Volquez' Surgery

RHP Edinson Volquez this morning had season-ending surgery to repair the torn ulnar collateral ligament ("Tommy John") and torn flexor mass in his right elbow...the 90-minute procedure was performed by Reds medical director Dr. Timothy Kremchek...**Volquez** is expected to miss about 12 months.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 1** (0-0) of a 3-game series vs **Peter Chase's** Cubs and **Game 8** (1-6) of a **10-game homestand**, the Reds' longest of the season (1-3 vs SD, 0-3 vs Col, **3g vs Chi**)...including tonight's game the Reds will finish the season with 30g at **Great American Ball Park** and 28g on the road...following this series the Reds embark on a 6-game road trip to **SF** (3g) and **StL** (3g).

EMMY AWARD: For the second consecutive year, Reds TV rightsholder **FOX Sports Ohio** has won an **Emmy Award** for its *Reds Live* pre-game show (sports programs category)...congratulations to hosts **Jim Day** and **Jeff Piccoro**, producer **Kent Weaver** and directors **Brian Hunterman** and **Roy Alferts**...FOX Sports Ohio also won an **Emmy** for its **Columbus Blue Jackets** NHL game coverage (live sporting event category).

DOT, DOT, DOT: During pre-game ceremonies tonight the Reds will recognize the 2009 Ohio Division II state champion **Ross High School Rams** softball team, coached by **Paul Fernandez**...the Reds are **14 games under .500** and **11.0g out of first place**, both season highs...are **3-14** since the All-Star break...at 40-0 the Reds club is the National League's only undefeated team when leading after 8 innings....**RHP Justin Lehr** today is celebrating his 32nd birthday...Louisville **1B Kevin Barker** was named **International League Player of the Week** (7g, .455, 3hr, 11rbi).

FIRST WATCH: The Reds have allowed **92 first inning runs**, the most in the Major Leagues (SD & Det T2nd, 72), and have been outscored in the opening frame, **92-56**...have allowed first-inning runs in 45 of their 104g this season.

MEDICAL UPDATES: **3B Scott Rolen** showed no signs of a concussion after he was hit in the helmet yesterday by a **Jason Marquis** pitch...he will be examined again before tonight's game...**RHP Jared Burton** (DL, right shoulder fatigue) and **RHP Micah Owings** (DL, tight right shoulder) are scheduled to throw bullpens today...**OF Chris Dickerson** (DL, bruised right rotator cuff) is scheduled to take batting practice today...**OF Willy Taveras** missed the last 4g with a sore left wrist.

BATTING LEADER: **Joey Votto** is hitting .337 but missed 21g while on the disabled list and thus remains 23 plate apps shy of qualifying for the National League leaders...even with an 0-for-23, **Votto** would be hitting .310 to rank among the league leaders.

M*A*S*H: The Reds currently have **9 players on the disabled list**, including 7 players from their **Opening Day Roster:** **C Ramon Hernandez** (left knee surgery), **RF Jay Bruce** (broken right wrist), **OF Chris Dickerson** (bruised right rotator cuff), **RHP Edinson Volquez** (right elbow), **RHP Micah Owings** (tight right shoulder), **RHP Mike Lincoln** (cervical disc replacement surgery) and **RHP Jared Burton** (right shoulder fatigue)...also on the DL are **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (season-ending left shoulder surgery) and **IF Danny Richar** (season-ending left shoulder surgery)...each member of the **Opening Day** starting infield missed extended time because of various ailments, including **SS Alex Gonzalez** (disabled following right elbow surgery), **1B Joey Votto** (disabled with stress/anxiety), **2B Brandon Phillips** (hairline fracture, right thumb) and since-traded **3B Edwin Encarnacion** (disabled with a chip fracture in his left wrist).

