### Today's Transactions

Today the Reds are expected to recall from Class AAA Louisville **RHP Robert Manuel** (#60)...a corresponding roster move will be made prior to tonight's game..**Manuel** has spent the season with the Bats and in 32 apps there went 3-3, 2.51 with 8 saves (43ip, 33h, 15r, 12er, 9bb, 36k, 2hr)...when he pitches will become the fourth Reds player this season to make his Major League debut (**RHP Carlos Fisher**, **LHP Matt Maloney**, **IF Drew Sutton**)...for the Bats converted 8-9 save opps and stranded all 20 inherited baserunners...opponents hit .209, including .169 by LH batters (10-59) and .232 by RH batters (23-99).

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** Is **Game 2** (0-1) of a 4-game series vs **Craig Hughner's** Phillies and **Game 2** (0-1) of a 7-game road trip that also includes an upcoming weekend series **at NYM** (3g)...will be the Reds' first trip to Flushing's **Citi Field**...after the **All-Star** break will open the second half of the season with an abbreviated 4-game homestand vs the **Brewers** before hitting the road again for a 7-day, 6-game trip to **LAD** (3g) and **Chi** (3g).

**HISTORIC:** The 21-run differential in last night's 22-1 loss at Phi was the **largest margin of defeat** in the history of the Reds franchise, which began play in **1869**...twice since 1900 they previously lost by 19 runs, 25-6 vs the Brooklyn Superbas on **9/23/1901** and 23-4 at Pit on **4/27/1912**...on **7/26/1892** they lost by 20 runs in a 26-6 defeat here at Phi...last night Reds pitchers allowed 22 runs for the first time since a 22-6 loss at Chi on **8/13/1937**...allowed 12 of the runs with 2 outs...in 7.1 innings the bullpen allowed 13 runs and 12 earned runs, its highest single-game totals since a 16-3 loss on **6/1/98 at SF** (7.2ip, 13r, 12er)...following last night's game the staff's ERA jumped to 4.21 from 4.00, including an increase in the bullpen's ERA from a league-leading 3.25 to 3.58 (4th)...the Phillies tied a club record by scoring 10 first-inning runs...the Reds allowed 10 runs in the first inning for the first time since **5/6/2005**, when they allowed 10 in the first frame of a 13-6 loss vs the Dodgers...when **IF Paul Janish** pitched the eighth inning he became the first Reds position player to pitch more than once in the same season since **OF Mel Queen** pitched in 7g during the second half of the **1966 campaign**...**Queen** became a full-time pitcher the next year...**Janish** also pitched in the 15-3 loss vs Mil on 5/6...information courtesy Elias Sports Bureau, Reds TV and Stats, Inc..

**DOT, DOT, DOT....:** The Reds have lost 3 of their last 4g...**Joey Votto** has a career-high **9-game hitting streak** (15-38, .395, 1hr, 5rbi), the longest active streak on the team...**Ryan Hanigan** leads all National League rookie batters in on-base percentage (.422)...**Ramon Hernandez** needs 2 runs scored to reach **500** in his career...**Jonny Gomes** has hit hit 5 of the Reds' last 14 homers and 4 of the team's last 9 homers.

**INJURY PLAGUED:** The Reds are **5-5** in the 10 games that included the projected Opening Day lineup of **C Ramon Hernandez**, **1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips**, **3B Edwin Encarnacion**, **SS Alex Gonzalez**, **RF Jay Bruce**, **CF Willy Taveras** and either **Chris Dickerson** or **Jerry Hairston Jr.** in LF.

**M\*A\*S\*H:** From the **Opening Day** roster the Reds are missing starting **SS Alex Gonzalez** (right elbow surgery, out 4-5 weeks), starting **RHP Edinson Volquez** (right elbow) and reliever **RHP Mike Lincoln** (bulging disc in his neck)...all are on the disabled list, along with **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (season-ending left shoulder surgery) and **IF Danny Richar** (torn labrum, left shoulder)...**Volquez** today in Cincinnati was scheduled to throw 75 feet off flat ground...**Gonzalez** today at home was scheduled to hit off a tee and throw about 50 feet.

**MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUTS:** When he pitches **RHP Robert Manuel** will become the fourth Reds player this season to make his Major League debut (**RHP Carlos Fisher**, **LHP Matt Maloney**, **IF Drew Sutton**)...in **2008**, 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts: **RHP Johnny Cueto**, **IF Paul Janish**, **OF Jay Bruce**, **LHP Daniel Ray Herrera**, **RHP Daryl Thompson**, **IF Adam Rosales**, **OF Chris Dickerson**, **RHP Ramon Ramirez**, **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** and **RHP Josh Roenicke**.

