TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 4** (1-2) of a 4-game series vs **Sarge's** Phillies and **Game 4** (1-2) of a 7-game road trip that also includes this weekend's series **at NYM** (3g)...will be the Reds' first trip to Flushing's **Citi Field...**after the **All-Star** break will open the second half of the season with an abbreviated 4-game homestand vs the **Brewers** before hitting the road again for a 7-day, 6-game trip to **LAD** (3g) and **Chi** (off day, 3g).

<u>DOT. DOT. DOT....</u>: Newest Red RHP Robert Manuel today is celebrating his 26th birthday...Joey Votto has a career-high 11-game hitting streak (17-46, .370, 1hr, 5rbi), the longest active streak on the team...Ryan Hanigan leads all National League rookie batters in on-base percentage (.422)...Ramon Hernandez needs 2 runs scored to reach 500 in his career...Jonny Gomes has hit hit 5 of the Reds' last 16 homers and 4 of the team's last 11 homers.

INJURY PLAGUED: The Reds are 5-5 in the 10 games that included the projected Opening Day lineup of C Ramon Hernandez, 1B Joey Votto, 2B Brandon Phillips, 3B Edwin Encarnacion, SS Alex Gonzalez, RF Jay Bruce, CF Willy Taveras and either Chris Dickerson or Jerry Hairston Jr. in LF.

<u>M*A*S*H</u>: From the Opening Day roster the Reds are missing starting SS Alex Gonzalez (right elbow surgery, out 4-5 weeks), starting RHP Edinson Volquez (right elbow) and reliever RHP Mike Lincoln (bulging disc in his neck)...all are on the disabled list, along with C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo (season-ending left shoulder surgery) and IF Danny Richar (torn labrum, left shoulder)...Volquez today in Cincinnati was scheduled to throw 75 feet off flat ground...Gonzalez took today off in Cincinnati and tomorrow will resume hitting off a tee and throwing...several other players missed action because of various ailments, including 1B Joey Votto (stress), 2B Brandon Phillips (hairline fracture, right thumb), OF Willy Taveras (tight right hamstring), IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr. (flu) and 3B Edwin Encarnacion (chip fracture, left wrist).

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUTS: When he pitches RHP Robert Manuel will become the fourth Reds player this season to make his Major League debut (RHP Carlos Fisher, LHP Matt Maloney, IF Drew Sutton)...in 2008, 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts: RHP Johnny Cueto, IF Paul Janish, OF Jay Bruce, LHP Daniel Ray Herrera, RHP Daryl Thompson, IF Adam Rosales, OF Chris Dickerson, RHP Ramon Ramirez, C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo and RHP Josh Roenicke.

ALL-STAR AMONG US: Sherri J. Friedman of Amberley Village is the Reds' nominee for *PEOPLE Magazine's* All-Stars Among Us campaign, which recognizes an individual from each Major League Baseball team who serves his or her community in extraordinary ways...she will be honored on the field during ceremonies prior to the All-Star Game in St. Louis...Friedman was elected in online voting for her community service through Most Valuable Kids of Greater Cincinnati, an organization that distributes unused tickets to underserved children...she has helped 22,000 kids experience local sporting and entertainment events, including more than 4,800 Reds games.

<u>ALL-STAR RESOLUTION</u>: State Senator **Gary Cates** (R-Butler County) has introduced a resolution in the Ohio Senate urging Major League Baseball to select the Reds and Great American Ball Park as hosts for the **2013 All-Star Game**...the Reds last hosted the Mid-Summer Classic in **1988** at Riverfront Stadium...in June the club hosted one of the summer's MLB jewel events, the **Gillette Civil Rights Game**.

XM ALL-STAR FUTURES GAME: Class AA Carolina OF Chris Heisey (U.S. Team) and Class A Dayton RHP Juan Carlos Sulbaran (World Team) have been selected to participate in Major League Baseball's XM II-Star Futures Game on Sunday, 7/12 at Busch Stadium in St. Louis...Futures Game alumni include Reds players Homer Bailey (2006), Jay Bruce (2007), Francisco Cordero (1999), Edwin Encarnacion (2003-05), Brandon Phillips (2002), Edinson Volquez (2005) and Joey Votto (2006-07)...Cordero and Volquez are the only 2 Reds players to appear in both the Futures Game and the All-Star Game... Cordero was an All-Star in 2004 and 2007, Volquez was an All-Star last year.

MINOR LEAGUE PLAYERS OF THE MONTH: Class AA Carolina IF Zack Cozart and LHP Travis Wood have been named the organization's Minor League Players of the Month...in 27g Cozart hit .319 with 6 doubles, 6hr, 12rbi and 4sb...in 6 starts Wood went 4-0, 1.13 with 1 shutout (40ip, 24h, 6bb, 39k).

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (20-20 .500): The Reds went 5-7-2 in their 14 home series and produced a winning record on just 2 of their 7 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3, 1-2, 3-3, 3-3)...in 7 seasons at GABP are 261-265-1...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38)...at 217-217-1 the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since 6/26/04 (57-57)...also reached .500 at 219-219-1.

