King Lehr

RHP Justin Lehr earned last night's 5-4 victory after pitching 6.+ innings while allowing 11 hits and 1 run...according to **Elias Sports Bureau**, Lehr is just the third pitcher since 1900 to earn a win while allowing zero or 1 run and at least 11 hits in 6.0 innings pitched or less...the other 2 were Cle's **Jack Kralick** in **1965** (6ip, 11h, 1r) and Bal's **Pat Rapp** in **2000** (6ip, 11h, 1r).

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** Is **Game 3** (1-1) of a 3-game series vs **Jeff Risch's** Cardinals and **Game 6** (3-2) of a 6-game road trip that also included a weekend visit to SF (2-1)...tomorrow the Reds return to Great American Ball Park for a 7-game homestand vs the **Nationals** (4g) and **Giants** (3g)...including tonight's game will finish the 2009 campaign with 27g at **Great American Ball Park** and 23g on the road.

**DOT. DOT. DOT:** The Reds have won 4 of their last 6g following a 1-14 stretch...since the All-Star break the Reds are **7-18** and have **lost 7.5g** in the NL Central standings...at **42-0** the Reds club is the National League's only undefeated team when leading after 8 innings.

**MEDICAL UPDATES:** RHP **Micah Owings** (DL, tight right shoulder) on Mon at Lehigh Valley made a rehab start for Louisville and allowed 1 run on 5 hits in 4.2 innings (2bb, 2k, 1hr, 79 pitches, 52 strikes)...he is scheduled to make another rehab start for the Bats on Sat...RHP **Johnny Cueto** left Mon's start at StL after 2.0 innings with a **tight left hip flexor** but isn't expected to miss Sat's start vs the Nationals...**3B Scott Rolen** (DL, concussion) will undergo more testing once his headaches subside.

**FIRST WATCH:** The Reds have allowed **97 first inning runs**, the most in the Major Leagues, and have been outscored in the opening frame, **97-61**...have allowed first-inning runs in 49 of their 112g this season.

**BATTING LEADER:** **Joey Votto** is hitting .315 but missed 21g while on the disabled list and thus remains 14 plate apps shy of qualifying for the National League leaders...even with an 0-for-14, **Votto** would be hitting .301.

**HAL MCCOY:** Reds beat writer **Hal McCoy** of the *Dayton Daily News* will retire following this season...he has worked for the *DDN* for 49 years and is enshrined in the writers' wing of the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown...the longest-tenured baseball beat writer in the country, the 2009 campaign is **McCoy's** 37th covering the Redlegs.

**M\*A\*S\*H:** The Reds currently have **8 players on the disabled list**, including 5 players from their **Opening Day** roster: **C Ramon Hernandez** (left knee surgery), **RF Jay Bruce** (broken right wrist), **RHP Edinson Volquez** (right elbow surgery), **RHP Micah Owings** (tight right shoulder) and **RHP Mike Lincoln** (cervical disc replacement surgery)...also on the DL are **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (season-ending left shoulder surgery), **IF Danny Richar** (season-ending left shoulder surgery) and **3B Scott Rolen** (concussion).

**OPENING DAY LINEUP:** Because of injuries and trades, the Reds will finish the season with just **10g** (5-5) that included the projected **2009 Opening Day** lineup of **C Ramon Hernandez**, **1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips**, **3B Edwin Encarnacion**, **SS Alex Gonzalez**, **RF Jay Bruce**, **CF Willy Taveras** and either **Chris Dickerson** or **Jerry Hairston Jr.** in LF...Reds manager **Dusty Baker** has produced **92 different lineups** in 112g.

**SURGERIES:** Six Reds players have had surgical procedures this season, including **C Ramon Hernandez** (cleaned out left knee), **SS Alex Gonzalez** (removed loose bodies, right elbow), **RHP Mike Lincoln** (cervical disc replacement), **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder), **IF Danny Richar** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder) and **RHP Edinson Volquez** (repaired torn ulnar collateral ligament and torn flexor mass, right elbow)...**Castillo**, **Richar** and **Volquez** will not play again the rest of the season.

**SIGNATURE SUNDAY:** One hour after **Sunday's** 1:10 p.m. game vs Wsh, the entire Reds team will host in the FOX Sports Ohio Champions Club **Signature Sunday** to benefit the Reds Community Fund...fans can chose from the \$250 **Baseball** package (includes a team-signed baseball), \$500 **Bat** package (team-signed bat) or \$750 **Jersey** package (team-signed jersey)...all packages include 2 tickets to that afternoon's game against the Nationals...fans can sign up online at [reds.com/signature](http://reds.com/signature) or by calling (513) 765-7234.

**REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (24-30 .444):** From 7/28-8/4 the Reds lost 8 straight home games, tying the ballpark record for consecutive home losses (8/5-8/16, 2008)...went **5-10-3 in their 18 home series**...produced a winning record on 2 of their 9 homestands (2-3, 2-4, **3-2**, **6-3**, 1-2, 3-3, 3-3, 2-2, 2-8).

**REDS ON THE ROAD (25-33, .431):** The Reds are 3-2 on this road trip (2-1 at SF, 1-1 at StL)...Fri's 10-5 win at SF snapped their season-high 8-game road losing streak...have dropped 10 of their last 13 road games and 12 of their last 16 road games...went **8-8-2 in their previous 18 road series**...produced a winning or .500 record on 5 of their 9 road trips, including this one (**7-3**, **3-2**, **3-3**, 2-5, 2-4, **3-3**, 2-5, 0-6, **3-2**)...entering this season and dating to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

**IN THE STANDINGS (128):** The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 46, FOURTH - 35, FIFTH - 36, SIXTH - 1...at **20-14** and **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g over .500** at **36-24...yesterday were a season high 13.5g out of first place...**at **45-61** were a season high **16g under .500**...have spent **64** days above, **15** days at and **49** days below .500.

**REDS vs CARDINALS:** The Reds are 934-1,058 all-time vs the Cardinals, including 6-6 this season...**at Busch Stadium:** Reds are 11-19, including 3-3 this season and 6-15 here the last 3 years...have lost 8 of the last 11g and 11 of the last 15g here...**at Old Busch** went 119-139..

**REDS vs NATIONALS:** The Reds are 226-190 all-time vs the franchise formerly known as the Montreal Expos, including 2-1 this season...went 4-3 in 2008 after they swept the 4-game series in July at GABP and were swept in a 3-game set at Nationals Park in August...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 13-7 vs the franchise, including 4-0 last season and 11-4 vs the Nats...the Reds' 4-game sweep at GABP from 7/3-7/6 of last year was their first 4-game series sweep since **July 2006 vs Col** and their first 4-game series sweep vs the Expos/Nationals since **July 1973** at Riverfront Stadium.

**Last Pitched:** Fri at SF and received no decision in the 10-5 victory (6+ip, 9h, 5er, 1bb, 2k, 2hr, 108 pitches, 70 strikes)...left trailing, 4-3, but was charged with another run scored off Masset...allowed a pair of 2-run HR, to Molina in the first inning and to Velez in the fifth.

**Red Hots:** Is making his 10th start of the season, his ninth since his second promotion...**in 8 starts since he rejoined the rotation on 6/27 is 2-3, 6.60 (45ip, 33er)**...in his 9 starts overall the Reds went 3-6 and scored 46 runs (5.11 r/g)...has 3 quality starts...once was the victim of a blown save...has walked 25 batters, 13 scored.

**2009 Season:** Began the year at Class AAA Louisville, where he went 3-5, 4.57 with 2 complete games and a shutout in 8 starts before he was promoted on 5/22...started the 7-6 loss vs Cle on 5/23, then was optioned back to Louisville the next day...made 6 more starts for the Bats (5-0, 0.81) before he was recalled again to start on 6/27 at Cle...in that 5/23 start vs the Indians became only the sixth different pitcher to start a game for the Reds this season, in the club's 42nd game...was the longest such streak to begin a season since **RHP John Roper** became the staff's **sixth** different starter in the **42nd game** of the **1994** campaign.

**At Louisville:** In 14 apps for the Bats produced 11 quality starts, including quality starts in each of his last 7 apps (5-1, 1.07, 50.1ip, 47h, 6er, 12bb, 45k)...in his first start of the season allowed a season-high 8 earned runs in 5.1 innings (13.50era) and in his last 13 starts posted a 2.03era (84.1ip, 19er)...following his most recent start for the Bats ranked among the International League leaders in innings pitched (89.2, 1st), wins (8, 2nd), strikeouts (82, 2nd) and ERA (2.71, 10th)...**for the Bats, in 6 starts between his 5/22 and 6/27 promotions went 5-0, 0.81.**

**IL Pitcher of the Week:** Twice this season was named the International League's **Pitcher of the Week**...in 2 starts the week of **4/20-4/26** went 2-0, 2.92 with 18 strikeouts in 12.1 innings (10h, 6bb)...in the 10-3 win at Toledo on 4/26, over 6.1 innings he struck out a career-high 15 batters to tie the Louisville single-game record...in 2 starts from **6/1-6/7** went 2-0 without allowing a run (14.2ip, 11h, 2bb, 14k).

**Career Highs:** **Innings:** 7.1 (2x), 7/3/09 vs StL & 7/27/09 vs SD (longest) & 1.2 (shortest), 6/26/07 at Phi; **Hits:** 15, 7/26/08 vs Col; **Runs:** 9, 7/21/09 at LAD; **Earned Runs:** 7, 7/16/09 vs Mil; **Walks:** 7, 6/27/09 at Cle; **Strikeouts:** 6, 7/8/09 at Phi; **HR allowed:** 3, 6/15/08 vs Bos (Ellsbury solo, Crisp 2-run, Drew solo).

