### Double Dipping

The starting times for tomorrow's day/night doubleheader here vs the Pirates are 1:10 and 7:10 p.m. ET...both games will be broadcast on 700 WLW Radio, as always, and FOX Sports Ohio...the Redlegs and Buccos were rained out on 4/10, the fourth game of the season...the Reds last played a doubleheader on 5/10/08 at NYM (12-6 loss, 7-1 win) and last played a DH at home on 7/2/05 vs Hou (4-3 Astros win, 11-6 Reds win)...the Reds and Pirates last played a double dip in the Queen City on 7/2/93 at Riverfront Stadium (10-9 Pirates win, 9-1 Reds win).

**TODAY'S GAME:** Is Game 3 (1-1) of a 3-game series vs Joe Jareck's Dodgers and Game 3 (1-1) of a 7-game homestand that includes a 4-game set with the Pirates beginning tomorrow...including today's game the Reds will finish the season with 18g at Great American Ball Park and 16g on the road.

**AARON'S ACES:** This afternoon Aaron Harang is hosting 30 fans in sun deck Section 143 as part of his Aaron's Aces program targeting local military families...guests receive an autographed t-shirt, in-stadium welcomes via the public address announcer and scoreboard and a \$10 concession voucher...when he is not scheduled to pitch, Aaron meets the guests in the bullpen...fans with family members currently on active duty or who recently returned from active duty can sign up online at [www.reds.com/community](http://www.reds.com/community), then click on ticket programs.

**TOMORROW'S ROSTER MOVES:** RHP Johnny Cueto (inflammation, right shoulder) is expected to be reinstated from the 15-day disabled list in time to start the second game of tomorrow's day/night doubleheader vs the Pirates...the corresponding roster move will be made as necessary.

**DOT, DOT, DOT:** Yesterday's 11-4 loss snapped the Reds' season-high 5-game winning streak...Fri's 4-2 win snapped Cin's 9-game losing streak to the Dodgers...at 48-0 the Reds club is the National League's only undefeated team when leading after 8 innings.

**FIRST WATCH:** The Reds have allowed 109 first inning runs, the most in the Major Leagues and have been outscored in the opening frame, 109-62...allowed first-inning runs in 53 of their 128g this season.

**HAL McCOY:** Reds beat writer Hal McCoy of the *Dayton Daily News* will retire following this season...he will be honored in a pregame ceremony on Wed, 9/16...McCoy has worked for the DDN for 49 years and is enshrined in the writers' wing of the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown...the longest-tenured baseball beat writer in the country, the 2009 campaign is McCoy's 37th covering the Redlegs.

**OPENING DAY LINEUP:** Because of injuries and trades, the Reds will finish the season with just 10g (5-5) that included the projected 2009 Opening Day lineup of C Ramon Hernandez, 1B Joey Votto, 2B Brandon Phillips, 3B Edwin Encarnacion (traded) SS Alex Gonzalez (traded), RF Jay Bruce, CF Willy Taveras and either Chris Dickerson or Jerry Hairston Jr. (traded) in LF...Reds manager Dusty Baker has produced 106 different lineups in 128g.

**SURGERIES:** Seven Reds players have had surgical procedures this season, including C Ramon Hernandez (cleaned out left knee), SS Alex Gonzalez (removed loose bodies, right elbow), RHP Mike Lincoln (cervical disc replacement), C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder), IF Danny Richar (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder), RHP Edinson Volquez (repaired torn ulnar collateral ligament and torn flexor mass, right elbow) and RHP Aaron Harang (appendectomy).

**MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUTS:** Six Reds players made their Major League debuts this season, including RHP Carlos Fisher, LHP Matt Maloney, IF Drew Sutton, RHP Robert Manuel, C Craig Tatum and OF Drew Stubbs...in 2008, 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts: RHP Johnny Cueto, IF Paul Janish, OF Jay Bruce, LHP Daniel Ray Herrera, RHP Daryl Thompson, IF Adam Rosales, OF Chris Dickerson, RHP Ramon Ramirez, C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo and RHP Josh Roenicke.