REDS ON THE ROAD (21-22, .488): The Reds are 1-2 on this road trip...have won 3 of their last 5 road games and 4 of their last 7 road games...went 7-4-2 in their previous 13 completed road series...produced the following records on their previous road trips: 7-3, 3-2, 3-3, 2-5, 2-4 and 3-3...entering this season and dating to 2006, the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips.

IN THE STANDINGS (94): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 46, FOURTH - 34, FIFTH - 3, SIXTH - 1...at 20-14 and 26-20 were a season-high 6g over .500...prior to this season hadn't been 6g over .500 since 2006, when they reached a season-high 12g over .500 at 36-24...4 times were a season-high 2g under .500 (0-2, 1-3, 34-36, 35-37)... have spent 64 days above, 15 days at and 15 days below .500.

REDS vs PHILLIES: Reds are 1,045-843 all-time vs the Phillies, including 2-4 in 2009 and 5-9 the last 2 seasons... **at Great American Ball Park**: Reds are 10-15, including 1-2 this season... **at Citizens Bank Park**: Reds are 8-12, including 1-2 this season, 2-5 the last 2 seasons and 3-7 the last 3 seasons...on 4/12/04 Cin earned a 4-1 victory in the first regular season game played here.

Last Started: Sat vs StL and earned the 5-2 victory (6.2ip, 6h, 2er, 2bb, 6k, 1hr, 97 pitches, 64 strikes)...left leading, 5-2...allowed a solo HR to Rasmus in the first inning and another run in the sixth when Pujols scored on a fly ball/fielder's choice...in the bottom of the second inning hit his third HR of the season, a solo shot off Thompson that gave the Reds a 2-1 lead they would not relinquish...became the first pitcher to produce both a victory and a homer on the Fourth of July since NYY's Bob Turley did it in a 2-1 complete game win at Washington on 7/4/58.

Red Hots: Is making his 16th start of the season, his second vs the Phillies...in 5 of his last 6 starts threw at least 5.1 innings and allowed 2 runs or fewer...in his previous 15 starts the Reds went 7-8 and scored 66 runs (4.40 r/g)...has 6 quality starts...with an 8-2 win on 4/26 vs Atl snapped his 9-game losing streak dating back to a 9-3 Diamondbacks victory on 5/25/08 at Atl...in 14 apps and 10 starts between victories went 0-9. 8.53.

In Relief: Made his only relief appearance of the season in the 16-inning, 6-5 loss at SD on 5/16...threw a career-high 5.2 innings in relief (3h, 1er, 3bb, 5k, 1hr, 81 pitches, 44 strikes)...entered the game in the 11th inning as the Reds' seventh and final pitcher...retired his first 10 batters until Scott Hairston singled with 1 out in the 14th inning...Nick Hundley homered to end the 5-hour, 14 minute struggle...in 9 starts since then is 3-4, 4.93 (49.1ip. 27er).

At The Plate: In 2007 won the National League's Silver Slugger Award (.333, 4hr, 15rbi)...has 8 career home runs, including 3 this season (5/10 vs StL, pinch-hit solo off Ryan Franklin; 6/17 vs Atl, 3-run off Javier Vazquez; 7/4 vs StL, solo off Brad Thompson)...his 5 career home runs prior to 2009 are listed on page 149 of the media guide...on 5/7 vs Mil produced the first triple by a Reds pitcher since Eric Milton did it on 4/13/06 at Cubs.

Tomorrow at Mets: Bronson Arroyo

Last Pitched: Sun vs StL and suffered the 10-1 loss (5+ip, 11h, 8r, 5er, 2bb, 2k, 1hr, 89 pitches, 58 strikes)...left trailing, 8-0....allowed 2 runs in the first inning, 2 in the fourth and 4 in the fifth.

Red Hots: Tomorrow at NYM will make his 18th start of the season, his second of the year vs the Mets...in his previous 17 starts the Reds went 8-9 and scored 68 runs (4 r/g)...has 8 quality starts but none in his last 3 apps...hasn't gone more than 3 apps without producing a quality start since he began the 2008 season with 5 straight non-quality starts...since he was acquired by the Reds prior to the 2006 season leads all Major League pitchers with 120 starts and ranks third in the National League with 754.1 innings pitched (Aaron Harang 761.1ip, Roy Oswalt 754.2ip).

In The Big Inning: Allowed at least 1 run in the first inning of 9 of his 17 starts, including 7 of his last 9 starts...has posted a 10.59era in the first inning (17ip, 20er) and a 4.92era after the first frame (86ip, 47er).

Unlucky June 24: On 6/24 each of the last 2 seasons started against the Blue Jays at Tor's Rogers Centre...in those 2 starts, a 14-1 loss on 6/24/08 and an 8-2 loss on 6/24/09, allowed 17 runs in 4.2 innings...in the 2008 loss became only the sixth starting pitcher in Major League history to allow at least 10 earned runs while retiring 3 batters or fewer...in the **2009 loss** allowed 5 runs in the first inning on homers by Hill (2-run), Wells (solo) and Lind (2-run)...in the calendar year between those 2 starts went 19-9, 4.19...the 19 wins were the second-most in the Major Leagues in that 1-year span (Tor's Roy Halladay, 22-6, 2.49).
