Homestand Note

The Reds are **1-8** on this homestand (1-3 vs SD, 0-3 vs Col, 0-2 vs Chi)...never in their history have the Reds won fewer than 2g on a homestand of at least 10g...last went **2-8** on a homestand from **6/8-6/18, 2006** (courtesy Elias Sports Bureau).

Streaking

The Reds' **8-game losing streak** ties the **Great American Ball Park** record for consecutive *home* losses (8/5-8/16, 2008)...is their longest losing streak *overall* since an **8-game skid** from **4/27-5/6, 2005**...haven't lost more than 8 consecutive *home games* since an **0-9** stretch from **5/27-6/19, 2001** and haven't lost more than 8 straight decisions *overall* since an **11-game** losing streak from **6/14-6/24, 1998**...during this current streak the Reds have posted a **5.35** team ERA (74ip, 44er) while hitting **.181** (47-260) with **21 runs scored** (2.63 r/g).

On The Road, Again

On their most recent road trip (0-3 at LAD, 0-3 at Chi), **Reds pitchers** posted a 7.50era while **Reds batters** hit .204 with 20 runs scored (3.33 r/g)...the Reds led in 5 of the 6 losses...were winless on a road trip of at least 6g for the first time since **6/7-6/14, 2004** (0-3 at Oak, 0-3 at Cle, 0-1 at Phi)...the active **8-game road losing streak** is Cin's longest since an 8-game road skid from **5/31-6/15, 2005**.

Gametime Change

The starting time for the Reds' game against the Dodgers on **Sat, 8/29** at Great American Ball Park has been changed to **4:10 p.m. ET** to accommodate the **FOX** national broadcast...the game originally was scheduled to begin at 7:10.

Today's Transaction

RHP Jared Burton today was sent to Class A Dayton on a rehabilitation assignment...since 7/26 **Burton** has been on the 15-day disabled list with right shoulder fatigue...he is eligible to come off the DL on Sunday.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 3** (0-2) of a 3-game series vs **Jimmy Bank's** Cubs and **Game 10** (1-8) of a **10-game homestand**, the Reds' longest of the season (1-3 vs SD, 0-3 vs Col, **0-2 vs Chi**)...including tonight's game the Reds will finish the season with 28g at **Great American Ball Park** and 28g on the road...following this series the Reds embark on a 6-game road trip to **SF** (3g) and **StL** (3g).

DOT. DOT. DOT: Prior to tonight's game, Vietnam veteran and Purple Heart recipient **Ed Vlaikov** will throw out a ceremonial first pitch on behalf of the **Combat Wounded Veterans of the Military Order of the Purple Heart**...at **45-61** the Reds are **16 games under .500** and **12.5g out of first place**, both season highs...since the All-Star break are **3-16** and have **lost 7.5g** in the NL Central standings...at **40-0** the Reds club is the National League's only undefeated team when leading after 8 innings.

JET LAG: The Reds' upcoming road trip will include the third of their 3 scheduled visits to the **West Coast** (3g at SF, 3g at StL)...are **0-6** on the **West Coast** so far this season (0-3 at SD, 0-3 at LAD)...over the last 4 seasons the Redlegs are **11-31** (.262) on the **West Coast** (0-12 at LAD, 4-9 at SD, 5-6 at SF, 1-2 at Oak, 1-2 at Sea)...this stretch includes an active **12-game losing streak** at **Dodger Stadium**, where the Reds haven't won since their final appearance of **2005** (a 6-1 victory by **Brandon Claussen** on 7/28/05)...were swept in all four 3-game series there since then.

FIRST WATCH: The Reds have allowed **93 first inning runs**, the most in the Major Leagues (Bal 75, Mil 75, SD 73), and have been outscored in the opening frame, **93-56**...have allowed first-inning runs in 46 of their 106g this season.

