Today the Reds placed on the 15-day disabled list, retroactive to yesterday, **OF Chris Dickerson** (severely sprained left ankle) and **C Ryan Hanigan** (concussion)...both were injured in Sun's game at Pit...their spots on the roster will be taken by **OF Darnell McDonald** (#16) and **C Corky Miller** (#37), whose contracts were selected from Louisville... to make room on the 40-man roster, **RHP Mike Lincoln** (cervical disc surgery) and **RHP Edinson Volquez** (right elbow surgery) were transfered from the 15-day to the 60-day disabled list.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is Game 1 of a 3-game series vs Michael Vassallo's Brewers and Game 4 (1-2) of a 6-game road trip that included a weekend series at Pit (1-2) and a day off here yesterday...on Fri the Reds return to Great American Ball Park for a 7-game homestand vs LAD (3g) and Pit (4g) that includes Mon's day/night doubleheader (1:10pm, 7:10pm) vs the Pirates...including tonight's game the Reds will finish the season with 20g at Great American Ball Park and 19g on the road.

DOT. DOT. The Reds are **5-10** after a day off...for the third straight day are a season high **18.5g out of first place**...in the last 5g Reds batters are **4-for-34 with RISP** (.118)...since the All-Star break are **10-26** (.278) and have lost **13.5g** in the National League Central standings...at **45-0** the Reds club is the National League's only undefeated team when leading after 8 innings.

FIRST WATCH: The Reds have allowed 103 first inning runs, the most in the Major Leagues (Hou 97, SD 85, Bal 82), and have been outscored in the opening frame, 103-62...allowed first-inning runs in 51 of their 123g this season.

BATTING LEADER: **Joey Votto** is hitting .312 but missed 21g while on the disabled list and remains 4 plate apps shy of qualifying for the National League leaders...even with an 0-for-4, **Votto** would be hitting .309.

<u>HAL McCOY</u>: Reds beat writer **Hal McCoy** of the *Dayton Daily News* will retire following this season...he will be honored in a pregame ceremony on **Wed, 9/16...McCoy** has worked for the *DDN* for 49 years and is enshrined in the writers' wing of the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown...the longest-tenured baseball beat writer in the country, the 2009 campaign is **McCoy's** 37th covering the Redlegs.

<u>OPENING DAY LINEUP</u>: Because of injuries and trades, the Reds will finish the season with just **10g** (5-5) that included the projected **2009 Opening Day** lineup of **C Ramon Hernandez**, **1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips**, **3B Edwin Encarnacion** (traded) **SS Alex Gonzalez** (traded), **RF Jay Bruce**, **CF Willy Taveras** and either **Chris Dickerson** or **Jerry Hairston Jr.** (traded) in LF...Reds manager **Dusty Baker** has produced **102 different lineups** in 123g.

<u>SURGERIES</u>: Seven Reds players have had surgical procedures this season, including C Ramon Hernandez (cleaned out left knee), SS Alex Gonzalez (removed loose bodies, right elbow), RHP Mike Lincoln (cervical disc replacement), C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder), IF Danny Richar (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder), RHP Edinson Volquez (repaired torn ulnar collateral ligament and torn flexor mass, right elbow) and RHP Aaron Harang (appendectomy).

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUTS: Six Reds players made their Major League debuts this season, including RHP Carlos Fisher, LHP Matt Maloney, IF Drew Sutton, RHP Robert Manuel, C Craig Tatum and OF Drew Stubbs...in 2008, 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts: RHP Johnny Cueto, IF Paul Janish, OF Jay Bruce, LHP Daniel Ray Herrera, RHP Daryl Thompson, IF Adam Rosales, OF Chris Dickerson, RHP Ramon Ramirez, C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo and RHP Josh Roenicke.

REDS HALL OF FAME: Through September 2, Reds fans can vote for the Reds Hall of Fame Class of 2010 online at reds.com/HOF or via paper ballot that can be found at the Hall of Fame and Museum, the Reds Community Corner at Section 120 in Great American Ball Park or at participating Skyline Chili and Montgomery Inn locations... the candiates include Bret Boone, Jeff Brantley, Norm Charlton, John Franco, Danny Graves, Kevin Mitchell, Hal Morris, Paul O'Neill, Chris Sabo and Scott Sullivan.

EMMY AWARD: For the second consecutive year, Reds TV rightsholder **FOX Sports Ohio** has won an **Emmy Award** for its *Reds Live* pre-game show (sports programs category)....congratulations to hosts **Jim Day** and **Jeff Piecoro**, producer **Kent Weaver** and directors **Brian Hunterman** and **Roy Alfers**...FOX Sports Ohio also won an **Emmy** for its **Columbus Blue Jackets** NHL game coverage (live sporting event category).

