### Today's News

Today the Reds are expected to recall from Class AAA Louisville **LHP Matt Maloney** (#56)...a corresponding roster move will be made prior to gametime...**Maloney** went 9-9, 3.08 in 22 starts at Louisville and from 6/6-6/18 went 0-2, 6.11 in 3 starts for the Reds...he is the only lefthanded pitcher to start for the Redlegs this season.

**TODAY'S GAME:** Is **Game 2** (1-0) of a 3-game series vs **Joe Jareck's** Dodgers and **Game 2** (1-0) of a 7-game homestand that also includes an upcoming 4-game set with the **Pirates**...that series vs Pit includes a **day/night doubleheader** on Monday (1:10pm, 7:10pm)...the Reds are coming off a **4-2 road trip** to **Pit** (1-2) and **Mil** (3-0) that included their first 3-game sweep at **Miller Park** since **July 2003**...including today's game the Reds will finish the season with 19g at **Great American Ball Park** and 16g on the road.

**MONDAY'S ROSTER MOVES:** On Monday, **RHP Johnny Cueto** (inflammation, right shoulder) is expected to be reinstated from the 15-day disabled list in time to start the second game of the day/night doubleheader vs the Pirates...the corresponding roster move will be made as necessary.

**DOT. DOT. DOT:** The Reds' season-high **5-game winning streak** is their longest since last year's season-best **6-game winning streak** from 5/12-5/18...last night's 4-2 win snapped Cin's 9-game losing streak to the Dodgers...at **48-0** the Reds club is the National League's only undefeated team when leading after 8 innings...**Joey Votto** is the first Reds first baseman with at least 20 HR and 20 doubles in consecutive seasons since **Sean Casey** accomplished the feat in 1999 & 2000.

**FIRST WATCH:** The Reds have allowed **107 first inning runs**, the most in the Major Leagues and have been outscored in the opening frame, **107-62**...allowed first-inning runs in 52 of their 127g this season.

**HAL MCCOY:** Reds beat writer **Hal McCoy** of the *Dayton Daily News* will retire following this season...he will be honored in a pregame ceremony on **Wed, 9/16**...**McCoy** has worked for the *DDN* for 49 years and is enshrined in the writers' wing of the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown...the longest-tenured baseball beat writer in the country, the 2009 campaign is **McCoy's** 37th covering the Redlegs.

**OPENING DAY LINEUP:** Because of injuries and trades, the Reds will finish the season with just **10g** (5-5) that included the projected **2009 Opening Day** lineup of **C Ramon Hernandez**, **1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips**, **3B Edwin Encarnacion** (traded) **SS Alex Gonzalez** (traded), **RF Jay Bruce**, **CF Willy Taveras** and either **Chris Dickerson** or **Jerry Hairston Jr.** (traded) in LF...Reds manager **Dusty Baker** has produced **106 different lineups** in 127g.

**SURGERIES:** **Seven** Reds players have had surgical procedures this season, including **C Ramon Hernandez** (cleaned out left knee), **SS Alex Gonzalez** (removed loose bodies, right elbow), **RHP Mike Lincoln** (cervical disc replacement), **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder), **IF Danny Richar** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder), **RHP Edinson Volquez** (repaired torn ulnar collateral ligament and torn flexor mass, right elbow) and **RHP Aaron Harang** (appendectomy).

**MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUTS:** Six Reds players made their Major League debuts this season, including **RHP Carlos Fisher**, **LHP Matt Maloney**, **IF Drew Sutton**, **RHP Robert Manuel**, **C Craig Tatum** and **OF Drew Stubbs**...in **2008**, 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts: **RHP Johnny Cueto**, **IF Paul Janish**, **OF Jay Bruce**, **LHP Daniel Ray Herrera**, **RHP Daryl Thompson**, **IF Adam Rosales**, **OF Chris Dickerson**, **RHP Ramon Ramirez**, **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** and **RHP Josh Roenicke**.

**REDS HALL OF FAME:** Through **Wednesday**, Reds fans can vote for the **Reds Hall of Fame Class of 2010** online at [reds.com/HOF](http://reds.com/HOF) or via paper ballot that can be found at the **Hall of Fame and Museum**, the **Reds Community Corner** at **Section 120** in Great American Ball Park or at participating **Skyline Chili** and **Montgomery Inn** locations...the candidates include **Bret Boone**, **Jeff Brantley**, **Norm Charlton**, **John Franco**, **Danny Graves**, **Kevin Mitchell**, **Hal Morris**, **Paul O'Neill**, **Chris Sabo** and **Scott Sullivan**.