**ALL-STAR AMONG US:** Sherri J. Friedman of Amberley Village is the Reds' nominee for *PEOPLE Magazine's All-Stars Among Us* campaign, which recognizes an individual from each Major League Baseball team who serves his or her community in extraordinary ways...she will be honored on the field during ceremonies prior to the **All-Star Game** in St. Louis...**Friedman** was elected in online voting for her community service through **Most Valuable Kids of Greater Cincinnati**, an organization that distributes unused tickets to underserved children...she has helped 22,000 kids experience local sporting and entertainment events, including more than 4,800 Reds games.

**ALL-STAR RESOLUTION:** State Senator **Gary Cates** (R-Butler County) has introduced a resolution in the Ohio Senate urging Major League Baseball to select the Reds and Great American Ball Park as hosts for the **2013 All-Star Game**...the Reds last hosted the Mid-Summer Classic in **1988** at Riverfront Stadium...in June the club hosted one of the summer's MLB jewel events, the **Gillette Civil Rights Game**.

**XM ALL-STAR FUTURES GAME:** Class AA Carolina **OF Chris Heisey** (U.S. Team) and Class A Dayton **RHP Juan Carlos Sulbaran** (World Team) have been selected to participate in Major League Baseball's **XM II-Star Futures Game** on Sunday, 7/12 at **Busch Stadium** in St. Louis..**Futures Game** alumni include Reds players **Homer Bailey** (2006), **Jay Bruce** (2007), **Francisco Cordero** (1999), **Edwin Encarnacion** (2003-05), **Brandon Phillips** (2002), **Edinson Volquez** (2005) and **Joey Votto** (2006-07)...**Cordero** and **Volquez** are the only 2 Reds players to appear in both the **Futures Game** and an **All-Star Game**... **Cordero** was an All-Star in 2004 and 2007, **Volquez** was an All-Star last year.

**REDS ON THE ROAD (20-21, .488):** The Reds have won 2 of their last 3 road games and 3 of their last 5 road games...went **7-4-2 in their previous 13 road series**...produced the following records on their road trips: 7-3, 3-2, 3-3, 2-5, 2-4 and 3-3...entering this season and dating to 2006, **Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

**IN THE STANDINGS (92):** The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 46, FOURTH - 32, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...at **20-14** and **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g over .500** at **36-24**...4 times were a season-high **2g under .500** (0-2, 1-3, 34-36, 35-37)...have spent **64** days above, **14** days at and **14** days below .500.

**REDS vs PHILLIES:** Reds are 1,044-842 all-time vs the Phillies, including 1-3 in 2009 and 4-8 the last 2 seasons...**at Citizens Bank Park:** Reds are 7-11, including 0-1 this season, 1-4 the last 2 seasons and 2-6 the last 3 seasons.

**Last Started:** Thu vs Ari and received no decision in the 10-inning, 3-2 victory (7ip, 4h, 2er, 3bb, 8k, 1hr, 114 pitches, 73 strikes)...left trailing, 2-1...allowed only a 2-out, run-scoring bloop single to Tracy in the second inning and a solo HR to Reynolds in the sixth...the Reds won it on Votto's bases loaded, run-scoring single.

**Red Hots:** Is making his 18th start of the season, his second of the year vs the Phillies...in his previous 17 starts the Reds went 8-9 and scored 62 runs (3.65 r/g)...in his 17 starts **Reds batters** hit .244 (140-573)...on 6/4 at StL suffered the 3-1 loss in a game in which **Harang** and **Chris Carpenter** each threw a complete game.

**Home Cookin':** Is **4-3, 2.83** (54ip, 17er) in 9 starts at Great American Ball Park and **1-5, 4.94** (51ip, 28er) in 8 starts on the road.

**Streaking:** From **4/28-6/4** allowed a home run in 8 consecutive apps (10hr), the longest streak by a Reds pitcher since **RHP Ramon Ortiz** tied the National League record by allowing a home run in **15** consecutive apps from **5/1-7/17, 2005**.

**Milestones:** On 4/23 at Chi recorded the **1,000th strikeout** of his career (**Derrek Lee**)...his 3-hitter in the club's fifth game, a 2-0 win on 4/12 vs Pit, was the quickest complete game by a Reds pitcher since **Pete Harnisch** threw a CG in the Reds' fourth game of **1999**.

**Staff Ace:** Since he was acquired from the Athletics at the **2003 trading deadline** is the Reds' leader in most statistical pitching categories, including starts (184), wins (68), innings pitched (1174.0) and strikeouts (989)...since the beginning of the **2006 season** leads the National League with **755.1** innings pitched...in 2005 and 2007 won the BBWAA's Johnny Vander Meer Award as the club's Most Outstanding Pitcher.

