna Sabec's** Phillies and **Game 1** of a 7-game road trip that also includes an upcoming weekend series **at NYM** (3g)...will be the Reds' first trip to Flushing's **Citi Field**...are coming off a **3-3 homestand** vs the **Diamondbacks** (2-1) and **Cardinals** (1-2)...after the **All-Star** break will open the second half of the season with an abbreviated 4-game homestand vs the **Brewers** before hitting the road again for a 7-day, 6-game trip to **LAD** (3g) and **Chi** (3g).

STREAKING: The Reds have won 3 of their last 5g, 5 of their last 8g and 6 of their last 10g...**Ryan Hanigan** (13-27, .481) and **Joey Votto** (14-34, .412, 1hr, 5rbi) have career-high **8-game hitting streaks**, the longest active streaks on the team.

DOT, DOT, DOT....: **Ryan Hanigan** leads all National League rookie batters in on-base percentage (.428)...**Ramon Hernandez** needs 2 runs scored to reach **500** in his career.

MINOR LEAGUE PLAYERS OF THE MONTH: Class AA Carolina **IF Zack Cozart** and **LHP Travis Wood** have been named the organization's **Minor League Players of the Month**...in 27g **Cozart** hit .319 with 6 doubles, 6hr, 12rbi and 4sb...in 6 starts **Wood** went 4-0, 1.13 with 1 shutout (40ip, 24h, 6bb, 39k).

INJURY PLAGUED: The Reds are **5-5** in the 10 games that included the projected Opening Day lineup of **C Ramon Hernandez**, **1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips**, **3B Edwin Encarnacion**, **SS Alex Gonzalez**, **RF Jay Bruce**, **CF Willy Taveras** and either **Chris Dickerson** or **Jerry Hairston Jr.** in LF.

M*A*S*H: From the **Opening Day** roster the Reds are missing starting **SS Alex Gonzalez** (right elbow surgery, out 4-5 weeks), starting **RHP Edinson Volquez** (right elbow) and reliever **RHP Mike Lincoln** (bulging disc in his neck)...all are on the disabled list, along with **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (season-ending left shoulder surgery) and **IF Danny Richar** (torn labrum, left shoulder)...**Volquez** tomorrow in Cincinnati is scheduled to throw off flat ground...**Gonzalez** today at home was scheduled to begin hitting off a tee...several other players missed action because of various ailments, including **1B Joey Votto** (stress), **2B Brandon Phillips** (hairline fracture, right thumb), **OF Willy Taveras** (tight right hamstring), **IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr.** (flu) and **3B Edwin Encarnacion** (chip fracture, left wrist).

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUTS: **RHP Carlos Fisher**, **LHP Matt Maloney** and **IF Drew Sutton** made their Major League debuts this season...in 2008, 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts: **RHP Johnny Cueto**, **IF Paul Janish**, **OF Jay Bruce**, **LHP Daniel Ray Herrera**, **RHP Daryl Thompson**, **IF Adam Rosales**, **OF Chris Dickerson**, **RHP Ramon Ramirez**, **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** and **RHP Josh Roenicke**.

ALL-STAR AMONG US: Sherri J. Friedman of **Amberley Village** is the Reds' nominee for *PEOPLE Magazine's All-Stars Among Us* campaign, which recognizes an individual from each Major League Baseball team who serves his or her community in extraordinary ways...she will be honored on the field during ceremonies prior to the **All-Star Game** in St. Louis...**Friedman** was elected in online voting for her community service through **Most Valuable Kids of Greater Cincinnati**, an organization that distributes unused tickets to underserved children...she has helped 22,000 kids experience local sporting and entertainment events, including more than 4,800 Reds games.

ALL-STAR RESOLUTION: State Senator **Gary Cates** (R-Butler County) has introduced a resolution in the Ohio Senate urging Major League Baseball to select the Reds and Great American Ball Park as hosts for the **2013 All-Star Game**...the Reds last hosted the Mid-Summer Classic in **1988** at Riverfront Stadium...in June the club hosted one of the summer's MLB jewel events, the **Gillette Civil Rights Game**.

XM ALL-STAR FUTURES GAME: Class AA Carolina **OF Chris Heisey** (U.S. Team) and Class A Dayton **RHP Juan Carlos Sulbaran** (World Team) have been selected to participate in Major League Baseball's **XM II-Star Futures Game** on Sunday, 7/12 at **Busch Stadium** in St. Louis...**Futures Game** alumni include Reds players **Homer Bailey** (2006), **Jay Bruce** (2007), **Francisco Cordero** (1999), **Edwin Encarnacion** (2003-05), **Brandon Phillips** (2002), **Edinson Volquez** (2005) and **Joey Votto** (2006-07)...**Cordero** and **Volquez** are the only 2 Reds players to appear in both the **Futures Game** and an **All-Star Game**... **Cordero** was an All-Star in 2004 and 2007, **Volquez** was an All-Star last year.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (20-20 .500): The Reds went **5-7-2 in their 14 home series** and produced a winning record on just 2 of their 7 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3, 1-2, 3-3, 3-3)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **261-265-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38)...**at 217-217-1** the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since **6/26/04** (57-57)...also reached .500 **at 219-219-1**.