**Bailey's Most Recent Starts:** **5/23 vs Cle**, in his only appearance of the season received no decision in the 7-6 loss (4.1ip, 3h, 6er, 6bb, 3k, 1hr, 95 pitches, 53 strikes)...left leading, 6-4, with the bases loaded and 1 out but was charged with 2 more runs scored off Burton...the 6 runs allowed tied his career high and the 6 walks were a new career high...walked the leadoff batter in the first, second and fifth innings...in the second allowed 4 runs on a 2-run HR to De Rosa and a 2-out, 2-run single to Cabrera...was optioned to Louisville the next day..**6/27 at Cle**, in his second start of the season earned the 7-3 victory (5ip, 3h, 3er, 7bb, 2k, 106 pitches, 54 strikes)...left leading, 6-3...for the second straight start established a career-high for walks...2 batters who walked scored...after the Reds scored 4 runs in the top of the second allowed a run scoring-GIDP in the bottom of the inning...with 2 outs in the fourth allowed Sizemore's 2-run single...**7/3 vs StL** and was the victim of a blown save in the 7-4 loss (7.1ip, 3h, 2er, 2bb, 5k, 1hbp, 104 pitches, 70 strikes)...left leading, 3-0, but was charged with 2 of the runs that scored on Pujols' grand slam off Weathers...Pujols drove in 5 of the Cardinals' 7 runs...**7/8 at Phi**, recorded a career-high 6 strikeouts but received no decision in the 3-2 loss (6ip, 7h, 2er, 0bb, 6k, 1hr, 95 pitches, 63 strikes)...left with the score tied, 2-2...allowed only an RBI-single to Howard in the fourth inning and a 2-out, solo HR to Werth in the sixth...Phillies won it in the ninth on Victorino's game-ending single off Weathers...**7/16 vs Mil**, in the Reds' second-half opener suffered the 9-6 loss (5.1ip, 6h, 7er, 4bb, 3k, 1hr, 101 pitches, 58 strikes)...left trailing, 4-2, but was charged with 3 more runs scored off Masset...in the third inning allowed a 3-run HR to Fiedler...was charged with 4 of the Brewers' 5 runs in the sixth...**7/21 at LAD** and allowed a career-high 9 runs in the 12-3 loss (2.2ip, 8h, 9r, 6er, 2bb, 0k, 1hbp, 2wp, 81 pitches, 45 strikes)...left trailing, 9-1...in the first inning allowed a 2-run triple to Ramirez...in the second allowed a 2-run HR to Kemp...in the third allowed 5 more runs (3 unearned) on 2 hits, 2 walks, a hit batsman and 2 errors..**7/27 vs SD**, tied his career-high with 7.1 innings and snapped the Reds' season-high 6-game losing streak with a 6-4 victory (6h, 3er, 1bb, 4k, 2hr, 111 pitches, 75 strikes)...left leading, 6-3...in the fifth inning allowed an RBI-single to Rodriguez...in the sixth allowed back-to-back solo HR to Cabrera (first career) and AGonzalez..**8/1 vs Col** and suffered the 6-2 loss (5.1ip, 7h, 5er, 2bb, 4k, 1hr, 100 pitches, 65 strikes)...left trailing, 5-2...allowed 3 runs in the fourth inning on a 2-ruin single to Stewart and a sac fly to Gonzalez...in the fifth allowed a solo HR to Smith and in the sixth gave up a run-scoring double to Tulowitzki.

## Tomorrow vs Nationals: Bronson Arroyo

**Last Pitched:** Sat at SF and suffered the 4-2 loss (7ip, 7h, 3er, 0bb, 2k, 1hr, 102 pitches, 71 strikes)...left trailing, 3-2...allowed a pair of RBI-hits to Molina and a solo HR to Velez.

**Red Hots:** Tomorrow vs Wsh will make his 24th start of the season...his 21 wins beginning 6/29/08 are tied for fourth-most in the Major Leagues (Halladay 24, Sabathia 23, Santana 22, 3 others w/ 21)...in his previous 23 starts the Reds went 10-13 and scored 85 runs (3.69 r/g)...leads the pitching staff with 13 quality starts.

**Workhorse:** Since he was acquired by the Reds prior to the 2006 season leads all Major League pitchers with 126 starts and ranks second in the National League with 796.0 innings pitched (**Aaron Harang** 1st, 798.2ip).

**In The Big Inning:** Allowed at least 1 run in the first inning of 12 of his 23 starts, including 10 of his last 15 starts...has posted a 9.00era in the first inning (23ip, 23er) and a 4.29era after the first frame (121.2ip, 58er).
