TONIGHT'S GAME: Is Game 2 (0-1) of a 3-game series vs Jonathan Veremis' Cubs and Game 9 (1-7) of a 10-game homestand, the Reds' longest of the season (1-3 vs SD, 0-3 vs Col, 0-1 vs Chi)...including tonight's game the Reds will finish the season with 29g at Great American Ball Park and 28g on the road...following this series the Reds embark on a 6-game road trip to SF (3g) and StL (3g).

<u>POT, DOT.</u> During pre-game ceremonies tonight the Reds will recognize the 2009 Ohio Division I state champion **Archbishop Moeller High School** baseball team...coached by **Tim Held**, the Crusaders won their **fifth state title**... **Astronaut Greg Johnson**, who in May piloted a space shuttle mission to the **Hubble Space Telescope**, will throw out a ceremonial first pitch...at **45-60** the Reds are **15 games under .500** and **11.5g out of first place**, both season highs...are **3-15** since the All-Star break...at **40-0** the Reds club is the National League's only undefeated team when leading after 8 innings.

FIRST WATCH: The Reds have allowed 92 first inning runs, the most in the Major Leagues (Bal 75, SD 73), and have been outscored in the opening frame, 92-56...have allowed first-inning runs in 45 of their 105g this season.

MEDICAL UPDATES: 3B Scott Rolen showed no signs of a concussion after he was hit in the helmet Sun by a Jason Marquis pitch...an MRI was normal...he did not play last night but will be examined again before tonight's game...RHP Jared Burton (DL, right shoulder fatigue) could begin a rehab assignment in the next couple days...RHP Micah Owings (DL, tight right shoulder) will throw a 75-pitch simulated game tomorrow...OF Chris Dickerson (DL, bruised right rotator cuff) is scheduled to take normal batting practice again today.

BATTING LEADER: **Joey Votto** is hitting .335 but missed 21g while on the disabled list and thus remains 23 plate apps shy of qualifying for the National League leaders...even with an 0-for-23, **Votto** would be hitting .310 to rank among the league leaders.

<u>M*A*S*H</u>: The Reds currently have **9 players on the disabled list**, including 7 players from their **Opening Day** roster: **C Ramon Hernandez** (left knee surgery), **RF Jay Bruce** (broken right wrist), **OF Chris Dickerson** (bruised right rotator cuff), **RHP Edinson Volquez** (right elbow surgery), **RHP Micah Owings** (tight right shoulder), **RHP Mike Lincoln** (cervical disc replacement surgery) and **RHP Jared Burton** (right shoulder fatigue)...also on the DL are **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (season-ending left shoulder surgery) and **IF Danny Richar** (season-ending left shoulder surgery).

<u>OPENING DAY LINEUP</u>: Because of injuries and trades, the Reds will finish the season with just **10g** (5-5) that included the projected **2009 Opening Day** lineup of C Ramon Hernandez, **1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips**, **3B Edwin Encarnacion**, **SS Alex Gonzalez**, **RF Jay Bruce**, **CF Willy Taveras** and either **Chris Dickerson** or **Jerry Hairston Jr.** in LF...Reds manager **Dusty Baker** has produced **85 different lineups** in 105g.

<u>SURGERIES</u>: Six Reds players have had surgical procedures this season, including **C** Ramon Hernandez (cleaned out left knee), **SS** Alex Gonzalez (removed loose bodies, right elbow), **RHP Mike Lincoln** (cervical disc replacement), **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder), **IF Danny Richar** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder) and **RHP Edinson Volquez** (repaired torn ulnar collateral ligament and torn flexor mass, right elbow)...**Castillo**, **Richar** and **Volquez** will not play again the rest of the season.

EMMY AWARD: For the second consecutive year, Reds TV rightsholder **FOX Sports Ohio** has won an **Emmy Award** for its *Reds Live* pre-game show (sports programs category)...congratulations to hosts **Jim Day** and **Jeff Piecoro**, producer **Kent Weaver** and directors **Brian Hunterman** and **Roy Alfers**...FOX Sports Ohio also won an **Emmy** for its **Columbus Blue Jackets** NHL game coverage (live sporting event category).

REDS HALL OF FAME: Through September 2, Reds fans can vote for the Reds Hall of Fame Class of 2010 online at reds.com/HOF or via paper ballot that can be found at the Hall of Fame and Museum, the Reds Community Corner at Section 120 in Great American Ball Park or at participating Skyline Chili locations...the candiates include Bret Boone, Jeff Brantley, Norm Charlton, John Franco, Danny Graves, Kevin Mitchell, Hal Morris, Paul O'Neill, Chris Sabo and Scott Sullivan.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (23-29.442): The Reds have lost their last 7 home games, their longest skid of the season at GABP...went 5-9-3 in their previous 17 home series...including this one produced a winning record on 2 of their 9 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3, 1-2, 3-3, 3-3, 2-2, 1-7)...in 7 seasons at GABP are 264-274-1.

REDS ON THE ROAD (22-31, .407): The Reds went 0-6 on their most recent road trip (0-3 at LAD, 0-3 at Chi)...have lost their last 8 road games, a season high, and 10 of their last 11 road games...went 7-8-2 in their 17 road series... produced a winning or .500 record on 4 of their 8 road trips (7-3, 3-2, 3-3, 2-5, 2-4, 3-3, 2-5, 0-6)...entering this season and dating to 2006, the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips.