**Opening Day:** In the 2-1 loss vs the Mets made his fourth straight Opening Day start, the first Reds pitcher to do so since **RHP Jose Rijo** had the honors in 4 straight seasons from 1992-95...the only other Reds pitchers to make at least 4 consecutive Opening Day starts are **Pete Donohue** (5 straight, 1923-27) and **Mario Soto** (5, 1982-86)...**Soto** holds the club record for overall Opening Day starts (6)...in 4 career Opening Day starts **Harang** is 1-3, 3.52 (23ip, 9er).

**Community Affairs:** Is one of the club's more active members of the local community...for the third straight season, as part of his **Aaron's Aces** ticket program is hosting at all Sunday home games children of military personnel serving in the **War On Terrorism**...along with wife **Jen** donated \$55,000 to the **Miracle League of Greater Cincinnati** and **Northern Kentucky** and on 5/9 attended the dedication of that field at the **Durham Recreation Complex** in Western Hills...for his community service has been the club's nominee for the **Robert Clemente Award** (2007), **Branch Rickey Award** (2007) and **Marvin Miller Man of the Year Award** (2007, 2008).

**Career Highs:** **Innings:** 10.0 (longest), 7/23/07 vs Mil & 1.0 (shortest, 2x), 9/5/03 at StL & 7/28/07 vs Chi; **Hits:** 14, 9/28/05 at Mil; **Runs:** 9, 4/3/06 vs Chi; **Earned runs:** 8 (3x), last on 5/30/09 at Mil; **Walks:** 7, 7/8/08 for Cin at Chi; **Strikeouts:** 13, 9/29/07 vs Chi; **HR allowed:** 4 (3x), last on 8/19/07 at Mil (Braun solo, Hall 2-run, Fielder 2-run, Hardy solo); **Complete Games:** 13, last on 6/4/09 for Cin at StL (3-1 loss); **Shutouts:** 6, last on 4/12/09 for Cin vs Pit (2-0 win).

## Tomorrow's Pitcher: RHP Homer Bailey

**Last Pitched:** Fri vs StL and was the victim of a blown save in the 7-4 loss (7.1ip, 3h, 2er, 2bb, 5k, 1hbp, 104 pitches, 70 strikes)...left leading, 3-0, but was charged with 2 of the runs that scored on Pujols' grand slam off Weathers...Pujols drove in 5 of the Cardinals' 7 runs, including a grand slam in the eighth inning off Weathers that gave StL a 4-3 lead.

**Red Hots:** Tomorrow will make his fourth start of the season, his third since his second promotion and his third career start vs the Phillies...in 2 starts since he rejoined the staff on 6/27 is 1-0, 3.65...in his 3 starts overall the Reds went 1-2 and scored 17 runs (5.67 r/g)...once was the victim of a blown save...has walked 15 batters, 7 scored.

**2009 Season:** Began the year at Class AAA Louisville, where he went 3-5, 4.57 with 2 complete games and a shutout in 8 starts before he was promoted on 5/22...started the 7-6 loss vs Cle on 5/23, then was optioned back to Louisville the next day...made 6 more starts for the Bats (5-0, 0.81) before he was recalled again to start on 6/27 at Cle...in that 5/23 start vs the Indians became only the sixth different pitcher to start a game for the Reds this season, in the club's 42nd game...was the longest such streak to begin a season since **RHP John Roper** became the staff's **sixth** different starter in the **42nd game** of the **1994** campaign.

**At Louisville:** In 14 apps for the Bats produced 11 quality starts, including quality starts in each of his last 7 apps (5-1, 1.07, 50.1ip, 47h, 6er, 12bb, 45k)...in his first start of the season allowed a season-high 8 earned runs in 5.1 innings (13.50era) and in his last 13 starts posted a 2.03era (84.1ip, 19er)...following his most recent start for the Bats ranked among the International League leaders in innings pitched (89.2, 1st), wins (8, 2nd), strikeouts (82, 2nd) and ERA (2.71, 10th)...**for the Bats, in 6 starts between his 5/22 and 6/27 promotions went 5-0, 0.81**.

**IL Pitcher of the Week:** Twice this season was named the International League's **Pitcher of the Week**...in 2 starts the week of **4/20-4/26** went 2-0, 2.92 with 18 strikeouts in 12.1 innings (10h, 6bb)...in the 10-3 win at Toledo on 4/26, over 6.1 innings he struck out a career-high 15 batters to tie the Louisville single-game record...in 2 starts from **6/1-6/7** went 2-0 without allowing a run (14.2ip, 11h, 2bb, 14k).