MEDICAL UPDATES: **3B Scott Rolen** showed no signs of a concussion after he was hit in the helmet Sun by a **Jason Marquis** pitch...an MRI was normal...he did not play in either of the last 2g...**RHP Jared Burton** (DL, right shoulder fatigue) will begin a rehab assignment tonight at Dayton...**RHP Micah Owings** (DL, tight right shoulder) will throw a simulated game this afternoon...**OF Chris Dickerson** (DL, bruised right rotator cuff) is scheduled to take normal batting practice again today.

BATTING LEADER: **Joey Votto** is hitting .333 but missed 21g while on the disabled list and thus remains 22 plate apps shy of qualifying for the National League leaders...even with an 0-for-23, **Votto** would be hitting .307 to rank among the league leaders.

M*A*S*H: The Reds currently have **9 players on the disabled list**, including 7 players from their **Opening Day** roster: **C Ramon Hernandez** (left knee surgery), **RF Jay Bruce** (broken right wrist), **OF Chris Dickerson** (bruised right rotator cuff), **RHP Edinson Volquez** (right elbow surgery), **RHP Micah Owings** (tight right shoulder), **RHP Mike Lincoln** (cervical disc replacement surgery) and **RHP Jared Burton** (right shoulder fatigue)...also on the DL are **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (season-ending left shoulder surgery) and **IF Danny Richar** (season-ending left shoulder surgery).

OPENING DAY LINEUP: Because of injuries and trades, the Reds will finish the season with just **10g** (5-5) that included the projected **2009 Opening Day** lineup of **C Ramon Hernandez, 1B Joey Votto, 2B Brandon Phillips, 3B Edwin Encarnacion, SS Alex Gonzalez, RF Jay Bruce, CF Willy Taveras** and either **Chris Dickerson** or **Jerry Hairston Jr.** in LF...Reds manager **Dusty Baker** has produced **86 different lineups** in 106g.

SURGERIES: Six Reds players have had surgical procedures this season, including **C Ramon Hernandez** (cleaned out left knee), **SS Alex Gonzalez** (removed loose bodies, right elbow), **RHP Mike Lincoln** (cervical disc replacement), **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder), **IF Danny Richar** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder) and **RHP Edinson Volquez** (repaired torn ulnar collateral ligament and torn flexor mass, right elbow)...**Castillo, Richar** and **Volquez** will not play again the rest of the season.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (23-30 .434): The Reds have lost their last 8 home games, tying the ballpark record for consecutive home losses (8/5-8/16, 2008)...including this series went **5-10-3 in their 18 home series**...including this one produced a winning record on just 2 of their 9 homestands (2-3, 2-4, **3-2, 6-3**, 1-2, 3-3, 3-3, 2-2, 1-8)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **264-275-1**...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38)...at **217-217-1** the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since **6/26/04** (57-57)...also reached .500 at **219-219-1**.

REDS ON THE ROAD (22-31, .407): The Reds went 0-6 on their most recent road trip (0-3 at LAD, 0-3 at Chi)...have lost their last 8 road games, a season high, and 10 of their last 11 road games...went **7-8-2 in their 17 road series**...produced a winning or .500 record on 4 of their 8 road trips (**7-3, 3-2, 3-3**, 2-5, 2-4, **3-3**, 2-5, 0-6)...entering this season and dating to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

IN THE STANDINGS (121): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 46, FOURTH - 35, FIFTH - 29, SIXTH - 1...at **20-14** and **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g** over .500 at **36-24**...at **45-61** are **16g under .500** and **12.5g out of first place**, both season highs...have spent **64** days above, **15** days at and **42** days below .500.

REDS vs CUBS: The Reds are 1,050-1,083 all-time vs the Cubs, including 982-1,012 since 1900 and 3-8 this season...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 25-28, including 1-4 this season...4 Cubs batters rank in the Top 8 in home runs by an opponent at Great American Ball Park (**Lance Berkman** 21, **Albert Pujols** 15, **Jason Bay** 14, **Derrek Lee** 13, **Aramis Ramirez** 12, **Alfonso Soriano** 11, **Geoff Jenkins** 11, **Sammy Sosa** 10)...**last Cubs sweep:** at Cin: 5/28-5/30, 2001 (3g)...at Chi: 7/24-7/26, 2009 (3g).