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (26-35.426): The Reds went 2-5 on their most recent homestand (1-3 vs Wsh, 1-2 vs SF)...went 5-12-3 in their 20 home series...produced a winning record on just 2 of their 10 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3, 1-2, 3-3, 3-3, 2-2, 2-8, 2-5)...in 7 seasons at GABP are 267-280-1...from 7/28-8/4 lost 8 straight home games, tying the ballpark record for consecutive home losses (8/5-8/16, 2008)...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38)...at 217-217-1 the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since 6/26/04 (57-57)...also reached .500 at 219-219-1.

REDS ON THE ROAD (26-36, .419): The Reds are 1-2 on this road trip (1-2 at Pit)...have dropped 13 of their last 17 road games and 15 of their last 20 road games...went 8-10-2 in their previous 20 road series...produced a winning or .500 record on 5 of their 9 road trips (7-3, 3-2, 3-3, 2-5, 2-4, 3-3, 2-5, 0-6, 3-3)...entering this season and dating to 2006, the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips.

IN THE STANDINGS (141): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 46, FOURTH - 35, FIFTH - 48, SIXTH - 2...at 20-14 and 26-20 were a season-high 6g over .500...prior to this season hadn't been 6g over .500 since 2006, when they reached a season-high 12g over .500 at 36-24...at 51-71 were a season-high 20g under .500...for the 3rd straight day face a season high 18.5-game deficit...have spent 64 days above, 15 days at and 62 days below .500.

REDS vs BREWERS: The Reds are 95-95-1 all-time vs the Brewers, including 5-7 this season and 15-15 the last 2 seasons...<u>at Great American Ball Park</u>: Reds are 29-28, including 3-3 this season...<u>at Miller Park</u>: Reds are 39-37, including 2-4 this season and 8-6 the last 2 seasons...<u>last Reds sweep</u>: at Mil: 6/5-6/6, 2001 (2g); 7/11-7/13, 2003 (3g); 5/13-5/16, 2002 (4g)...<u>last Brewers sweep</u>: at Mil: 4/27-4/28, 2004 (2g), 5/29-5/31, 2009 (3g).

Wins Beginning 6/29/08 In the 14-1 loss on 6/24/08 at Tor, Bronson Arroyo made the shortest start of his career and became only the sixth starting pitcher in Major League history to allow at least 10 earned runs in a game in which he retired 3 batters or fewer (1+ip, 11), 10er)beginning with his next start, a 9-5 win at Cle on 6/29/08, Arroyo has 22 wins, tied for fourth-most in the Major Leagues since then: CC Sabathia

Since he was acquired by the Reds prior to the 2006 season, Bronson Arroyo ranks among the Major League leaders in games started and innings pitched:
Category NL ML Starts

Last Pitched: Wed vs SF and suffered the 1-0 loss (8ip, 9h, 1er, 1bb, 5k, 99 pitches, 71 strikes)...allowed only an RBI-double to Schierholtz in the eighth inning that snapped his career-high scoreless streak at 17.0 innings...Zito threw 6.0 shutout innings...the start of the game was delayed 40 minutes by rain.

Red Hots: Is making his 26th start of the season...his 22 wins beginning 6/29/08 are tied for fourth-most in the Major Leagues (see box to the left)...in his previous 25 starts the Reds went 11-14 and scored 92 runs (3.68 r/g).

Quality: Leads the pitching staff with 15 quality starts and produced QS in each of his last 5 apps (1-3, 2.41, 37.1ip, 10er).

As Luck Would Have It....: Went 9-8, 5.38 in 18 starts before the All-Star break...in the second half is 2-4 in 7 starts despite a sterling 2.72era.

Zeroes: From 8/8-8/19 put together a 17.0-inning scoreless streak, the longest by a Reds pitcher this season and tying his career high (7/2-7/19, 2004).

<u>Workhorse</u>: Since he was acquired by the Reds prior to the 2006 season leads all Major League pitchers with 128 starts and leads the National League with 813.0 innings pitched (**Aaron Harang** 2nd, 812.2ip).

In The Big Inning: Allowed at least 1 run in the first inning of 12 of his 25 starts, including 10 of his last 17 starts...has posted an 8.28era in the first inning (25ip, 23er) and a 3.89era after the first frame (136.2ip, 59er).

<u>Unlucky June 24</u>: On the date 6/24 each of the last 2 seasons started against the Blue Jays at Tor's Rogers Centre...in those 2 starts, a 14-1 loss on 6/24/08 and an 8-2 loss on 6/24/09, allowed 17 runs in 4.2 innings... in the **2008 loss** became only the sixth starting pitcher in Major League history to allow at least 10 earned runs while retiring 3 batters or fewer...in the **2009 loss** allowed 5 runs in the first inning on homers by Hill (2-run), Wells (solo) and Lind (2-run)...in the calendar year between those 2 starts went 19-9, 4.19...the 19 wins were the second-most in the Major Leagues in that 1-year span (Tor's Roy Halladay, 22-6, 2.49).

