Prior to tonight's game <mark>Adam Rosales</mark> will receive the <mark>Heart & Hustle Award</mark> from the Major League Baseball Players Alumni Association...the annual award recognizes one player on each team who demonstrates a passion for and best embodies the values, spirit and traditions of the game...past Reds winners include **Jerry Hairston Jr.** (2008), **Ryan** Freel (2007) and Adam Dunn (2006).

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is Game 3 (1-1) of a 4-game series vs Mike Gazda's Nationals and Game 3 (1-1) of a 7-game homestand that includes a day off Monday followed by a mid-week visit from the Giants (3g)...following this homestand the Reds hit the road again for a 6-game trip to Pit (3g) and Mil (off day, 3g).

FRIENDS OF REDS BASEBALL: At tonight's game Ramon Hernandez and former Red Alex Gonzalez are hosting from Su Casa Hispanic Ministry 100 fans in moon deck Section 143 as part of their Los Amigos del Beisbol de Los Rojos ticket program targeting local hispanic families...the guests received transportation to and from the game, a custom Reds cap, a \$10 concession voucher and in-stadium welcomes via the PA announcer and scoreboard.

SIGNATURE SUNDAY: One hour after tomorrow's 1:10 p.m. game vs Wsh, the entire Reds team will host in the FOX Sports Ohio Champions Club **Signature Sunday** to benefit the Reds Community Fund...fans can chose from the \$250 **Baseball** package (includes a team-signed baseball), \$500 **Bat** package (team-signed bat) or \$750 **Jersey** package (team-signed jersey)...all packages include 2 tickets to that afternoon's game against the Nationals...fans still can sign up online at reds.com/signature or by calling (513) 765-7234.

**DOT, DOT.** Today's **14.0-game deficit** is the Reds' largest of the season...since the All-Star break are **8-20** and have lost 9.0g in the NL Central standings...at 44-0 the Reds club is the National League's only undefeated team when leading after 8 innings.

MEDICAL UPDATES: RHP Homer Bailey left Wed's game at StL in the first inning after he was hit on the arch of his left foot by an Albert Pujols line drive...x-rays were negative...he is not expected to miss Tue's start vs the Giants... RHP Micah Owings (DL, tight right shoulder) on Mon at Lehigh Valley made a rehab start for Louisville (4.2ip, 5h, 1er, 2bb, 2k, 1hr, 79 pitches, 52 strikes)...he is scheduled to make another rehab start for the Bats tonight...3B Scott Rolen (DL, concussion) will begin light weight lifting and cardiovascular excercises once his headaches subside.

FIRST WATCH: The Reds have allowed 100 first inning runs, the most in the Major Leagues (Hou 85, SD 78), and have been outscored in the opening frame, 100-61...allowed first-inning runs in 50 of their 115g this season.

BATTING LEADER: Joey Votto is hitting .315 but missed 21g while on the disabled list and remains 11 plate apps shy of qualifying for the National League leaders...even with an 0-for-11, Votto would be hitting .304.

<u>HAL McCOY</u>: Reds beat writer **Hal McCoy** of the *Dayton Daily News* will retire following this season...he has worked for the *DDN* for 49 years and is enshrined in the writers' wing of the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown... the longest-tenured baseball beat writer in the country, the 2009 campaign is McCoy's 37th covering the Redlegs.

<u>M\*A\*S\*H</u>: The Reds currently have **8 players on the disabled list**, including 5 players from their **Opening Day** roster: C Ramon Hernandez (left knee surgery), RF Jay Bruce (broken right wrist), RHP Edinson Volquez (right elbow surgery), RHP Micah Owings (tight right shoulder) and RHP Mike Lincoln (cervical disc replacement surgery)... also on the DL are C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo (season-ending left shoulder surgery), IF Danny Richar (season-ending left shoulder surgery) and 3B Scott Rolen (concussion)...each member of the Opening Day starting infield missed extended time because of various ailments, including since-traded SS Alex Gonzalez (disabled following right elbow surgery), 1B Joey Votto (disabled with stress/anxiety), 2B Brandon Phillips (hairline fracture, right thumb) and sincetraded 3B Edwin Encarnacion (disabled with a chip fracture in his left wrist).