REDS ON THE ROAD (20-20 .500): The Reds have won 2 straight road games and 3 of their last 4 road games...went **7-4-2 in their previous 13 road series**...produced the following records on their road trips: 7-3, 3-2, 3-3, 2-5, 2-4 and 3-3...entering this season and dating to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

IN THE STANDINGS (91): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 46, FOURTH - 31, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...**at 20-14** and **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g over .500** at **36-24**...4 times were a season-high **2g under .500** (0-2, 1-3, 34-36, 35-37)...have spent **64** days above, **14** days at and **13** days below .500.

REDS vs PHILLIES: Reds are 1,044-841 all-time vs the Phillies, including 1-2 in 2009 and 4-7 the last 2 seasons...**at Citizens Bank Park:** Reds are 7-10, including 1-3 in 2008 and 2-5 the last 2 seasons...on 4/12/04 Cin earned a 4-1 victory in the first regular season game played there...**last Reds sweep:** at Phi: 4/5-4/7, 1996 (2g); 6/27-6/29, 1995 (3g); 7/22-7/24, 1996 (4g)...**last Phillies sweep:** at Phi: 4/9-4/10, 1963 (2g); 4/12-4/14, 1993 (3g); 5/13-5/15, 1975 (4g).

IF Paul Janish pitched in the ninth inning of the 15-3 loss vs Mil on 5/6 (1ip, 5h, 5er, 0bb, 2k, Fielder 2-run HR)...he became the first Reds position player to pitch since Lenny Harris on 6/1/98 at SF.				

Reds Pitchers: Rank sixth in the National League with a 4.00 team ERA...on the homestand went 3-3, 3.27 (55ip, 20er)...the Reds already have 7 team shutouts, the most since they had 7sho in 2007...haven't produced more than 7 shutouts in a season since 2006 (10sho)...had 6 shutouts last year...with a 7-0 win on 5/5 at Fla reached 6 shutouts in their 26th game, their fastest to 6 team shutouts since the 1914 Reds threw their sixth shutout in their 25th game.

Reds Starters: Rank eighth in the National League with 4.38 rotation ERA...on the homestand went 2-2, 3.86 (37.1ip, 16er)...have produced 39 quality starts (Cueto 11, Harang 9, Arroyo 8, Owings 6, Volquez 3, Bailey 1, Maloney 1)...the Reds went 29-10 in those quality starts (.744)...from 6/3-6/10 produced a season-high 7 consecutive quality starts, their best stretch since they threw 8 consecutive QS from 8/6-8/14, 2005...through the first 41g of the season used just 5 starting pitchers, their longest such streak to begin a year since RHP John Roper became the staff's sixth different starter in the 42nd game of the 1994 campaign...on 5/23 vs Cle, in the club's 42nd game, RHP Homer Bailey became the Reds' sixth starting pitcher...Aaron Harang threw a 3-hitter in the 2-0 win vs Pit in the club's fifth game of the season...was the earliest complete game by a Reds pitcher since Pete Harnisch beat the Cardinals, 3-0 in Busch Stadium, in the fourth contest of the 1999 campaign.

Reds Relievers: Lead the National League with a 3.25 bullpen ERA...on the homestand went 1-1, 2.04 (17.2ip, 4er)...Pujols' eighth-inning grand slam off Weathers on Fri produced the first runs allowed by Reds relievers since 6/26 at Cle (5g, 16.2ip) and the first homer allowed by the Reds bullpen since 6/20 (10g, 31.2ip)...in their last 70g have posted a 2.71era (222.1ip, 67er) and in their last 58g have posted a 2.64era (187.1ip, 55er)...the previous note does not include the pitching performance by IF Paul Janish in the ninth inning of the 15-3 loss on 5/6 vs Mil (1ip, 5er)...had 1 blown save in their first 51g and then 3 blown saves in their next 5g...didn't blow a save until the club's 36th game, a 6-5 loss in 16 innings on 5/16 at SD...for the second straight season the Reds' bullpen was the last in the Major Leagues to suffer a blown save...in 2008 didn't blow a save until the 41st game (5/14)...over the last 2 seasons Francisco Cordero has recorded 54 of the bullpen's 55 saves (34sv in 2008, 20sv in 2009)...David Weathers has the only other save over the last 2 seasons (6/10/09 at Wsh).

Is an All-Star for the third time (2004 for Tex, 2007 for Mil)...with 20 saves ranks among the National League leaders...converted 20 of his 21 save opps, including each of his last 5 save opps...in the 12-inning, 4-2 win on 6/10 at Wsh suffered his first blown save since 7/21/08 vs SD...had converted 29 consecutive save chances, including his first 15 save opps this year...including last season has recorded 54 of the bullpen's last 55 saves (34sv in 2008, 20sv in 2009, Weathers 1sv in 2009)...with 231 career saves ranks 30th on that all-time list...Ugeth Urbina is 29th with 237 saves...in the 3-0 victory on 4/22 at Chi recorded his 100th save in the National League to become only the 11th pitcher in history with at least 100 saves in each league (see box below).
