TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 1** of a 3-game series vs **Deanna Sabec's** Phillies and **Game 1** of a 7-game road trip that also includes an upcoming weekend series **at NYM** (3g)...will be the Reds' first trip to Flushing's **Citi Field**...are coming off a **3-3 homestand** vs the **Diamondbacks** (2-1) and **Cardinals** (1-2)...after the **All-Star** break will open the second half of the season with an abbreviated 4-game homestand vs the **Brewers** before hitting the road again for a 7-day, 6-game trip to **LAD** (3g) and **Chi** (3g).

STREAKING: The Reds have won 3 of their last 5g, 5 of their last 8g and 6 of their last 10g...**Ryan Hanigan** (13-27, .481) and **Joey Votto** (14-34, .412, 1hr, 5rbi) have career-high **8-game hitting streaks**, the longest active streaks on the team.

<u>DOT, DOT, DOT....</u>: Ryan Hanigan leads all National League rookie batters in on-base percentage (.428)...Ramon Hernandez needs 2 runs scored to reach **500** in his career.

MINOR LEAGUE PLAYERS OF THE MONTH: Class AA Carolina IF Zack Cozart and LHP Travis Wood have been named the organization's Minor League Players of the Month...in 27g Cozart hit .319 with 6 doubles, 6hr, 12rbi and 4sb...in 6 starts Wood went 4-0, 1.13 with 1 shutout (40ip, 24h, 6bb, 39k).

INJURY PLAGUED: The Reds are 5-5 in the 10 games that included the projected Opening Day lineup of C Ramon Hernandez, 1B Joey Votto, 2B Brandon Phillips, 3B Edwin Encarnacion, SS Alex Gonzalez, RF Jay Bruce, CF Willy Taveras and either Chris Dickerson or Jerry Hairston Jr. in LF.

<u>M*A*S*H</u>: From the Opening Day roster the Reds are missing starting SS Alex Gonzalez (right elbow surgery, out 4-5 weeks), starting RHP Edinson Volquez (right elbow) and reliever RHP Mike Lincoln (bulging disc in his neck)...all are on the disabled list, along with C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo (season-ending left shoulder surgery) and IF Danny Richar (torn labrum, left shoulder)...Volquez tomorrow in Cincinnati is scheduled to throw off flat ground...Gonzalez today at home was scheduled to begin hitting off a tee...several other players missed action because of various ailments, including 1B Joey Votto (stress), 2B Brandon Phillips (hairline fracture, right thumb), OF Willy Taveras (tight right hamstring), IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr. (flu) and 3B Edwin Encarnacion (chip fracture, left wrist).

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUTS: RHP Carlos Fisher, LHP Matt Maloney and IF Drew Sutton made their Major League debuts this season...in 2008, 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts: RHP Johnny Cueto, IF Paul Janish, OF Jay Bruce, LHP Daniel Ray Herrera, RHP Daryl Thompson, IF Adam Rosales, OF Chris Dickerson, RHP Ramon Ramirez, C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo and RHP Josh Roenicke.

ALL-STAR AMONG US: Sherri J. Friedman of Amberley Village is the Reds' nominee for *PEOPLE Magazine's* All-Stars Among Us campaign, which recognizes an individual from each Major League Baseball team who serves his or her community in extraordinary ways...she will be honored on the field during ceremonies prior to the All-Star Game in St. Louis...Friedman was elected in online voting for her community service through Most Valuable Kids of Greater Cincinnati, an organization that distributes unused tickets to underserved children...she has helped 22,000 kids experience local sporting and entertainment events, including more than 4,800 Reds games.

<u>ALL-STAR RESOLUTION</u>: State Senator **Gary Cates** (R-Butler County) has introduced a resolution in the Ohio Senate urging Major League Baseball to select the Reds and Great American Ball Park as hosts for the **2013 All-Star Game**...the Reds last hosted the Mid-Summer Classic in **1988** at Riverfront Stadium...in June the club hosted one of the summer's MLB jewel events, the **Gillette Civil Rights Game**.

XM ALL-STAR FUTURES GAME: Class AA Carolina OF Chris Heisey (U.S. Team) and Class A Dayton RHP Juan Carlos Sulbaran (World Team) have been selected to participate in Major League Baseball's XM II-Star Futures Game on Sunday, 7/12 at Busch Stadium in St. Louis...Futures Game alumni include Reds players Homer Bailey (2006), Jay Bruce (2007), Francisco Cordero (1999), Edwin Encarnacion (2003-05), Brandon Phillips (2002), Edinson Volquez (2005) and Joey Votto (2006-07)...Cordero and Volquez are the only 2 Reds players to appear in both the Futures Game and an All-Star Game... Cordero was an All-Star in 2004 and 2007, Volquez was an All-Star last year.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (20-20 .500): The Reds went 5-7-2 in their 14 home series and produced a winning record on just 2 of their 7 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3, 1-2, 3-3, 3-3)...in 7 seasons at GABP are 261-265-1...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38)...at 217-217-1 the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since 6/26/04 (57-57)...also reached .500 at 219-219-1.

