Surgery For Volquez

**RHP Edinson Volquez** is scheduled to have right elbow surgery Monday...on the disabled list since 6/2, **Volquez** yesterday complained of elbow stiffness and soreness after throwing 20 pitches of a scheduled 80-pitch simulated game...a prognosis for recovery will be determined after Monday's surgery.

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** Is **Game 2** (0-1) of a 3-game series vs **Jay Alves'** Rockies and **Game 6** (1-4) of a **10-game homestand**, the Reds' longest of the season (1-3 vs SD, **0-1 vs Col**, 3g vs Chi)...including tonight's game the Reds will finish the season with 32g at **Great American Ball Park** and 28g on the road...following this homestand the Reds embark on a 6-game road trip to **SF** (3g) and **StL** (3g).

**DOT, DOT, DOT:** The Reds are **12 games under .500** and **10.0g out of first place**, both season highs...are **3-12** since the All-Star break...at 40-0 the Reds club is the National League's only undefeated team when leading after 8 innings.... **RHP Justin Lehr** will celebrate his 32nd birthday on Monday.

**FIRST WATCH:** The Reds have allowed **92 first inning runs**, the most in the Major Leagues (SD 2nd, 72), and have been outscored in the opening frame, **92-55**.

**TRANSACTIONS:** Yesterday, the Reds acquired from the Blue Jays **3B Scott Rolen** and cash in exchange for **3B Edwin Encarnacion**, **RHP Josh Roenicke** and minor league **RHP Zach Stewart**; acquired from the Yankees minor league **C Chase Weems** for **IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr.**; selected from Louisville the contracts of **RHP Justin Lehr** and **RHP Kip Wells**...Wednesday, the Reds acquired from the Mariners **OF Wladimir Balentien** in exchange for **RHP Robert Manuel**.

**MEDICAL UPDATES:** **RHP Edinson Volquez**, on the 15-day disabled list since 6/2 with **right elbow tendinitis**, yesterday cut short a scheduled 80-pitch simulated game...his status will be updated...**RHP Jared Burton** (DL, right shoulder fatigue) and **RHP Micah Owings** (DL, tight right shoulder) are scheduled to throw bullpens...**OF Chris Dickerson** (DL, bruised right rotator cuff) today is scheduled to take regular batting practice today...**OF Willy Taveras** missed the last 2g with a sore left wrist...he will be examined again today.

**BATTING LEADER:** **Joey Votto** is hitting .340 but missed 21g while on the disabled list and thus remains 26 plate apps shy of qualifying for the National League leaders...even with an 0-for-26, **Votto** would be hitting .309 to rank among the league leaders.

**M\*A\*S\*H:** The Reds currently have **9 players on the disabled list**, including 7 players from their **Opening Day Roster**: **C Ramon Hernandez** (left knee surgery), **RF Jay Bruce** (broken right wrist), **OF Chris Dickerson** (bruised right rotator cuff), **RHP Edinson Volquez** (right elbow), **RHP Micah Owings** (tight right shoulder), **RHP Mike Lincoln** (cervical disc replacement surgery) and **RHP Jared Burton** (right shoulder fatigue)...also on the DL are **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (season-ending left shoulder surgery) and **IF Danny Richar** (season-ending left shoulder surgery)...each member of the **Opening Day** starting infield missed extended time because of various ailments, including **SS Alex Gonzalez** (disabled following right elbow surgery), **1B Joey Votto** (disabled with stress/anxiety), **2B Brandon Phillips** (hairline fracture, right thumb) and **3B Edwin Encarnacion** (disabled with a chip fracture in his left wrist).

**OPENING DAY LINEUP:** Because of injuries and trades, the Reds will finish the season with just **10g** (5-5) that included the projected **2009 Opening Day** lineup of **C Ramon Hernandez**, **1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips**, **3B Edwin Encarnacion**, **SS Alex Gonzalez**, **RF Jay Bruce**, **CF Willy Taveras** and either **Chris Dickerson** or **Jerry Hairston Jr.** in LF...Reds manager **Dusty Baker** has produced **82 different lineups** in 102g.

**SURGERIES:** Five Reds players have had surgical procedures so far this season, including **C Ramon Hernandez** (cleaned out left knee), **SS Alex Gonzalez** (removed loose bodies, right elbow), **RHP Mike Lincoln** (cervical disc replacement), **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder) and **IF Danny Richar** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder).