**EMMY AWARD:** For the second consecutive year, Reds TV rightsholder **FOX Sports Ohio** has won an **Emmy Award** for its *Reds Live* pre-game show (sports programs category)...congratulations to hosts **Jim Day** and **Jeff Piccoro**, producer **Kent Weaver** and directors **Brian Hunterman** and **Roy Alfes**...FOX Sports Ohio also won an **Emmy** for its **Columbus Blue Jackets** NHL game coverage (live sporting event category).

**REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (27-35 .435):** The Reds are 1-0 on this homestand (1-0 vs LAD)...went **5-12-3 in their previous 20 home series**...produced a winning record on just 2 of their 10 homestands (2-3, 2-4, **3-2**, **6-3**, 1-2, 3-3, 3-3, 2-2, 2-8, 2-5)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **268-280-1**...from 7/28-8/4 lost 8 straight home games, tying the ballpark record for consecutive home losses (8/5-8/16, 2008)...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38).

**REDS ON THE ROAD (29-36 .446):** The Reds' current 4-game road winning streak ties their longest of the season (5/5-5/13)...went 4-2 on their most recent road trip (1-2 at Pit, 3-0 at Mil)...went **9-10-2 in their 21 road series**...produced a winning or .500 record on 6 of their previous 10 road trips (**7-3**, **3-2**, **3-3**, 2-5, 2-4, **3-3**, 2-5, 0-6, **3-3**, **4-2**).

**IN THE STANDINGS (145):** The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 46, FOURTH - 35, FIFTH - 52, SIXTH - 2...at **20-14** and **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g over .500** at **36-24**...at **51-71** were a season-high **20g under .500**...for 5 straight days from **8/22-8/26** faced a season-high **18.5-game deficit**...spent **64** days above, **15** days at and **66** days below .500.

**REDS vs DODGERS:** Reds are 996-1,035 since 1900 vs the Dodgers, including 1-3 in 2009 and 2-10 the last 2 seasons...have lost 9 of the last 10g vs LAD and the last 12g at Dodger Stadium...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 8-13, including 1-0 this season...LA was Cin's only NL opponent with a winning mark at Cinergy Field (123-118)...**at Dodger Stadium:** Reds are 160-184, including 0-3 in each of the last 4 seasons...haven't won there since their final appearance of the 2005 season, a 6-1 victory by **Brandon Claussen** on **7/28/05**...**last Reds sweep:** at Cin: 5/7-5/8, 1996 (2g); 6/12-6/14, 1992 (3g)...at LA: 5/14-5/16, 2004 (3g).

IF Paul Janish pitched in the ninth inning of the 15-3 loss vs Mil on 5/6 (1ip, 5h, 5er, 0bb, 2k, Fielder 2-run HR) and in the eighth inning of the historic 22-1 loss on 7/6 at Phi (1ip, 4h, 6er, 2bb, 1k, Werth grand slam)...he became the first Reds position player to pitch since Lenny Harris on 6/1/98 at SF and the first Reds position player to pitch more than once in a season since OF Mel Queen took the mound 7 times during the second half of the 1966 campaign.				

**Reds Pitchers:** Rank 10th in the National League with a 4.38 staff ERA...**on the homestand are 1-0, 2.00 (9ip, 2er)**...in the 22-1 loss on 7/6 at Phi allowed 22 runs in a game for the first time since a 22-6 loss at Chi on **8/13/37**...the Reds already have 11 team shutouts, their highest total since they had 11sho in 1999...haven't had more than 11 shutouts since 1990, when they threw 12...had 6 shutouts all of last year.

**Reds Starters:** Rank 12th in the National League with a 4.77 rotation ERA...**on the homestand are 1-0, 0.00 (8ip, 0er)**...have produced 60 quality starts (**Arroyo** 16, **Harang** 14, **Cueto** 12, **Owings** 6, **Bailey** 5, **Volquez** 3, **Lehr** 3, **Maloney** 1)...the Reds went 42-18 in those quality starts (.700)...from **6/3-6/10** produced a season-high **7 consecutive quality starts**, their best stretch since they threw 8 consecutive QS from **8/6-8/14, 2005**...through the first 41g of the season used just 5 starting pitchers, their longest such streak to begin a year since **RHP John Roper** became the staff's **sixth** different starter in the **42nd game of the 1994 campaign**...on 5/23 vs Cle, in the club's 42nd game, **RHP Homer Bailey** became the Reds' sixth starting pitcher...**Aaron Harang** threw a 3-hitter in the 2-0 win vs Pit in the club's fifth game of the season...was the earliest complete game by a Reds pitcher since **Pete Harnisch** beat the Cardinals, 3-0 in Busch Stadium, in the **fourth** contest of the **1999** campaign.