OPENING DAY LINEUP: Because of injuries and trades, the Reds will finish the season with just **10g** (5-5) that included the projected **2009 Opening Day** lineup of **C Ramon Hernandez, 1B Joey Votto, 2B Brandon Phillips, 3B Edwin Encarnacion, SS Alex Gonzalez, RF Jay Bruce, CF Willy Taveras** and either **Chris Dickerson** or **Jerry Hairston Jr.** in LF...Reds manager **Dusty Baker** has produced **84 different lineups** in 104g.

SURGERIES: Six Reds players have had surgical procedures this season, including **C Ramon Hernandez** (cleaned out left knee), **SS Alex Gonzalez** (removed loose bodies, right elbow), **RHP Mike Lincoln** (cervical disc replacement), **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder), **IF Danny Richar** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder) and **RHP Edinson Volquez** (repaired torn ulnar collateral ligament and torn flexor mass)...**Castillo, Richar** and **Volquez** will not play again the rest of the season.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (23-28 .451): The Reds have lost their last 6 home games, their longest skid of the season at GABP...went **5-9-3 in their previous 17 home series**...including this one produced a winning record on just 2 of their 9 homestands (2-3, 2-4, **3-2, 6-3**, 1-2, 3-3, 3-3, 2-2, 1-6)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **264-273-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38)...**at 217-217-1** the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since **6/26/04** (57-57)...also reached .500 at **219-219-1**.

REDS ON THE ROAD (22-31, .407): The Reds went 0-6 on their most recent road trip (0-3 at LAD, 0-3 at Chi)...have lost their last 8 road games, a season high, and 10 of their last 11 road games...went **7-8-2 in their 17 road series**...produced a winning or .500 record on 4 of their 8 road trips (**7-3, 3-2, 3-3**, 2-5, 2-4, **3-3**, 2-5, 0-6)...entering this season and dating to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

JET LAG: The Reds' next road trip (3g at SF, 3g at StL) will include the third of their 3 scheduled visits to the **West Coast**...are **0-6** on the **West Coast** so far this season (0-3 at SD, 0-3 at LAD)...over the last 4 seasons the Redlegs are **11-31 (.262) on the West Coast** (0-12 at LAD, 4-9 at SD, 5-6 at SF, 1-2 at Oak, 1-2 at Sea).

IN THE STANDINGS (119): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 46, FOURTH - 35, FIFTH - 27, SIXTH - 1...at **20-14** and **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g over .500** at **36-24**...at **45-59** are **14g under .500** and **11.0g out of first place**, both season highs...have spent **64** days above, **15** days at and **40** days below .500.

REDS vs CUBS: The Reds are 1,050-1,081 all-time vs the Cubs, including 982-1,010 since 1900 and 3-6 this season...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 25-26, including 1-2 this season...4 Cubs batters rank in the Top 7 in home runs by an opponent at Great American Ball Park (**Lance Berkman** 21, **Albert Pujols** 15, **Jason Bay** 14, **Aramis Ramirez** 12, **Derrek Lee** 12, **Alfonso Soriano** 11, **Sammy Sosa** 10).

Last Started: Wed vs SD and suffered the 7-1 loss (7+ip, 9H, 7er, 4bb, 5k, 2hr, 120 pitches, 76 strikes)...left trailing, 5-1, but was charged with a pair of runs scored off Roenicke...in the first inning allowed 5 runs on 4 hits, including a 2-run HR by AGonzalez and a 3-run HR by Blanks...Reds batters were held to 1 hit, a solo HR by Hairston Jr..

Red Hots: Is making his 23rd start of the season, his third of the year vs the Cubs...with 11 quality starts ranks third on the staff behind **Bronson Arroyo** (12qs) and **Johnny Cueto** (12qs)...in his previous 22 starts the **Reds** went 9-13 and scored 80 runs (3.64 r/g)...in his 22 starts **Reds batters** hit .239 (176-737)...on 6/4 at StL suffered the 3-1 loss in a game in which **Harang** and **Chris Carpenter** each threw a complete game.