OPENING DAY LINEUP: Because of injuries and trades, the Reds will finish the season with just 10g (5-5) that included the projected 2009 Opening Day lineup of C Ramon Hernandez, 1B Joey Votto, 2B Brandon Phillips, 3B Edwin Encarnacion, SS Alex Gonzalez, RF Jay Bruce, CF Willy Taveras and either Chris Dickerson or Jerry Hairston Jr. in LF...Reds manager Dusty Baker has produced 94 different lineups in 115g.

SURGERIES: Six Reds players have had surgical procedures this season, including C Ramon Hernandez (cleaned out left knee), SS Alex Gonzalez (removed loose bodies, right elbow), RHP Mike Lincoln (cervical disc replacement), C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder), IF Danny Richar (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder) and RHP Edinson Volquez (repaired torn ulnar collateral ligament and torn flexor mass, right elbow).

REDS HALL OF FAME: Through September 2, Reds fans can vote for the Reds Hall of Fame Class of 2010 online at reds.com/HOF or via paper ballot that can be found at the Hall of Fame and Museum, the Reds Community Corner at Section 120 in Great American Ball Park or at participating Skyline Chili and Montgomery Inn locations. the candiates include Bret Boone, Jeff Brantley, Norm Charlton, John Franco, Danny Graves, Kevin Mitchell, Hal Morris, Paul O'Neill, Chris Sabo and Scott Sullivan.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (25-31 .446): The Reds are 1-1 on this homestand (1-1 vs Wsh)...went 5-10-3 in their previous 18 home series...produced a winning record on 2 of their previous 9 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3, 1-2, 3-3, 3-3, 2-2, 2-8)...in 7 seasons at GABP are 266-276-1.

IN THE STANDINGS (131): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 46, FOURTH - 35, FIFTH - 39, SIXTH - 1...at 20-14 and 26-20 were a season-high 6g over .500...today are a season-high 14.0g out of first place...at 45-61 were a season high 16g under .500...have spent 64 days above, 15 days at and 52 days below .500.

REDS vs NATIONALS: The Reds are 227-191 all-time vs the franchise formerly known as the Montreal Expos, including 3-2 this season...at Great American Ball Park: Reds are 14-8 vs the franchise, including 1-1 this season and 12-5 vs the Nationals...last night's 2-0 loss snapped the Reds' 5-game home winning streak vs Wsh...last Expos/Nationals **sweep**: at Cin: 4/29-4/30, 1986 (2g); 8/31-9/2, 1992 (3g)...at Wsh: 8/1-8/3, 2008 (3g).

<u>Last Pitched</u>: Mon at StL and left the 4-1 loss after the second inning with a tight left hip flexor (2ip, 1h, 1er, 1bb, 2k, 39 pitches, 23 strikes)...in the first inning allowed a sac fly to Holliday.

**Red Hots**: The 23-year-old righthander is making his 24th start of the season...in his 23 starts the Reds went 11-12 and scored 84 runs (3.65 r/g)...in 9 of his 23 starts threw at least 7.0 innings and in 16 of his 23 starts threw at least 6.0 innings.

Streaking: Through 16 starts on 7/1 was 8-4, 2.69...in 7 starts since then is 0-5, 9.49 (30.1ip, 32er)...the 5-game losing streak is the longest of his young career...in 5 starts from 4/22-5/13 went 4-0, 1.25 (36ip, 5er)...the 4-game winning streak was the longest of his career...in each of 4 starts from 4/22-5/8 threw at least 7.0 innings while allowing no more than 1 run, the longest streak of that kind by a Reds pitcher since Tim Belcher had a 4-game run from 5/27-6/13, 1992 (courtesy Elias Sports Bureau).