**REDS HALL OF FAME:** Through Wednesday, Reds fans can vote for the Reds Hall of Fame Class of 2010 online at [reds.com/HOF](http://reds.com/HOF) or via paper ballot that can be found at the Hall of Fame and Museum, the Reds Community Corner at Section 120 in Great American Ball Park or at participating Skyline Chili and Montgomery Inn locations...the candidates include Bret Boone, Jeff Brantley, Norm Charlton, John Franco, Danny Graves, Kevin Mitchell, Hal Morris, Paul O'Neill, Chris Sabo and Scott Sullivan.

**REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (27-36 .429):** The Reds are 1-1 on this homestand (1-1 vs LAD)...went 5-12-3 in their previous 20 home series...produced a winning record on just 2 of their 10 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3, 1-2, 3-3, 3-3, 2-2, 2-8, 2-5)...in 7 seasons at GABP are 268-281-1...from 7/28-8/4 lost 8 straight home games, tying the ballpark record for consecutive home losses (8/5-8/16, 2008).

**REDS ON THE ROAD (29-36 .446):** The Reds' current 4-game road winning streak ties their longest of the season (5/5-5/13)...went 4-2 on their most recent road trip (1-2 at Pit, 3-0 at Mil)...went 9-10-2 in their 21 road series...produced a winning or .500 record on 6 of their previous 10 road trips (7-3, 3-2, 3-3, 2-5, 2-4, 3-3, 2-5, 0-6, 3-3, 4-2).

**IN THE STANDINGS (146):** The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 46, FOURTH - 35, FIFTH - 53, SIXTH - 2...at 20-14 and 26-20 were a season-high 6g over .500...prior to this season hadn't been 6g over .500 since 2006, when they reached a season-high 12g over .500 at 36-24...at 51-71 were a season-high 20g under .500...for the sixth time are a season-high 18.5-game out of first place...have spent 64 days above, 15 days at and 67 days below .500.

**REDS vs DODGERS:** Reds are 996-1,036 since 1900 vs the Dodgers, including 1-4 in 2009 and 2-11 the last 2 seasons...have lost 10 of the last 11g & 21 of the last 25g vs LAD and the last 12g at Dodger Stadium...at Great American Ball Park: Reds are 8-14, including 1-1 this season...LA was Cin's only NL opponent with a winning mark at Cinergy Field (123-118).

**UP NEXT: REDS vs PIRATES:** The Reds are 972-1,020 all-time vs the Pirates, including 4-4 this season...at Great American Ball Park: Reds are 26-29 all-time, including 1-1 this season...at PNC Park: Reds are 34-33 all-time, including 3-3 this season.

Wins Beginning 6/29/08

In the 14-1 loss on 6/24/08 at Tor, **Bronson Arroyo** made the shortest start of his career and became only the sixth starting pitcher in Major League history to allow at least 10 earned runs in a game in which he retired 3 batters or fewer (1+ip, 11h, 10er)...beginning with his next start, a 9-5 win at Cle on 6/29/08, **Arroyo** has 22 wins, tied for fourth-most in the Major Leagues since then:

Since he was acquired by the Reds prior to the 2006 season, **Bronson Arroyo** ranks among the Major League leaders in games started and innings pitched:

**Last Pitched:** Tue at Mil and was a victim of a blown save in the 13-inning, 8-6 victory (7ip, 6h, 1er, 1bb, 4k, 1hr, 116 pitches, 73 strikes)...left leading, 6-1, but the Brewers scored 5 runs in the ninth off Burton, Rhodes and Cordero...in the third inning allowed a 2-out, solo HR to Lopez on the ninth pitch of the at bat.

**Red Hots:** Is making his 27th start of the season...his 22 wins beginning 6/29/08 are tied for fourth-most in the Major Leagues (see box to the left)...in his previous 26 starts the Reds went 12-14 and scored 100 runs (3.85 r/g).

