#### Streaking

The Reds' current **7-game losing streak**, all at home, is 1 shy of the **Great American Ball Park record** (8g, 8/5-8/16, 2008) and their longest overall since an **0-7** stretch from **9/22-9/29, 2007**...haven't lost more than 7 straight games since an **8-game skid** from **4/27-5/6, 2005**...during this current streak the Reds have posted a **5.26** team ERA (65ip, 38er) while hitting **.181** (41-226) with **18 runs scored** (2.57 r/g).

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** Is **Game 2** (0-1) of a 3-game series vs **Jonathan Veremis'** Cubs and **Game 9** (1-7) of a **10-game homestand**, the Reds' longest of the season (1-3 vs SD, 0-3 vs Col, **0-1 vs Chi**)...including tonight's game the Reds will finish the season with 29g at **Great American Ball Park** and 28g on the road...following this series the Reds embark on a 6-game road trip to **SF** (3g) and **StL** (3g).

**DOT, DOT, DOT:** During pre-game ceremonies tonight the Reds will recognize the 2009 Ohio Division I state champion **Archbishop Moeller High School** baseball team...coached by **Tim Held**, the Crusaders won their **fifth state title**... **Astronaut Greg Johnson**, who in May piloted a space shuttle mission to the **Hubble Space Telescope**, will throw out a ceremonial first pitch...at **45-60** the Reds are **15 games under .500** and **11.5g out of first place**, both season highs...are **3-15** since the All-Star break...at **40-0** the Reds club is the National League's only undefeated team when leading after 8 innings.

**FIRST WATCH:** The Reds have allowed **92 first inning runs**, the most in the Major Leagues (Bal 75, SD 73), and have been outscored in the opening frame, **92-56**...have allowed first-inning runs in 45 of their 105g this season.

**MEDICAL UPDATES:** **3B Scott Rolen** showed no signs of a concussion after he was hit in the helmet Sun by a **Jason Marquis** pitch...an MRI was normal...he did not play last night but will be examined again before tonight's game...**RHP Jared Burton** (DL, right shoulder fatigue) could begin a rehab assignment in the next couple days...**RHP Micah Owings** (DL, tight right shoulder) will throw a 75-pitch simulated game tomorrow...**OF Chris Dickerson** (DL, bruised right rotator cuff) is scheduled to take normal batting practice again today.

**BATTING LEADER:** **Joey Votto** is hitting .335 but missed 21g while on the disabled list and thus remains 23 plate apps shy of qualifying for the National League leaders...even with an 0-for-23, **Votto** would be hitting .310 to rank among the league leaders.

**M\*A\*S\*H:** The Reds currently have **9 players on the disabled list**, including 7 players from their **Opening Day** roster: **C Ramon Hernandez** (left knee surgery), **RF Jay Bruce** (broken right wrist), **OF Chris Dickerson** (bruised right rotator cuff), **RHP Edinson Volquez** (right elbow surgery), **RHP Micah Owings** (tight right shoulder), **RHP Mike Lincoln** (cervical disc replacement surgery) and **RHP Jared Burton** (right shoulder fatigue)...also on the DL are **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (season-ending left shoulder surgery) and **IF Danny Richar** (season-ending left shoulder surgery).

**OPENING DAY LINEUP:** Because of injuries and trades, the Reds will finish the season with just **10g** (5-5) that included the projected **2009 Opening Day** lineup of **C Ramon Hernandez**, **1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips**, **3B Edwin Encarnacion**, **SS Alex Gonzalez**, **RF Jay Bruce**, **CF Willy Taveras** and either **Chris Dickerson** or **Jerry Hairston Jr.** in LF...Reds manager **Dusty Baker** has produced **85 different lineups** in 105g.

**SURGERIES:** Six Reds players have had surgical procedures this season, including **C Ramon Hernandez** (cleaned out left knee), **SS Alex Gonzalez** (removed loose bodies, right elbow), **RHP Mike Lincoln** (cervical disc replacement), **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder), **IF Danny Richar** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder) and **RHP Edinson Volquez** (repaired torn ulnar collateral ligament and torn flexor mass, right elbow)...**Castillo**, **Richar** and **Volquez** will not play again the rest of the season.

**EMMY AWARD:** For the second consecutive year, Reds TV rightsholder **FOX Sports Ohio** has won an **Emmy Award** for its *Reds Live* pre-game show (sports programs category)...congratulations to hosts **Jim Day** and **Jeff Piecoro**, producer **Kent Weaver** and directors **Brian Hunterman** and **Roy Alferts**...FOX Sports Ohio also won an **Emmy** for its **Columbus Blue Jackets** NHL game coverage (live sporting event category).

