Today's News

Today the Reds placed on the 15-day disabled list, retroactive to Sunday, RHP Johnny Cueto (inflammation, right shoulder); returned from a rehab assignment and reinstated from the 15-day DL RHP Micah Owings (tight right shoulder); sent to Louisville on a rehab assignment 3B Scott Rolen (concussion)...in 2 rehab starts at Louisville Owings went 1-0, 0.87 (10.1ip, 8h, 1er, 7bb, 5k, 1hr)...he will start tomorrow night at Pit instead of Cueto...1B Joey Votto left last night's game in the the first inning with blurry vision...he will be examined again this morning.

TODAY'S GAME: Is **Game 3** (0-2) of a 3-game series vs **Jim Moorehead's** Giants and **Game 7** (1-5) of a 7-game homestand that included a **1-3** series the Nationals...following this afternoon's game the Reds hit the road again for a 6-game trip to **Pit** (3g) and **Mil** (off day, 3g)...including today's game will finish the 2009 campaign with 21g at **Great American Ball Park** and 22g on the road.

DOT, DOT, DOT: At **50-69** the Reds are **19g under .500** and face a **17.5-game deficit**, both season highs...since the All-Star break are **8-24** (.250) and have lost **12.5g** in the NL Central standings...at **44-0** the Reds club is the National League's only undefeated team when leading after 8 innings.

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUTS: Last night OF Drew Stubbs became the sixth Reds player to make his Major League debuts this season, joining RHP Carlos Fisher, LHP Matt Maloney, IF Drew Sutton, RHP Robert Manuel and C Craig Tatum...in 2008, 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts: RHP Johnny Cueto, IF Paul Janish, OF Jay Bruce, LHP Daniel Ray Herrera, RHP Daryl Thompson, IF Adam Rosales, OF Chris Dickerson, RHP Ramon Ramirez, C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo and RHP Josh Roenicke.

FIRST WATCH: The Reds have allowed 100 first inning runs, the most in the Major Leagues (Hou 89, SD 82, Bal 80), and have been outscored in the opening frame, 100-61...allowed first-inning runs in 50 of their 119g this season.

BATTING LEADER: **Joey Votto** is hitting .316 but missed 21g while on the disabled list and remains 9 plate apps shy of qualifying for the National League leaders...even with an 0-for-9, **Votto** would be hitting .308.

M*A*S*H: The Reds currently have 7 players on the disabled list, including 4 players from their Opening Day roster: C Ramon Hernandez (left knee surgery), RF Jay Bruce (broken right wrist), RHP Edinson Volquez (right elbow surgery) and RHP Mike Lincoln (cervical disc replacement surgery)...also on the DL are C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo (season-ending left shoulder surgery), IF Danny Richar (season-ending left shoulder surgery) and 3B Scott Rolen (concussion, on rehab assignment)...each member of the Opening Day starting infield missed extended time because of various ailments, including since-traded SS Alex Gonzalez (disabled following right elbow surgery), 1B Joey Votto (disabled with stress/anxiety), 2B Brandon Phillips (hairline fracture, right thumb) and since-traded 3B Edwin Encarnacion (disabled with a chip fracture in his left wrist).

<u>OPENING DAY LINEUP</u>: Because of injuries and trades, the Reds will finish the season with just **10g** (5-5) that included the projected **2009 Opening Day** lineup of **C Ramon Hernandez**, **1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips**, **3B Edwin Encarnacion**, **SS Alex Gonzalez**, **RF Jay Bruce**, **CF Willy Taveras** and either **Chris Dickerson** or **Jerry Hairston Jr.** in LF...Reds manager **Dusty Baker** has produced **98 different lineups** in 119g.

<u>SURGERIES</u>: Six Reds players have had surgical procedures this season, including **C** Ramon Hernandez (cleaned out left knee), **SS** Alex Gonzalez (removed loose bodies, right elbow), **RHP Mike Lincoln** (cervical disc replacement), **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder), **IF Danny Richar** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder) and **RHP Edinson Volquez** (repaired torn ulnar collateral ligament and torn flexor mass, right elbow)...**Castillo**, **Richar** and **Volquez** will not play again the rest of the season.

REDS HALL OF FAME: Through September 2, Reds fans can vote for the Reds Hall of Fame Class of 2010 online at reds.com/HOF or via paper ballot that can be found at the Hall of Fame and Museum, the Reds Community Corner at Section 120 in Great American Ball Park or at participating Skyline Chili and Montgomery Inn locations... the candiates include Bret Boone, Jeff Brantley, Norm Charlton, John Franco, Danny Graves, Kevin Mitchell, Hal Morris, Paul O'Neill, Chris Sabo and Scott Sullivan.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (25-35 .417): The Reds are 1-5 on this homestand (1-3 vs Wsh, 0-2 vs SF)...including this one have gone 5-12-3 in their 20 home series...including this one have produced a winning record on just 2 of their 10 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3, 1-2, 3-3, 3-3, 2-2, 2-8, 1-5)...in 7 seasons at GABP are 266-280-1... from 7/28-8/4 lost 8 straight home games, tying the ballpark record for consecutive home losses (8/5-8/16, 2008)... last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38)...at 217-217-1 the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since 6/26/04 (57-57)...also reached .500 at 219-219-1.