**Reds Relievers:** Rank third in the National League with a 3.62 bullpen ERA (LAD 1st, 3.33)...**on the homestand are 0-0, 18.00 (1ip, 2er)**...in 7.1 innings during the 22-1 loss on 7/6 at Phi allowed 13r/12er, the bullpen's highest single-game totals since identical totals in a 16-3 loss on **6/1/98 at SF**...bullpen's ERA excluding that game drops from 3.62 to 3.41 (385.2ip, 146er)...didn't blow a save until the club's 36th game, a 6-5 loss in 16 innings on 5/16 at SD...for the second straight season the Reds' bullpen was the last in the Major Leagues to suffer a blown save...in 2008 didn't blow a save until the 41st game (5/14)...over the last 2 seasons **Cordero** has recorded **62** of the bullpen's **63** saves (34sv in 2008, 28sv in 2009)...**David Weathers** has the club's only other save over the last 2 seasons (6/10/09 at Wsh).

51 JARED BURTON, rhp40g, 0-0-0, 5.32												
Has posted a 3.86era in 9 apps since he was reinstated from the 15-day disabled list (9.1ip, 4er)...from 7/26-8/9 was on the DL with right shoulder fatigue...made rehab apps for Dayton (1g, 1ip, 1h, 0r, 0bb, 3k) and Louisville (2g, 1-0, 2ip, 0h, 0bb, 2k)...began the season with Cin and posted a 6.33era in 20 apps before he was optioned to Louisville on 6/1, when Edinson Volquez came off the disabled list...never left the team and was recalled the next day, when Volquez returned to the disabled list...posted a 2.19era in 9 more apps for the Reds before he was optioned to Louiville on 7/1, when IF Drew Sutton was promoted...returned to Cin on 7/20 and made 2 more apps before he went on the disabled list with the right shoulder injury...overall made 10 apps for Louisville (3-0, 0.82, 11ip, 8h, 1er, 3bb, 10k).

**48 FRANCISCO CORDERO, rhp53g, 2-3-28, 2.06**  
Was an All-Star for the third time (2004 for Tex, 2007 for Mil)...has pitched 4 straight days for the first time since 7/3-7/6, 2008...has pitched in 5 straight games for the first time since he threw in a career-high 6 straight Brewers games from 5/4-5/9, 2007...with 28 saves ranks T5th in the National League...converted 28 of his 30 save opps...including last season has recorded 62 of the bullpen's last 63 saves (34sv in 2008, 28sv in 2009, Weathers 1sv in 2009)...with 239 career saves ranks 29th on that all-time list...Dan Quisenberry is 28th with 244...in the 3-0 victory on 4/22 at Chi recorded his 100th save in the National League to become only the 11th pitcher in history with at least 100 saves in each league (see box).

In the first inning of the 5-2 loss on 8/12 at StL replaced the injured Homer Bailey and threw a career-high 4.1 innings...in his last 21 apps has posted a 2.51era (32.1ip, 9er)...11 times has thrown at least 2.0 innings and 14 times has thrown more than 1.0 inning...in the 11-inning, 4-3 win on 5/24 vs Cle picked up the victory his Major League debut...on 5/21 was promoted from Louisville (13g, 2-0-2, 2.00, 18ip, 11h, 4er, 4bb, 21k, 0hr, .175 opponents' BA).

Last name is pronounced MASS-it...has made a career-high 53 apps...opponents are hitting just .198 (40-202), including .185 by RH batters (24-130)...from 4/28-6/14 produced a career-best 16.2-inning scoreless streak, the second-longest by a Reds pitcher this season (Arroyo 17ip)...from 5/19-5/25 was on the 15-day disabled list with a strained left oblique muscle...posted a 1.23era in 11 apps before his disabling (14.2ip, 2er) and a 3.40era in 42 apps since he came off the DL (42.1ip, 16er).