**REDS HALL OF FAME:** Through September 2, Reds fans can vote for the **Reds Hall of Fame Class of 2010** online at [reds.com/HOF](http://reds.com/HOF) or via paper ballot that can be found at the **Hall of Fame and Museum**, the **Reds Community Corner** at **Section 120** in Great American Ball Park or at participating **Skyline Chili** locations...the candidates include **Bret Boone**, **Jeff Brantley**, **Norm Charlton**, **John Franco**, **Danny Graves**, **Kevin Mitchell**, **Hal Morris**, **Paul O'Neill**, **Chris Sabo** and **Scott Sullivan**.

**REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (23-29 .442):** The Reds have lost their last 7 home games, their longest skid of the season at GABP...went **5-9-3 in their previous 17 home series**...including this one produced a winning record on 2 of their 9 homestands (2-3, 2-4, **3-2, 6-3**, 1-2, 3-3, 3-3, 2-2, 1-7)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **264-274-1**.

**REDS ON THE ROAD (22-31 .407):** The Reds went 0-6 on their most recent road trip (0-3 at LAD, 0-3 at Chi)...have lost their last 8 road games, a season high, and 10 of their last 11 road games...went **7-8-2 in their 17 road series**...produced a winning or .500 record on 4 of their 8 road trips (**7-3, 3-2, 3-3**, 2-5, 2-4, **3-3**, 2-5, 0-6)...entering this season and dating to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

**JET LAG:** The Reds' next road trip (3g at SF, 3g at StL) will include the third of their 3 scheduled visits to the **West Coast**...are **0-6** on the **West Coast** so far this season (0-3 at SD, 0-3 at LAD)...over the last 4 seasons the Redlegs are **11-31 (.262) on the West Coast** (0-12 at LAD, 4-9 at SD, 5-6 at SF, 1-2 at Oak, 1-2 at Sea).

**IN THE STANDINGS (120):** The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 46, FOURTH - 35, FIFTH - 28, SIXTH - 1...at **20-14** and **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g** over .500 at **36-24**...at **45-60** are **15g under .500** and **11.5g out of first place**, both season highs...have spent **64** days above, **15** days at and **41** days below .500.

**REDS vs CUBS:** The Reds are 1,050-1,082 all-time vs the Cubs, including 982-1,011 since 1900 and 3-7 this season...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 25-27, including 1-3 this season...4 Cubs batters rank in the Top 7 in home runs by an opponent at Great American Ball Park (**Lance Berkman** 21, **Albert Pujols** 15, **Jason Bay** 14, **Aramis Ramirez** 12, **Derrek Lee** 12, **Alfonso Soriano** 11, **Sammy Sosa** 10)...**last Cubs sweep:** at Cin: 4/26-4/27, 1995 (2g); 5/28-5/30, 2001 (3g)...at Chi: 7/21-7/22, 2004 (2g); 7/24-7/26, 2009 (3g).

**Last Pitched:** Thu vs SD and suffered the 7-4 loss (5ip, 9h, 6er, 2bb, 3k, 1hr, 96 pitches, 58 strikes)...left trailing, 6-1...allowed solo runs in the first and second innings and then 4 runs in the fifth on Headley's RBI-double and Venable's 3-run HR.

**Red Hots:** The 23-year-old righthander is making his 22nd start of the season, his third of the year vs the Cubs...in his 21 starts the Reds went 11-10 and scored 80 runs (3.81 r/g)...in 9 of his 21 starts threw at least 7.0 innings and in 16 of his 21 starts threw at least 6.0 innings.

**Quality:** With 12 quality starts is tied with **Bronson Arroyo** for the staff lead...his 2 strings of 5 consecutive QS (4/22-5/13, 5/24-6/14) are the longest stretches of quality starts by a Reds pitcher this season...last year, **Edinson Volquez** produced a string of 12 straight QS (4/22-6/20).

**Streaking:** Through 16 starts on 7/1 was 8-4, 2.69...in **5 starts since then is 0-4, 10.32** (22.2ip, 26er)...the 4-game losing streak is the longest of his young career...in 5 starts from 4/22-5/13 went **4-0, 1.25** (36ip, 5er)...the 4-game winning streak was the longest of his career...in each of 4 starts from 4/22-5/8 threw at least 7.0 innings while allowing no more than 1 run, the longest streak of that kind by a Reds pitcher since **Tim Belcher** had a 4-game run from **5/27-6/13, 1992** (courtesy Elias Sports Bureau).

**Home Cookin'**...For the season is **2-3, 4.20** in 9 starts at home (55.2ip, 26er, 8hr) and **6-5, 3.95** in 12 starts on the road (70.2ip, 31er, 10hr).

**World Baseball Classic:** Started the Dominican Republic's second game of the tournament and threw 4.2 scoreless innings to earn the 9-0 win vs Panama in the San Juan bracket (4.2ip, 3h, 1bb, 5k).