REDS ON THE ROAD (25-34, .424): The Reds have dropped 11 of their last 14 road games and 13 of their last 17 road games...went 8-9-2 in their 19 road series...produced a winning or .500 record on 5 of their 9 road trips (7-3, 3-2, 3-3, 2-5, 2-4, 3-3, 2-5, 0-6, 3-3)...entering this season and dating to 2006, the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips.

IN THE STANDINGS (136): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 46, FOURTH - 35, FIFTH - 44, SIXTH - 1...at 20-14 and 26-20 were a season-high 6g over .500...prior to this season hadn't been 6g over .500 since 2006, when they reached a season-high 12g over .500 at 36-24...at 50-69 today the Reds are 19g under .500 and face a 17.5-game deficit, both season highs...have spent 64 days above, 15 days at and 57 days below .500.

REDS vs GIANTS: Reds are 912-1,120 all-time vs the Giants franchise, including 2-3 this season...at Great American Ball Park: Reds are 10-11, including 0-2 this season...prior to Tue night's loss had won the previous 4g vs SF here... last Giants sweep: at Cin: 4/5-4/7, 1999 (3g)...at SF: 5/3-5/5, 2002 (3g).

<u>UP NEXT: REDS at PIRATES</u>: The Reds are **971-1,018 all-time** vs the Pirates, including 3-2 this season...<u>at PNC Park</u>: Reds are 33-31 all-time, including 2-1 this season.

Last Started: Fri vs Wsh and suffered the 2-0 loss (7ip, 6h, 2er, 3bb, 6k, 2hr, 115 pitches, 75 strikes)... left trailing, 2-0...allowed both runs on solo HR, to Belliard in the fifth inning and to Nieves leading off the seventh...Reds batters produced 8 hits.

Red Hots: Is making his 26th start of the season...

with 13 quality starts ranks second on the staff to **Bronson Arroyo** (15qs)... in his previous 25 starts the Reds went 10-15, scored 87 runs (3.48 r/g) and twice were shut out...in his 25 starts **Reds batters** hit .239 (200-838)... on 6/4 at StL suffered the 3-1 loss in a game in which **Harang** and **Chris Carpenter** each threw a complete game.

The Streak: In 13 starts from 5/30-8/3 went 0-9, 5.49...snapped that career-high 9-game losing streak with a 5-2 win on 8/9 at SF...the 9-game skid tied Bal's Jason Berken for the longest in the Major Leagues this season...was the longest by a Reds pitcher in a single season since Tom Hume's 9-game losing streak from 4/19-7/4, 1978.

Staff Ace: Since he was acquired from the Athletics at the 2003 trading deadline is the Reds' leader in most statistical pitching categories, including starts (192), wins (69), innings pitched (1224.1) and strikeouts (1,039)...since the beginning of the 2006 season ranks second in the National League with 805.2 innings pitched (Bronson Arroyo 1st, 813ip)... in 2005 and 2007 won the BBWAA's Johnny Vander Meer Award as the club's Most Outstanding Pitcher.

Community Affairs: Is one of the club's more active members of the local community...for the third straight season, as part of his Aaron's Aces ticket program is hosting at all Sunday home games children of military personnel serving in the War On Terrorism...along with wife Jen donated \$55,000 to the Miracle League of Greater Cincinnati and Northern Kentucky and on 5/9 attended the dedication of that field at the Durham Recreation Complex in Western Hills...for his community service has been the club's nominee for the Robert Clemente Award (2007, 2009), Branch Rickey Award (2007) and Marvin Miller Man of the Year Award (2007, 2008, 2009).

<u>Last Started For The Reds</u>: On 7/26 at Cubs and in the 5-2 loss left after 3.0 innings with a tight right shoulder (3ip, 3h, 2er, 4bb, 2k, 66 pitches, 38 strikes)...left trailing, 2-1...in the second inning allowed a run on 1 hit and 3 walks, including a 2-out, a bases-loaded walk to Fukudome...retired the first 2 batters of the third inning before Bradley walked and then scored on Soriano's double...the next day went on the disabled list.

Red Hots: Tomorrow will make his 19th start of the season, his second of the year vs the Pirates and his first since a stint on the 15-day disabled list...had been on the DL with a tight right shoulder...in his previous 18 starts the Reds went 7-11 and scored 79 runs (4.39 r/g)...has 6 quality starts...with an 8-2 win on 4/26 vs Atl snapped his 9-game losing streak dating back to a 9-3 Diamondbacks victory on 5/25/08 at Atl...in 14 apps and 10 starts between victories went 0-9, 8.53.