**JET LAG:** The Reds' next road trip (3g at SF, 3g at StL) will include the third of their 3 scheduled visits to the **West Coast**...are **0-6** on the **West Coast** so far this season (0-3 at SD, 0-3 at LAD)...over the last 4 seasons the Redlegs are **11-31 (.262) on the West Coast** (0-12 at LAD, 4-9 at SD, 5-6 at SF, 1-2 at Oak, 1-2 at Sea)...this stretch includes an active **12-game losing streak** at **Dodger Stadium**, where the Reds haven't won since their final appearance of **2005** (a 6-1 victory by **Brandon Claussen** on 7/28/05)...were swept in all four 3-game series there since then.

**REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (23-25 .479):** The Reds have lost their last 4 home games, their longest skid of the season at GABP...went **5-8-3 in their previous 16 home series**...produced a winning record on just 2 of their previous 8 homestands (2-3, 2-4, **3-2, 6-3**, 1-2, 3-3, 3-3, 2-2)...have lost their last 4 home games, a season high...in 7 seasons at GABP are **264-271-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38).

**REDS ON THE ROAD (22-31, .407):** The Reds went 0-6 on their most recent road trip (0-3 at LAD, 0-3 at Chi)...have lost their last 8 road games, a season high, and 10 of their last 11 road games...went **7-8-2 in their 17 road series**...produced a winning or .500 record on 4 of their 8 road trips (**7-3, 3-2, 3-3**, 2-5, 2-4, **3-3**, 2-5, 0-6)...entering this season and dating to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

**IN THE STANDINGS (117):** The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: **FIRST** - 1, **SECOND** - 9, **THIRD** - 46, **FOURTH** - 35, **FIFTH** - 25, **SIXTH** - 1...at **20-14** and **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g over .500** at **36-24**...at **45-57** are **12g under .500** and **10.0g out of first place**, both season highs...have spent **64** days above, **15** days at and **38** days below .500.

**REDS vs ROCKIES:** The Reds are 71-65 all-time vs the Rockies, including 0-1 this season and 1-5 in 2008...since 6/2/07 oave lost 8 of their last 9g vs Col...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 12-8, including 0-1 this season and 0-3 in 2008...Col's sweep from 7/25-7/27 of last year was its first in Cin since June 2001...in that 3-game sweep, Rockies batters hit .375 (45-120)...**last Rockies sweep:** at Cin: 7/25-7/27, 2008 (3g)...at Col: 7/23, 1998 (2g, day/night DH); 6/3-6/5, 2005 (3g).

IF Paul Janish pitched in the ninth inning of the 15-3 loss vs Mil on 5/6 (1ip, 5h, 5er, 0bb, 2k, Fielder 2-run HR) and in the eighth inning of the historic 22-1 loss on 7/6 at Phi (1ip, 4h, 6er, 2bb, 1k, Werth grand slam)...he became the first Reds position player to pitch since Lenny Harris on 6/1/98 at SF and the first Reds position player to pitch more than once in a season since OF Mel Queen took the mound 7 times during the second half of the 1966 campaign.				

**Reds Pitchers:** Rank 13th in the National League with a 4.46 staff ERA...**on the homestand are 1-4, 5.20 (45ip, 26er, 9hr)**...in the 22-1 loss on 7/6 at Phi allowed 22 runs in a game for the first time since a 22-6 loss at Chi on **8/13/37**...the Reds already have 9 team shutouts, their highest total since they had 10sho in 2006...had 6 shutouts all of last year.

**Reds Starters:** Rank 14th in the National League with a 4.92 rotation ERA...**on the homestand are 1-3, 6.46 (30.2ip, 22er, 6hr)**...have produced 47 quality starts (**Cueto 12, Harang 11, Arroyo 11, Owings 6, Volquez 3, Bailey 3, Maloney 1**)...the Reds went 34-13 in those quality starts (.723)...from **6/3-6/10** produced a season-high **7 consecutive quality starts**, their best stretch since they threw 8 consecutive QS from **8/6-8/14, 2005**...through the first 41g of the season used just 5 starting pitchers, their longest such streak to begin a year since **RHP John Roper** became the staff's **sixth** different starter in the **42nd game** of the **1994 campaign**...on 5/23 vs Cle, in the club's 42nd game, **RHP Homer Bailey** became the Reds' sixth starting pitcher...**Aaron Harang** threw a 3-hitter in the 2-0 win vs Pit in the club's fifth game of the season...was the earliest complete game by a Reds pitcher since **Pete Harnisch** beat the Cardinals, 3-0 in Busch Stadium, in the **fourth** contest of the **1999** campaign.

