Today the Reds returned from a rehabilitation assignment and reinstated from the 15-day disabled list 3B Scott Rolen...he had been on the DL since 8/11 with a concussion suffered vs Col on 8/2, when he was hit in the helmet by a **Jason Marquis** pitch...in 2 rehab starts at Louisville **Rolen** went 2-for-6 with an RBI...he will take the roster spot vacated by **RHP Aaron Harang**, who has been placed on the 15-day DL, retroactive to Friday...late last night **Harang** had a season-ending appendectomy at The Good Samaritan Hospital in Cincinnati (Dr. Joann Lohr)...he expects to be released from the hospital later today.

TODAY'S GAME: Is Game 3 (0-2) of a 3-game series vs Danny Hart's Pirates and Game 3 (0-2) of a 6-game road trip that includes an off day in Milwaukee tomorrow followed by 3g at Miller Park...following this road trip return to Great American Ball Park for a 7-game homestand vs LAD (3g) and Pit (4g) that includes a day/night doubleheader (1:10pm, 7:10pm) vs the Pirates on Mon, 8/31...including today's game the Reds will finish the season with 20g at Great American Ball Park and 20g on the road.

DOT, DOT, DOT: At 51-71 the Reds are 20g below .500 and 18.5g out of first place, both season highs...in the last 4g Reds batters are 3-for-28 with RISP...since the All-Star break are 9-26 (.257) and have lost 13.5g in the NL Central standings...at **44-0** the Reds club is the National League's only undefeated team when leading after 8 innings.

FIRST WATCH: The Reds have allowed 103 first inning runs, the most in the Major Leagues (Hou 92, SD 85, Bal 81), and have been outscored in the opening frame, 103-61...allowed first-inning runs in 51 of their 122g this season.

BATTING LEADER: Joey Votto is hitting .311 but missed 21g while on the disabled list and remains 6 plate apps shy of qualifying for the National League leaders...even with an 0-for-6, Votto would be hitting .304.

HAL McCOY: Reds beat writer Hal McCoy of the Dayton Daily News will retire following this season...he has worked for the DDN for 49 years and is enshrined in the writers' wing of the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown... the longest-tenured baseball beat writer in the country, the 2009 campaign is McCoy's 37th covering the Redlegs.

M\*A\*S\*H: The Reds currently have 6 players on the disabled list, including 4 players from their Opening Day roster: C Ramon Hernandez (left knee surgery), RF Jay Bruce (broken right wrist), RHP Edinson Volquez (right elbow surgery) and RHP Mike Lincoln (cervical disc replacement surgery)...also on the DL are C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo (season-ending left shoulder surgery) and IF Danny Richar (season-ending left shoulder surgery).

OPENING DAY LINEUP: Because of injuries and trades, the Reds will finish the season with just 10g (5-5) that included the projected 2009 Opening Day lineup of C Ramon Hernandez, 1B Joey Votto, 2B Brandon Phillips, 3B Edwin Encarnacion, SS Alex Gonzalez, RF Jay Bruce, CF Willy Taveras and either Chris Dickerson or Jerry Hairston Jr. in LF...Reds manager Dusty Baker has produced 101 different lineups in 122g.

SURGERIES: RHP Aaron Harang last night became the seventh Reds player to have a surgical procedure this season (appendectomy)...the other 6 include C Ramon Hernandez (cleaned out left knee), SS Alex Gonzalez (removed loose bodies, right elbow), RHP Mike Lincoln (cervical disc replacement), C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder), IF Danny Richar (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder) and RHP Edinson Volquez (repaired torn ulnar collateral ligament and torn flexor mass, right elbow)...Castillo, Richar, Volquez and Harang will not play again the rest of the season.

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUTS: Six Reds players made their Major League debuts this season, including RHP Carlos Fisher, LHP Matt Maloney, IF Drew Sutton, RHP Robert Manuel, C Craig Tatum and OF Drew Stubbs...in 2008, 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts: RHP Johnny Cueto, IF Paul Janish, OF Jay Bruce, LHP Daniel Ray Herrera, RHP Daryl Thompson, IF Adam Rosales, OF Chris Dickerson, RHP Ramon Ramirez, C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo and RHP Josh Roenicke.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (26-35 .426): The Reds went 2-5 on their most recent homestand (1-3 vs Wsh, 1-2 vs SF)...went 5-12-3 in their 20 home series...produced a winning record on just 2 of their 10 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3, 1-2, 3-3, 3-3, 2-2, 2-8, 2-5)...in 7 seasons at GABP are 267-280-1...from 7/28-8/4 lost 8 straight home games, tying the ballpark record for consecutive home losses (8/5-8/16, 2008)...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38)...at 217-217-1 the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since 6/26/04 (57-57)...also reached .500 at 219-219-1.