Streaking: Earned his last victory on **5/25**...in 12 starts since then is **0-8, 5.56** (69.2ip, 43er)...the 8-game losing streak is a career-high and the longest by a Reds pitcher in a season since **Danny Graves** finished the 2003 campaign **0-8** (7/5-9/2, 2003)...no Reds pitcher has lost more than 8 consecutive decisions in a season since **Tom Hume's** 9-game skid from **4/19-7/4, 1978**...**Graves** did lost 10 straight decisions over 2 seasons from **7/5/03-4/27/04** (0-8, 0-2).

Home Cookin': Is **4-5, 3.57** (68ip, 27er, 9hr) in 11 starts at Great American Ball Park and **1-7, 5.45** (66ip, 40er, 12hr) in 10 starts on the road.

Staff Ace: Since he was acquired from the Athletics at the **2003 trading deadline** is the Reds' leader in most statistical pitching categories, including starts (189), wins (68), innings pitched (1203.0) and strikeouts (1,016)...since the beginning of the **2006 season** ranks second in the National League **784.1** innings pitched (**Bronson Arroyo** 1st, 789ip)...in 2005 and 2007 won the BBWAA's Johnny Vander Meer Award as the club's Most Outstanding Pitcher.

Long Balls: From 4/28-6/4 allowed a home run in 8 consecutive apps (10hr), the longest streak by a Reds pitcher since **RHP Ramon Ortiz** tied the National League record by allowing a home run in **15** consecutive apps from 5/1-7/17, 2005.

Community Affairs: Is one of the club's more active members of the local community...for the third straight season, as part of his **Aaron's Aces** ticket program is hosting at all Sunday home games children of military personnel serving in the **War On Terrorism**...along with wife **Jen** donated \$55,000 to the **Miracle League of Greater Cincinnati and Northern Kentucky** and on 5/9 attended the dedication of that field at the **Durham Recreation Complex** in Western Hills...for his community service has been the club's nominee for the **Robert Clemente Award** (2007), **Branch Rickey Award** (2007) and **Marvin Miller Man of the Year Award** (2007, 2008).

Career Highs: Innings: 10.0 (longest), 7/23/07 vs Mil & 1.0 (shortest, 2x), 9/5/03 at StL & 7/28/07 vs Chi; **Hits:** 14, 9/28/05 at Mil; **Runs:** 9, 4/3/06 vs Chi; **Earned runs:** 8 (3x), last on 5/30/09 at Mil; **Walks:** 7, 7/8/08 for Cin at Chi; **Strikeouts:** 13, 9/29/07 vs Chi; **HR allowed:** 4 (3x), last on 8/19/07 at Mil (Braun solo, Hall 2-run, Fielder 2-run, Hardy solo); **Complete Games:** 13, last on 6/4/09 for Cin at StL (3-1 loss); **Shutouts:** 6, last on 4/12/09 for Cin vs Pit (2-0 win).

Tomorrow's Pitcher: RHP Johnny Cueto

Last Pitched: Thu vs SD and suffered the 7-4 loss (5ip, 9h, 6er, 2bb, 13k, 1hr, 96 pitches, 58 strikes)...left trailing, 6-1...allowed solo runs in the first and second innings and then 4 runs in the fifth on Headley's RBI-double and Venable's 3-run HR.

Red Hots: The 23-year-old righthander tomorrow will make his 22nd start of the season, his third of the year vs the Cubs...in his 21 starts the Reds went 11-10 and scored 80 runs (3.81 r/g)...in 9 of his 21 starts threw at least 7.0 innings and in 16 of his 21 starts threw at least 6.0 innings...with 12 quality starts is tied with **Bronson Arroyo** for the staff lead.

Streaking: Through 16 starts on 7/1 was 8-4, 2.69...**in 5 starts since then is 0-4, 10.32** (22.2ip, 26er)...the 4-game losing streak is the longest of his young career.

Home Cookin'...For the season is **2-3, 4.20** in 9 starts at home (55.2ip, 26er, 8hr) and **6-5, 3.95** in 12 starts on the road (70.2ip, 31er, 10hr).
