The first known Ladies Day in the Major Leagues happened in Cincinnati on June 6, 1882. The Reds hosted a team from Baltimore for an afternoon game before an estimated crowd at 1,600. Women were admitted free, with a gentleman escort. The Reds won 1-0, thanks in part to a triple play in the first inning. The club continued the practice of Tuesday "Ladies Days" for the rest of the 1882 season.