REDS ON THE ROAD (25-36, .410): The Reds are 0-2 on this road trip (0-2 at Pit)...have dropped 13 of their last 16 road games and 15 of their last 19 road games...including this series are 8-10-2 in their 20 road series...produced a winning or .500 record on 5 of their 9 road trips (7-3, 3-2, 3-3, 2-5, 2-4, 3-3, 2-5, 0-6, 3-3)...entering this season and dating to 2006, the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips.

IN THE STANDINGS (139): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 46, FOURTH - 35, FIFTH - 46, SIXTH - 2...at 20-14 and 26-20 were a season-high 6g over .500...prior to this season hadn't been 6g over .500 since 2006, when they reached a season-high 12g over .500 at 36-24...today face a season high 18.5-game deficit...at 51-71 are a season high 20g under .500...have spent 64 days above, 15 days at and 60 days below .500.

REDS vs PIRATES: The Reds are 971-1,020 all-time vs the Pirates, including 3-4 this season...at Great American Ball Park: Reds are 26-29 all-time, including 1-1 this season...at PNC Park: Reds are 33-33 all-time, including 2-3 this season...last Pirates sweep: at Cin: 7/23-7/24, 2003 (2g); 3/31-4/3, 2003 (3g); 7/11-7/14, 1991 (4g)...at Pit: 8/20-8/21, 1998 (2g); **4/11-4/13, 2008 (3g)**; 8/22-8/24, 1969 (4g).

**Last Pitched**: Tue vs SF and received no decision in the 10-inning, 8-5 loss (5.2ip, 7h, 5er, 3bb, 4k, 92 pitches, 54 strikes)...left with the score tied, 5-5...in the third inning allowed a solo HR to Uribe...tooik a 5-1 lead into the sixth inning but allowed 4 runs on 2 walks and 4 hits...the Giants won it with 3 runs in the 10th off Cordero.

**Red Hots**: Is making his 12th start of the season and his first career appearance vs the Pirates...in his 11 starts overall the Reds went 3-8 and scored 53 runs (4.82 r/g)...has 3 quality starts...once was the victim of a blown save...has walked 28 batters, 14 scored.

**2009 Season**: Began the year at Class AAA Louisville, where he went 3-5, 4.57 with 2 complete games and a shutout in 8 starts before he was promoted on 5/22...started the 7-6 loss vs Cle on 5/23, then was optioned back to Louisville the next day...made 6 more starts for the Bats (5-0, 0.81) before he was recalled again to start on 6/27 at Cle...in that 5/23 start vs the Indians became only the sixth different pitcher to start a game for the Reds this season, in the club's 42nd game...was the longest such streak to begin a season since **RHP John Roper** became the staff's **sixth** different starter in the **42nd game** of the **1994** campaign.

At Louisville: In 14 apps for the Bats produced 11 quality starts, including quality starts in each of his last 7 apps (5-1, 1.07, 50.1ip, 47h, 6er, 12bb, 45k)...in his first start of the season allowed a season-high 8 earned runs in 5.1 innings (13.50era) and in his last 13 starts posted a 2.03era (84.1ip, 19er)...following his most recent start for the Bats ranked among the International League leaders in innings pitched (89.2, 1st), wins (8, 2nd), strikeouts (82, 2nd) and ERA (2.71, 10th)...for the Bats, in 6 starts between his 5/22 and 6/27 promotions went 5-0, 0.81.

<u>IL Pitcher of the Week</u>: Twice this season was named the International League's **Pitcher of the Week**...in 2 starts the week of **4/20-4/26** went 2-0, 2.92 with 18 strikeouts in 12.1 innings (10h, 6bb)...in the 10-3 win at Toledo on 4/26, over 6.1 innings he struck out a career-high 15 batters to tie the Louisville single-game record... in 2 starts from **6/1-6/7** went 2-0 without allowing a run (14.2ip, 11h, 2bb, 14k).

<u>Career Highs</u>: Innings: 7.1 (2x), 7/3/09 vs StL & 7/27/09 vs SD (longest) and 1.2 (shortest, non-injured), 6/26/07 at Phi & 3bf (shortest, injured) 8/12/09 at StL; **Hits**: 15, 7/26/08 vs Col; **Runs**: 9, 7/21/09 at LAD; **Earned Runs**: 7, 7/16/09 vs Mil; **Walks**: 7, 6/27/09 at Cle; **Strikeouts**: 6, 7/8/09 at Phi; **HR allowed**: 3, 6/15/08 vs Bos (Ellsbury solo, Crisp 2-run, Drew solo).