<u>JET LAG</u>: The Reds' next road trip (3g at SF, 3g at StL) will include the third of their 3 scheduled visits to the **West Coast**...are **0-6** on the **West Coast** so far this season (0-3 at SD, 0-3 at LAD)...over the last 4 seasons the Redlegs are **11-31** (.262) on the **West Coast** (0-12 at LAD, 4-9 at SD, 5-6 at SF, 1-2 at Oak, 1-2 at Sea).

IN THE STANDINGS (120): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 46, FOURTH - 35, FIFTH - 28, SIXTH - 1...at 20-14 and 26-20 were a season-high 6g over .500...prior to this season hadn't been 6g over .500 since 2006, when they reached a season-high 12g over .500 at 36-24...at 45-60 are 15g under .500 and 11.5g out of first place, both season highs...have spent 64 days above, 15 days at and 41 days below .500.

REDS vs CUBS: The Reds are 1,050-1,082 all-time vs the Cubs, including 982-1,011 since 1900 and 3-7 this season... at Great American Ball Park: Reds are 25-27, including 1-3 this season...4 Cubs batters rank in the Top 7 in home runs by an opponent at Great American Ball Park (Lance Berkman 21, Albert Pujols 15, Jason Bay 14, Aramis Ramirez 12, Derrek Lee 12, Alfonso Soriano 11, Sammy Sosa 10)...last Cubs sweep: at Cin: 4/26-4/27, 1995 (2g); 5/28-5/30, 2001 (3g)...at Chi: 7/21-7/22, 2004 (2g); 7/24-7/26, 2009 (3g).

Streaking

The Reds' current **7-game losing streak**, all at home, is 1 shy of the **Great American Ball Park record** (8g, 8/5-8/16, 2008) and their longest overall since an **0-7** stretch from **9/22-9/29**, **2007...**haven't lost more than 7 straight games since an **8-game skid** from **4/27-5/6**, **2005...**during this current streak the Reds have posted a **5.26** team ERA (65ip, 38er) while hitting **.181** (41-226) with **18 runs scored** (2.57 r/g).

Last Pitched: Thu vs SD and suffered the 7-4 loss (5ip, 9h, 6er, 2bb, 3k, 1hr, 96 pitches, 58 strikes)...left trailing, 6-1...allowed solo runs in the first and second innings and then 4 runs in the fifth on Headley's RBI-double and Venable's 3-run HR

Red Hots: The 23-year-old righthander is making his 22nd start of the season, his third of the year vs the Cubs...in his 21 starts the Reds went 11-10 and scored 80 runs (3.81 r/g)...in 9 of his 21 starts threw at least 7.0 innings and in 16 of his 21 starts threw at least 6.0 innings.

Quality: With 12 quality starts is tied with **Bronson Arroyo** for the staff lead...his 2 strings of 5 consecutive QS (4/22-5/13, 5/24-6/14) are the longest stretches of quality starts by a Reds pitcher this season...last year, **Edinson Volquez** produced a string of 12 straight QS (4/22-6/20).

Streaking: Through 16 starts on 7/1 was 8-4, 2.69...in 5 starts since then is 0-4, 10.32 (22.2ip, 26er)...the 4-game losing streak is the longest of his young career...in 5 starts from 4/22-5/13 went 4-0, 1.25 (36ip, 5er)...the 4-game winning streak was the longest of his career...in each of 4 starts from 4/22-5/8 threw at least 7.0 innings while allowing no more than 1 run, the longest streak of that kind by a Reds pitcher since Tim Belcher had a 4-game run from 5/27-6/13, 1992 (courtesy Elias Sports Bureau).

Home Cookin'...For the season is **2-3**, **4.20** in 9 starts at home (55.2ip, 26er, 8hr) and **6-5**, **3.95** in 12 starts on the road (70.2ip, 31er, 10hr).

World Baseball Classic: Started the Dominican Republic's second game of the tournament and threw 4.2 scoreless innings to earn the 9-0 win vs Panama in the San Juan bracket (4.2ip, 3h, 1bb, 5k).

Last Pitched: Fri vs Col and received no decision in the 5-3 loss (5ip, 4h, 3er, 6bb, 0k, 0hr, 97 pitches, 52 strikes)...left with the score tied, 3-3...was his first Major League appearance since **5/22/06 for Mil at Cin** and his first career big league start...in the first inning allowed 2 runs on 3 hits, a walk and an error.

Red Hots: Last name is pronounced LERR...tomorrow will make his second start of the season..recorded his last Major League victory on 5/18/06 vs Phi (5-4 Brewers win)...media guide bio is available in the press box.

2009 Season: In December was signed by the Phillies to a minor league contract and began the season with Class AAA Lehigh Valley (8g, 7gs, 5-2, 4.75)...on 5/22 was traded to the Reds in exchange for cash...went 8-1, 2.51 in 11 starts and 1 relief appearance at Class AAA Louisville before he was promoted on 8/1 to take the spot in the rotation vacated by **RHP Micah Owings**, who went on the disabled list with a tight right shoulder...overall at Class AAA went **13-3**, **3.31** in 18 starts and 2 relief apps...when promoted, his 13 victories tied for the most among all minor league pitchers...twice was International League Pitcher of the Week, from **4/13-4/19** for Lehigh Valley (2gs, 2-0, 1.59) and from **7/20-7/26** for Louisville (2gs, 2-0, 1.88).

<u>Career Highlights</u>: Prior to this season had made all 66 of his Major League apps in relief...was International League Pitcher of the Week twice in 2009 and once in 2008...in 2007 was a Pacific Coast League All-Star and started the Triple-A All-Star Game...in 2000 was a California League All-Star.