UP NEXT: REDS vs GIANTS: Reds are 910-1,117 all-time vs the Giants franchise, including 5-1 last season...won the last 5g vs SF...**at AT&T Park:** Reds are 14-19, including 2-1 last season.

Last Pitched: Fri vs Col and received no decision in the 5-3 loss (5ip, 4h, 3er, 6bb, 0k, 0hr, 97 pitches, 52 strikes)...left with the score tied, 3-3...was his first Major League appearance since **5/22/06 for Mil at Cin** and his first career big league start...in the first inning allowed 2 runs on 3 hits, a walk and an error.

Red Hots: Last name is pronounced LERR...is making his second start of the season...Fri's no-decision in the 5-3 loss vs Col was his first Major League appearance since **5/22/06 for Mil at Cin** and his first career big league start...recorded his last Major League victory on **5/18/06 vs Phi** (5-4 Brewers win)...media guide bio is available in the press box.

2009 Season: In December was signed by the Phillies to a minor league contract and began the season with Class AAA Lehigh Valley (8g, 7gs, 5-2, 4.75)...on 5/22 was traded to the Reds in exchange for cash...went 8-1, 2.51 in 11 starts and 1 relief appearance at Class AAA Louisville before he was promoted on 8/1 to take the spot in the rotation vacated by **RHP Micah Owings**, who went on the disabled list with a tight right shoulder...overall at Class AAA went **13-3, 3.31** in 18 starts and 2 relief apps...when promoted, his 13 victories tied for the most among all minor league pitchers...twice was International League Pitcher of the Week, from **4/13-4/19** for Lehigh Valley (2gs, 2-0, 1.59) and from **7/20-7/26** for Louisville (2gs, 2-0, 1.88).

Career Highlights: Prior to this season had made all 66 of his Major League apps in relief...was International League Pitcher of the Week twice in 2009 and once in 2008...in 2007 was a Pacific Coast League All-Star and started the Triple-A All-Star Game...in 2000 was a California League All-Star.

Friday at Giants: RHP Homer Bailey

Last Pitched: Sat vs Col and suffered the 6-2 loss (5.1ip, 7h, 5er, 2bb, 4k, 1hr, 100 pitches, 65 strikes)...left trailing, 5-2...allowed 3 runs in the fourth inning on a 2-ruin single to Stewart and a sac fly to Gonzalez...in the fifth allowed a solo HR to Smith and in the sixth gave up a run-scoring double to Tulowitzki.

Red Hots: Fri at SF will make his ninth start of the season, his eighth since his second promotion...**in 7 starts since he rejoined the rotation on 6/27 is 2-3, 6.46 (39ip, 28er)**...in his 8 starts overall the Reds went 2-6 and scored 36 runs (4.50 r/g)...has 3 quality starts...once was the victim of a blown save...has walked 24 batters, 12 scored.

2009 Season: Began the year at Class AAA Louisville, where he went 3-5, 4.57 with 2 complete games and a shutout in 8 starts before he was promoted on 5/22...started the 7-6 loss vs Cle on 5/23, then was optioned back to Louisville the next day...made 6 more starts for the Bats (5-0, 0.81) before he was recalled again to start on 6/27 at Cle..

At Louisville: In 14 apps for the Bats produced 11 quality starts, including quality starts in each of his last 7 apps (5-1, 1.07, 50.1ip, 47h, 6er, 12bb, 45k)...in his first start of the season allowed a season-high 8 earned runs in 5.1 innings (13.50era) and in his last 13 starts posted a 2.03era (84.1ip, 19er)...**for the Bats, in 6 starts between his 5/22 and 6/27 promotions went 5-0, 0.81**...twice was named the International League's **Pitcher of the Week**.
