**TONIGHT'S GAME**: Is **Game 2** (0-1) of a 3-game series vs **Richard Dierkes'** Cardinals and **Game 5** (2-2) of a 6-game road trip that also included a weekend visit to SF (2-1)...following this series the Reds return to Great American Ball Park for a 7-game homestand vs the **Nationals** (4g) and **Giants** (3g)...including tonight's game will finish the 2009 campaign with 27g at **Great American Ball Park** and 24g on the road.

**DOT. DOT. DOT:** The Reds enter today's games a season-high **13.5g out of first place...**since the All-Star break are **6-18** and have **lost 8.5g** in the NL Central standings...at **42-0** the Reds club is the National League's only undefeated team when leading after 8 innings.

<u>MEDICAL UPDATES</u>: RHP Micah Owings (DL, tight right shoulder) last night at Lehigh Valley made a rehab start for Louisville and allowed 1 run on 5 hits in 4.2 innings (2bb, 2k, 1hr, 79 pitches, 52 strikes)...RHP Johnny Cueto left last night's start after 2.0 innings with a tight left hip flexor...he will be examined again this afternoon...3B Scott Rolen will undergo an ImPACT test once his headache subsides.

FIRST WATCH: The Reds have allowed **97 first inning runs**, the most in the Major Leagues, and have been outscored in the opening frame, **97-58...**have allowed first-inning runs in 49 of their 111g this season.

**BATTING LEADER**: **Joey Votto** is hitting .316 but missed 21g while on the disabled list and thus remains 16 plate apps shy of qualifying for the National League leaders...even with an 0-for-16, **Votto** would be hitting .299. **HAL McCoy**: Reds beat writer **Hal McCoy** of the *Dayton Daily News* will retire following this season...he has worked

for the *DDN* for 49 years and is enshrined in the writers' wing of the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown... the longest-tenured baseball beat writer in the country, the 2009 campaign is **McCoy's** 37th covering the Redlegs.

M\*A\*S\*H: The Reds currently have 8 players on the disabled list, including 6 players from their **Opening Day** roster:

C Ramon Hernandez (left knee surgery), RF Jay Bruce (broken right wrist), OF Chris Dickerson (bruised right rotator cuff), RHP Edinson Volquez (right elbow surgery), RHP Micah Owings (tight right shoulder) and RHP Mike Lincoln (cervical disc replacement surgery)...also on the DL are C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo (season-ending left shoulder surgery) and IF Danny Richar (season-ending left shoulder surgery)...each member of the Opening Day starting infield missed extended time because of various ailments, including SS Alex Gonzalez (disabled following right elbow surgery), 1B Joey Votto (disabled with stress/anxiety), 2B Brandon Phillips (hairline fracture, right thumb) and since-traded 3B Edwin Encarnacion (disabled with a chip fracture in his left wrist).

<u>OPENING DAY LINEUP</u>: Because of injuries and trades, the Reds will finish the season with just **10g** (5-5) that included the projected **2009 Opening Day** lineup of **C Ramon Hernandez**, **1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips**, **3B Edwin Encarnacion**, **SS Alex Gonzalez**, **RF Jay Bruce**, **CF Willy Taveras** and either **Chris Dickerson** or **Jerry Hairston Jr.** in LF...Reds manager **Dusty Baker** has produced **91 different lineups** in 111g.

<u>SURGERIES</u>: Six Reds players have had surgical procedures this season, including **C Ramon Hernandez** (cleaned out left knee), **SS Alex Gonzalez** (removed loose bodies, right elbow), **RHP Mike Lincoln** (cervical disc replacement), **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder), **IF Danny Richar** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder) and **RHP Edinson Volquez** (repaired torn ulnar collateral ligament and torn flexor mass, right elbow)...**Castillo**, **Richar** and **Volquez** will not play again the rest of the season.

REDS HALL OF FAME: Through September 2, Reds fans can vote for the Reds Hall of Fame Class of 2010 online at <a href="reds.com/HOF">reds.com/HOF</a> or via paper ballot that can be found at the Hall of Fame and Museum, the Reds Community Corner at Section 120 in Great American Ball Park or at participating Skyline Chili and Montgomery Inn locations... the candiates include Bret Boone, Jeff Brantley, Norm Charlton, John Franco, Danny Graves, Kevin Mitchell, Hal Morris, Paul O'Neill, Chris Sabo and Scott Sullivan.

**EMMY AWARD**: For the second consecutive year, Reds TV rightsholder **FOX Sports Ohio** has won an **Emmy Award** for its *Reds Live* pre-game show (sports programs category)...congratulations to hosts **Jim Day** and **Jeff Piecoro**, producer **Kent Weaver** and directors **Brian Hunterman** and **Roy Alfers**...FOX Sports Ohio also won an **Emmy** for its **Columbus Blue Jackets** NHL game coverage (live sporting event category).

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (24-30 .444): From 7/28-8/4 the Reds lost 8 straight home games, tying the ballpark record for consecutive home losses (8/5-8/16, 2008)...went 5-10-3 in their 18 home series...produced a winning record on 2 of their 9 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3, 1-2, 3-3, 3-3, 2-2, 2-8).

REDS ON THE ROAD (24-33, .421): Fri's 10-5 win at SF snapped the Reds' season-high 8-game road losing streak... have dropped 10 of their last 12 road games and 12 of their last 15 road games...went 8-8-2 in their previous 18 road series...produced a winning or .500 record on 4 of their previous 8 road trips (7-3, 3-2, 3-3, 2-5, 2-4, 3-3, 2-5, 0-6)... entering this season and dating to 2006, the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips.