<u>Perfect</u>: Began the season 3-0 for the third time in his career but for the first time won his first 3 starts of a season...won his first 2 starts in 2006, when he started off 5-0...began the 2005 campaign 4-0...was the first Reds pitcher to begin the season in the rotation and win his first 3 starts since **LHP Pete Schourek** did it in 1996 and the first righthander since **Jack Armstrong** won his first 5 starts of 1990.

Arroyo's Most Recent Starts: 4/14 at Mil and earned the 6-1 victory (6.1ip, 4h, 1er, 4bb, 3k, 1hr, 105 pitches, 57 strikes)...left leading, 3-1, and the Reds added 3 runs in the ninth inning...allowed only Hardy's solo HR in the second inning...5/6 vs Mil and suffered the 15-3 loss (1ip+4bf, 7h, 9er, 3bb, 0k, 2hr, 46 pitches, 24 strikes)...tied for the shortest start of his career...left trailing, 9-0...in the first inning allowed 5 runs on 2 walks and 4 hits, including a 3-run HR by Hardy...in the second allowed Braun's grand slam...6/24 at Tor and suffered the 8-2 loss (3.2p, 8h, 7r, 6er, 3bb, 2k, 3hr, 93 pitches, 54 strikes)...left trailing, 7-2, with the bases loaded but Burton stranded all 3 runners...in the 5-run first inning allowed a 2-run HR to Hill, a solo HR to Wells and a 2-run HR to Lind...the homers to Hill and Wells were on consecutive pitches...in the second inning allowed a 2-out, RBI-double to Wells...allowed an unearned run in the fourth...6/30 vs Ari and suffered the 6-2 loss (5.1ip, 10h, 6r, 5er, 4bb, 2k, 2hr, 105 pitches, 65 strikes)...left trailing, 6-0...gave up 3 runs in both the third and sixth innings...in the sixth allowed back-to-back HR to Montero (2-run) and pitcher Haren (1st career)...7/5 vs StL and suffered the 10-1 loss (5+ip, 11h, 8r, 5er, 2bb, 2k, 1hr, 89 pitches, 58 strikes)...left trailing, 8-0.... allowed 2 runs in the first inning, 2 in the fourth and 4 in the fifth...7/10 at NYM, in the Reds' first game at new Citi Field threw a 4-hitter in the 3-0 win (9ip, 0bb, 5k, 115 pitches, 75 strikes)...didn't allow a runner to reach second base...was his eighth career complete game and his second career shutout...7/17 vs Mil and in his second-half debut threw 7.0 scoreless innings to earn the 4-0 win (6h, 2bb, 6k, 2hbp, 109 pitches, 63 strikes)...extended his scoreless streak to 16.0 innings innings, 1.0 shy of his career high (17.0ip, 7/2-7/19, 2004)...7/22 at LAD and suffered the 6-2 loss (5.1ip, 5h, 5er, 4bb, 8k, 1hr, 100 pitches, 58 strikes)...left with the score tied, 2-2, but was charged with 3 more runs after Ramirez hit Masset's first pitch for pinch-hit grand slam...allowed a solo HR to Ethier in the first inning, an RBI-bloop triple to Loney in the fourth...**7/28 vs SD** and suffered the 3-2 loss (6.1ip, 9h, 3er, 2bb, 6k, 1hr, 119 pitches, 7-1 strikes)...left with the score tied, 2-2, but was charged with the go-ahead run scored on Kouzmanoff's sac fly off Masset...in the first inning allowed Gwynn's leadoff trip and then Kouzmanoff's RBI-double...in the third allowed a solo HR to AGonzalez...8/2 vs Col and received no decision in the 11-inning, 6-4 loss (7ip, 7h, 3er, 3bb, 1k, 1hr, 114 pitches, 72 strikes)...left trailing, 3-0, but Nix tied it in the bottom of the seventh with a 3-run HR off Marquis...allowed Stewart's solo HR with 2 outs in the fourth inning and 2 more runs on 3 hits in the sixth...8/8 at SF and suffered the 4-2 loss (7ip, 7h, 3er, 0bb, 2k, 1hr, 102 pitches, 71 strikes)...left trailing, 3-2...allowed a pair of RBI-hits to Molina and a solo HR to Velez...8/13 vs Wsh and threw a 2-hitter in the 7-0 victory (1bb, 3k, 103 pitches, 63 strikes)...was his third complete game and second shutout of the season...allowed singles to Dunn in the second inning and to Zimmerman in the seventh...Gomes hit 3 homers...time of game was 2:07.