Bailey's Most Recent Starts: 5/23 vs Cle, in his only appearance of the season received no decision in the 7-6 loss (4.1ip, 3h, 6er, 6bb, 3k, 1hr, 95 pitches, 53 strikes)...left leading, 6-4, with the bases loaded and 1 out but was charged with 2 more runs scored off Burton...the 6 runs allowed tied his career high and the 6 walks were a new career high...walked the leadoff batter in the first, second and fifth innings...in the second allowed 4 runs on a 2-run HR to De Rosa and a 2-out, 2-run single to Cabrera...was optioned to Louisville the next day...6/27 at Cle, in his second start of the season earned the 7-3 victory (5ip, 3h, 3er, 7bb, 2k, 106 pitches, 54 strikes)...left leading, 6-3...for the second straight start established a career-high for walks...2 batters who walked scored...after the Reds scored 4 runs in the top of the second allowed a run scoring-GIDP in the bottom of the inning...with 2 outs in the fourth allowed Sizemore's 2-run single...7/3 vs StL and was the victim of a blown save in the 7-4 loss (7.1ip, 3h, 2er, 2bb, 5k, 1hbp, 104 pitches, 70 strikes)...left leading, 3-0, but was charged with 2 of the runs that scored on Pujols' grand slam off Weathers...Pujols drove in 5 of the Cardinals' 7 runs...7/8 at Phi, recorded a career-high 6 strikeouts but received no decision in the 3-2 loss (6ip, 7h, 2er, 0bb, 6k, 1hr, 95 pitches, 63 strikes)...left with the score tied, 2-2...allowed only an RBI-single to Howard in the fourth inning and a 2-out, solo HR to Werth in the sixth...Phillies won it in the ninth on Victorino's game-ending single off Weathers...**7/16 vs Mil**, in the Reds' second-half opener suffered the 9-6 loss (5.1ip, 6h, 7er, 4bb, 3k, 1hr, 101 pitches, 58 strikes)...left trailing, 4-2, but was charged with 3 more runs scored off Masset...in the third inning allowed a 3-run HR to Fielder...was charged with 4 of the Brewers' 5 runs in the sixth...7/21 at LAD and allowed a career-high 9 runs in the 12-3 loss (2.2ip, 8h, 9r, 6er, 2bb, 0k, 1hbp, 2wp, 81 pitches, 45 strikes)...left trailing, 9-1...in the first inning allowed a 2-run triple to Ramirez...in the second allowed a 2-run HR to Kemp...in the third allowed 5 more runs (3 unearned) on 2 hits, 2 walks, a hit batsman and 2 errors...7/27 vs SD, tied his career-high with 7.1 innings and snapped the Reds' season-high 6-game losing streak with a 6-4 victory (6h, 3er, 1bb, 4k, 2hr, 111 pitches, 75 strikes)...left leading, 6-3...in the fifth inning allowed an RBI-single to Rodriguez...in the sixth allowed back-to-back solo HR to Cabrera (first career) and AGonzalez...8/1 vs Col and suffered the 6-2 loss (5.1ip, 7h, 5er, 2bb, 4k, 1hr, 100 pitches, 65 strikes)...left trailing, 5-2...allowed 3 runs in the fourth inning on a 2-ruin single to Stewart and a sac fly to Gonzalez...in the fifth allowed a solo HR to Smith and in the sixth gave up a run-scoring double to Tulowitzki...8/7 at SF and received no decision in the 10-5 victory (6+ip, 9h, 5er, 1bb, 2k, 2hr, 108 pitches, 70 strikes)...left trailing, 4-3, but was charged with another run scored off Masset...allowed a pair of 2-run HR, to Molina in the first inning and to Velez in the fifth...8/12 at StL and in the 5-2 loss left the game after 3 batters when he was hit on the arch of his left foot by a Pujols line drive (3h, 3r, 2er, 0bb, 0k, 12 pitches, 8 strikes).

### **Tuesday at Brewers: Bronson Arroyo**

<u>Last Pitched</u>: Wed vs SF and suffered the 1-0 loss (8ip, 9h, 1er, 1bb, 5k, 99 pitches, 71 strikes)...allowed only an RBI-double to Schierholtz in the eighth inning that snapped his career-high scoreless streak at 17.0 innings...Zito threw 6.0 shutout innings... the start of the game was delayed 40 minutes by rain.

**Red Hots**: Tue at Mil will make his 26th start of the season...in his previous 25 starts the Reds went 11-14 and scored 92 runs (3.68 r/g).

**Quality**: Leads the pitching staff with 15 quality starts and produced QS in each of his last 5 apps (1-3, 2.41, 37.1ip, 10er).

As Luck Would Have It....: Went 9-8, 5.38 in 18 starts before the All-Star break...in the second half is 2-4 in 7 starts despite a sterling 2.72era.

<u>Workhorse</u>: Since he was acquired by the Reds prior to the 2006 season leads all Major League pitchers with 128 starts and leads the National League with 813.0 innings pitched (**Aaron Harang** 2nd, 812.2ip).

In The Big Inning: Allowed at least 1 run in the first inning of 12 of his 25 starts, including 10 of his last 17 starts...has posted an 8.28era in the first inning (25ip, 23er) and a 3.89era after the first frame (136.2ip, 59er).