IN THE STANDINGS (127): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 46, FOURTH - 35, FIFTH - 35, SIXTH - 1...at 20-14 and 26-20 were a season-high 6g over .500...prior to this season hadn't been 6g over .500 since 2006, when they reached a season-high 12g over .500 at 36-24...are a season high 13.5g out of first place...at 45-61 were a season high 16g under .500...have spent 64 days above, 15 days at and 48 days below .500.

REDS vs CARDINALS: The Reds are 933-1,058 all-time vs the Cardinals, including 5-6 this season...at Busch Stadium: Reds are 10-19, including 2-3 this season and 5-15 there the last 3 years...have lost 8 of the last 10g and 11 of the last 14g there...at Old Busch went 119-139...at StL: 6/28-6/29, 2005 (2g); 9/26-9/28, 2008 (3g); 8/13-8/16, 2001 (4g).

Last Pitched: Wed vs Chi and in his second career start threw a 4-hitter to earn the 4-0 win (9ip, 1bb, 4k, 117 pitches, 78 strikes)...was his first Major League complete game and shutout and his first victory since May 2006...became the first Reds pitcher to throw a shutout in his first or second career start since Charlie Leibrandt beat the Braves, 5-0, in his big league debut on 4/13/80 and the first pitcher to do it for any team since the Red Sox' Clay Buchholz threw a no-hitter on 9/1/07 vs Bal in his second career start.

Red Hots: Last name is pronounced LEER...media guide bio is available in the press box...is making his third career start, all this season...in his 2 starts the Reds went 1-1 and scored 7 runs (3.5 r/g)...has 1 quality start... on 7/31 vs CoI made his first Major League appearance since 5/22/06 for Mil at Cin and his first career big league start...on 8/5 vs Chi earned his first career victory since 5/18/06 vs Phi (5-4 Brewers win).

**2009 Season**: In December was signed by the Phillies to a minor league contract and began the season with Class AAA Lehigh Valley (8g, 7gs, 5-2, 4.75)...on 5/22 was traded to the Reds in exchange for cash...went 8-1, 2.51 in 11 starts and 1 relief appearance at Class AAA Louisville before he was promoted on 8/1 to take the spot in the rotation vacated by

RHP Micah Owings, who went on the disabled list with a tight right shoulder...overall at Class AAA went 13-3, 3.31 in 18 starts and 2 relief apps...when promoted, his 13 victories tied for the most among all minor league pitchers...twice was International League Pitcher of the Week, from 4/13-4/19 for Lehigh Valley (2gs, 2-0, 1.59) and from 7/20-7/26 for Louisville (2gs, 2-0, 1.88).

<u>Career Highlights</u>: Prior to this season had made all 66 of his Major League apps in relief...was International League Pitcher of the Week twice in 2009 and once in 2008...in 2007 was a Pacific Coast League All-Star and started the Triple-A All-Star Game...in 2000 was a California League All-Star.

Lehr's Most Recent Starts: 7/31 vs Col and received no decision in the 5-3 loss (5ip, 4h, 3er, 6bb, 0k, 0hr, 97 pitches, 52 strikes)...left with the score tied, 3-3...was his first Major League appearance since 5/22/06 for Mil at Cin and his first career big league start...in the first inning allowed 2 runs on 3 hits, a walk and an error.

<u>Last Pitched</u>: Fri at SF and received no decision in the 10-5 victory (6+ip, 9h, 5er, 1bb, 2k, 2hr, 108 pitches, 70 strikes)...left trailing, 4-3, but was charged with another run scored off Masset...allowed a pair of 2-run HR, to Molina in the first inning and to Velez in the fifth.

Red Hots: Tomorrow will make his 10th start of the season, his ninth since his second promotion...in 8 starts since he rejoined the rotation on 6/27 is 2-3, 6.60 (45ip, 33er)...in his 9 starts overall the Reds went 3-6 and scored 46 runs (5.11 r/g)...has 3 quality starts...once was the victim of a blown save...has walked 25 batters, 13 scored.

**2009 Season**: Began the year at Class AAA Louisville, where he went 3-5, 4.57 with 2 complete games and a shutout in 8 starts before he was promoted on 5/22...started the 7-6 loss vs Cle on 5/23, then was optioned back to Louisville the next day...made 6 more starts for the Bats (5-0, 0.81) before he was recalled again to start on 6/27 at Cle...in that 5/23 start vs the Indians became only the sixth different pitcher to start a game for the Reds this season, in the club's 42nd game...was the longest such streak to begin a season since **RHP John Roper** became the staff's **sixth** different starter in the **42nd game** of the **1994** campaign.

At Louisville: In 14 apps for the Bats produced 11 quality starts, including quality starts in each of his last 7 apps (5-1, 1.07, 50.1ip, 47h, 6er, 12bb, 45k)...in his first start of the season allowed a season-high 8 earned runs in 5.1 innings (13.50era) and in his last 13 starts posted a 2.03era (84.1ip, 19er)...following his most recent start for the Bats ranked among the International League leaders in innings pitched (89.2, 1st), wins (8, 2nd), strikeouts (82, 2nd) and ERA (2.71, 10th)...for the Bats, in 6 starts between his 5/22 and 6/27 promotions went 5-0, 0.81.