Quality: With 12 quality starts ranks third on the staff behind Aaron Harang (13qs) and Bronson Arroyo (14qs)...his 2 strings of 5 consecutive QS (4/22-5/13, 5/24-6/14) are the longest stretches of quality starts by a Reds pitcher this season...last year, Edinson Volquez produced a string of 12 straight QS (4/22-6/20).

Home Cookin': For the season is 2-4, 4.55 in 10 starts at home (61.1ip, 31er, 9hr) and 6-5, 3.96 in 13 starts on the road (72.2ip, 32er, 10hr).

World Baseball Classic: Started the Dominican Republic's second game of the tournament and threw 4.2 scoreless innings to earn the 9-0 win vs Panama in the San Juan bracket (4.2ip, 3h, 1bb, 5k).

### Tomorrow's Pitcher: RHP Justin Lehr

Last Pitched: Tue at StL and earned the 5-4 victory (6+ip, 11h, 1er, 1bb, 1k, 0hr, 89 pitches, 58 strikes)...left leading, 4-1...allowed 11 singles and stranded 7 baserunners...gave up only an RBI-single to Ludwick with 2 outs in the third inning...in the sixth inning singled off Mitchell Boggs for his first Major League hit...according to Elias Sports Bureau, became just the third pitcher since 1900 to earn a win while allowing zero or 1 run and at least 11 hits in 6.0 innings pitched or less...the other 2 were Cle's Jack Kralick in 1965 (6ip, 11h, 1r) and Bal's Pat Rapp in 2000 (6ip, 11h, 1r).

Red Hots: Last name is pronounced LEER...media guide bio is available in the press box...tomorrow will make his fourth career start, all this season, and his first career appearance vs the Nationals... in his 3 starts the Reds went 2-1 and scored 12 runs (4 r/g)...has 2 quality apps in 3 starts...on 7/31 vs Col made his first Major League appearance since 5/22/06 for Mil at Cin and his first career big league start...on 8/5 vs Chi earned his first career victory since 5/18/06 vs Phi (5-4 Brewers win).

2009 Season: In December was signed by the Phillies to a minor league contract and began the season with Class AAA Lehigh Valley (8g, 7gs, 5-2, 4.75)...on 5/22 was traded to the Reds in exchange for cash...went 8-1, 2.51 in 11 starts and 1 relief appearance at Class AAA Louisville before he was promoted on 8/1 to take the spot in the rotation vacated by RHP Micah Owings, who went on the disabled list with a tight right shoulder...overall at Class AAA went 13-3, 3.31 in 18 starts and 2 relief apps...when promoted, his 13 victories tied for the most among all minor league pitchers...twice was International League Pitcher of the Week, from 4/13-4/19 for Lehigh Valley (2gs, 2-0, 1.59) and from 7/20-7/26 for Louisville (2gs, 2-0, 1.88).

Lehr's Most Recent Starts: 7/31 vs Col and received no decision in the 5-3 loss (5ip, 4h, 3er, 6bb, 0k, 0hr, 97 pitches, 52 strikes)...left with the score tied, 3-3...was his first Major League appearance since 5/22/06 for Mil at Cin and his first career big league start...in the first inning allowed 2 runs on 3 hits, a walk and an error...8/5 vs Chi and in his second career start threw a 4-hitter to earn the 4-0 win (9ip, 1bb, 4k, 117 pitches, 78 strikes)...was his first Major League complete game and shutout and his first victory since May 2006...became the first Reds pitcher to throw a shutout in his first or second career start since Charlie Leibrandt beat the Braves, 5-0, in his big league debut on 4/13/80 and the first pitcher to do it for any team since the Red Sox' Clay Buchholz threw a no-hitter on 9/1/07 vs Bal in his second career start.