<u>REDS ON THE ROAD (20-20, .500)</u>: The Reds have won 2 straight road games and 3 of their last 4 road games...went **7-4-2 in their previous 13 road series**...produced the following records on their road trips: 7-3, 3-2, 3-3, 2-5, 2-4 and 3-3...entering this season and dating to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

IN THE STANDINGS (91): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 46, FOURTH - 31, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...at 20-14 and 26-20 were a season-high 6g over .500...prior to this season hadn't been 6g over .500 since 2006, when they reached a season-high 12g over .500 at 36-24...4 times were a season-high 2g under .500 (0-2, 1-3, 34-36, 35-37)... have spent 64 days above, 14 days at and 13 days below .500.

REDS vs PHILLIES: Reds are 1,044-841 all-time vs the Phillies, including 1-2 in 2009 and 4-7 the last 2 seasons...<u>at</u>
Citizens Bank Park: Reds are 7-10, including 1-3 in 2008 and 2-5 the last 2 seasons...on 4/12/04 Cin earned a 4-1 victory in the first regular season game played there...<u>last Reds sweep</u>: at Phi: 4/5-4/7, 1996 (2g); 6/27-6/29, 1995 (3g); 7/22-7/24, 1996 (4g)...<u>last Phillies sweep</u>: at Phi: 4/9-4/10, 1963 (2g); 4/12-4/14, 1993 (3g); 5/13-5/15, 1975 (4g).

Road Warrior...Is making his 10th start on the road...for the season is 2-2, 3.43 in 7 starts at home (44.2ip, 17er) and 6-2, 2.14 in 9 starts on the road (59ip, 14er).

Streaking: In 5 starts from 4/22-5/13 went 4-0, 1.25 (36ip, 5er)...the 4-game winning streak was the longest of his career...in each of 4 starts from 4/22-5/8 threw at least 7.0 innings while allowing no more than 1 run, the longest streak of that kind by a Reds pitcher since Tim Belcher had a 4-game run from 5/27-6/13, 1992 (courtesy Elias Sports Bureau)

World Baseball Classic: Started the Dominican Republic's second game of the tournament and threw 4.2 scoreless innings to earn the 9-0 win vs Panama in the San Juan bracket (4.2ip, 3h, 1bb, 5k).

Tomorrow's Pitcher: RHP Aaron Harang

Last Started: Thu vs Ari and received no decision in the 10-inning, 3-2 victory (7ip, 4h, 2er, 3bb, 8k, 1hr, 114 pitches, 73 strikes)...left trailing, 2-1...allowed only a 2-out, run-scoring bloop single to Tracy in the second inning and a solo HR to Reynolds in the sixth...the Reds won it on Votto's bases loaded, run-scoring single.

Red Hots: Tomorrow will make his 18th start of the season, his second of the year vs the Phillies...in his previous 17 starts the Reds went 8-9 and scored 62 runs (3.65 r/g)...in his 17 starts Reds batters hit .244...on 6/4 at StL suffered the 3-1 loss in a game in which Harang and Chris Carpenter each threw a complete game

Home Cookin': Is 4-3, 2.83 (54ip, 17er) in 9 starts at Great American Ball Park and 1-5, 4.94 (51ip, 28er) in 8 starts on the road.

Streaking: From 4/28-6/4 allowed a home run in 8 consecutive apps (10hr), the longest streak by a Reds pitcher since RHP Ramon Ortiz tied the National League record by allowing a home run in 15 consecutive apps from 5/1-7/17, 2005.

Milestones: On 4/23 at Chi recorded the 1,000th strikeout of his career (**Derrek Lee**)...his 3-hitter in the club's fifth game, a 2-0 win on 4/12 vs Pit, was the quickest complete game by a Reds pitcher since Pete Harnisch threw a CG in the Reds' fourth game of 1999.

Staff Ace: Since he was acquired from the Athletics at the 2003 trading deadline is the Reds' leader in most statistical pitching categories, including starts (184), wins (68), innings pitched (1174.0) and strikeouts (989)...since the beginning of the 2006 season leads the National League with 755.1 innings pitched...in 2005 and 2007 won the BBWAA's Johnny Vander Meer Award as the club's Most Outstanding Pitcher.