**Start Me Up:** In the last 23g, Reds starting pitchers are **3-16, 7.17** (123ip, 98er)...**Bronson Arroyo** earned 2 of the 3 wins by throwing a complete game in the 3-0 victory at NYM on 7/10 and 7.0 shutout innings in the 4-0 win on 7/17 vs Mil...**Homer Bailey** was the winner in Mon's game vs SD (7.1ip, 3r)...in the 20 other apps during this stretch Reds starters went **0-16, 8.58** (99.2ip, 95er)...in the last 13g overall are 1-10, 7.03 (71.2ip, 56er).

**Reds Relievers:** Rank fourth in the National League with a 3.58 bullpen ERA (LAD 3.33, SF 3.38, NYM 3.55)...**on the homestand are 0-1, 2.51 (14.1ip, 4er, 3hr)**...in 7.1 innings during the 22-1 loss on 7/6 at Phi allowed 13r/12er, the bullpen's highest single-game totals since identical totals in a 16-3 loss on **6/1/98 at SF**...bullpen's ERA excluding that game drops from 3.65 to 3.32 (309ip, 114er)...didn't blow a save until the club's 36th game, a 6-5 loss in 16 innings on 5/16 at SD...for the second straight season the Reds' bullpen was the last in the Major Leagues to suffer a blown save...in 2008 didn't blow a save until the 41st game (5/14)...over the last 2 seasons **Francisco Cordero** has recorded **57** of the bullpen's **58** saves (34sv in 2008, 23sv in 2009)...**David Weathers** has the only other save over the last 2 seasons (6/10/09 at Wsh).

**48 FRANCISCO CORDERO, rhp** **41g, 1-2-23, 1.79**  
Was an All-Star for the third time (2004 for Tex, 2007 for Mil)...in his last 11 apps has allowed just 1 run on 3 hits (10.1ip, 1hr)...with 23 saves ranks among the National League leaders...converted 23 of his 24 save opps, including each of his last 8 save opps...in the 12-inning, 4-2 win on 6/10 at Wsh returned to the mound after a rain delay and suffered his only blown save since 7/21/08 vs SD...had converted 29 consecutive save chances, including his first 15 save opps this year...including last season has recorded 57 of the bullpen's last 58 saves (34sv in 2008, 23sv in 2009, Weathers 1sv in 2009)...with 234 career saves ranks 30th on that all-time list...Ugeth Urbina is 29th with 237 saves...in the 3-0 victory on 4/22 at Chi recorded his 100th save in the National League to become only the 11th pitcher in history with at least 100 saves in each league (see box).

In his last 11 apps has posted a 1.59era (17ip, 3er)...8 times has thrown 2.0 innings, including 6 times in his last 8 apps, and 11 times has thrown more than 1.0 inning...in the 11-inning, 4-3 win on 5/24 vs Cle picked up the victory his Major League debut...in his outing on 6/7 vs the Cubs faced 4 batters but recorded 5 outs (K/CS, K, K, K)...on 5/21 was promoted from Class AAA Louisville (13g, 2-0-2, 2.00, 18ip, 11h, 4er, 4bb, 21k, 0hr, .175 opponents' BA).

**25 DAVID WEATHERS, rhp** **41g, 2-3-1, 3.47**  
In the 12-inning, 4-2 win on 6/10 at Wsh recorded his only save since 2007, when he led the staff with 33 saves...has 937 career apps, 18th on the all-time list...Rollie Fingers is 17th with with 944 apps...over the last 10 seasons (2000-09) leads all Major League pitchers with 686 apps (3.33era, 744.1ip, 275er)...on 4/14 at Mil became the 20th pitcher in Major League history to appear in 900 games...on 5/8 vs StL pitched in the 907th game of his career, moving him past the immortal Cy Young and into 19th place alone on the all-time list.