**Quality:** Leads the pitching staff with 16 quality starts...produced QS in each of his last 6 apps (1-3, 2.23, 44.1ip, 11er), the longest streak of quality starts by a Reds pitcher this season...last year, **Edinson Volquez** produced a team-best string of 12 straight QS (4/22-6/20).

**As Luck Would Have It.....:** Went **9-8, 5.38** in 18 starts before the All-Star break...in the second half is **2-4** in 8 starts despite a sterling **2.54era**.

**Zerooes:** From **8/8-8/19** put together a **17.0-inning scoreless streak**, the

longest by a Reds pitcher this season and tying his career high (7/2-7/19, 2004).

**Workhorse:** Since he was acquired by the Reds prior to the 2006 season leads all Major League pitchers with 129 starts and leads the National League with **820.0 innings pitched**...teammate **Aaron Harang** ranks second in that span with **812.2ip**.

**In The Big Inning:** Allowed at least 1 run in the first inning of 12 of his 26 starts...has posted an 7.96era in the first inning (26ip, 23er) and a 3.79era after the first frame (142.2ip, 60er).

**Career Highs:** **Innings:** 9.0 (longest, 8x), last on 8/13/09 for Cin vs Wsh & 1+4bf (shortest, 2x), 6/24/08 for Cin at Tor & 5/6/09 for Cin vs Mil; **Hits:** 13, 9/26/08 for Cin at StL; **Runs:** 10 (2x), 6/23/00 for Pit at NYM & 6/24/08 for Cin at Tor; **Earned Runs:** 10, 6/24/08 for Cin at Tor; **Walks:** 5 (4x), last on 8/20/08 at Chi; **Strikeouts:** 12, 7/19/04 for Bos at Sea; **HR allowed:** 4, 4/7/08 vs Phi (Rollins leadoff, Burrell 2, Jenkins); **Complete Games:** 9, last on 8/13/09 for Cin vs Wsh (7-0 win); **Shutouts:** 3, last on 8/13/09 for Cin vs Wsh (7-0 win).

## Tomorrow’s Game 1: RHP RHP Kip Wells

**Last Pitched:** Wed at Mil, in his first start since 7/21/08 received no decision in the 10-inning, 4-3 victory (5ip, 7h, 3er, 3bb, 2k, 2hr, 1hbp, 97 pitches, 55 strikes)...left trailing, 3-2, but the Reds tied it in the eighth inning and won it in the 10th...allowed all 3 runs on a pair of home runs in the fifth inning, a solo HR to Gerut with 1 out and a 2-out, 2-run HR to Fielder.

**Red Hots:** Media guide bio is in the press box...tomorrow will make his fifth appearance and second start for the Reds...Wed’s appearance at Mil was his first Major League start since 7/21/08, snapping a string of 66 consecutive relief apps for the Rockies, Royals, Nationals and Reds.

**Wells vs Pirates:** In his career vs Pit is **3-1, 2.73** in 3 starts and 4 relief apps...last pitched vs the Pirates on 8/21 at PNC Park, in relief received no decision in the 5-2 Reds loss (2ip, 3k, 26 pitches, 18 strikes).

**2009 Season:** Was signed by the Nationals during spring training...began the season at Class AAA Syracuse and was promoted on 4/20 after posting a 2.45era in 2 starts...from 5/31-6/14 was on Wsh’s disabled list with a strained right shoulder...was released on 7/6 and the next day was signed by the Reds to a minor league contract...was assigned to Class AAA Louisville and posted a 3.07 in 1 start and 4 relief apps before he was promoted on 7/31, along with RHP Justin Lehr, when the Reds traded IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr. to the Yankees and 3B Edwin Encarnacion and RHP Josh Roenicke to the Blue Jays...made his Reds debut on 8/10 at StL after Cueto left in the second inning with an injury.

## Tomorrow’s Game 2: RHP Johnny Cueto
